THE TWINS: Are returning home after winning a three-game series in Toronto over the weekend, taking games two and three on Saturday and Sunday...tonight, Minnesota will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with the first of three against the Red Sox...they will continue the series over the next two days, enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Reds for three games over the weekend.

☞ Today marks day 13 of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on Thursday.

☞ Twins have nine wins through 16 games...in 2025, Minnesota didn't earn its ninth win until game 24 on April 23.

☞ As of last night, the Twins have moved into a share of first place in the AL Central and in the American League...Cleveland is also at 9-7 (list lower right).

THEY MEASURE 'EM IN METRES IN TORONTO: The Twins beat the Blue Jays yesterday afternoon at Rogers Centre by a score of 8-2, winning the three-game series two games to one...Iaj Bradley (3-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with four walks and seven strikeouts...Andrew Morris made his major league debut, allowing one run on six hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with no walks and two strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Luke Keaschall...Kody Clemens (2) and Tristan Gray (2) each homered, Clemens being a solo shot and Gray's a three-run blast.

BOSTON COMMON: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the first of six meetings in 2026...Twins went 3-3 against the Sox last season, going 2-1 at Fenway Park from May 2-4 and 1-2 at Target Field from July 28-30.

☞ Twins have gone 8-6 in their last 14 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with five doubles, two home runs and a .932 OPS in his last 12 games against the Red Sox, dating back to June of 2023.

☞ Byron Buxton has hit safely in nine-straight games against the Red Sox, hitting .368 (14-for-38) with one double, four home runs, six RBI and a 1.111 OPS in that span...additionally, he has reached base safely via hit or walk in 14-straight against Boston, dating back to April of 2021 (.383 OBP / 1.013 OPS).

☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with five walks, a .471 on-base percentage and an .828 OPS in 12 career games against the Red Sox.

☞ Matt Wallner has hit safely in all six career games vs. the Red Sox, hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three walks, a .458 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a .958 OPS.

THERE ARE NO LEFTIES LEFT: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 10th time in 17 games...they have gone 4-5 against left-handed starters this season...their four wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit vs. Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit vs. Framber Valdez (8-6) and Saturday at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4).

☞ In the first eight games vs. lefties, the Twins hit .173 (22-for-127) with a .543 OPS, but have hit .297 (33-for-111) with an .859 OPS over their last six.

☞ The nine lefty starters are the most any team has faced this season.

☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .394 (28-for-71) with a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.049 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average leads all of baseball (min. 80 PA)...his OPS ranks fifth.

OFFENSIVE COORDINATING: Twins have scored 79 runs on the season, second-most in the AL and sixth-most in baseball, trailing Houston (93), Los Angeles-NL (91), Atlanta (90), Washington (89) and Milwaukee (80)...through 16 games in 2025, the Twins had scored 55 runs, ranking 24th in baseball.

DO YOU EVEN LIFT, BRO?: The Twins have homered seven times in their last four games and have hit 17 on the season, tied with Texas and Washington for fifth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (28), Atlanta (21), Houston (19) and Los Angeles-AL (19).

FLORIDA MAN: Low-A Fort Myers infielder/outfielder Demeury Pena has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...the 20-year-old played in five games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .625 (10-for-16) with one double, one RBI and four walks, including a four-hit game on Friday at Jupiter...the Donån, DR native was signed by the Twins in January of 2023.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2013, Justin Morneau hit a seventh-inning home run off the rightfield foul pole at Target Field to break up a Matt Harvey no-hitter...in 2018, the second game of a four-game series vs. the White Sox was postponed (as were games 3 and 4) due to blizzard-like conditions...the Twin Cities experienced approximately 16 inches of snow over the scheduled four-game series...in 2025, the Twins unveiled and dedicated a statue outside Target Field honoring the career and legacy of St. Paul native and 2024 National Baseball Hall of Fame inductee Joe Mauer...the statue is located outside Target Field's Gate 34 heading toward 6th Street and 1st Avenue.

