**THE TWINS:** After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (1-2 at New York-NL and 0-3 at Tampa Bay), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a split of the first two games against the Mariners the last two nights...today, Minnesota will conclude the three-game series against Seattle...starting tomorrow, the Twins will begin a four-game series against the Blue Jays through Sunday.  
 ☞ Twins have gone 1-3 in rubber games this season...their one win was April 12 at Toronto...their three losses were March 29 at Baltimore, April 5 vs. Tampa Bay and April 23 at New York-NL.

**THINGS GET MESSY LATE VERSUS Ms:** The Twins lost to the Mariners last night at Target Field by a score of 7-1 as the series tied back up at 1-1...Joe Ryan (2-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs (1 inherited by Funderburk) on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, walked just once and went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position...Byron Buxton went 2-for-4 and homered for the second-straight night, his team-leading seventh of the season.

**NOTE:** Twins went 18-8 last May, their most wins for any month in 2025...18 wins also tied for the seventh-most in club history (since 1961).

**SEATTLE'S BEST:** The Twins and Mariners are playing for the third of six times this season...Minnesota will travel to Seattle for three games from July 31-August 2.

☞ Byron Buxton has a .966 OPS (.341 OBP / .625 SLG) in his last 29 games against Seattle...in that span, he has 12 home runs and 32 RBI...additionally, Buck's 13 career home runs against the Mariners are his most vs. any opponent outside the AL Central.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .400 (18-for-45) with three doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, a .460 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.238 OPS in his last 11 games vs. Seattle pitching.

☞ Notables lifetime vs. George Kirby: Josh Bell is 4-for-7 with two home runs...Matt Wallner is 3-for-7 with one home run.

**AUSTIN MARTIN. INTENSITY. DRIVEN:** Austin Martin currently leads the club with 18 walks...he has posted a .488 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances...Martin has reached base safely in 18-straight games with a plate appearance and in 21 of 23 games with a plate appearance...it marks the longest streak for a Twin since Brooks Lee's 19-game on-base streak from May 28-June 20, 2025...the 18-straight is tied for seventh-longest active streak in baseball (Nick Kurtz the leader at 22)...below are baseball's longest active on-base streaks:

**BYE BYE BYE-RON:** Byron Buxton hit his seventh home run of the season last night...after going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Buck has homered seven times in his last 10 games (63 PA), since April 13...since that date, only three other players in baseball have hit as many home runs: Munetaka Murakami - 8, Aaron Judge - 8, Mike Trout - 7.

**TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF:** Twins need a victory today to earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...looking to snap a series loss streak of three (Reds, Mets and Rays)...they have gone 3-6-0 in series play (see right margin/above).  
 ☞ Twins last series win over the Mariners was June 24-26, 2025, taking two of three at Target Field.

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** After going 1-for-4 last night, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in 14-straight games with a plate appearance, second-longest stretch of his career...his career-long is 16, done August 17-September 5, 2025...during this streak, he has recorded 11 hits with 11 walks in 57 plate appearances for a .386 on-base percentage.  
 ☞ On the season, he is hitting .300 (15-for-50) with 14 walks, a .453 on-base percentage and an .873 OPS against right-handed pitching.

**A GLOVE STORY:** In celebration of the 2026 Twins Nike RBI baseball and softball seasons, the Minnesota Twins Community Fund and Twins pitchers Taj Bradley, Pablo López and Bailey Ober will distribute 3,000 new gloves and baseballs to RBI participants ages 8-and-under...tonight's celebration of baseball and fun includes a hot dog cookout, face painting and more activities put on by the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board, a Twins Nike RBI partner...the event goes from 5-6:30 pm at Bryant Square Park in Minneapolis.

- Bradley will make his seventh start of the season in this afternoon's rubber match against the Seattle Mariners.
- In his last start on April 24 at Tampa Bay, Taj went 6.1 innings, giving up six runs (all earned) on seven hits (4 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts...Bradley's four homers allowed matched a career-high (most recent - June 1, 2024 at Baltimore).
- Through six starts this season for Minnesota, Bradley ranks second in MLB in average pitches thrown per game at 99.0, trailing only Toronto's Dylan Cease (100.3).

**LAST TIME OUT:** On April 24 at Tampa Bay, Bradley was roughed up for the first time all season, taking the loss after going 6.1 innings and giving up six runs on seven hits (4 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in a 6-2 Twins loss.

- The loss was Bradley's first of the 2026 season and first in seven starts dating back to last season...the last game he lost was on September 17, 2025 vs. New York-AL.
- Bradley allowed two home runs apiece to Junior Caminero and Jonathan Aranda, making it the first time in his career that two opposing hitters have both had multi-homer games against him in the same game.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** On Saturday, April 18 vs. Cincinnati, Bradley recorded his third quality start of the season going 6.0 innings and allowing two runs (both earned) on five hits, with two walks and five strikeouts...after completing his start, Taj's 1.63 ERA (27.2 IP, 5 ER) was the lowest by a Twins starting pitcher through their first five starts of a season since Sonny Gray's 0.62 ERA (29.0 IP, 2 ER) in 2023; Gray would go onto finish second in the AL Cy Young voting that season.

**BOUNCE BACK TIME:** Bradley has given up four home runs in a start two prior times before last Friday in Tampa Bay...here is how he pitched in his two starts following the starts in which he allowed four homers:

- ⚡ JUNE 8, 2024 VS. BALTIMORE:** Went 5.0 innings pitched, giving up one run on three hits with one walk and seven strikeouts (99 pitches/66 strikes).
- ⚡ JULY 2, 2023 AT SEATTLE:** Went 3.1 innings pitched, giving up five runs (all earned) on nine hits with one walk and three strikeouts (73 pitches/53 strikes).

**WORKHORSE:** Through his first six starts this season, Bradley is averaging 99.0 pitches thrown per game, here is where that stacks up among MLB starters:

**BETTER UNDER PRESSURE:** This season, with runners on base, Taj is holding opposing hitters to a .176 (9-for-51) BAA with nine walks and 17 strikeouts and with RISP is holding hitters to a .179 (5-for-28) BAA with two walks and 10 strikeouts...in comparison his career numbers with runners on base is a .259 (164-for-633) BAA and with RISP is a .265 (91-for-344) BAA.

**HOT START:** Despite his tough start against Tampa Bay, Bradley is still off to the best start of his career, here are how his numbers through six starts this year compare to his numbers through six starts in the first three years of his career.

**CAREER AGAINST THE MARINERS:** Bradley has made three career starts against the Mariners, going 0-0 with a 6.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 10 ER), with seven walks, 16 strikeouts and a .977 OPS against...the .977 career OPS against is the third highest against American League opponents, trailing only Chicago-AL (1.026) and Tampa Bay (1.157).

- ⚡ LAST TIME VS. THE M'S:** In his most recent start against the Mariners on June 24, 2024 while with the Rays, Bradley did not factor into the decision after going 5.1 innings pitched with one earned run allowed on two hits, with four walks and eight strikeouts.

**DUE FOR A WIN AGAINST THE AL WEST:** In 17 career starts against the American League West, Bradley is 2-6 with a 4.81 ERA (88.0 IP, 47 ER), 40 walks, 107 strikeouts and a slash line against of .221/.309/.432...his record of 2-6 (25% winning percentage) is his lowest winning percentage against any division in MLB.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.93 ERA (206.1 IP, 113 ER), 66 walks, 233 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP in 39 career home starts compared to 10-13 with a 4.48 ERA (213.0 IP, 106 ER), 89 walks, 214 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in 42 road appearances (40 starts).

- ⚡ SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 2.19 ERA (12.1 IP, 3 ER), two walks and 15 strikeouts in two home starts compared to a 2-1 record with a 3.32 ERA (21.2 IP, 8 ER), 11 walks and 19 strikeouts in four road starts.
- ⚡ CAREER AT TARGET FIELD:** In eight career starts at Target Field, Taj is 1-1 with a 5.06 ERA (42.2 IP, 24 ER), 15 walks, 47 strikeouts and a slash line against of .269/.333/.467.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .215/.282/.369 (14-for-65) with four doubles, two home runs, four RBI, six walks and 23 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .262/.347/.400 (17-for-65) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks and 14 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- ⚡ SPLIT NASTY:** Bradley's split finger continues to be one of the best pitches in baseball, here are some of his ranks on the pitch in comparison with other splits in baseball (all min. 10 plate appearances): Run Value - 3 (T-4th), wOBA - .150 (T-6th), BAA - .125 (T-7th), SLG - .167 (T-8th), Whiff % - 42.3 (10th) and K% - 36.0 (15th).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - BAILEY OBER (2026: 2-1, 3.94 ERA // CAREER: 33-31, 4.07 ERA)**

Bailey Ober will start tomorrow night's series opener against the Blue Jays...in his last outing on April 25 at Tampa Bay, Ober recorded his second quality start in a row, but took the loss, pitching 6.0 innings while giving two runs on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts...in his career against Toronto, Ober has a 2-3 record with a 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER), seven walks, 41 strikeouts and .211 (30-for-142) BAA...Bailey has made four starts at home this season, going 2-0 with a 3.68 ERA (22.0 IP, 9 ER), eight walks, 23 strikeouts and a .224 (19-for-94) BAA.
