THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Kansas City, followed by a win in Anaheim last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three against the Angels and conclude the series/roadtrip tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, they will travel home to spend an off-day on Thursday, then begin their final homestand of the season...over the homestand they will host Arizona (3 games this weekend), New York-AL (3 games September 15-17) and Cleveland (four games September 19-21).

MUST HAVE BEEN THE CLEATS: The Twins beat the Angels last night at Angel Stadium by a score of 12-3, scoring 10 unanswered runs after the second inning...it marked their first back-to-back wins since August 5-6...Simeon Woods Richardson (6-4) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, three being home runs...Royce Lewis (wearing SKOL purple and gold cleats) hit two home runs (11, 12) and James Outman (3) hit his first as a Twin.
 According to @OptaSTATS, with the Vikings' 27-24 defeat over the Bears in Chicago last night, Monday marked the second time the Twins and Vikings won road games in the same day (regular or Postseason)...the previous was September 15, 1985, when Bert Blyleven led the Twins 5-2 over Cleveland and Tommy Kramer led the Vikings to a 31-16 victory in Tampa Bay.

SEEING RED: The Twins and Angels are playing the fifth of six games in 2025...these two are scheduled to play seven times in 2026 with three games at Target Field, from July 10-12 and four games at Angel Stadium, from September 17-20.

Minnesota has gone 10-1 in their last 11 against the Angels, dating back to September of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +53 (92-39).

Since the start of last season, the Twins are hitting .320 (113-for-353) with 8.3 runs-per-game and a .932 OPS in 10 games against Los Angeles-AL.

The Twins current six-game winning streak vs. the Angels is their longest since winning eight straight, from June 3-September 7, 1996.

Trevor Larnach has hit safely in eight-straight vs. the Angels, hitting .414 (12-for-29) with nine RBI, seven walks and a 1.065 OPS in that span.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Orange County native Royce Lewis played in his first game at Angel Stadium last night, going 2-for-5 with two home runs and four RBI...the homers were his 11th and 12th of the season, four short of his single-season career-high of 16 (2024)...he also now has 44 RBI on the season, eight short of his career-high (52 in 2023)...over his last eight games, Lewis is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with one double, three home runs, eight RBI, one walk, a .353 on-base percentage, a .636 slugging percentage and a .989 OPS.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with one double, six RBI and an .880 OPS in his last nine games...he has now reached safely in 17 of his last 18 games...over those 18, he is hitting .338 (23-for-68) with four doubles, eight RBI, eight walks, a .403 on-base percentage and an .800 OPS.

HOT WHEELS: Since August 12, the Twins have stolen 33 bases in 39 attempts, second-most in baseball, trailing New York-NL (36)...they already have 90 this season, their most under a Rocco Baldelli-led team (since 2019)...they have 23 steals in their last 12 games, tied for second-most in their history and most in any 12-game span since 1965...below are the game-by-game stolen bases over the last 12 games:

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS: Over their last 20 games, since August 18, the Twins have posted a 3.4 BsR (base running runs above average), which is the best in baseball...in 108 games leading up to the trade deadline (July 31), the Twins posted a -5.5 BsR, ranking 27th in baseball (lower left)...in 36 games since, they have posted a BsR of 2.1, seventh-best in baseball (lower right):

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): Twins need a win tonight or tomorrow to secure their 18th series of the season...Minnesota is 17-27-2 in series play, going 11-10-2 at home and 6-17-0 on the road.

Twins have won four-straight series over the Angels, dating back to September of 2023.

Twins have won just one series (August 29-31 vs. SD) in their last eight tries (chart in right margin).

Minnesota's last road series win was August 4-6, taking two of three at Detroit.

AUSTIN POWER: Over his last 13 games, Austin Martin has reached base 24 times (14 hits, 10 walks) in 46 plate appearances for an on-base percentage of .522 in that span...over those 13 games, his batting average is .389 (14-for-36) with three doubles, nine runs scored, just six strikeouts and a .994 OPS.

ALL ABOUT OLIVARES: High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Jose Olivares yesterday was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week...the 22-year-old made the start on Tuesday at Quad Cities, allowing one run on one hit in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts...the Altigracia de Orituco, VZ native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2021.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Rod Carew hit a pinch-hit grand slam in the seventh for the Twins as Minnesota beat Texas, 6-0...it marked Carew's third grand slam of that year...it was the ninth pinch-hit grand slam in Twins history and one of 15 to date...the last to do it was Matt LeCroy on May 19, 2004 at Toronto.