LET'S RUN IT BACK: Fans who purchased tickets directly from the Twins for the club's Home Opener will receive complimentary tickets to the team's Friday, April 17 home game vs. the Cincinnati Reds (7:10 first pitch)...the Friday night Target Field party will also feature a pregame happy hour and the season's first postgame fireworks show.

☞ **Pregame Happy Hour Details:** From 5:00 pm-7:10 pm, featuring \$2 beers, \$2 hot dogs, \$2 snacks and a live performance by Minneapolis-based singer/songwriter Tim Mahoney and his band.

- ☞ Is making his fifth career start against Boston; 1-2, 1.57 ERA (23.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks and 20 strikeouts.
- ☞ In his most recent start on April 8 vs. Detroit, Ober earned the win, allowing two runs on five hits with one walk and two strikeouts through 5.2 innings pitched.

- OBER AND OUT:** Ober earned his first win of 2026 on April 8 vs. Detroit, allowing two runs on five hits through 5.2 innings pitched with one walk and two strikeouts in an 8-6 Twins victory.
- ☞ Threw 99 pitches, seven short of his career-high and most since throwing 101 pitches on September 14, 2025 vs. Arizona.
 - ☞ His 5.2 innings pitched marked his longest outing of the season, surpassing his previous season-high of 4.0 innings pitched, which he threw in each of his first two starts of 2026.
 - ☞ Was his first win at Target Field since April 22, 2025 vs. Chicago-AL.

- 2025 SEASON RECAP:** Made 27 starts in the 2025 season, going 6-9 with a 5.10 ERA (146.1 IP, 83 ER), 31 walks and 120 strikeouts.
- ☞ Finished second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1), quality starts (8) and strikeouts (120).
 - ☞ Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed and one walk in final start on September 25 at Texas...also recorded his 600th career strikeout, fanning Joc Pederson in the first inning.
 - ☞ Battled discomfort in left hip for majority of season after starting to feel it in spring training...eventually on July 2, went on 15-day Injured List, his first time on IL in three seasons (2022).

- BAILEY TEA PARTY:** Ober is making his fifth career start against Boston; is 1-2, 1.57 ERA (23.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks, 20 strikeouts, a 1.13 WHIP and a .258 (23-for-89) BAA...made his only career start at Target Field against Boston on June 20, 2023; took the loss despite making a quality start, allowing three runs on eight hits - two of which were homers by Adam Duvall and Christian Arroyo - with one hit batter, no walks and four strikeouts.
- ☞ Has made a quality start in three consecutive games against Boston dating back to April 17, 2022, tied for the third longest active streak in Major League Baseball (1st: José Berríos - 5).
 - ☞ His 1.57 ERA against Boston is his lowest ERA vs. a single opponent against whom he has recorded multiple starts.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In five MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 17-15 with a 4.20 ERA (323.2 IP, 151 ER), 78 walks, 316 strikeouts, a .238 (293-for-1230) BAA and a .726 OPS against in 61 starts at home compared to 15-15 with a 4.01 ERA (307.2 IP, 137 ER), 59 walks, 295 strikeouts, a .240 (280-for-1165) BAA and a .700 OPS against in 57 road starts.
- ☞ In 2025, went 2-6 at home with a 5.12 ERA (82.2 IP, 47 ER), 18 walks, 70 strikeouts and a .783 OPS against in 15 starts, compared to 4-3 on the road with a 5.09 ERA (63.2 IP, 36 ER), 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and an .837 OPS against in 12 starts.
 - ☞ Allowed 17 of his 30 home runs at Target Field in 2025.
 - ☞ With his win on April 8, snapped a streak of 13 home starts without a victory dating back to May 8, 2025 vs. Baltimore, which was tied for the second longest such streak in club history (1961-); longest is Mike Pelfrey's 17-gamer from April 23, 2013-April 17, 2015.

- LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .154/.214/.231 (4-for-26) with two doubles, two walks and four strikeouts, while righties are slashing .310/.355/.517 (9-for-29) with a home run, three doubles, two walks and three strikeouts.
- ☞ Has allowed opponents to hit .353 (6-for-17) with runners in scoring position, surrendering a home run, two doubles, eight RBI, a walk and three strikeouts.

- THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:
