**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. Seattle earlier this week, followed by a win over Toronto last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of four games against the Toronto Blue Jays and conclude the series on Sunday afternoon.

☞ Twins have gone 9-8 at home this season, compared to 5-10 on the road...their nine wins are tied for fourth-most in the AL...they have scored 5.24 runs-per-game at home, eighth-highest mark in all of baseball.

**THE BAILEY SHOW:** The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 7-1... Bailey Ober (3-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...the bullpen (Banda, Morris and Topa) combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded six hits, three from Byron Buxton, who doubled (5) and homered (8)...Ryan Jeffers also added a two-run homer, his fourth of the season... Trevor Larnach walked twice, extending his on-base streak to 16 games, tying his career-best.

**IT'S THE FIRST OF THE MONTH:** The Twins completed the March/April portion of their schedule last night...below are the club's March/April hitting (top) and pitching (bottom) number comparisons over the last five seasons:

**WORTH NOTING:** Twins played four extra games in March this season, from the 26th-30th.

**POUTINE PUNCH:** The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the fifth of seven games in 2026...one more win for Minnesota in these next three games and they will clinch the season-series over Toronto for the first time since 2024 (4-2).

☞ Twins have now won three straight over the Jays, their longest streak head-to-head since winning four straight, from May 6, 2019-September 17, 2021, which spanned three years... last time they won at least three straight in *one season* was May 2-July 25, 2018, when they won four straight.

☞ Notables this season vs. Toronto: Ryan Jeffers is 4-for-10 with two home runs and six RBI... Austin Martin is 4-for-9 with a double and four walks.

☞ Twins have scored 26 runs vs. the Jays this season, their most against any opponent.

☞ Twins have homered in 11 straight against the Blue Jays and multiple times in each of their last nine...in those 11, they have totaled 23 homers.

☞ In 14 career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .444 on-base percentage, a .604 slugging percentage and a 1.049 OPS.

☞ Byron Buxton has posted a .971 OPS with 10 doubles, 11 home runs, 23 RBI and a .577 slugging percentage in 36 career regular season games against the Blue Jays.

**BEEN A WHILE:** Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 15th time in 33 games... they have gone 5-9 against left-handed starters this season...their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framer Valdez (8-6), April 11 at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and April 13 vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6).

☞ Twins have dropped their last four when a lefty starts: April 15 against Boston vs. Connelly Early, April 17 against Cincinnati vs. Brandon Williamson, April 18 against Cincinnati vs. Andrew Abbott and April 25 at Tampa Bay vs. Shane Bieber.

☞ The 14 lefty starters are the most any MLB team has faced this season.

☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .364 (32-for-88) with a .467 on-base percentage and a .979 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his batting average ranks tied for fourth in all of baseball (min. 80 PA)...his OPS ranks 14th.

☞ Austin Martin is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with 14 walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .947 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...in his career vs. lefties, he is slashing .294/.400/.406 (.806 OPS).

**OFFENSE TAKEN:** Twins scored seven-plus runs for the 10th time in 32 games this season last night...their 154 runs scored are eighth-most in baseball and second-most in the AL, trailing only Houston (168)...through their first 32 games in 2025, they had scored just 123 runs, which ranked 18th in baseball.

☞ On the season, the Twins have posted a .326 on-base percentage, ranking fifth-best in the AL, trailing Houston (.346), Detroit (.333), Los Angeles (.332) and Tampa Bay (.327).

☞ Twins have hit 38 home runs this season, tied with Chicago for fourth-most in the AL, trailing New York (48), Los Angeles (42) and Houston (40)...through 32 games last season, the Twins had just 25 home runs.

**LONG GONE BYRON:** After going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered eight times in his last 15 games (72 PA), since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Munetaka Murakami, Mike Trout and Aaron Judge for most homers in baseball...despite the early season homer drought, Buck still ranks tied for seventh in the AL in homers on the entire season.

**COMPLIMENTS TO THE JEFF:** Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in a season-long six-straight games...the longest hitting streak by a Twin on the season is seven, by Austin Martin (April 8-17) and Brooks Lee (April 9-15)...over his last 15 games, Jeffers is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with one triple, four home runs, 17 RBI, nine walks, a .466 on-base percentage, a .646 slugging percentage and a 1.111 OPS.

**TENACIOUS D:** Twins defense has committed just one error in its last eight games since April 23 - a Simeon Woods Richardson throwing error on Sunday at Tampa Bay...since that date, only the Athletics and Mariners have committed as few errors - both with one.

**MUSSEL UP:** Low-A Fort Myers beat Daytona last night by a score of 24-8, setting a club record for runs scored, passing the previous record of 22 runs on August 7, 2012...this record eclipsed both the Miracle era (1992-2019) and the Mussels era (since 2020).

- ⌘ Making his seventh start of the season, 58th start of his career (60th game) and fourth career start vs. Toronto (second this season).
- ⌘ On April 26 at Tampa Bay, took the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits (1 HR) in 4.1 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts.
- ⌘ Is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (11.2 IP, 7 ER), five walks and seven strikeouts in two starts at Target Field this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sim made his sixth start of the season on April 26 at Tampa Bay opposite right-hander and former Twins reliever Griffin Jax, who started as the opener for the Rays that day...took the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits - including a home run from Yandy Diaz - through 4.1 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell in the series finale by a score of 4-2.

- ⌘ Sim has allowed a home run in all six starts this season, becoming the first Twins starter to allow a homer in six consecutive starts to begin a season since Liam Hendriks did so in seven straight to begin his 2012 campaign.
- ⌘ Has surrendered three walks in each of his last three starts dating back to April 15 vs. Boston, becoming the first Twins starter to do so since Lance Lynn walked three-or-more batters in five straight from April 2-30, 2018.
- ⌘ Joined Cleveland's Slade Ceconci and Boston's Brayan Bello as the only starters in MLB to have four losses and an ERA of 6.00-or-higher through their first six starts of 2026.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Sim made his fifth start of the season on April 21 at New York-NL, his former organization, opposite right-hander Nolan McLean...allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) through 5.0 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins came from behind to win game one of the series by a score of 5-3; he did not factor into the decision.

- ⌘ He fired a season-high 95 pitches in the outing, his most since a 99-pitch performance on July 28, 2025 vs. Boston.
- ⌘ Sim was drafted by New York-NL in the second round of the 2018 Amateur Draft before being traded to Toronto along with left-hander Anthony Kay in exchange for right-hander Marcus Stroman and cash.

**OUR FRIENDS FROM THE NORTH:** Sim is set to make his fourth career start against Toronto and second this season (also on April 10); he is 0-1 with an 11.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 15 ER), four walks, six strikeouts, six home runs allowed, a 1.92 WHIP and a .352 (19-for-54) BAA in his career against the Blue Jays...in his most recent outing against Toronto on April 10 at Rogers Centre, Sim took the loss, allowing five runs on six hits - one of them being a two-run blast off the bat of Brandon Valenzuela - with one walk and two strikeouts.

- ⌘ He has allowed five runs in each of his three career outings against Toronto.
- ⌘ Simeon has faced 13 active Blue Jay batters, who have combined for a .367 (22-for-60) BAA with eight doubles, five home runs (Andrés Giménez, Davis Schneider x3, Brandon Valenzuela), 12 RBI, four walks and eight strikeouts against him.
- ⌘ Sim was traded from Toronto to Minnesota on July 30, 2021 alongside Austin Martin in exchange for right-hander Jose Berrios.

**FEASTING AND EASTING:** Today's game will mark Simeon's 13th career start against an AL East opponent and fifth out of his seven starts this season; 1-3, 6.63 ERA (57.0 IP, 42 ER) with 24 walks, 44 strikeouts, 13 homers allowed, a 1.72 WHIP and a .316 (74-for-234) BAA in his career against the AL East.

- ⌘ In four starts against the AL East this season, Sim is 0-3 with a 7.20 ERA (20.0 IP, 16 ER) with nine walks, 11 strikeouts, a 1.90 WHIP and a .345 (29-for-84) BAA.
- ⌘ His 6.63 ERA against the AL East is his highest against any MLB division.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In his career, Sim has gone 6-5 with a 4.03 ERA (140.2 IP, 63 ER), 55 walks, 133 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 28 games (27 starts) at home compared to 6-9 with a 4.81 ERA (144.0 IP, 77 ER), 57 walks, 114 strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP in 31 road games (30 starts).

- ⌘ Is 0-1, 5.40 ERA (11.2 IP, 7 ER) with five walks, seven strikeouts, a 1.71 WHIP and a .319 (15-for-47) BAA in two starts at Target Field this season.
- ⌘ Has yielded three-or-fewer earned runs in nine of his last 10 home starts dating back to June 21, 2025 vs. Milwaukee, owning a 3.06 ERA (53.0 IP, 18 ER) with 23 walks, 49 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP and a .218 (43-for-197) BAA during that span; the lone exception was his most recent home start on April 15 vs. Boston, when he allowed six earned runs.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** So far in 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .317/.388/.533 (19-for-60) with four doubles, three home runs, seven walks and 10 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .306/.368/.516 (19-for-62) with four doubles, three home runs, six walks and five strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .249/.324/.390 (124-for-497) with 54 walks and 112 strikeouts (2.07 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .246/.313/.422 (145-for-590) with 58 walks and 135 strikeouts (2.33 K/BB).

**THE ARSENAL:** Woods Richardson relies on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⌘ He and Taj Bradley are the only Twins pitchers to throw at least 100 pitches with three different pitch types within his arsenal this season (4-seam fastball, split finger, slider).
- ⌘ Sim's -8 run value with his split finger ranks as the worst among all pitchers in Major League Baseball; it also is tied for the second worst run value of any pitcher by any pitcher in the league this season (worst: Zack Littell's sinker, -9 run value).
- ⌘ This season, Sim has an overall strikeout percentage of just 11.0%, over nine percent below his career average of 20.2; it falls within the bottom two percent among all pitchers this season.

**WHERE'S THE SUPPORT?:** In six starts this season, Simeon has received just nine runs of support from the Twins offense, which is tied for the seventh fewest runs of support provided to a starter through his first six starts of 2026...it is by far the least amount of run support a Twins starter has received through six starts this season, with the next fewest being Joe Ryan (18).

- ⌘ Of his six starts, four of them have yielded just one-or-fewer runs of support, with four of his nine total runs of support coming in one game on April 10 at Toronto; the Twins lost that game 10-4.
- ⌘ Since the start of the 2024 season, Simeon has received 130 total runs of support, which ranks as the fifth fewest among starting pitchers in Major League Baseball during that span (min. 50 starts).
- ⌘ His RSA of 2.70 is tied for the fifth lowest in the American League this season (min. 30.0 IP).

**CAREER NOTES**

- Recorded a career-high 7 wins in 2025, the second most on the team... finished the year third on the team in strikeouts (107), starts (22) and innings pitched (111.1).
- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
