**THE TWINS:** Finished their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5, going 2-1 against San Diego and 0-4 against Chicago-AL...tonight, they will begin a six-game roadtrip with the first of three against the Royals over the weekend, followed by three in Anaheim against the Angels from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ The Twins went 2-4 on their last roadtrip, going 1-2 at Chicago-AL (August 22-24) and 1-2 at Toronto (August 25-27).

**TWINS SWEEPED OUT OF MINNESOTA:** The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 11-8 at Target Field, suffering the four-game sweep, their first at the hands of the White Sox in Minnesota in the history of the two clubs...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 15 hits and were led by Luke Keaschall's first career four-hit game...Austin Martin reached a career-high-tying four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk and Trevor Larnach reached three times, going 3-for-5...Matt Wallner hit his 50th career home run.

**LIFE OF PABLO** The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Pablo López from his rehab assignment and have reinstated him from the 60-day Injured List...López, who was placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 4 with a grade 2 strain of the teres major muscle in his right shoulder, recently made three starts on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA (11.1 IP, 4 ER), two walks and 14 strikeouts...prior to sustaining the injury, he went 5-3 with a 2.82 ERA (60.2 IP, 19 ER), 14 walks, 61 strikeouts and a .225 (51-for-227) opponent batting average in 11 starts for the Twins this season...he threw about 2-3 warm-up pitches on June 3 in Sacramento and felt tightness in his shoulder and had to be removed.

☞ To make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins have outrighted right-handed pitcher Noah Davis...Davis was recalled by the Twins on Monday and made two relief appearances during his most recent stint, allowing five runs (4 ER) on six hits, with no walks and three strikeouts in 2.0 innings pitched.

**LAKES TO FOUNTAINS:** The Twins are playing the 11th of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 5-5 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 4-2 at Target Field.

☞ These two last faced each other for three games from August 8-10 at Target Field, as the Twins won two of three.

☞ These two last faced each other at Kauffman for four games from April 7-10 as the Twins won just one game.

☞ Twins are 33-22 against the Royals since the start of 2022.

☞ Twins are 33-20 in their last 53 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 61-42 vs. Kansas City...61 wins are his most against any opponent.

☞ This season, Ryan Jeffers is 11-for-28 (.393) with two doubles and three walks against KC.

☞ Matt Wallner has reached safely in 13-straight starts against the Royals, posting a .397 on-base percentage in that span.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .310 (45-for-145) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 33 runs scored and a .965 OPS in his last 39 games against the Royals.

☞ Last series vs. KC, Luke Keaschall went 6-for-13 (.462) with one double, one home run and four RBI...he won the finale with a two-run walk-off home run off Carlos Estévez.

**BYE BYE BYRON:** Byron Buxton enters tonight's game with 162 home runs for his career, tied with Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...one more will pass Sanó and tie Tom Brunansky:

**STICKY FINGERS:** The Twins have stolen 18 bases in their last nine games...since August 12, they have stolen 27 bases in 33 attempts...in that span, they are tied with New York-AL for second in baseball, trailing New York-NL (32)...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 84 this season...in lower right margin are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli.

**STRIKE UP THE BAND:** Twins pitchers struck out 40 Sox hitters over the four-game series, giving them 1,177 strikeouts on the season, eighth-most in club history (since 1961)...the current team is on pace to strike out 1,361, which would land fifth-most in Twins history.

**SO MANY TREVORS:** Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a career-high 15-straight games...the long for a Twin this season was 24 by Ty France, from May 16-June 13...during the streak, Larnach is hitting .375 (21-for-56) with four doubles, seven RBI, seven walks, a .444 on-base percentage and an .891 OPS.

**LUKE WHO'S ON BASE AGAIN:** Luke Keaschall set a career-high with four hits last night and has now reached safely in 30 of 33 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .418 on the season, reaching base 59 times (40 hits, 16 walks, 3 hit-by-pitch) in 141 plate appearances, most in Twins history (1961-) through a player's first 33 career games...he leads all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 125 plate appearances).

**GET YOUR ROLL ON:** Double-A Wichita infielder Kaelen Culppepper hit his 20th home run of the season last night against Tulsa, becoming one of three Twins minor leaguers to post a 20/20 season (also 24 stolen bases)...he joins Triple-A St. Paul's Kyler Fedko (26 HR/33 SB) and Wichita teammate Kala'i Rosario (25 HR/25 SB).

- ⚔ Making 12th major league start of the season and 170th career start...first start back in the majors since being placed on the Injured List...ninth career start against Kansas City.
- ⚔ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 5 (retroactive to June 4), then transferred to the 60-day Injured List on June 11 due to a Grade 2 right teres major strain...pitched three games on rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints...went 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA (11.1 IP, 4 ER), two walks, 14 strikeouts and a .304 (14-for-46) opponent batting average.
- ⚔ In eight career starts against the Royals, López has gone 5-1, posting a 2.16 ERA (50.0 IP, 12 ER) with five walks, 56 strikeouts and a .226 (42-for-186) opponent batting average.

