THE TWINS: Completed their first homestand of the season with a record of 5-2, going 1-2 vs. Tampa Bay last weekend and 4-0 vs. Detroit this week...tonight, Minnesota will begin a three-game weekend series in Toronto against the Blue Jays...they will return to Minneapolis next week to host the Red Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday, have an off-day on Thursday, then host the Reds for three next weekend.
 ☞ Today marks day 10 of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on Thursday, April 16.
 ☞ Twins are seeking five-straight wins tonight, which would be their most since winning 13-straight, from May 3-17, 2025...their last defeat was the series finale vs. Tampa Bay on Sunday.

TWINS GRAB A MOP AND CLOSE UP FOR THE WEEKEND: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-1, sweeping the Tigers in four games...Mick Abel was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with four hits allowed, three walks and six strikeouts...Garrett Acton earned his first major league win in his Twins debut, allowing one run on one hit in 2.0 innings pitched...Eric Orze recorded his first save of the season and fourth of his career with a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Josh Bell, who hit a solo home run in the fourth inning...Brooks Lee recorded two-RBI with a bases-loaded single in the bottom of the eighth and two outs, giving the Twins the lead.
 ☞ The victory moved the Twins over the .500 mark for the first time since June 16, 2025, when they were 36-35.
 ☞ Orze's save yesterday marked the third time since saves became official in 1969 that a team swept a four-game series and earned saves from four different pitchers (credit *Elias*):

CANADIAN IMPORT: Tonight's starter, Simeon Woods Richardson, was acquired by the Twins along with utility player Austin Martin via trade with the Jays on July 30, 2021, in exchange for José Berrios...SWR last appeared in Toronto's system with Double-A New Hampshire in 2021 and was the Jays fourth ranked prospect by MLB.com that season.

LAKES AND LEAFS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the first of seven games in 2026...Target Field will host the Jays for four games from May 31-June 3...last season, Minnesota went 2-4 against they Jays, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 6-8 and 1-2 at Rogers Centre from August 25-27.
 ☞ Derek Shelton was John Gibbons' quality control coach here in 2017, his last job prior to being hired as Paul Molitor's bench coach in 2018...Shelty has a managerial record of 1-8 lifetime against the Jays.
 ☞ Byron Buxton has posted a .927 OPS with nine doubles, 10 home runs, 22 RBI and a .577 slugging percentage in 33 career regular season games against the Blue Jays...in 13 career games at Rogers Centre, he is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.093 OPS...that's his highest OPS in any AL ballpark.
 ☞ In 12 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner has posted a 1.005 OPS, including five home runs (3 at Rogers), 10 RBI and a .643 slugging percentage.
 ☞ In 13 career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .400 (18-for-45) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .471 on-base percentage, a .644 slugging percentage and a 1.115 OPS.

POUTINE POP: In their last game here on August 27, 2025, the Twins hit four home runs (Buxton - 2, Keaschall, Lee)...the Twins have now homered in 23-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 49 total homers in those 23...their last homerless game in Toronto was August 25, 2017...it marks their longest streak in an opposing ballpark in club history (since 1961):

NOTE: The next closest opponent to the Twins streak was the Red Sox, who homered 16 times here from April 25, 2018-September 10, 2019.

THAT HAS TO BE EVERY LEFTY IN THE LEAGUE BY NOW: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the eighth time in 14 games...they faced Trevor Rogers on Opening Day in Baltimore (1-2 loss), Kris Bubic on March 30 at Kansas City (1-3 loss), Noah Cameron on April 1 at Kansas City (9-13 loss) Cole Ragans on April 2 at Kansas City (5-1 win), Steven Matz on Saturday vs. Tampa Bay (1-7 loss), Tarik Skubal Tuesday night vs. Detroit (4-2 win) and Framber Valdez on Wednesday night vs. Detroit (8-6 win).
 ☞ In the first eight games vs. lefties, the Twins hit .173 (22-for-127) with a .543 OPS, but have hit .328 (20-for-61) with an .816 OPS over their last three.
 ☞ Two home runs hit off lefties this season: Matt Wallner off Kris Bubic on March 30 at KC and Josh Bell off Bailey Falter on April 1 at KC.
 ☞ Only the Astros have faced as many left-handed starters this season, also facing seven.
 ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .388 (26-for-67) with a .494 on-base percentage and a 1.001 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average ranks second in all of baseball (min. 70 PA), trailing only Andrew Vaughn (.392)...his OPS ranks ninth.

