THE TWINS: After finishing their seven-game homestand with a record of 2-5 (2-1 against San Diego and 0-4 against Chicago-AL), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with consecutive losses in Kansas City on Friday and Saturday night...today, they will play the three-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium and their last against the Royals in 2025...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Anaheim to play a three-game series from Monday-Wednesday. **☞** Twins are looking to win their first game since 7-1 victory last Sunday, August 31 vs. San Diego...their six-game losing streak matches their season-long (previously June 12-18)... their last seven-game losing streak was May 14-20, 2024 (also 7).

KANSAS CITY MISERY: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 11-2...the loss marked Minnesota's 27th series defeat of the season (17-26-2)... Joe Ryan (13-8) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on four hits on a career-low tying 2.0 innings pitched (also 8/7/24 at CHC)...he allowed each of the first five Royals batters to reach base and score, including a three-run homer to Salvador Perez...the offense recorded seven hits, walked twice and struck out seven times.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed catcher Ryan Jeffers on the 7-day Concussion Injured List...additionally, they have recalled outfielder Carson McCusker and right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl from Triple-A St. Paul, and have designated right-handed pitcher Brooks Kriske for release or assignment.

☞ Jeffers, who sustained the injury Thursday against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, has hit .262 (101-for-386) with 24 doubles, nine home runs, 44 RBI, 48 walks, 47 runs scored and a .747 OPS in 114 games for the Twins this season.

☞ McCusker, who will be making his third stint with the Twins this season, has played in 106 games for the Saints in 2025, hitting .246 (96-for-390) with 25 doubles, 22 home runs, 70 RBI, 57 runs scored, a .316 on-base percentage, a .479 slugging percentage and a .795 OPS...in his previous two stints with the Twins this season, he hit .222 (2-for-9) in six games.

☞ Ohl, who will be making his second stint with the Twins this season, recently made two appearances (1 start) for St. Paul, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts from August 30-September 4...in his first stint with Minnesota from July 29-August 24, he went 0-3 with a 5.66 ERA (20.2 IP, 13 ER) with five walks and 16 strikeouts.

☞ Kriske, who was claimed off waivers from the Chicago Cubs on August 5, made 16 appearances for the Twins, going 0-1 with a 7.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 15 ER), 15 walks and 18 strikeouts.

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins and Royals are playing for the 13th and final time this season... Minnesota is 5-7 against the Royals, going 1-5 at Kauffman and 4-2 at Target Field.

☞ Last night's loss, secured the season-series for the Royals, marking the Twins first loss in a season to KC since 2021 (9-10).

☞ These two will meet for the first time in 2026 for three games at Kauffman Stadium, from March 30-April 2...Twins will host the Royals for the first time, from June 5-7 (3 games).

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .301 (46-for-153) with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI, 34 runs scored and a .942 OPS in his last 41 games against the Royals...however, he has just one hit in 16 at-bats against KC this season.

BUCK BOMBS: Byron Buxton enters today's game with 162 home runs for his career, tied with Miguel Sanó for 11th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...Buck's last homer came last Sunday vs. San Diego, off Kyle Hart...one more homer will pass Sanó and tie Tom Brunansky:

ALSO: At 29 home runs and 21 stolen bases, one more home run and he will join Kirby Puckett (1986 - 31 HR, 20 SB) as the only players in club history with a 30/20 season.

KEA HITTER: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in six-straight games...his season/career-high is seven, done from August 13-20...during the current streak, Keaschall is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with four RBI, two walks and an .861 OPS...he leads all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage (minimum of 125 plate appearances).

STAFF ON STRIKE: Twins have 1,189 strikeouts on the season, eighth-most in club history (since 1961)...below are the club's all-time strikeouts rankings per season:

HOT WHEELS: The Twins have stolen 19 bases in their last 11 games...since August 12, they have stolen 28 bases in 34 attempts...in that span, they rank third in baseball, trailing New York-NL (36) and New York-AL (29)...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 85 this season...in the right margin are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli.

FINAL DESTINATIONS: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the seventh time this season...the other six were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15), three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22), three games vs. the Athletics (August 19-21) and four games vs. Chicago-AL (September 1-4).

