**THE TWINS:** After finishing their final homestand of 2025 with a record of 3-7 (1-2 vs. Arizona, 1-2 vs. New York-AL and 1-3 vs. Cleveland), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win in Texas last night... tonight, they will play the second of three against Texas... after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Philadelphia to play three against the Phillies at Citizens Bank Park over the weekend and finish out the season.

**THIS AIN'T IS TEXAS:** The Twins beat the Rangers last night at by a score of 4-1...Zebby Matthews (5-6) was the starter and earned the win...he gave up one run, a leadoff homer to Joc Pederson, marking just his second leadoff home run allowed in his career...Matthews allowed four hits with no walks and six strikeouts in a career-high-tying 7.0 innings of work...Kody Funderburk (1.0 IP) and Cole Sands (1.0 IP) — who earned his third save of the season — combined for 2.0 hitless innings of relief, with no walks and two strikeouts... the offense recorded eight hits, including two apiece from Kody Clemens and Edouard Julien.

☞ Per *TruMedia*, Matthews is the first Twins starter to yield a leadoff HR, then pitch 7.0+ IP scoreless innings since Pablo López on Opening Day of last season (March 28, 2024 at KC).

**LONE STAR STATS:** Twins and Rangers are playing each other for the fourth, fifth and sixth times in 2025... these two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from June 10-12, as the Twins won game two... Twins and Rangers will first meet in 2026 for a four-day, three-game series at Globe Life Field from June 15-18, followed by the season series finale from September 25-27.

☞ The Twins are 10-3 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023, 3-0 in 2024 and 1-0 in 2025...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 20-7 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined, including a record of 14-3 in their last 17.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with two doubles, two home runs and a .920 OPS in 10 career games against Texas.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, three walks, a stolen base and a 1.206 OPS in his last five games against Texas, including two three-hit performances earlier this season (3-for-4 on 6/10, 3-for-3 on 6/11).

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 14-4 all-time in Arlington, going 4-0 at Globe Life Park and 10-4 at Globe Life Field...his .778 win percentage in this city is his best; Washington, D.C. (2-1, .667) and Toronto (14-7, .667) are next.

**AUSTIN POWER:** Austin Martin has reached base safely in 24 of his last 27 games, recording a .421 on-base percentage and batting .319 (29-for-91) with seven doubles, five RBI, 15 walks, eight stolen bases and an .816 OPS...he ranks sixth in baseball in on-base percentage in that span.

☞ Martin has posted a .405 on-base percentage in 21 games this month, eighth-best in the AL and 23rd-best in baseball.

**KODE RED:** Kody Clemens is batting .375 (12-for-32) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, three walks, two stolen bases, a .429 on-base percentage, a .719 slugging percentage and a 1.147 OPS in his last nine games since September 12...his batting average, on-base percentage and slugging percentage all rank first on the team since that date...his .712 slugging percentage also ranks third in the American League since that date, behind only Cal Raleigh (.909) and Salvador Perez (.743)...Clemens also recorded his 100th career RBI last night, driving in James Outman on a single in the sixth inning.

**KEA PLAYER:** Luke Keaschall has reached safely in 44 of 49 games to start his career...he has posted an on-base percentage of .382 on the season, reaching base 79 times (55 hits, 19 walks, 5 hit-by-pitch) in 207 plate appearances...is tied for the fourth-most times on base in Twins history (1961-) through a player's first 49 career games.

☞ His .382 on-base percentage is the third highest among all rookies in baseball (minimum of 200 plate appearances), behind Roman Anthony (.396) and Nick Kurtz (.383).

**HOT WHEELS:** The Twins have stolen 26 bases in their last 15 games...in 25 games since August 26, they have stolen 44 bases in 50 attempts, the most stolen bases in any 25-game span in Twins history (1961-)... their 111 stolen bases so far this season are tied for the 13th-most in team history and the most since 2012, when they swiped 135 bases. >>>

☞ The Twins have stolen 56 bases since August 1, the second-most in baseball behind New York-AL (58).

☞ Christian Vázquez swiped his first base of the season last night, making him the 17th different Twin to steal a base this season...that ties the second most in a season in Twins history, with the 2004 club...the team record is 18 separate players with at least one stolen base in 2001.

**NEED A LITTLE WINDSURGE HERE!!!:** Yesterday, Minor League Baseball™ (MiLB™) announced the league awards and All-Star team for the Double-A classification in Major League Baseball's player development system...the Wichita Wind Surge were well represented earning four spots on the Texas League Team...Kala'i Rosario, Kaelen Culpepper and Pierson Ohl all earned spots on the All-Star team...the four spots on the All-Star team tie Springfield for the most of any team in the league...the four spots also are the most earned by the Wind Surge in their five year history...the team had three All-Stars in 2024.

☞ Kala'i Rosario spent the full season with the Wind Surge playing in a team-high 130 games, batting .256 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs...he was named as a Texas League All-Star outfielder...the 23-year-old led the Texas League in home runs (25), RBI (83), runs (92), doubles (30), total bases (242), extra-base hits (60), and was third in the league in hits (127), second in slugging and OPS...Rosario set new season franchise records for home runs and RBI in a season...he also became the second player in club history to hit for the cycle in a game.

☞ Tyler Fedko was named Texas League All-Star designated hitter...the 26-year-old spent 88 games with the Wind Surge and played the final two months at Triple-A St. Paul...Fedko finished second in the league with 20 home runs and led the league in slugging and OPS...he became the first Wind Surge player to have 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season.

