**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-2 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. the Rays over the weekend, followed by consecutive wins over the Tigers the last two nights... tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the third of four games against Detroit... after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to Toronto for a three-game weekend series at Rogers Centre.

☞ Today marks day eight of a stretch of 15-straight days with a game for Minnesota...their next off-day will be on April 16.

☞ Twins are seeking three-straight wins tonight, which would be their most since August 5-8, 2025, when they won two over Detroit and one over Kansas City.

**BRADLEY BRINGS THE HEAT ON COLD NIGHT:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2...Taj Bradley (2-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on six hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with no walks and 10 strikeouts — his seventh career double-digit strikeout total...the offense recorded 10 hits for the second-straight game, marking their first time with back-to-back double-digit hit totals since September 12-13, 2025 (12, 10 vs. ARI)...Josh Bell had three hits and drove in one run, while Ryan Jeffers had a two-run double off Tarik Skubal in the fifth inning...the pitching staff's 14 strikeouts were two short of their season-high of 16, done March 28 at Baltimore.

**JUNGLE BOOK:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the third of 13 games tonight...after this series, these two will meet again for three games at Comerica Park, from June 9-11...they won't meet back in Minnesota until August 31-September 2 for three games.

☞ With a win on August 17, 2025 and two wins this week, the Twins have now won three-straight over the Tigers for the first time since July 23-August 1, 2022...the last time they won four-straight was April 26-May 24, 2022, when they won five-straight.

☞ The Twins have gone 42-24 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season, second-most home wins against any opponent in that span (Kansas City - 45-17).

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 151, 36 ahead of Cleveland (115).

☞ Byron Buxton has a .943 OPS and a .605 slugging percentage in his last 19 games against the Tigers, hitting seven doubles and six home runs in 83 plate appearances.

☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .841 OPS in 22 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 22 career games vs. the Tigers (.400 OBP, 18 H, 16 BB)...Lewis has drawn at least one walk in eight-straight games vs. Detroit.

☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all eight career games vs. Detroit, hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, five walks and a 1.090 OPS.

**COOL HANDS LUKE:** Luke Keaschall has made nine outs on balls hit 100+ mph, second-most in baseball, trailing Bobby Witt Jr. (10)...Keaschall is hitting .364 (4-for-11) against offspeed pitches this season, second-highest mark in baseball (minimum of 10 PA), trailing only Matt Chapman (.444)...below is a look at his first five games this season and his last six:

**SO. MANY. LEFTIES:** Minnesota is facing its sixth lefty starter in its last nine games and seventh time in 12 games...they faced Trevor Rogers on Opening Day in Baltimore (1-2 loss), Kris Bubic on March 30 at Kansas City (1-3 loss), Noah Cameron on April 1 at Kansas City (9-13 loss) Cole Ragans on April 2 at Kansas City (5-1 win), Steven Matz on Saturday vs. Tampa Bay (1-7 loss) and Tarik Skubal last night (4-2 win)

☞ Twins are hitting .196 (30-for-153) with seven doubles, two home runs, 21 walks and 48 strikeouts against lefties this season...the two home runs were from Matt Wallner off Kris Bubic on March 30 at KC and Josh Bell off Bailey Falter on April 1 at KC.

☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .385 (25-for-65) with a .481 on-base percentage and a .989 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average ranks second in all of baseball (min. 70 PA), trailing only Andrew Vaughn (.392)...his OPS ranks 10th.

**MAJORITY REPORT:** A win tonight and/or tomorrow and the Twins will earn their first series victory of the season...they have gone 0-3-0 in series play (series results lower right).

☞ Minnesota's last series win came September 23-25 at Texas, taking two of three from the Rangers during their final roadtrip of 2025.

☞ The Twins last series win of four games was June 2-4, 2025, when they took three of four from the A's in Sacramento.

☞ The Twins last series win over the Tigers was in three games at Comerica Park, from August 4-6, 2025...their last four-game series win over the Tigers came July 8-11, 2021, sweeping in four games at Target Field.

**WARNING BELL:** Over his last seven games, Josh Bell is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with two doubles, two home runs, five walks, seven RBI, seven runs scored, a .444 on-base percentage, a .682 slugging percentage and a 1.126 OPS.

☞ Among all AL players this season with a minimum of 40 plate appearances, he ranks 11th in both slugging percentage (.559) and OPS (.954).