**DO YOU REMEMBER... THE VERY FIRST START OF SEPTEMBER:** López missed 80 games and spent 92 days on the Injured List, the longest IL stint of his major league career...second longest of his professional career (missed entirety of 2014 minor league season with the Mariners due to Tommy John surgery)...pitched three games on a rehab assignment with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints:

- ⚔ First start was on August 21 vs. the Round Rock Express, opposite Carl Edwards Jr., where he was dealt the loss in St. Paul's 0-6, shutout defeat...allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in 1.2 innings...his fastball averaged 94.3 and topped out and 95.3...recorded a 32 pitch first inning, then exited in the second after two outs with a runner on first.
- ⚔ Second start on August 26 at Toledo, opposite former Twin Randy Dobnak, where he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 5-4 victory over the Mud Hens...allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts over 4.0 innings...permitted three consecutive hits to start the game, a double to Hao-Yu Lee, an RBI triple to Akil Baddoo and an RBI single to Justyn-Henry Malloy...also allowed a solo home run to Gage Workman in the second...his fastball averaged 93.8 and topped out at 95.2.
- ⚔ Returned to Toledo for his third and final rehab start in the Saints' series finale against the Mud Hens, once again opposite Randy Dobnak...he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 1-2, walk-off defeat...allowed four hits with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.2 shutout innings...went hitless through 2.0 innings to start the game before giving up a single to Kevin Newman...his fastball averaged 93.9 and topped out at 95.6.

**LAST TIME OUT IN THE MAJORS:** Last pitched in the majors on June 3 at the Athletics, opposite Grant Holman, where he earned his fifth win of the season in Minnesota's 10-3 victory...allowed two runs on four hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings...permitted an RBI single to Brent Rooker in the first, scoring Lawrence Butler, and a sacrifice fly to Shea Langeliers in the third, scoring Tyler Soderstrom...left the game after the fifth inning due to a right shoulder strain and was subsequently placed on the IL.

- ⚔ Recorded his first pickoff of the season and fourth of his career, throwing out Max Schuemann at first in the fourth inning.

**ROYAL TREATMENT:** López is 5-1 in eight career starts against Kansas City, posting a 2.16 ERA (50.0 IP, 12 ER) with five walks, 56 strikeouts and a .226 (42-for-186) opponent batting average...five wins are tied for his most against any opponent (also, 5-5 against New York-NL).

- ⚔ His five wins against the Royals are tied for his most against any opponent, the other being the New York Mets against whom his record is 5-5...his .833 win percentage is his highest among opponents he has faced at least six times.
- ⚔ He is undefeated at Kauffman Stadium, going 2-0 in three starts in his career, posting a 0.53 ERA (17.0 IP, 1 ER) with one home run, four walks and 21 strikeouts...is one of two opposing ballparks in which he has played in at least twice and never lost, the other being American Family Field in Milwaukee in which he is 2-0 with 0.00 ERA in three career starts.
- ⚔ In two starts against Kansas City this season (April 8 and May 23), Pablo has posted a 0.87 ERA (10.1 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.80 ERA (213.0 IP, 90 ER), 10.35 K/9, 1.94 BB/9 and 0.93 HR/9 in 36 starts at home, compared to 18-13 with a 3.49 ERA (239.2 IP, 93 ER), 9.69 K/9, 2.25 BB/9 and 1.24 HR/9 in 41 road starts.

- ⚔ In his seven starts on the road this season, López has gone 3-3, posting a 2.54 ERA (39.0 IP, 11 ER) with nine walks and 33 strikeouts; compared to 2-0, 3.32 ERA (21.2 IP, 8 ER), with five walks and 28 strikeouts in his four home starts this season.

**PLATOON SPLITS:** Through 11 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .282/.318/.403 in 124 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .155/.226/.272 in 103 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 87.4 mph and a whiff rate of 23.2 compared to righties' 87.3 mph and 29.9 percent.

- ⚔ He has an all-time low 26.0 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters, compared to a all-time high 37.5 percent hard hit rate against left-handed batters.

**THE ARSENAL:** López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer almost 43% of the time...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⚔ Has a 7.0 foot extension, ranking in the 93rd percentile and a 32.5 hard-hit percentage, ranking in the 93rd percentile, but ranks bottom four percentile in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.
- ⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sweepers, Pablo has the 10th lowest hard hit percentage at 17.2 percent and 10th in slugging percentage (.150).
