**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (1-2 at New York-NL and 0-3 at Tampa Bay), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a win over the Mariners last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the series with the second of three against Seattle...after this series concludes tomorrow afternoon, the Twins will welcome the Blue Jays for four games from Thursday-Sunday.

☞ Twins are just 2-9 in their last 11 since April 15, following a stretch where they went 8-1 in nine games from April 6-14.

☞ Twins are 8-6 at home, compared to 5-10 on the road...the offense has scored 5.6 runs-per-game at home, compared to 4.3 runs-per-game on the road...the pitching staff has posted a 3.66 ERA at home, compared to a 4.97 ERA on the road.

**PRIELIPP - JUST ANOTHER MAGIC MONDAY:** The Twins beat the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 11-4, snapping their five-game losing streak...Connor Prielipp (1-0) was the starter and winner in his second career start, allowing two runs on just one hit in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, walked seven times and went 5-for-12 with runners in scoring position...five different Twins recorded multiple hits (Larnach, Jeffers, Clemens, Keaschall & Gray) as Clemens drove in a career-high-tying five runs, including a three-run homer, his third of the season...Byron Buxton also added a home run, his sixth of the season.

**TWINS AND MS:** The Twins and Mariners are playing for the second of six times this season...Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from July 31-August 2

☞ Dating back to June 25 of last season, the Twins have won three-straight over Seattle, their longest streak since June 29, 2024-May 30, 2025 (also 3)...last time they won at least four-straight over the Ms was July 30-August 28, 2010, when they won five-straight.

☞ Byron Buxton has a .947 OPS (.339 OBP / .609 SLG) in his last 28 games against Seattle...in that span, he has 11 home runs and 31 RBI...additionally, Buck has 12 career home runs against the Mariners, his most vs. any opponent outside the AL Central.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .415 (17-for-41) with two doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .478 on-base percentage, an .805 slugging percentage and a 1.283 OPS in his last 10 games vs. Seattle pitching.

☞ Over his last nine games vs. the Mariners, Victor Caratini is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with seven RBI, a .472 on-base percentage and a .956 OPS.

**SIMPLY AUSTIN:** Austin Martin currently leads the club with 18 walks...he has posted a .500 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances...Martin has reached base safely in 17-straight games with a plate appearance and in 20 of 22 games with a plate appearance...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-game on-base streak from May 28-June 20, 2025...the 17-straight is tied for seventh-longest active streak in baseball (Nick Kurtz the leader at 22).

**TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF:** With a victory either tonight or tomorrow, the Twins will earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...they have gone 3-6-0 in series play (series results in the right margin).

☞ Twins last series win over the Mariners was June 24-26, 2025, taking two of three at Target Field.

**HOMeward BOUND:** The 11 runs scored last night marked Minnesota's most since scoring 13 on April 13 vs. Boston...they entered last night's game having scored five runs over their previous three games (all in Tampa) and 20 runs over their entire six-game roadtrip.

☞ On the season, the Twins have scored 4.93 runs-per-game, third-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball, trailing Atlanta (5.72), Los Angeles-NL (5.66), Chicago-NL (5.38), Washington (5.38), Houston (5.21) and New York-AL (5.17).

**BIG BUCK HUNTING:** Byron Buxton hit his sixth home run of the season last night...after going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Buck has homered six times in his last nine games (58 PA), since April 13...since that date, only five other players in baseball have hit as many home runs (Murakami - 8, Trout - 6, Judge - 6, Caminero - 6, Rice - 6).

**RISP ASSESSMENTS:** Twins went 5-for-12 with runners in scoring position, their most hits with RISP since going 6-for-7 on April 13 vs. Boston...Twins began the season hitting .314 (49-for-156) with runners in scoring position through their first 19 games...in their last 10 games, they are hitting .205 (18-for-88) with RISP — 2-8 in that span...despite the recent slide, they still rank third in the AL in RISP average and eighth in baseball.

☞ Notable individuals with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .500 (10-for-20)...Josh Bell is hitting .357 (10-for-28)...Brooks Lee is hitting .429 (9-for-21)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .333 (10-for-30)...Tristan Gray is hitting .333 (5-for-15)...Trevor Larnach is hitting .313 (5-for-16).

**YARD SALE:** Twins have hit 35 home runs this season, tied with Chicago for fourth-most in the AL, trailing New York (46), Los Angeles (39) and Houston (37)...through 29 games last season, the Twins had 23 home runs.

☞ 60 of the club's 143 runs scored have come off homers (42%)...they have hit 21 solo shots, five two-run homers, seven three-run jimmy jacks and two grand slams.

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** After going 2-for-4 last night, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely 13-straight games with a plate appearance, tied for second-longest of his career...his other 13-game on-base streak came July 6-26, 2024 and his career-long is 16, done August 17-September 5, 2025...during the streak, he has recorded 10 hits with 11 walks in 53 plate appearances for a .396 on-base percentage.

☞ On the season, he is hitting .298 (14-for-47) with 14 walks, a .459 on-base percentage and an .863 OPS against right-handed pitching.

**FREE BAGS:** The Twins drew seven walks last night, marking the fourth time this season with seven-plus walks in a game...Twins have now drawn 126 walks this season, tied with Milwaukee for fourth-most in baseball, trailing New York-AL (137), Los Angeles-AL (132) and Chicago-NL (130).

### THIS AND THAT:

☞ Twins have scored 5.57 runs-per-game at home this season, second-most in the AL, trailing New York (5.77).

☞ Twins run differential of +7 (143-136) is the third-best figure in the AL, trailing New York (+49) and Detroit (+10).

