THE TWINS: After completing their first homestand with a record of 5-2 (1-2 vs. Tampa Bay and 4-0 vs. Detroit), the Twins began their short weekend roadtrip with a loss to the Blue Jays in Toronto last night...today, Minnesota will play the second of three in Canada...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will return to Minneapolis to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand...they will host the Red Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday, enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Reds for three games next weekend.
 ☞ Today marks day 11 of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on Thursday, April 16.

BLACK AND BLUE JAYS: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays last night at Rogers Centre by a score of 10-4, allowing 10 unanswered runs and snapping their four-game winning streak...Minnesota jumped out to a 4-0 lead, including three runs scored in the first inning, but allowed a five-run fourth by Toronto...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Ryan Jeffers, who went 3-for-3 with a three-run homer in the first inning.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson (retroactive to April 9) and infielder Royce Lewis (retroactive to April 10) on the 15-day Injured List and 10-day Injured List, respectively.
 ☞ Laweryson made five appearances for the Twins, allowing four runs (3 earned) on three hits in 6.1 innings pitched (4.26 ERA), with two walks and eight strikeouts, including recording his first major league save on April 6 vs. Detroit.
 ☞ Lewis has played in 12 games, hitting .222 (8-for-36) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, six runs scored, eight walks, a .378 on-base percentage and an .822 OPS.
 ☞ To replace Laweryson and Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled utility player Ryan Kreidler and right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris from Triple-A St. Paul.
 ☞ Kreidler played in nine games for the Saints, hitting .214 (6-for-28) with one double, one home run, three RBI, three runs scored, nine walks, two stolen bases, a .405 on-base percentage and a .762 OPS...the 28-year-old has played in parts of four major league seasons with the Tigers, appearing in 89 career games.
 ☞ Morris, who is the club's 13th-best prospect per MLB.com, made two starts for the Saints this season, allowing one run on five hits in 7.1 innings pitched (1.23 ERA), with two walks and five strikeouts.

ROGER THAT: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the second of seven games in 2026...Target Field will host the Jays for four games from April 30-May 3.
 ☞ Byron Buxton has posted an .893 OPS with nine doubles, 10 home runs, 22 RBI and a .555 slugging percentage in 34 career regular season games against the Blue Jays...in 14 career games at Rogers Centre, he is hitting .293 (17-for-58) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.000 OPS...that's his highest OPS in any AL ballpark.
 ☞ In 13 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner has posted a .920 OPS, including five home runs (3 at Rogers), 10 RBI and a .587 slugging percentage.

CN POWER: The Twins have now homered in 24-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 51 total homers in those 24...their last homerless game in Toronto was August 25, 2017...it marks their longest streak in an opposing ballpark in club history (since 1961):

NOTE: The Twins streak is the longest for any opponent or Blue Jays team in this ballpark's history.

MAJORITY REPORT: Twins need wins today and tomorrow to earn their second series win of the season...they have gone 1-3-0 in series play (series results in the right margin).
 ☞ Minnesota's last series win on the road came September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip of 2025.
 ☞ Twins are 0-2-0 in their last two series' vs. the Jays, their last win being August 30-September 1, 2024, taking two of three at Target Field...their last series win in Rogers Centre was May 10-12, 2024.

ARE THERE ANY LEFTIES LEFT?: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the ninth time in 15 games...they have gone 3-5 against left-handed starters this season...their three wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit vs. Tarik Skubal (4-2) and April 8 vs. Detroit vs. Framber Valdez (8-6).
 ☞ In the first eight games vs. lefties, the Twins hit .173 (22-for-127) with a .543 OPS, but have hit .321 (26-for-81) with an .871 OPS over their last four.
 ☞ The eight lefty starters are the most any team has faced this season.
 ☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .406 (28-for-69) with a .506 on-base percentage and a 1.071 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average leads all of baseball (min. 70 PA)...his OPS ranks fifth.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALL/TWIN(S) HISTORY: In 2022, for the first time, twin brothers pitched for opposite team in the same game — and both figured in the decision...Taylor Rogers recorded the save in the Padres 4-2 win over the Giants, while brother Tyler Rogers was charged with the loss...they became just the sixth pair of twins to appear in the same major league game, and the first since Jose Canseco and Ozzie Canseco played for the 1990 Athletics.

LET'S RUN IT BACK: The Twins yesterday announced that fans who purchased tickets directly from the Twins for the club's Home Opener will receive complimentary tickets to the team's Friday, April 17 home game vs. the Cincinnati Reds (7:10 first pitch)...the Friday night Target Field party will also feature a pregame happy hour and the season's first postgame fireworks show.
 ☞ **Pregame Happy Hour Details:** From 5:00 pm-7:10 pm, featuring \$2 beers, \$2 hot dogs, \$2 snacks and a live performance by Minneapolis-based singer/songwriter Tim Mahoney and his band.

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Ryan picked up his first win of 2026 on April 6 vs. Detroit; surrendered three runs (two earned) on three hits with three walks and seven strikeouts (matched season-high)...snapped a four-game losing streak dating back to September 6, 2025, the longest losing streak of his career. ☞ His seven strikeouts were his most at Target Field against Detroit since June 16, 2023 (also 7). ☞ Ryan's 73 strikeouts against Detroit since the start of the 2022 season are the most by a pitcher in Major League Baseball.

2025 RECAP: Made a career-high 30 starts (31 appearances), finishing 13-10 with a 3.42 ERA (171.0 IP, 65 ER), 39 walks, 194 strikeouts (4.97 K/BB), a 1.04 WHIP and a .218 (138-for-633) BAA...matched his single-season high in wins (2022)...finished top 10 in the American League in strikeouts (6th), WHIP (6th), wins (T-6th), BAA (9th) and ERA (10th)...was named to the American League All-Star team for the first time in his career...received the Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, as voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.

JOE AND THE JAYS: Ryan is making his fifth career start against the Blue Jays (2-1); enters the game with a 4.70 ERA (23.0 IP, 12 ER), five walks, 24 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP and a .261 (23-for-88) BAA...last faced the Blue Jays on August 25, 2025; allowed six runs in 5.0 innings pitched on seven hits - two of them being home runs by Alejandro Kirk and Andrés Giménez - one hit batter, one walk and seven strikeouts in a 10-4 loss at Rogers Centre. ☞ Has made three starts at Rogers Centre; 1-1, 5.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 10 ER) with two walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .275 (19-for-69) BAA.

WEST COAST VS. EAST COAST: Ryan is 9-6 in 23 career starts against the AL East, posting a 3.33 ERA (135.0 IP, 50 ER) with 27 walks, 148 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and a .221 (112-for-507) BAA. ☞ In 2025, Ryan made five starts against AL East opponents; 3-1, 3.38 ERA (34.2 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks, 41 strikeouts, 1.13 WHIP and a .234 (30-for-128) BAA. ☞ Made his first start against an AL East opponent in 2026 on Opening Day, March 26 at Baltimore; threw 5.1 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 58 career road starts, Ryan is 20-20 with a 3.95 ERA (318.2 IP, 140 ER), 71 walks and 339 strikeouts, compared to 27-17 with a 3.66 ERA (337.0 IP, 137 ER), 82 walks and 397 strikeouts in 60 home appearances (59 starts). ☞ Posted a 7-5 record and a 3.48 ERA (85.1 IP, 33 ER) with 21 walks and 103 strikeouts through 15 starts (16 games) at Target Field in 2025. ☞ His 103 strikeouts at home ranked fifth in the American League; 390 strikeouts at Target Field are third most all-time, trailing Kyle Gibson (436) and José Berríos (432). ☞ His start on April 6 vs. Detroit marked his first win at Target Field since August 31, 2025 vs. San Diego.
