THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their six-game roadtrip, dropping consecutive games in Kansas City on Friday and Saturday night, followed by a win in the finale on Sunday afternoon...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three against the Angels in Anaheim and conclude the series/roadtrip on Wednesday afternoon.

GREAT WIN, THROW ON YOUR FOOTBALL JERSEY: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-1, avoiding the three-game sweep and snapping their six-game losing streak...Bailey Ober (5-7) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...he retired each of his first nine batters and 14 of his first 15...the bullpen pitched 3.0 scoreless innings of relief as Genesis Cabrera earned his fifth career save...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by homers from Byron Buxton (30) and Kody Clemens (16).

For the flight to California postgame, Twins players and staff did their annual NFL jersey trip...highlights included: Hank Conger - He Hate Me (XFL), Ryan Fitzgerald - Pat Tillman, Rocco Baldelli - Alan Page, Kody Funderburk - Jared Allen...overall 14 Vikings jerseys were represented...several players weren't necessarily NFL fans so Royals visiting clubbies ran across the street to Arrowhead to buy a handful at the Chiefs team store.

SEND ME AN ANGEL: The Twins and Angels are playing the fourth of six games in 2025...the Twins hosted the Angels for three games from April 25-27, sweeping in three games...in that series, they outscored Los Angeles 21-5.

Minnesota's last visit to Anaheim was April 26-28, 2024, sweeping in three games...they were wins number four, five and six of their 12-game winning streak, from April 22-May 4.

Minnesota has gone 9-1 in their last 10 against the Angels, dating back to September of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +44 (80-36).

Since the start of last season, the Twins are hitting .324 (101-for-312) with 7.9 runs-per-game and a .930 OPS in nine games against Los Angeles-AL.

The Twins current five-game winning streak vs. the Angels is their longest since also winning five, from May 14-23, 2019...a win tonight would mark their longest since winning eight straight, from June 3-September 7, 1996.

Trevor Larnach has hit safely in seven-straight vs. the Angels, hitting .440 (11-for-25) with eight RBI, six walks and a 1.148 OPS in that span.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: The Twins have gone 12-7 against California teams this season, going 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL (April 25-27), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 3-4 against the Athletics (June 2-5 & August 19-21), 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-24) and 2-1 vs. San Diego (August 29-31).

WE DO TALK ABOUT BRUNO: Byron Buxton hit his 163rd career home run yesterday, passing Miguel Sanó and tying Tom Brunansky for 10th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

BYE BYE BYRON: Yesterday's homer for Byron Buxton marked the 30th time in club history that a Twin has hit 30 home runs in a season...he became the 20th different Twin on that list and first since Miguel Sanó (30) and Jorge Polanco (33) in 2021.

At 30 home runs and 21 stolen bases, Buxton joined Kirby Puckett (1986 - 31 HR, 20 SB) as the only players in club history with a 30/20 season...he is one of four players in baseball with those numbers, joining Julio Rodriguez (30 HR, 25 SB), Juan Soto (38 HR, 29 SB) and Corbin Carroll (30 HR, 25 SB).

ONE-NOTHING: Byron Buxton hit his 17th career leadoff home run yesterday in Kansas City...he has eight leadoff home runs on the season, fourth-most in baseball (Ohtani - 12, Neto - 9, Lindor - 9)...Buck is also tied with Brian Dozier (8 in 2017) for the second-most single-season leadoff homers in Twins history (1961-), behind Jacque Jones (11 in 2002)...below are the all-time Twins leadoff homer leaders:

HOT WHEELS: Since August 12, the Twins have stolen 31 bases in 37 attempts, tied for second in baseball with New York-AL and trailing New York-NL (36) in that span...in 2024, the Twins stole 65 bases; they already have 88 this season...in the right margin are stolen bases by year under Rocco Baldelli...they have 21 steals in their last 11 games, their most in any 11-game span since 1965...below are the game-by-game stolen bases over the last 11 games:

KEA CONTRIBUTIONS: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in seven-straight games, matching his season/career-high, previously done from August 13-20...during the current streak, Keaschall is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with four RBI, two walks and an .812 OPS...overall, he leads all rookies in baseball in on-base percentage at .405 (minimum of 125 plate appearances).

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis recorded two hits yesterday, giving him 71 on the season, extending his single-season career-high (68 in 2024)...over his last seven games, Lewis is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with one double, one home run, four RBI, one walk, a .345 on-base percentage, a .464 slugging percentage and an .809 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN PAUL MOLITOR HISTORY: On this day in 1998, Paul Molitor hit the penultimate home run of his career in this ballpark, off Allen Watson, a two-out solo shot in the seventh inning, en route to a Twins 5-0 victory...Mollie's final homer came on September 19 of that season, at Detroit, off Frank Castillo...the homer against the Angels was his one hit that day and extended his hitting streak to nine games, eventually finishing the streak at 17 games.