☞ Kaelen Culpepper was named Texas League All-Star utility player...the 22-year-old was the Minnesota Twins' first round pick in 2024 from Kansas State University...he spent the first half of the season in High-A Cedar Rapids and led the kernels to the first half division title...Culpepper played in 59 games with Wichita, batting .285 with 11 home runs and 30 RBI.

☞ Pierson Ohl was named a Texas League All-Star reliever...the 26-year-old Ohl pitched in just 13 games with the Wind Surge and had a record of four wins and a one loss with a 2.08 ERA in 39 innings...he recorded 46 strikeouts and opponents batted .209... Ohl played at three levels this season pitching at Triple-A St Paul and made his major league debut with the Twins in July.

**WELCOME TO THE BLACK PARADE:** Following the era-defining accomplishment of their Long Live: The Black Parade tour, My Chemical Romance has announced 17 new live dates in celebration of the 20th anniversary of their landmark third studio album...The Black Parade 2026 will visit stadiums across North America, the UK, and Europe next year...following two completely sold-out Mexico City dates in February, the tour's North American leg will resume on August 9 at New York City's famed Citi Field, visit major markets across the country, and wrap on October 24 with a three-night run at Los Angeles's historic Hollywood Bowl...once again hand-selected, the North American leg's very special guests include: Franz Ferdinand, Pierce The Veil, Modest Mouse, Iggy Pop, Sleater-Kinney, The Breeders, Babymetal, Jimmy Eat World, and The Mars Volta.

☞ Tickets for all new dates go on sale this Friday, September 26, at 12:00 pm local time.

☞ My Chemical Romance will visit Target Field on August 24, 2026, featuring Sleater-Kinney.

- ☞ Took the loss in his last start on September 17 vs. the Yankees...allowed seven runs on eight hits (2 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts over 4.0 innings of work...became the 48th pitcher since the start of 2023 to reach 400 strikeouts.
- ☞ In four career starts against the Rangers, is 0-2 with a 5.03 ERA (19.2 IP, 11 ER), three home runs allowed, 12 walks and 25 strikeouts.
- ☞ Is seeking his first MLB win since July 18...his team has not won one of his starts since July 18.

- LAST TIME OUT:** Took the loss in his last start on September 17 vs. the Yankees at Target Field, opposite Luis Gil, a 5-10 Minnesota defeat...allowed a season-high-tying seven runs on eight hits (season-high-tying 2 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts over 4.0 innings of work...in the first, allowed an RBI single to Cody Bellinger...gave up a solo home run to Trent Grisham in the third...five runs allowed in the fourth came via an RBI double by Jasson Dominguez, a three-run home run to Grisham and a bases-loaded balk...was the first outing in his career with a wild pitch and a balk.
- ☞ Tied his single-outing career high with four doubles allowed; also did so on September 4 vs. the White Sox, August 7, 2024 at St. Louis and July 2, 2023 at Seattle.
  - ☞ Extended his career-high streak of allowing a walk to 25-straight games (previous high was 15-straight done in 2024)...is the fourth-longest streak in the majors this season.
  - ☞ Brought his career strikeout total to 401...the only pitcher who has recorded more strikeouts through their first 74 career games since 2023 is Cleveland's Tanner Bibee (418).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on September 10 at Angel Stadium, opposite José Ureña, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-4 loss...allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts over 6.1 innings...marked his 12th quality start of the season and his first since July 18 vs. Baltimore...retired the first seven batters he faced...in the third, allowed an RBI single to Mike Trout and a two-run home run to Zach Neto...faced two over the minimum through his final 3.2 innings of work...98 pitches were his most in an outing since June 1 at Houston (104).

**FACING TEXAS:** Is facing the Rangers for the fifth time in his career, going 0-2 with a 5.03 ERA (19.2 IP, 11 ER), 12 walks and 25 strikeouts in his previous four starts...Texas batters have posted a .216 (16-for-74) batting average with three home runs, a .326 on-base percentage and a .365 slugging percentage...last faced Texas in Arlington on April 5 but did not factor into the decision of Tampa Bay's 6-4 loss; allowed four runs on two hits (2 HR), with four walks and seven strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

- ☞ In four starts against the American League West this season (HOU 2x, TEX, LAA), has gone 1-1 with a 3.33 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER), four home runs allowed, 10 walks, 29 strikeouts and a .155 (13-for-84) opponent batting average.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 12 road starts this season, has gone 2-4 with a 4.48 ERA (66.1 IP, 33 ER), 27 walks and 54 strikeouts, compared to 4-4 with a 5.89 ERA (70.1 IP, 46 ER), 27 walks and 64 strikeouts in 14 starts at home...in 37 career road games (35 starts), has gone 8-12 with a 4.71 ERA (185.1 IP, 97 ER), 28 home runs, 76 walks, 183 strikeouts and a .245 opponent batting average.

- ☞ Three of his four career starts against the Rangers have come in Arlington...has gone 0-1 with a 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP, 7 ER), three home runs allowed, eight walks, 21 strikeouts and a .203 (12-for-59) opponent batting average at Globe Life Field.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed batters have slashed .246/.329/.440 with 13 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 42 RBI and a 1.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 248 at-bats against Bradley...right-handed batters have slashed .251/.314/.376 with 13 doubles, seven home runs, 30 RBI and a 2.63 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 271 at-bats against Bradley.

- ☞ In his career, lefties have slashed .243/.315/.420 with a 2.81 strikeout-to-walk ratio, while righties have slashed .248/.310/.445 with a 2.94 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Bradley.

**THE ARSENAL:** Through 26 starts in 2025, Bradley has relied on a four pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant.
