**THE TWINS:** Have gone 4-2 through six games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. the Rays over the weekend, followed by three consecutive wins over the Tigers this week... today, Minnesota will conclude their first homestand of 2025 with the four-game series finale against Detroit... after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Toronto for a three-game weekend series at Rogers Centre... they will return to Minneapolis for a homestand that begins with Boston on Monday.

☞ Today marks day nine of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota... their next off-day will be on April 16.

☞ Twins are seeking four-straight wins today, which would be their most since winning 13-straight, from May 3-17, 2025.

**TWINS CAGE TIGERS JUST LONG ENOUGH:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 8-6, scoring six runs in the first inning... Bailey Ober (1-0) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts... Kody Funderburk closed out the ninth inning with two outs, earning his third career save and first of season... Twins now one of two teams in baseball with four different relievers to earn saves (Fundy, Topa, Sands, Laweryson), the other being Colorado with five... the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Byron Buxton, who singled twice and doubled... Royce Lewis added two hits and drove in two runs with a first inning single.

**EYE OF THE TIGERS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the fourth of 13 games tonight... after this series, these two will meet for three games at Comerica Park, from June 9-11... their next meeting in Minnesota will come August 31-September 2 for three games.

☞ With a win on August 17, 2025 and three wins this week, the Twins have now won four-straight over the Tigers for the first time since April 26-May 24, 2022, when they won five-straight.

☞ The Twins have gone 43-24 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season, second-most home wins against any opponent in that span (Kansas City - 45-17).

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 151, 36 ahead of Cleveland (115).

☞ Byron Buxton has a .989 OPS and a .625 slugging percentage in his last 20 games against the Tigers, hitting eight doubles and six home runs in 88 plate appearances.

☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .866 OPS in 23 career games vs. the Tigers... he has reached base safely in all 23 career games vs. the Tigers (.416 OBP, 20 H, 17 BB)... Lewis has drawn at least one walk in nine-straight games vs. Detroit.

☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all nine career games vs. Detroit, hitting .343 (12-for-35) with two doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, five walks and a .996 OPS.

**CARE-ATINI PROVIDER:** Victor Caratini has five hits in his last 12 at-bats... in nine games this season, Caratini is hitting .294 (10-for-34) with three walks and four RBI.

☞ Among all players in baseball with a minimum of 10 plate appearances, he ranks second in batting average against offspeed pitches at .400 (4-for-10), trailing only Matt Chapman (.444).

☞ Over his career, Caratini has hit .407 (11-for-27) with two doubles, and a .915 OPS in eight games at Target Field.

☞ Behind the plate, Caratini has posted an 80% success rate on challenges (4-for-5), third-best in baseball (min. 5 attempts), trailing Dillon Dingler (89%) and Agustín Ramirez (82%).

**SWEEP! SWEEP! SWEEP! SWEEP!** Twins are seeking their first sweep of the season today... they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games: April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field, May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field and May 16-18 at Baltimore.

☞ No team in baseball has swept an opponent in four games this season.

☞ Twins last four-game sweep of an opponent came June 13-16, 2024 vs. Oakland.

☞ They have recorded seven four-game sweeps since moving into Target Field (since 2010)... one was against Detroit from July 8-11, 2021.

☞ Their last sweep of Detroit in any number of games came April 26-28, 2022 in three games at Target Field... their last sweep of the tigers in four games came July 8-11, 2021 at Target Field.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** Twins went 5-for-13 with runners in scoring position last night and have now gone 14-for-43 (.326) with RISP through three games during this series... on the season, they are now hitting .273 (30-for-110) with RISP, which ranks fifth in the AL and 11th in baseball.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1995, Twins Hall of Famer Bob Allison passed away in Rio Verde, Arizona, at the age of 60 after a long battle with ataxia... Allison was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame in 2003... in 2000, the Twins beat the Kansas City Royals, 13-7, as both teams each hit three consecutive home runs in the same game for the first time in baseball history... Ron Coomer, Jacque Jones and Matt LeCroy did it in the sixth inning... Carlos Beltrán, Jermaine Dye and Mike Sweeney of Kansas City two innings later.

### THIS AND THAT:

☞ Twins have seen 4.02 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, fifth-most in the AL and sixth-most in baseball.

☞ Twins have driven in 20 runs with the bases loaded this season, the most in the AL, the next closest being Houston with 11.

☞ Twins lead baseball in challenges with 42 (22 as hitters, 20 on defense), the next highest is Miami with 31.

**LAST TIME OUT:** In his first career start at Target Field against the Tampa Bay Rays on April 4, Abel tossed four innings, giving up six hits and four runs, while walking three, hitting two and striking out three in a 7-1 Twins loss.

- Abel has had trouble in his second and third innings of work in both of his outings so far this year; has given up a combined nine earned runs on 10 hits in his second and third innings (6th and 7th inning in his first outing, which was in relief).
- He is the first Twins pitcher to record a loss in each of his first two outings of the season with an ERA greater than 11.00 since Stephen Gonslaves (0-2, 11.37 ERA) in 2018.

**2025 SEASON RECAP:** Combined to go 10-6 with a 3.34 ERA (137.1 IP, 51 ER), 56 walks, 153 strikeouts and a .219 BAA (112-for-511) in 28 games (26 starts) between Triple-A Lehigh Valley, Philadelphia, Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.

- In four appearances (two starts) with Minnesota, went 1-2 with a 8.36 ERA (14.0 IP, 13 ER), seven walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.79 WHIP.
- Ended season 3-4 with a 6.23 ERA (39.0 IP, 27 ER), 16 walks, 39 strikeouts and a 1.51 WHIP in 10 major league games (8 starts).

**CAREER VS. DETROIT:** Mick has never pitched against Detroit and hasn't faced any current Tiger hitters at the major league level.

- WELCOME TO THE CENTRAL:** Abel has made two career appearances (one start) against AL Central foes on August 23, 2025 at Chicago-AL (start) and on September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland.
- Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.29 ERA (7.0 IP, 8 ER), five walks, eight strikeouts and a 1.86 WHIP in those two games.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In his 12 career big-league appearances (9 starts), Abel holds a 1-4 record with a 8.75 ERA (23.2 IP, 23 ER), 15 walks, 26 strikeouts and a 2.03 WHIP at home, compared to a 2-2 record with a 5.16 ERA (22.2 IP, 13 ER), eight walks, 20 strikeouts and a 1.41 WHIP on the road.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters are slashing .500/.619/.688 (8-for-16) in 21 plate appearances off Abel, while righties are slashing .353/.476/.412 (6-for-17) in 21 plate appearances.

**THE ARSENAL:** In his first two appearances of 2026 Abel has deployed a six-pitch mix...here are the numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:
