THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 1-5 (1-2 at New York-NL and 0-3 at Tampa Bay), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a 1-2 series loss to the Mariners this week, winning game one on Monday night...

'PEN PUNCHED IN THE NINTH: The Twins lost to the Mariners yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-3, blowing a 3-2 lead entering the ninth inning...

IT'S GONNA BE MAY: With tonight being Minnesota's final March/April game, below are the club's March/April hitting (top) and pitching (bottom) number comparisons over the last five seasons:

^ - 147 runs are their most since scoring 175 in 1996. # - 241 hits are their most since recording 262 in 2002...

\* - 130 walks are the club record for March/April...also second-most for any "month" in club history, trailing their June 1962 total of 135.

WORTH NOTING: Twins played four extra games in March this season, from the 26th-30th.

LAKES AND LEAFS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the fourth of seven games in 2026...these two played a three-game weekend series at Rogers Centre from April 10-12 as the Twins won games two and three.

Notables last series vs. Toronto: Ryan Jeffers went 3-for-6 with a home run and four RBI... Austin Martin went 3-for-6 with a double and three walks...

Twins scored 19 runs during the Rogers Centre series, third-most in a series this season, trailing their Boston series (24) and Detroit series (22).

Twins have homered in 10-straight against the Blue Jays and multiple times in each of their last eight...in those 10, they have totaled 21 homers.

In 14 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner has posted a .917 OPS, including five home runs, 11 RBI and a .571 slugging percentage.

In 13 career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .400 (18-for-45) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .471 on-base percentage, a .644 slugging percentage and a 1.115 OPS...

Byron Buxton has posted an .875 OPS with nine doubles, 10 home runs, 22 RBI and a .541 slugging percentage in 35 career regular season games against the Blue Jays.

THAT IS SO OFFENSIVE: Twins recorded 12 hits yesterday, tying their season-high, done three times previously (March 29 at Baltimore, April 23 at New York-NL and Monday vs. Seattle)...

AUSTIN POWER: Austin Martin went 0-for-2 off the bench yesterday vs. Seattle, snapping his on-base streak at 18 games...he currently leads the club with 18 walks...

BUCK BLASTS: After going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered seven times in his last 14 games (68 PA), since April 13...

TOP JEFF AMERICA: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in a season-long five-straight games...the longest hitting by a Twin on the season is seven, by Austin Martin (April 8-17) and Brooks Lee (April 9-15)...

TREVOR TIME: After going 2-for-3 yesterday, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in 15-straight games with a plate appearance, one short of his career-long of 16, done August 17-September 5, 2025...

Larnach has started in 10 of the Twins last 11 games due to the Twins facing more right-handed starters recently...on the season, he is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with 14 walks, a .463 on-base percentage and an .897 OPS against right-handed pitching.

- ☞ Ober is making his seventh start of 2026, 122nd of his career and 64th at Target Field.
- ☞ Is making his eighth career start against Toronto; 2-3, 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER) with seven walks and 41 strikeouts.
- ☞ In his most recent start on April 25 at Tampa Bay, Ober made a quality start but took the loss, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) through 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bailey made his sixth start of his 2026 campaign on April 25 at Tampa Bay opposite left-hander Shane McCannan...took his first loss of the year despite making a quality start, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) through 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts.

- ☞ Threw just 83 pitches, his fewest amount of pitches thrown in a quality start since a 78-pitch, quality start effort on September 25, 2025 at Texas.
- ☞ Ober has walked one-or-more batters in each of his last eight starts dating back to September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland, his longest such streak since surrendering a walk in a career-high nine consecutive from June 22-August 11, 2021.
- ☞ Has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in each of his last three starts since April 13 vs. Boston, his most since doing so in five straight starts from April 10-May 3, 2025.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ober made his fifth start of the season on April 19 vs. Cincinnati opposite right-hander Brady Singer...made a quality start, allowing one unearned run on three hits with season-highs in innings pitched (6.1), walks (4), strikeouts (10) and pitches (102); he did not factor into the decision.

- ☞ His 10 strikeouts were his most since recording a career-high 12 on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland.
- ☞ Ober has walked one-or-more batters in each of his last seven starts dating back to September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland, his longest such streak since walking a batter in seven consecutive from September 16, 2022-May 5, 2023.

**TORONTOBER:** Ober is making his eighth career start against Toronto; is 2-3, 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER) with seven walks, 41 strikeouts (5.86 K/BB), a 0.96 WHIP and a .211 (30-for-142) BAA...faced our friends from across the border twice during the 2025 season, combining to go 0-1 with a 6.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs allowed (Addison Barger, George Springer x3), one walk and seven strikeouts; the Twins went 1-1 in those contests.

- ☞ Current Blue Jays batters are hitting a combined .217 (31-for-143) against Ober with four doubles, six home runs, seven walks and 33 strikeouts.
- ☞ Toronto has mashed eight homers against Ober in his career, the most he has surrendered to a non-AL Central opponent.

**THIS IS GETTING RIDICULOUS:** Ober is making his 23rd career start against the American League East and his fifth out of seven total starts this season; is 5-9, 3.53 ERA (119.2 IP, 47 ER) with 29 walks, 111 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .220 (98-for-445) BAA in his career against AL East opponents.

- ☞ This season in four starts against the AL East (Baltimore, Boston, Tampa Bay x2), Ober is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (20.0 IP, 12 ER), six walks, 15 strikeouts and a .240 (18-for-75) BAA.
- ☞ New York will be the only remaining member of the AL East that he has not faced this season.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In six MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 18-15 with a 4.15 ERA (336.0 IP, 155 ER), 83 walks, 333 strikeouts, a .237 (303-for-1276) BAA and a .723 OPS against in 63 starts at home compared to 15-16 with a 3.99 ERA (313.2 IP, 139 ER), 61 walks, 298 strikeouts, a .239 (283-for-1184) BAA and a .699 OPS against in 58 road starts.

- ☞ In four home starts this season, Ober is 2-0 with a 3.68 ERA (22.0 IP, 9 ER), eight walks, 23 strikeouts, a 1.23 WHIP and a .224 (19-for-85) BAA.
- ☞ The start will mark his fifth at Target Field out of seven total starts this season, his most home starts in a seven-start span to begin a season since also making five of his first seven starts at home in 2023.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .192/.276/.385 (10-for-52) with four doubles, two home runs, five walks and nine strikeouts, while righties are slashing .235/.307/.338 (16-for-68) with four doubles, one home run, six walks and 18 strikeouts.

- ☞ His .195 opponent batting average on balls in play ranks eighth among all right-handed starters in Major League Baseball (min. 50 at bats).

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Bailey has thrown 178 changeups this season, the most by an American League pitcher and second most in MLB, trailing only Cristopher Sánchez (200).
- ☞ He is fourth among MLB pitchers with a .190 (8-for-42) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 40 plate appearances).
- ☞ His 46.6% strikeout percentage with his sweeper ranks sixth in Major League Baseball among starting pitchers (min. 10 plate appearances).
- ☞ His 7.1 foot extension ranks in the league's 94th percentile, which is the third highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

**CHANGING IT UP:** Since his debut in 2021, Bailey has relied heavily on his four-seamer, with it being his predominant pitch in each of his first five big league seasons...through six starts this season, Ober has slowed opposing hitters down with his changeup, making it the primary pitch in his six-pitch arsenal, throwing it at a 34.4% clip...here are how his changeup numbers in 2026 compare to prior seasons:

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2026: 0-4, 6.30 ERA // CAREER: 12-14, 4.43 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to make his seventh start of the season tomorrow against his former organization, the Toronto Blue Jays, in the fifth game of a seven-game homestand at Target Field...in his most recent outing on April 24 at Tampa Bay, Sim took the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits (1 HR) in 4.1 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Rays 4-2 at Tropicana Field...this will be Sim's fourth career start against the Blue Jays and second this season (also on 4/10); is 0-1, 11.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 15 ER) with four walks and six strikeouts against Toronto...Simeon was traded to Toronto on July 28, 2019 from New York-NL along with left-hander Anthony Kay in exchange for right-hander Marcus Stroman, and was then dealt to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin for right-hander José Berrios.

## CAREER NOTES

- Finished 2025 second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1) and strikeouts (120).
- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for the Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