☞ Bell has 195 career home runs, needing five to become the 39th active player in baseball to reach the 200 home run mark...Xander Bogaerts is the closest to 200 among actives with 198...Javier Báez is the next trailing player to Bell with 193.

**CARE-ATINI PROVIDER:** Victor Caratini has four hits in his last eight at-bats...in eight games this season, Caratini is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with two walks and four RBI.

☞ Over his last four games, he is hitting .375 (3-for-8) with two RBI as a right-handed batter facing left-handed pitching.

☞ Over his career, Caratini has hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, and a .962 OPS in seven games at Target Field.

**HEAD SHOTS:** Twins enter today having used the ABS challenge system 38 times, the most in baseball...Twins have won 22 of those challenges, posting a 58% success rate (tied 11th in MLB)...they have won 10 of 20 on the hitting side and 12 of 18 on the pitching side.

☞ Ryan Jeffers has won eight of 13 challenges for a 62% success rate, fourth-highest percentage among catchers in baseball (min. 10 tries).

- ☞ Is making his 14th career start against Detroit; 4-3, 4.13 ERA (72.0 IP, 33 ER) with 13 walks and 76 strikeouts.
- ☞ In his most recent start on April 3 vs. Tampa Bay, Ober went 4.0 innings pitched, allowing three runs on four hits with two walks and four strikeouts.

**OBER AND OUT:** Ober made his first start at Target Field in 2026 on the April 3 home opener vs. Tampa Bay, allowing three runs through 4.0 innings with two walks and four strikeouts in a 10-4 Twins victory; he did not factor into the decision.

- ☞ Bailey's four doubles allowed matched a single-game career high, as Junior Caminero, Nick Fortes, Jake Fraley and Ben Williamson each collected a two-base knock off of the righty starter.
- ☞ His no-decision marked the first time he has not earned a decision in either of his first two starts of a season since 2021.

**2025 SEASON RECAP:** Made 27 starts in the 2025 season, going 6-9 with a 5.10 ERA (146.1 IP, 83 ER), 31 walks and 120 strikeouts.

- ☞ Finished second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1), quality starts (8) and strikeouts (120).
- ☞ Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed and one walk in final start on September 25 at Texas...also recorded his 600th career strikeout, fanning Joc Pederson in the first inning.
- ☞ Battled discomfort in left hip for majority of season after starting to feel it in spring training...eventually on July 2, went on 15-day Injured List, his first time on IL in three seasons (2022).

**EARN YOUR STRIPES:** Ober is making his 14th career start against Detroit; is 4-3, 4.13 ERA (72.0 IP, 33 ER) with 13 walks, 76 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .257 (72-for-280) BAA...has faced the Tigers six times at Target Field, with the last being on August 14, 2025, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched with four strikeouts; 2-0, 3.68 ERA (29.1 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 31 strikeouts at home against Detroit in his career.

- ☞ His 76 strikeouts vs. Detroit since the beginning of the 2021 season are tied with Lucas Giolito for the second most during that span (1st: Joe Ryan, 78).
- ☞ Is winless in six straight home starts against division opponents, with his last victory coming on April 22, 2025 vs. Chicago-AL.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In five MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 16-15 with a 4.22 ERA (318.0 IP, 149 ER), 77 walks, 314 strikeouts, a .239 (288-for-1207) BAA and a .730 OPS against in 60 starts at home compared to 15-15 with a 4.01 ERA (307.2 IP, 137 ER), 59 walks, 295 strikeouts, a .240 (280-for-1165) BAA and a .700 OPS against in 57 road starts.

- ☞ In 2025, went 2-6 at home with a 5.12 ERA (82.2 IP, 47 ER), 18 walks, 70 strikeouts and a .783 OPS against in 15 starts, compared to 4-3 on the road with a 5.09 ERA (63.2 IP, 36 ER), 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and an .837 OPS against in 12 starts.
- ☞ Allowed 17 of his 30 home runs at Target Field in 2025.
- ☞ Is winless in 13 consecutive home starts dating back to May 8, 2025 vs. Baltimore, tied for the second longest such streak in club history (1961-); longest is Mike Pelfrey's 17-gamer from April 23, 2013-April 17, 2015.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .154/.214/.231 (2-for-13) with a double, one walk and two strikeouts, while righties are slashing .316/.381/.632 (6-for-19) with a home run, three doubles, two walks and three strikeouts.

- ☞ Has allowed opponents to hit .375 (3-for-8) with runners in scoring position, surrendering a home run, two doubles, six RBI, a walk and three strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix in his first two starts of the season; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:
