**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 3-3, going 1-2 at Washington last week, following by a 2-1 series win at Cleveland over the weekend...tonight, Minnesota will begin a nine-game homestand with the first of three against Miami through Thursday afternoon...following this series, the Twins will host Milwaukee for three games over the weekend, then host Houston for three games from next Monday-Wednesday.  
 ☞ Twins are 3-2 this season following an off-day...their three wins are March 28 at Baltimore, April 21 at New York-NL and May 5 at Washington...their two losses are April 1 at Kansas City and April 17 vs. Cincinnati.

**BRING YA A:** Due to Game 6 of the Wolves-Spurs Western Conference Semifinals across the street on Friday night, the Twins have shifted the start time of their home game vs. the Milwaukee Brewers at Target Field to a 6:10 pm (CT) first pitch, rather than 7:10 pm as previously scheduled...Target Field gates will now open at 4:00 pm for the Twins pregame Friday Happy Hour, featuring \$2 beers, \$2 hot dogs, \$2 snacks and a live performance by The Johnny Holm Band.

**TWINS GET IT DONE FOR MOM:** The Twins celebrated Mother's Day with a win over the Guardians on Sunday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 5-4, their second-straight one-run win and third of the season (3-4)...it marked Minnesota's first series win since April 13-15 vs. Boston...Andrew Morris was the opener, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning...Kendry Rojas was named the winner, allowing one run on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched in relief of Morris, earning his first major league win...Yoendrys Gómez earned the save with a perfect ninth inning, throwing 10 pitches (9 strikes)...the offense recorded 13 hits, their fourth time with double-digit hit totals on the roadtrip...Kody Clemens had three hits and scored two runs.

**MIAMI VICE** 🍷 **MINNESOTA NICE:** Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this week...Twins are 12-13 against the Marlins, going 6-5 in Minnesota (2-1 at Metrodome and 4-4 at Target Field) and 6-8 in Miami (2-1 at Dolphin Stadium and 4-7 at loanDepot Park).

☞ These two last played each other for three games at loanDepot Park from July 1-3, 2025 as the Twins won just the middle game of the three games.

☞ The Marlins last visited Target Field for three games from September 24-26, 2024 as the Twins won just the middle game of the three games.

☞ 25 games against Miami are the fewest for Minnesota against any opponent in their history.  
 ☞ Josh Bell played parts of two seasons with Miami from 2023-24, hitting .249 (149-for-598) with 27 doubles, 25 home runs, 75 RBI and a .739 OPS in 157 games...he was traded from Cleveland to Miami on August 1, 2023, in exchange for Kahlil Watson and Jean Segura... began the next season (2024) with the Marlins and was traded away to Arizona at the deadline again for a player to be named later.

**NATIONWIDE NOT ON OUR SIDE:** Twins have gone just 2-7 against National League opponents this season, going 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23) and 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7)...they are seeking their first series win over an NL team since taking two of three over San Diego at Target Field from August 29-31, 2025.

**AS LONG AS HE KEEPS HOMERING, THERE WILL BE A NOTE:** After going homerless in his first 14 games (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered 13 times in his last 24 games (114 PA), since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 13 home runs still rank tied for third in the AL on the entire season (tied for 5th in MLB).

☞ Since April 21, he has not gone more than three games without hitting a home run.

☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 10, 2025 - Buck has hit 39 home runs in 126 games...over his last 162 games (since March 29, 2025), he has hit 48 home runs.

☞ Buck is on pace to finish the season with 51 homers...single-season career-high is 35 (2025).

**RISING STEADI-LEE:** Brooks Lee has 37 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (42)...below are Lee's first 10 games (March 26-April 8) compared to his numbers over his last 28 games (since April 9):

ADDITIONALLY: He has multiple hits eight times in his last 16 games.

**DEN OF THIEVES:** Twins matched a single-game season-high with three stolen bases on Sunday afternoon at Cleveland (Buxton, Clemens and Lee)...Minnesota now has stolen 16 bases in its last 15 games, since April 25...in that span, they are tied with Tampa Bay for fifth-most in baseball, trailing Cleveland (23), Miami (17), San Diego (17) and Boston (16)...in those games, Minnesota is 16-for-18 in stolen base attempts.

**THAT IS SO OFFENSIVE:** Twins finished the six-game roadtrip with double-digit hit totals four times...on the season, the Twins have posted a .325 on-base percentage, ranking fifth-best in the AL, trailing Houston (.333), New York (.331), Tampa Bay (.328) and the Athletics (.326).

☞ They also rank third in the AL in runs scored (194), trailing New York (217) and Houston (197).

**SIMPLY AUSTIN:** After reaching three more times on Sunday afternoon (2 hits, 1 walk), Austin Martin is hitting .337 with a .466 on-base percentage on the season...among players with a minimum of 115 plate appearances, Martin's on-base percentage leads baseball, while his batting average ranks third, trailing Brandon Marsh (.353) and Otto Lopez (.344).

☞ He has posted a walk percentage of 18.1, ranking sixth-highest in baseball (min. 115 PA), trailing Taylor Ward (21.9), Nick Kurtz (21.0), Mike Trout (20.4), Rhys Hoskins (19.5) and Bryan Reynolds (18.5).

**DON'T STOP RELIEVIN':** Since allowing 10 runs on eight hits (3 HR) on Wednesday at Washington, the bullpen has allowed just eight runs on 19 hits in 19.2 innings pitched for a 3.66 ERA...they have recorded back-to-back saves (García & Gómez) for the first time since saving all four games of the Detroit series, from April 6-9.

**CHICKEN-N-BEER:** The Twins announced yesterday that legendary hip hop artist and entertainer Ludacris will perform a postgame concert on Friday, June 26...admission to the concert is free with a ticket to that night's 7:10 pm Twins vs. Colorado Rockies game (available at twins.com/tickets)...a special VIP package - which includes a game ticket plus exclusive postgame field access near the stage - is available now at twins.com/Ludacris...a chart-topping, three-time GRAMMY Award winner renowned for his lyrical acumen, wit and imagery, Ludacris will take the on-field stage approximately 15 minutes after the game concludes.

☞ Ober is making his ninth start of 2026 (124th career) and 65th career start at Target Field.  
 ☞ Is making his second career start against Miami; 0-1, 7.20 ERA (5.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and seven strikeouts.  
 ☞ In his most recent start on May 6 at Washington, Ober took the loss, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bailey made his eighth start of the season on May 6 at Washington opposite right-hander Miles Mikolas...took his second loss of the season, allowing a season-high five runs on six hits - one being a go-ahead, two-run home run from Drew Millas in the fifth inning - in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins suffered their largest loss of the season, 15-2, at Nationals Park.

☞ Matched a season low 82 pitches through 5.0 innings before being pulled after failing to record an out in the sixth inning, surrendering back-to-back doubles to CJ Abrams and Brady House...the Nationals would go on to score 11 unanswered runs against the Twins bullpen, with one of those runs belonging to Ober.  
 ☞ Has allowed a home run in three consecutive starts dating back to April 25 at Tampa Bay, his longest such streak since a three-start home run streak from August 14-September 1, 2025.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Bailey made his seventh start of his 2026 campaign on April 30 vs. Toronto opposite right-hander Kevin Gausman...made his third consecutive quality start and earned the win, allowing just one run on four hits (1 HR) through 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts.

☞ The outing marked the first time Ober has recorded a quality start in three consecutive outings since a stretch of five straight quality starts from April 10-May 3, 2025; he went 4-0 with a 1.97 ERA (32.0 IP, 7 ER) during that span.

**GONE FISHIN':** Ober is making his second career start against Miami, and first since 2024; in his lone start against the Marlins on September 24, 2024, Ober took the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits through 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts as the Fish defeated the Twins 4-1 at LoanDepot Park.

☞ Current Marlins batters are hitting a combined .231 (3-for-13) against Ober with one double (Xavier Edwards), two walks and four strikeouts.

☞ Bailey is searching for his first win against a National League opponent since April 15, 2025 vs. New York-NL...after starting his career 3-1 through his first seven Interleague starts, Ober has gone just 2-7 through his last 17, owning a 5.90 ERA (90.0 IP, 59 ER) in those contests.

**WALK IT OUT:** Bailey has walked an unusual amount of batters to begin his 2026 campaign...through his first eight starts of the season, Ober has a walk rate of 8.3%, which is nearly three percent higher than his career average of 5.5%.

☞ He has walked 15 batters through his first eight games, matching the most walks in any eight-game span of his career (done three times, most recently from July 22-September 1, 2024).

☞ Has walked a batter in a career-high 10 consecutive games dating back to September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In six MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 19-15 with a 4.11 ERA (342.0 IP, 156 ER), 85 walks, 335 strikeouts, a .237 (307-for-1298) BAA and a .721 OPS against in 64 starts at home compared to 15-17 with a 4.07 ERA (318.2 IP, 144 ER), 63 walks, 301 strikeouts, a .240 (289-for-1205) BAA and a .703 OPS against in 59 road starts.

☞ In five home starts this season, Ober is 3-0 with a 3.21 ERA (28.0 IP, 10 ER), 10 walks, 25 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .215 (23-for-107) BAA.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .195/.271/.429 (15-for-77) with six doubles, four home runs, seven walks and 12 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .244/.316/.337 (21-for-86) with five doubles, one home run, eight walks and 20 strikeouts.

☞ His .246 opponent batting average on balls in play is tied for ninth among all right-handed starters in Major League Baseball.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

☞ Bailey has thrown 244 changeups this season, the most by an American League pitcher and third most in MLB, trailing Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez (318) and Chicago-NL's Edward Cabrera (245).

☞ He is third among MLB pitchers with a .180 (11-for-61) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 60 plate appearances).

☞ Ober has a breaking run value of four, which ranks in the league's 92nd percentile.

☞ His 7.1 foot extension ranks in the league's 95th percentile, which is the fourth highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

**CHANGING IT UP:** Since his debut in 2021, Bailey has relied heavily on his four-seamer, with it being his predominant pitch in each of his first five big league seasons...through eight starts this season, Ober has slowed opposing hitters down with his changeup, making it the primary pitch in his six-pitch arsenal, throwing it at a 35.5% clip...here are how his changeup numbers in 2026 compare to prior seasons:

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2026: 0-5, 6.92 ERA // CAREER: 12-15, 4.57 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to make his ninth start of the season tomorrow in the second game of a three-game set with the Miami Marlins...in his most recent outing on May 7 at Washington, Sim did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell in the rubber match 7-5 at Nationals Park...this will be Woods Richardson's third career start against the Marlins; is 1-0, 6.00 ERA (6.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks and five strikeouts against Miami; Twins are 2-0 in his two prior starts against the Fish.