☞ Other than those six sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale and avoided a sweep seven times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati, July 20 at Colorado, August 3 at Cleveland, August 13 at New York-AL and August 17 vs. Detroit.

☞ The last time the Twins were swept by the Royals was September 6-8, 2024 in three games at Kauffman Stadium.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Billy Amick and right-handed pitcher Jose Olivares have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Amick, 22, played in seven games for the kernels, hitting .480 (12-for-25) with four doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, five walks and a 1.461 OPS...the Mooresville, NC native was selected by the Twins in the second round (60th overall) in the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Tennessee.

☞ Olivares, 22, made the start on Tuesday at Quad Cities, allowing one run on one hit in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts...the Altamira de Orituco, VZ native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2021.

- ☞ Last started on September 1 vs. Chicago-AL, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-6 defeat...allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR) with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- ☞ Ober is 0-5 with a 5.00 ERA (63.0 IP, 35 ER), nine walks, 56 strikeouts and a .292 (75-for-257) opponent batting average in 13 career starts against the White Sox.
- ☞ Looking to snap his career-high six-decision loss streak and earn his first win since May 3 at Boston.

ROCK 'EM SOX 'EM: Last pitched on September 1 vs. Chicago-AL, opposite Fraser Ellard; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-6 defeat...allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...allowed a sacrifice fly to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and an RBI single to Alejandro Kirk in the first, a solo homer to George Springer in the second, and a solo homer to Springer in the fifth...his second longball to Springer marked his 100th career home run allowed.

- ☞ Is the only pitcher in Twins history (1961-) with 125-or-fewer innings pitched and 24-or-more home runs allowed in a single season.
- ☞ Is one of four pitchers to have nine-plus multi-homer games this season; also, Jake Irvin (11), Seth Lugo (10), and Zack Littell (9)...is the only one of those four to have done so in less than 25 games.

BIRDS ON THE BRAIN: Last pitched on August 26 at Toronto, opposite Chris Bassitt; he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-5 victory...allowed four runs on 10 hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...allowed a sacrifice fly to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and an RBI single to Alejandro Kirk in the first, a solo homer to George Springer in the second, and a solo homer to Springer in the fifth...his second longball to Springer marked his 100th career home run allowed.

A ROYAL PAIN: Ober is 0-5 in 13 career starts against the Royals, posting a 5.00 ERA (63.0 IP, 35 ER) with nine walks and 56 strikeouts...Kansas City is one of two teams he has faced four-plus times and never recorded a win (also the Cincinnati Reds)...his first start against the Royals on June 6, 2021 marked the second game of his rookie season and first on the road.

- ☞ Last faced the Royals on August 9 at Target Field where he allowed one run on four hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings.
- ☞ Despite his career numbers vs. KC, over his last three starts against the Royals, he has posted a 1.05 ERA (25.2 IP, 3 ER) with three walks, no home runs and 18 strikeouts.
- ☞ His .292 (75-for-257) opponent batting average is his highest among opponents he has faced at least four times, and his ERA is his third highest, behind the Texas Rangers (7.32) and Cincinnati Reds (6.23), both of which he has faced four times.
- ☞ Against the Royals, Ober has allowed career-high hits (75), earned runs (35) and triples (3), as well as the third highest number of home runs (10)...has allowed the second highest batting average among American League opponents (.292), behind the Houston Astros (.298).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Ober has gone 16-13 with a 4.11 ERA (304.1 IP, 139 ER), 8.93 K/9, 2.16 BB/9 and 1.72 HR/9 in 58 games (57 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.14 ERA (295.1 IP, 136 ER), 8.69 K/9, 1.71 BB/9 and 1.46 HR/9 in 55 road starts.

- ☞ Ober is 2-3, 6.02 ERA (52.1 IP, 35 ER) with 13 home runs, 11 walks, 39 strikeouts and a .324 (72-for-222) opponent batting average in 10 road starts this season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 23 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .290/.324/.529 in 275 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .277/.319/.513 in 261 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.9 mph and a whiff rate of 20.6 compared to righties' 92.0 mph and 26.7 percent.

- ☞ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at its highest since 2021, 30.4 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 50.3 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 36.7% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
