### DID BUCK HOMER LAST NIGHT?

—NO— \*OBVIOUSLY\*

**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-3 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 in D.C. against the Nationals, followed by a 1-1 split of the first two games in Cleveland against the Guardians...today, Minnesota will finish the trip with the three-game series finale in Cleveland...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow...starting on Tuesday, they will begin a nine-game homestand with three against Miami (Tuesday-Thursday), three against Milwaukee (next weekend), then three against Houston (May 18-20).  
 ☞ Twins have gone 1-5 in rubber games this season...their one win was April 12 at Toronto...their five losses were March 29 at Baltimore, April 5 vs. Tampa Bay, April 23 at New York-NL, April 29 vs. Seattle and Thursday at Washington.

**SO THE TWINS GO INTO EXTRAS IN CLEVELAND, AND.....:** The Twins beat the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 2-1 in 11 innings...the victory marked the club's second (2-13) win this season when scoring under four runs, second (2-4) one-run win and first (1-2) win in extras...Joe Ryan was the starter, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...the Twins used a season-high six relievers, who combined to pitch 5.0 hitless innings...Byron Buxton had both of the Twins' hits, recording a leadoff home run, then driving in the winning run with an RBI-double in the top of the 11th.  
 ☞ According to Elias, Buxton is the first player since at least 1900 to have all of his team's hits with one being a leadoff home run and the other producing a go-ahead/game-winning RBI.  
 ☞ Additionally, below are the last few instances of a player having both his team's RBI in a two-run winning effort, with both RBI coming on separate at-bats:

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas from Triple-A St. Paul...Rojas will be making his second stint with the Twins this season...he made his major league debut on April 22 at New York-NL, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, with two hits and three walks...since being optioned back to St. Paul on April 24, he has gone 1-0, 4.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 4 ER), three walks and 10 strikeouts in three relief appearances.  
 ☞ To make room for Rojas on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk to St. Paul...Funderburk made 19 appearances for the Twins, going 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), 13 walks and 10 strikeouts.

**OHIO PLAYERS:** The Twins and Guardians are playing the third of 13 meetings today...after this series, Minnesota will host Cleveland for a three-game series at Target Field from July 7-9.  
 ☞ Since the start of 2024, 17 of the 28 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 4-13 in those)...and 12 have been decided by one run (Twins 3-9).  
 ☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with two doubles, one home run, five walks, eight RBI, a .383 on-base percentage and an .812 OPS in 12 career games at Progressive Field...he has reached base safely in seven-straight games in this ballpark.

**ONE-NOTHING:** Buxton hit his second leadoff home run of the season last night and 22nd of his career...below are Twins (since 1961) all-time leadoff homers (left) and MLB leadoff homers since 2025 (right):

**KEEP ON TRUCKIN':** After going homerless in his first 14 games (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered 13 times in his last 23 games (109 PA), since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 13 home runs still rank tied for third in the AL on the entire season (tied for 3rd in MLB).  
 ☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 10, 2025 - Buck has hit 39 home runs in 128 games...over his last 162 games (since March 29, 2025), he has hit 48 home runs.  
 ☞ Since the start of last season, Buck has hit 48 home runs, fourth-most in the AL and seventh-most in baseball in that span.  
 ☞ Buck is on pace to finish the season with 52 homers...single-season career-high is 35 (2025).

**BEST OF:** With a win today, the Twins will earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...they have gone 3-8-1 in series play, 2-3-1 at home and 1-5-0 on the road...season results in the right margin.  
 ☞ Twins last series win over Cleveland was September 4-6, 2023 at Progressive Field, going 0-6-2 in series play vs. the Guards since.

**TWINS MLB WEEKLYS:** The Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul first baseman Aaron Sabato and Double-A Wichita outfielder Garrett Spain as co-minor league Players of the Week, and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Justin Mitrovich as their minor league Pitcher of the Week.  
 ☞ Sabato, 26, had three multi-hit games during the week, including a four-hit, three-homer game on Tuesday at Las Vegas...the Rye, NY native was selected by the Twins 27th overall in the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of North Carolina.  
 ☞ Spain, 25, doubled and tripled at Amarillo on Tuesday, then went 3-for-6 with three home runs and six RBI on Thursday at Amarillo...the Clarksville, TN native was acquired by the Twins in the minor league phrase of the 2025 Rule 5 Draft from Milwaukee.  
 ☞ Mitrovich, 22 made his professional debut in a start last Sunday at Daytona, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, allowing three hits, two walks and five strikeouts...the Trenton, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Elon University.

**SAY HI TO YOUR MOTHER FOR ME:** The Twins are 30-35 all-time on Mother's Day...they won on Mom's Day last season, on May 11, on a DaShawn Keirse Jr. walk-off single in the 10th inning to beat San Francisco...Twins have won each their last four Mother's Day games.
