THE TWINS: After completing their first homestand with a record of 5-2 (1-2 vs. Tampa Bay and 4-0 vs. Detroit), the Twins began their short weekend roadtrip with a split of the first two games at Rogers Centre on Friday (loss) and Saturday (win)...today, Minnesota will complete the three-game series with the finale in Canada...after today's game, the Twins will return to Minneapolis to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand...they will host the Red Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday, enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Reds for three games next weekend.

☞ Twins have eight wins through 15 games...in 2025, Minnesota didn't earn its 15th win until game 23 on April 22.

CANADA DRY(AN): The Twins beat the Blue Jays yesterday at Rogers Centre by a score of 7-4, scoring all seven runs in the third inning...Joe Ryan (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on two hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...after the Daulton Varsho two-run homer in the first inning, Ryan retired 20 of his final 22 batters (Guerrero Jr. single & Lukes HBP) through the seventh inning...the offense recored six hits, two from Brooks Lee who homered for the second-straight day...Trevor Larnach added a home run, his first of the season.

TAKE CARE, TORONTO: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the third of seven games in 2026...Target Field will host the Jays for four games from April 30-May 3.

☞ In 13 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner has posted a .920 OPS, including five home runs (3 at Rogers), 10 RBI and a .587 slugging percentage.

MEASURE 'EM IN METRES: The Twins have now homered in 25-straight games at Rogers Centre, hitting 53 total homers in those 25...their last homerless game in Toronto was August 25, 2017...it marks their longest streak in an opposing ballpark in club history (since 1961):

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF - TWO OUT OF THREE AIN'T BAD: With a victory today, the Twins will earn their second series win of the season...they have gone 1-3-0 in series play (series results in the right margin).

☞ Minnesota's last series win on the road came September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip of 2025.

☞ Twins are 0-2-0 in their last two series' vs. the Jays, their last win being August 30-September 1, 2024, taking two of three at Target Field...their last series win in Rogers Centre was May 10-12, 2024.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Marek Houston, and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Riley Quick and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Mike Paredes as their minor league Player and Co-Pitchers of the Week.

☞ Houston, 21, played in seven games for the Kernels, hitting .321 (9-for-28) with one double, one triple, two home runs, four RBI and four walks...the College Station, TX native was selected by the Twins 16th overall in the 2025 MLB Draft out of Wake Forest University...he is the eighth-ranked prospect in the Twins system, per MLB.com.

☞ Quick, 21, made his professional debut on Friday at Jupiter, pitching 2.0 perfect innings with five strikeouts...the Trussville, AL native was selected by the Twins 36th overall in the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Alabama...he is the 11th ranked prospect in the Twins system, per MLB.com.

☞ Paredes, 25, made the start at Arkansas on Tuesday, allowing one run on two hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the San Diego, CA native was selected by the Twins in the 18th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of San Diego State University.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/TAJ BRADLEY HISTORY: In 2010, the Twins played their first game at Target Field, hosting the Boston Red Sox and winning 5-2...Carl Pavano was the starter and winner while Jon Rauch earned the save...Joe Mauer went 3-for-5 with two RBI and Jason Kubel went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI...in 2023, Taj Bradley made his major league debut for the Rays, earning the win, while allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts.

- Bradley will make his fourth start of the season this afternoon and seventh career appearance (fifth start) against the Blue Jays.
- Taj's 1.08 ERA (16.2 IP, 2 ER) through three starts is the lowest he has ever had to begin a year; currently sits fourth in the American League in ERA among qualified pitchers.
- In his last start, Bradley went 6.1 innings pitched, giving up six hits while walking none and striking out 10; it was his seventh career game with double-digit strikeouts.
- With the win, Taj moved to 2-0 on the season, while also earning his second quality start in a row.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradley went toe-to-toe with Tarik Skubal in his last outing on April 7, getting the best of the two-time reigning Cy-Young winner and the Tigers in a 4-2 Twins victory; Bradley earned the win with a final line of 6.1 innings pitched with six hits allowed, no walks and 10 strikeouts.

- Bradley's 10 strikeouts were his most in a start as a Twin and most in a game since June 1, 2025 at Houston when he played for the Tampa Bay; his 104 pitches against Detroit also matched a career high, the last time he threw that many was also that June 1, 2025 start at Houston.
- With another quality start for Bradley, it means he now has three quality starts in his last four outings dating back to his September 24, 2025 start against Texas; in that span, he is 2-0 with a 1.22 ERA (22.2 IP, 3 ER), six walks and 31 strikeouts.

2025 RECAP: At the major league level in 2025, Bradley combined to go 6-8 with a 5.05 ERA (142.2 IP, 80 ER), 56 walks and 127 strikeouts in 27 starts between Tampa Bay and Minnesota.

Tallied 13 quality starts over the course of the year, the most in a single season in his career, eclipsing his previous career high of 10 in 2024.

CAREER VS. TORONTO: Bradley has faced Toronto six times (four starts) in his career, going 2-2 with a 4.88 ERA (24.0 IP, 13 ER), five walks, 23 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP.

- BACK TO THE AL EAST:** Taj is no stranger to the AL East after spending the better part of three seasons with the Rays; owns a career 10-9 record with a 5.02 ERA (122.0 IP, 68 ER), 39 walks, 128 strikeouts and a .254 (120-for-473) BAA.
- BORDER BATTLE:** In his two most recent starts against Toronto on July 25, 2024 and September 21, 2024, Bradley has earned the wins, combining for 11.0 innings pitched with one run allowed, three walks and 11 strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.99 ERA (200.1 IP, 111 ER), 64 walks, 228 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP in 38 career home starts compared to 9-12 with a 4.42 ERA (201.2 IP, 99 ER), 82 walks, 204 strikeouts and a 1.32 WHIP in 40 road appearances (38 starts).

- In 2025, between Tampa Bay and Minnesota, Bradley went 4-4 with a 5.89 ERA (70.1 IP, 46 ER), 27 walks, 64 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP in 14 home starts while going 2-4 with a 4.23 ERA (72.1 IP, 34 ER), 29 walks, 63 strikeouts and a 1.20 WHIP in 13 road starts.
- CAREER AT ROGERS CENTRE:** In three appearances (one start) at the Rogers Centre, has combined to go 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER), one walk, eight strikeouts and a .200 (6-for-30) BAA.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .212/.257/.273 (7-for-33) with two doubles, two walks and 13 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .226/.314/.226 (7-for-31) with zero extra-base-hits, two walks and nine strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, throwing his four seamer and curveball very evenly between righties and lefties, while deploying his split finger predominantly to lefties and cutter mostly to righties...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- ONE OF THE BEST IN THE BUSINESS:** Bradley's split finger is quickly becoming one of the best pitches in his arsenal and one of the best pitches in all of baseball, here are some statistics on the pitch: is tied for the best run value (3) among all pitchers in baseball, ranks second in wOBA (.100), third in whiff rate at 56.3% and SLG against (.111), and is fifth in BAA at .111 (all min. 10 PA).
- So far this season, Bradley's run value of (3) on his split finger is tied with Kevin Gausman, Yoshinobu Yamamoto and Nathan Eovaldi, who are all known for their splits and have made five All-Star Games between them.
