**THE TWINS:** After finishing their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5 (2-1 against San Diego and 0-4 against Chicago-AL), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a loss in Kansas City last night...tonight, they will play the second of three against the Royals over the weekend...after tomorrow afternoon's finale, Minnesota will travel to Anaheim to play a three-game series from Monday-Wednesday.

**TWINS WELCOME BACK THE BIG MAN:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 2-1, extending their losing streak to five games...Pablo López (5-4) made his return from the IL and was the starter, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...his only runs allowed came on a Maikel Garcia two-run homer in the third inning...Kody Funderburk and Justin Topa each pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief...the offense recorded five hits and scored their only run on a Johnny Pereda double in the fifth inning.

**35W SHOWDOWN:** The Twins are playing the 12th of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 5-6 against the Royals, going 1-4 at Kauffman and 4-2 at Target Field. ☞ Twins need to win each of these next two games to win the season-series...Twins haven't lost a season-series to the Royals since 2021, when they went 9-10...12-7 in 2022, 9-4 in 2023 and 7-6 in 2024.

☞ Twins have 195 wins all-time at Kauffman Stadium, their most in any opposing ballpark in their history (since 1961).

☞ Twins are 33-21 in their last 54 overall against the Royals, dating back to April of 2022. ☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 61-43 vs. Kansas City...61 wins are his most against any opponent.

☞ This season, Ryan Jeffers is 11-for-28 (.393) with two doubles and three walks against KC. ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .302 (45-for-149) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 33 runs scored and a .940 OPS in his last 40 games against the Royals.

☞ Over his last 21 games at Kauffman Stadium, Buxton is hitting .316 (25-for-79) with 11 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBI and a .955 OPS.

☞ This season vs. KC, Luke Keaschall has gone 7-for-17 (.412) with one double, one home run and four RBI.

☞ The Twins' only win at Kauffman this season was a 4-0 shutout on April 9 started by Joe Ryan...in that start, Ryan went 7.0 innings, allowing two hits, no walks and four strikeouts...in 10 career starts vs. the Royals, Ryan is 8-0, 1.34 ERA (60.1 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks, 64 strikeouts and a .166 opponent batting average.

**BUCK SHOTS:** Byron Buxton enters tonight's game with 162 home runs for his career, tied with Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...one more will pass Sanó and tie Tom Brunansky:

**ALSO:** At 29 home runs and 21 stolen bases, one more home run and he will join Kirby Puckett (1986-31 HR, 20 SB) as the only players in club history with a 30/20 season.

**NO TROUBLE FOR TREVOR:** Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in 16-straight games, extending his career-long...the long for a Twin this season was 24 by Ty France, from May 16-June 13...during the streak, Larnach is hitting .367 (22-for-60) with four doubles, seven RBI, seven walks, a .433 on-base percentage and an .866 OPS.

☞ After his eighth inning single last night, he has hit safely in seven-straight, one short of his career-high of eight, done from May 27-June 4.

**GRAND THEFT:** The Twins have stolen 19 bases in their last 10 games...since August 12, they have stolen 28 bases in 34 attempts...in that span, they rank second in baseball, trailing New York-NL (34)...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 85 this season...below are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli.

**TURN KEA TO START:** Luke Keaschall has hit safely in five-straight games...he has now reached safely in 31 of 34 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .414 on the season, reaching base 60 times (41 hits, 16 walks, 3 hit-by-pitch) in 145 plate appearances, most in Twins history (1961-) through a player's first 34 career games...he leads all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 125 plate appearances).

**PITCH PALS:** Twins have 1,183 strikeouts on the season, eighth-most in club history (since 1961)...the current team is on pace to strike out 1,359, which would land fifth-most in Twins history...below are the club's all-time strikeouts rankings per season:

**SERIES CONVERSATIONS:** Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to win their 18th series of the season...Minnesota is 17-26-2 in series play, going 11-10-2 at home and 6-16-0 on the road. ☞ Twins have gone 2-1-0 in series play against the Royals this season...their one series loss was at Kauffman Stadium, from April 7-10, winning just one of four games.