- ☞ Last started on September 2 vs. Chicago-AL where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-12 defeat...allowed three runs (2 earned) on two hits (1 HR), with three walks and a season-high-tying seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work.
- ☞ In his lone start vs. Los Angeles-AL earlier this season on April 26, Woods Richardson earned the win in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work.

ROCK 'EM, SOX 'EM: Last pitched on September 2 vs. Chicago-AL, opposite Davis Martin, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-12 defeat...allowed three runs (2 earned) on two hits (1 HR), with three walks and a season-high-tying seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings...gave up a solo home run to Andrew Benintendi in the second, then a two-run double in the fifth, scoring Brooks Baldwin and Will Robertson...Baldwin scored on a throwing error by Woods Richardson, his second error of the season (also, July 28 vs. Boston).

- ☞ First time pitching at least 5.0 innings since July 8.
- ☞ Fanned seven total batters, tying his season high, previously done on April 26 vs. the Los Angeles Angels.

SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW, SOMETHING BORROWED, SOMETHING BLUE: Pitched on August 27 at Toronto, opposite Eric Lauer, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-9 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits (career-high 3 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 3.2 innings...permitted a solo homer to Davis Schneider in the second, a two-run single to Bo Bichette in the third, and solo homers to Schneider and Andrés Giménez in the fourth before being replaced by Thomas Hatch.

FALLEN ANGELS: Woods Richardson has faced Los Angeles-AL just once in his career, earlier this season on April 26 at Target Field...he earned the win in Minnesota's 5-1 victory; allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and a season-high seven strikeouts...only run allowed was a solo home to Zach Neto in the third...is just one of two games this season in which he has not walked a batter (also, April 13 vs. Detroit).

- ☞ SWR is 3-1 in nine career starts against American League West opponents...has posted a 3.57 ERA (45.1 IP, 18 ER) with 16 walks and 44 strikeouts.
- ☞ His .177 (29-for-164) opponent batting average against the AL West is his best against any division, followed by the AL Central (.232).

THEIR NECK OF THE WOODS: In his career, Sim has gone 5-4 with a 4.12 ERA (118.0 IP, 54 ER), 8.54 K/9, 3.43 BB/9 and 1.07 HR/9 in 24 games (23 starts) at home compared to 5-6 with a 4.71 ERA (114.2 IP, 60 ER), 7.14 K/9, 3.77 BB/9 and 1.57 HR/9 in 25 road games (24 starts).

- ☞ He is 1-2 in nine games (8 starts) on the road so far this season, posting a 5.95 ERA (39.1 IP, 26 ER) with 23 walks, 33 strikeouts and a .267 (40-for-150) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through 19 major league games in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .267/.351/.435 in 161 at-bats vs. Woods Richardson, while righties have slashed .231/.305/.423 in 182 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.8 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 36.7 compared to righties' 91.6 mph and 47.9 percent.

- ☞ His whiff rate is 0.3 below his 2024 whiff rate for an average of 22.0 percent (lefties, 18.8 percent; righties, 24.5 percent)...compared to the last three years in which he has averaged 18.8 percent.

NIGHTMARES: So far this season, Simeon is 2-3 in 11 nighttime appearances (10 starts), posting a 5.62 ERA (49.2 IP, 31 ER) with 10 home runs, 27 walks and 42 strikeouts; compared to 3-1 with a 3.18 ERA (39.2 IP, 14 ER), six home runs, 13 walks and 36 strikeouts in eight daytime starts.

- ☞ SWR is 5-6 in 26 career night games (25 starts), and has posted a 5.17 ERA, a .256 opponent batting average and a .765 OPS with 19 home runs, 55 walks and 95 strikeouts; compared to 5-4 with a 3.62 ERA, a .238 opponent batting average, a .681 OPS, 15 home runs, 38 walks and 108 strikeouts in 23 day games (22 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his slider and curveball against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup and split finger against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He currently ranks in baseball's sixth percentile in barrel percentage (11.6), seventh percentile in ground ball percentage (31.7), and 10th percentile in max exit velocity (115.3).
- ☞ Between June 21 and today, SWR decreased his 4-seam fastball hard-hit rate from 60.3 percent to 46.7 percent, a decrease of 13.6, and lowering himself from the second highest hard-hit percentage among pitchers who have thrown at least 300 4-seam fastballs to the 109th highest, dropping 107 spots.