☞ Twins defense has committed just one error in its last five games - a Simeon Woods Richardson throwing error on Sunday at Tampa Bay.

- ⚔ Making his seventh start of 2026 and 121st start (122nd game) of his career.
- ⚔ Is 1-3 with a 4.13 ERA (24.0 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 32 strikeouts and a .237 (23-for-97) BAA in five career starts against Seattle.
- ⚔ Did not factor into the decision his last time out on April 23 at New York-NL, allowing seven runs (four earned) on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts in a 10-8 Twins loss.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ryan made his sixth start of the season on April 22 at New York-NL opposite right-hander Christian Scott...did not factor into the decision, allowing seven runs (four earned) on seven hits - two of which were home runs from Brett Baty and Carson Benge - with two walks and five strikeouts in a 5.0 inning outing...exited the game with a 7-2 deficit, but an eighth-inning grand slam from Ryan Jeffers to even the game at seven apiece took away a potential decision for Ryan.

- ⚔ Surrendered multiple home runs for the first time this season and first time doing so since allowing four blasts on September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland.
- ⚔ Three of his runs were unearned, all coming in the second inning after a passed ball on a Bo Bichette strikeout; his five unearned runs on the season are tied for the third most in baseball, only behind Arizona's Ryne Nelson and Los Angeles-AL's Walbert Ureña (6).
- ⚔ Threw 71.7% of pitches for strikes, his highest strike percentage of the season and highest since throwing 72.1% of his pitches for strikes on August 31, 2025 vs. San Diego.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan made his fifth start of the season on April 17 vs. Cincinnati opposite left-hander Brandon Williamson...took the loss, his second of the season; marked his second consecutive loss against an Interleague opponent dating back to September 26, 2025 at Philadelphia...despite the loss, made his second-straight quality start of the season, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits across 6.0 innings of work with no walks and six strikeouts.

- ⚔ First time recording a quality start in consecutive outings since doing so on July 1, 2025 at Miami and then on July 6 vs. Tampa Bay; the Twins lost both of those games.
- ⚔ Was his 18th career start of six-or-more strikeouts without allowing a walk, tying Johan Santana for the fourth most such starts in Twins club history (1961-).

**PACIFIC PALS:** This will mark Ryan's sixth career start vs. Seattle; he is 1-3 with a 4.13 ERA (24.0 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 32 strikeouts, five home runs allowed, a 1.25 WHIP and a .237 (23-for-97) BAA...in his last outing against Seattle on June 25, 2025 at Target Field, Ryan made a quality start and earned his first career win against the M's, firing 6.0 scoreless innings on three hits with no walks and eight strikeouts.

- ⚔ His 32 strikeouts against the Mariners are the fourth most by a Twins starter since Seattle's inaugural season in 1977 (1st: Bailey Ober - 42).
- ⚔ Ryan has faced 11 hitters on the Mariners' active roster; those hitters have combined for a .288 (23-for-80) BAA with seven doubles, three home runs (Garver, Naylor, Rodríguez), five walks and 24 strikeouts.

**WEST ON WEST:** Ryan is set to make his 24th start against an opponent from the AL West, tying the AL East for the second most starts Ryan has made against a division behind the AL Central...in his career, Ryan is 8-9 with a 4.71 ERA (122.1 IP, 64 ER), 39 walks and 153 strikeouts against AL West opponents.

- ⚔ In 2025, Ryan made six starts against the AL West, going 3-2 with a 3.97 ERA (34.0 IP, 15 ER), seven walks, 42 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .214 (27-for-126) BAA.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 60 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.97 ERA (330.2 IP, 146 ER), 74 walks and 349 strikeouts, compared to 27-18 with a 3.62 ERA (343.0 IP, 138 ER), 82 walks and 403 strikeouts in 61 home appearances (60 starts).

- ⚔ Since the start of the 2025 season, Ryan is 8-6 with a 3.36 ERA (96.1 IP, 36 ER), 24 walks, 116 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a .213 (76-for-357) BAA in 17 starts (18 games) at Target Field.
- ⚔ His 27 wins at home are tied for the eighth most in baseball since the start of the 2022 season.
- ⚔ His 10.84 K/9 in home starts since the start of the 2025 season ranks sixth among all starting pitchers in the American League.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, lefties are slashing .250/.297/.517 (15-for-60) with seven doubles, three home runs, two walks and 14 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .167/.235/.217 (10-for-60) with three doubles, six walks and 19 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .218/.277/.392 (268-for-1,231) with 85 walks and 307 strikeouts (3.61 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.272/.413 (291-for-1,296) with 71 walks and 445 strikeouts (6.27 K/BB).

- ⚔ Ryan's 6.27 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

⚔ Ryan's curveball ranks first among major league pitchers with a .043 (1-for-23) BAA and sixth in the league with a 50.0 strikeout percentage (minimum 20 plate appearances).

⚔ His .100 (1-for-10) opponent batting average against the split finger is tied for the fourth lowest in Major League Baseball (min. 10 plate appearances).

**NIGHT-MARE:** Tonight will mark Ryan's fifth night start of 2026, compared to just two starts during the day...he has performed significantly better under the sun rather than under the lights so far this season (see table below):

CAREER NOTES

- In 2026, was invited to participate in the World Baseball Classic as a member of Team USA.
- In 2025, made first career MLB All-Star Game appearance, throwing a 10-pitch perfect fourth inning with two strikeouts (SD Manny Machado and CHC Kyle Tucker).
- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive year in the Twins' season-opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...split the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