ZONE DEFENSE: Twins enter today having used the ABS success rate system 47 times, the most in baseball (next is Miami with 34)...Twins have won 29 of those challenges, posting a 62% success rate (7th in MLB)...they have won 12 of 23 on the hitting side and 17 of 24 on the pitching side.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers has won eight of 13 challenges for a 62% success rate, fourth-highest percentage among catchers in baseball (min. 10 tries)...Victor Caratini has posted a 78% success rate on challenges (7-for-9), second-best in baseball (min. 9 attempts), trailing Dillon Dingler (89%).
 ☞ Twins catchers have flipped 10 pitches into strikeouts, the most in baseball...next best is Colorado (6)...Jeffers leads all MLB catchers with eight.

LAST TIME OUT: Woods Richardson did not factor into the decision in his last start on April 5 vs. Tampa Bay, a Twins 4-1 loss...recorded his first quality start of the season, allowing one run on a Junior Caminero solo shot in the in the fourth inning, along with five hits, two walks and four strikeouts in 6.2 innings of work – the longest outing by a Twins starting pitcher so far this season.

☞ Became the first Twins starter in Target Field Era (2010-) to record two-or-fewer losses in his first 12 home starts in consecutive seasons (2024, 2025) and first in Twins club history (1961-) to accomplish this feat since Scott Erickson (1990, 1991).

2025 RECAP: Was a member of the Twins season-opening rotation for the first time in his career...posted a career-high in wins, finishing 7-4 with a 4.04 ERA (111.1 IP, 50 ER), 46 walks, 107 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP, his lowest in a full season...finished the season third on the team in strikeouts (107), starts (22) and innings pitched (111.1)...held opponents to a .194 (27-for-139) BAA post-All Star Break, owning a 2-0 record with a 4.23 ERA (38.1 IP, 18 ER), 18 walks, 45 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP during that span... finished the season 5-0 over his last 12 starts beginning June 26 vs. Seattle; posted a 3.10 ERA (58.0 IP, 20 ER) with 61 strikeouts and a 1.10 WHIP during that stretch.

HELLO AGAIN, OLD FRIEND: Sim is set to make his third career start against Toronto; he is 0-0 with an 11.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 10 ER), three walks and three strikeouts against the Blue Jays...in his most recent outing against Toronto on August 27, 2025, pitched 3.2 innings and allowed five runs on five hits – three of which were home runs – with two walks and two strikeouts in a 9-8 Twins loss at Rogers Centre; he did not factor in the decision.

☞ Each of his two career starts against the Blue Jays were in Toronto.
 ☞ Was traded from Toronto to Minnesota with Austin Martin in exchange for right-handed pitcher José Berrios on July 30, 2021.

TAKE IT EAST-Y: Today's game will mark Simeon's 10th career start against an AL East opponent...his 5.56 ERA (43.2 IP, 27 ER) against AL East opponents is his worst against a single division; he is 1-0 with 17 walks, 37 strikeouts, a 1.53 WHIP and a .287 (50-for-174) BAA in nine starts.

☞ In 5 starts against the AL East in 2025, Sim went 1-0 with a 6.26 ERA (23.0 IP, 16 ER), 10 walks and 23 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-4 with a 3.78 ERA (135.2 IP, 57 ER), 52 walks, 130 strikeouts and a 1.23 WHIP in 27 games (26 starts) at home compared to 6-7 with a 4.48 ERA (130.2 IP, 65 ER), 50 walks, 108 strikeouts and a 1.35 WHIP in 28 road games (27 starts).

☞ With the no-decision in his first home start of 2026 on April 5 vs. Tampa Bay, Simeon has avoided a loss in eight consecutive home starts dating back to June 26, 2025 vs. Seattle.
 ☞ Is 3-0, 1.93 ERA (42.0 IP, 9 ER) with 17 walks, 43 strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .190 (29-for-153) BAA at Target Field during that span.