☞ Other than the recent series win against San Diego (August 29-31), the Royals were the last team the Twins won a series against (August 8-10).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2002, Brad Radke pitched the Twins to a 6-0 victory at the Metrodome, beating the A's and snapping Oakland's 20-game win streak...Radke pitched a complete-game shutout with six hits allowed and one walk...in 2016, the Twins lost 10-3 to the Royals at Target Field, but Brian Dozier homered in his fifth-straight game, tying a team record, giving him 39 on the season and tying the American League record for a second baseman set by Alfonso Soriano (2003).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his career-high-tying 13th win of the season on August 31 vs. San Diego, opposite David Morgan, in a 7-2 Twins victory...threw 7.0 scoreless innings with five hits and one walk allowed, while striking out eight batters...marked his first outing since July 11 vs. Pittsburgh in which he did not allow a run through the first three innings...marked his fifth scoreless outing and his career-high-tying 14th quality start of the season...104 pitches set a season-high and were his most in an outing since he threw 110 on July 6, 2024 vs. Houston.

☞ Became the third pitcher in baseball this season to strike out four-or-more batters in each of their first 27 games of the season (also Sonny Gray and Garrett Crochet)...his 100 career games with four-or-more strikeouts are tied with Kevin Tapani for the 14th most in Twins history.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Took his seventh loss of the season on August 25 at Toronto, opposite Max Scherzer, in Minnesota's 4-10 loss...has lost back-to-back starts for the fifth time in his career and the first time since June 1-7, 2024...allowed a season-high-tying six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...gave up four runs in the first inning on two singles, a double and a two-run home run by Alejandro Kirk...other runs scored on a second-inning solo shot by Andrés Giménez and a fourth-inning RBI single by George Springer.

**KING OF KANSAS CITY:** In 10 career starts against the Royals, Ryan is 8-0 with a 1.34 ERA (60.1 IP, 9 ER), 11 walks and 64 strikeouts...in two starts so far this season against KC, he has gone 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER), no walks and nine strikeouts; batters have gone just 6-for-40 (.150) with one double, one home run and one hit-by-pitch.

☞ Among pitchers with 10-or-more starts all-time against the Royals, Ryan's ERA and 0.76 WHIP rank first, and his .166 (35-for-211) opponent batting average ranks second.

**JOE ON THE ROAD:** In 13 road starts this season, is 6-3 with a 2.97 ERA (78.2 IP, 26 ER), 11 home runs allowed, 13 walks and 80 strikeouts, compared to 7-4 with a 3.18 ERA (76.1 IP, 27 ER), eight home runs allowed, 17 walks and 94 strikeouts...in 54 career road starts, is 20-17 with a 3.84 ERA, a 4.97 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .230 opponent batting average.

☞ Is making his sixth career start at Kauffman Stadium...earned the win in his last start at the ballpark on April 9, throwing 7.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts.

☞ Among pitchers with five-or-more starts all-time at Kauffman, Ryan's 0.90 ERA (30.0 IP, 3 ER), 0.70 WHIP and .147 (15-for-102) opponent batting average rank first.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties have slashed .243/.289/.419 with 17 doubles, 11 home runs, 14 walks and 69 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .180/.239/.303 with 11 doubles, eight home runs, 16 walks and 105 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .216/.274/.376 with 76 walks and 278 strikeouts (3.66 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.271/.417 with 63 walks and 421 strikeouts (6.68 K/BB).

☞ His .180 BAA against righties ranks third among all qualified pitchers in baseball this season... among the same pitchers, his 6.56 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks fifth and his .542 opponent OPS vs. righties ranks seventh.

**THE ARSENAL:** Through 27 appearances (26 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:
