THE TWINS: The Twins opened their 66th season with a loss in Baltimore on Thursday afternoon...today, they will play the second of three at Camden Yards and finish the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play a three-game series against the Royals at Kauffman Stadium from Monday-Thursday (off-day Tuesday)...following this trip, Minnesota will open its 17th season at Target Field with a three-game weekend series against the Tampa Bay Rays, followed by a four-game series against the Detroit Tigers, from Monday-Thursday.

TWINS AND O'S GO DOWN TO THE WIRE: The Twins lost to the Orioles on Wednesday afternoon in Baltimore by a score of 2-1, dropping their second-straight opener...Joe Ryan made his second career Opening Day start, pitching 5.1 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed (Rutschman 4th inning single), two walks and seven strikeouts...Kody Funderburk (0-1) was issued the loss, allowing one run on one hit in 0.2 innings of relief...the offense recorded five hits, went 1-for-12 with runners in scoring position and left seven men on base...Byron Buxton tripled and scored on a sac fly by Luke Keaschall in the eighth inning...Victor Caratini reached twice in his Twins debut, going 1-for-3 with a walk.
 ☞ Joe Ryan held Oriole batters hitless for 3.2 innings before a Rutschman single, marking the longest for a Twin to carry a no-hitter in an opener since Jerry Koosman, who also went 3.2 hitless innings to open the 1981 season against Oakland (credit: Twins Radio Network Sports Bureau).

WAREHOUSE GAMES: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other today for the second of six games in 2026...Twins will host the O's for three games at Target Field from August 10-12.
 ☞ Thursday's loss snapped a six-game winning streak for the Twins over the Orioles, marking their first loss to the O's since September 29, 2024 at Target Field...marked their first loss at Baltimore since April 17, 2024.
 ☞ Twins are now 6-1 vs. Baltimore in their last seven after going 0-10 head-to-head prior to this stretch (from July 2, 2023-September 29, 2024).
 ☞ Since 2018, the Twins have hit 72 home runs in 45 games against the Orioles, their second-most vs. any opponent outside of the AL Central (77 vs. SEA)...37 have been hit at Camden.
 ☞ Josh Bell is hitting .333 (28-for-84) with seven home runs, 17 RBI, a .607 slugging percentage and a .981 OPS in 23 career games vs. the Orioles...he has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 vs. the O's...he has homered in five of his last 10 vs. the O's...he has reached base safely via hit or walk in eight-straight at Camden Yards.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .295 (13-for-44) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, a .545 slugging percentage and a .913 OPS in 12 career games at Camden Yards.
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with six walks, eight RBI, a .422 on-base percentage and an .867 OPS in 14 career games vs. Baltimore.

I'LL TAKE BUCK FOR 900: Byron Buxton is playing in his 899th career game today...21 Twins have played in 900-plus career games, the last to reach that mark being Max Kepler in 2023...the all-time club leader is Harmon Killebrew with 1,939 games from 1961-74...of Buck's 899 career games played, 755 have been in centerfield.

MAJORITY RULES: Twins went 18-32-2 in series play last season, going 11-13-2 at home and 7-19-0 on the road...Minnesota finished the season going 1-7-0 in their final eight series, their only win coming September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip.
 ☞ Twins need wins today and tomorrow to avoid losing their first series to the Orioles since getting swept in three games from September 27-29, 2024 at Target Field...their last series loss at Camden came April 15-17, 2024, getting swept in three games.

BUCK TRUCK HITS THE ROAD: Byron Buxton has posted a 1.192 OPS over his last 12 road games, dating back to August 27, including eight home runs, 13 RBI and an .872 slugging percentage in that span...since that date, he leads baseball in road homers and slugging percentage, second in OPS and tied for 10th in RBI — minimum of 50 road plate appearances.

ALL SAINTS DAY: Triple-A St. Paul opened their season last night in Indianapolis with a 4-2 win...Connor Prielipp was the starter, allowing one run on one hit in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Kaelen Culpepper (Twins no. 2 prospect) made his Triple-A debut, going 3-for-5 with one RBI on three singles...Alan Roden reached base five times, going 1-for-1 with four walks.

YOU STAY CLASSY, PLANET EARTH: A total of 247 players represented 16 different countries and territories outside of the 50 United States on 2026 Opening Day rosters and inactive lists, Major League Baseball announced on Thursday...the 247 players born outside the U.S. (26.1%) come from a total pool of 948 players (780 active 26-man roster players and 168 major league players on injured or restricted lists)...the Twins were represented by just two different non-U.S. countries: Puerto Rico (Victor Caratini) and Venezuela (Pablo López).

MORN-O'S: In his third career game at Camden Yards on July 25, 2004, Justin Morneau hit a 412-foot home run off Daniel Cabrera onto Eutaw Street, one of roughly 130 ball-markers in that area...Morneau hit .301 (69-for-229) in 64 career games vs. the O's, including a Camden Yards average of .315 (35-for-111) with 22 RBI in 30 games...on September 13, 2008, Mornny reached five times in this ballpark, going 4-for-4 with two doubles and one walk — one of seven times in his career to reach at least five times in a game.

- In 2025, made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2, 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- In his career, he owns a 2-1 record in his season debuts with a 3.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 22 strikeouts.

SPRING RECAP: Bradley made five starts in Twins major league spring training, going 1-1 with a 4.67 ERA (17.1 IP, 9 ER), seven walks and 23 strikeouts.

- Bradley's 23 spring strikeouts ranked second on staff, only trailing Mick Abel's 27 strikeouts, while his 17.1 innings pitched ranked third.
- Was slated to pitch for Team Mexico in WBC, but withdrew in late February to focus on getting a full camp and workload with Twins in preparation for his first full season with the club

2025 RECAP: At the major league level in 2025, combined to go 6-8 with a 5.05 ERA (142.2 IP, 80 ER), 56 walks and 127 strikeouts in 27 starts between Tampa Bay and Minnesota...made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2 with a 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER), 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.

- Acquired by Minnesota on July 31, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax, initially assigned to Triple-A St. Paul.
- Recalled by Minnesota on August 24 and made Twins debut that same day against Chicago-AL, pitching 5.0 innings and giving up nine hits and seven runs.
- Recorded career strikeout number 400 in his penultimate start of the season on September 27 against New York-AL.
- Ended his season with a quality start, allowing one run on two hits, with two walks and nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work on September 24 at Texas.
- Tallied 13 quality starts over the course of the year, the most in a single season in his career, eclipsing his previous career high of 10 in 2024.

CAREER VS. BALTIMORE: Bradley faces Baltimore for the eighth time in his career...holds an overall record of 2-3 against the Orioles with a 7.03 ERA (32.0 IP, 25 ER), eight walks and 34 strikeouts.

- In two career starts at Camden Yards, Bradley holds a 14.54 ERA (8.2 IP, 14 ER) with four walks and five strikeouts...his 14.54 ERA at Camden is his highest career ERA at any ballpark.
- Bradley's 32.0 career IP against Baltimore is his second most innings pitched against any MLB team, trailing only Boston (34.0 IP).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Over the course of his career, Bradley is 11-15 with a 5.10 ERA (194.0 IP, 110 ER), 64 walks, 218 strikeouts and a 1.27 WHIP in 37 career home starts compared to 8-12 with a 4.61 ERA (191.1 IP, 98 ER), 78 walks, 192 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 38 road appearances (36 starts).

- In 2025, between Tampa Bay and Minnesota, Bradley went 4-4 with a 5.89 ERA (70.1 IP, 46 ER), 27 walks, 64 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP in 14 home starts while going 2-4 with a 4.23 ERA (72.1 IP, 34 ER), 29 walks, 63 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP in 13 road starts.
- Bradley held opposing hitters to a .215 BAA on the road in 2025, tied with Joe Ryan for eighth lowest in the American League (min. 70.0 IP on road).

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Last season, left-handed hitters slashed .237/.319/.431 (62-for-262) against Bradley, while righties slashed .249/.314/.375 (69-for-277).

- Lefties posted an average exit velocity of 89.2 mph and a 23.1 whiff percentage, while righties posted a 88.6 mph exit velocity and a 25.3 whiff percentage.
- Hitters combined exit velocity against Bradley was 88.9 mph, nearly two mph lower than in 2024 (90.6 mph).

THE ARSENAL: In 27 starts in 2025, Bradley relied on a five pitch mix...threw his 4-seam fastball 38.6%, the lowest in his career...relied heavily on his cutter and sinker to right-handed hitters...utilized his split finger against lefties...threw his curveball relatively equally to righty and lefties, per Baseball Savant:

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:

- Bradley's 60 percent strikeout rate on his curveball ranked first in baseball among pitchers with 300-plus curves thrown last season
- His BAA and opponent slugging also ranked first at .082 and .137 respectively, while his xBA against of .092 was 34 points lower than any other pitcher who threw at least 300 curves on the year.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - BAILEY OBER (2025: 6-9, 5.10 ERA // CAREER: 31-30, 4.08 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is set to start tomorrow's game against the Baltimore at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...marks his first start of the season and his third career start in March...owns a 36.00 ERA (4.0 IP, 16 ER) through two career March starts, both coming on the road...boasts a 1-1 record with a 2.60 ERA (27.2 IP, 8 ER), seven walks and 26 strikeouts in five career starts against Baltimore...has a career 3.16 ERA (99.2 IP, 35 ER) against AL East opponents, his lowest ERA against any division...this spring, Ober started in four games, going 0-1 with a 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER), six walks and six strikeouts.
