CAUTION, WALKERS: Twins hitters drew six walks last night compared to their four hits... it marked the third time this season that the Twins have out-walked their hit total...

FULL PLATES: The Twins earned just their third win of the season last night when scoring three runs-or-fewer... the previous two were a 3-1 win on April 9 vs. Detroit...

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Since allowing 10 runs on eight hits (3 HR) on Wednesday at Washington, the bullpen has allowed just eight runs on 19 hits in 19.2 innings pitched...

BRING YA A: Due to Game 6 of the Wolves-Spurs Western Conference Semifinals across the street on Friday night, the Twins have shifted the start time of their home game vs. the Milwaukee Brewers at Target Field to a 6:10 pm (CT) first pitch...

- ☞ Making his ninth start of the season, 60th start of his career (62nd game) and third career start vs. Miami.
- ☞ On May 7 at Washington, Sim did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts.
- ☞ Is 0-2 with a 6.06 ERA (16.1 IP, 11 ER), six walks and nine strikeouts in three starts at Target Field this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Sim made his eighth start of the season on May 7 at Washington opposite right-hander Jake Irvin...did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on four hits through 4.1 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Nationals by a score of 7-5.

- ☞ Snapped a streak of seven consecutive games with a homer run allowed, which was tied for the longest such streak of his career (also 7, April 7-May 14, 2025)...it is the longest such streak by any pitcher this season.
- ☞ Threw just 61 pitches, besting his previous season-low of 68 on April 10 at Toronto; is his fewest amount of pitches thrown in a start since July 22, 2025 at Los Angeles-NL (58).
- ☞ His 6.92 ERA is the highest by a Twins starting pitcher through his first eight starts of a season since Lance Lynn posted a 7.47 ERA through his first eight starts of his 2018 campaign.

TWO STARTS AGO: Sim made his seventh start of the season on May 1 vs. Toronto opposite left-hander Patrick Corbin...took the loss, allowing six runs (four earned) on nine hits - including a season-high two home runs, both by Kazuma Okamoto - through 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Jays by a score of 7-3.

- ☞ His five game losing streak to begin the season is the longest of his career and is the longest losing streak by a Twins starter since Bailey Ober's five games from June 6-28, 2025.
- ☞ Allowed a home run in each of his first seven starts this season, becoming the first Twins starter to do so since Liam Hendriks in 2012.

HOOK, LINE AND SIM-KER: This will be Simeon's third career start against Miami; 1-0, 6.00 ERA (6.0 IP, 4 ER) with three walks, five strikeouts, a 1.83 WHIP and a .308 (8-for-26) BAA.

- ☞ Made his first career start against the Marlins on September 25, 2024, throwing career-lows in innings pitched (1.0) and pitches (36)...in the outing, Sim allowed three runs on six hits in his lone frame of work, with the damage coming on a Jake Burger three-run shot; Sim was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul the following day.
- ☞ In his second and most recent start against the Fish on July 2, 2025, Simeon earned the win, allowing just one run on two hits - the only blemish being a Kyle Stowers solo home run - with two walks and three strikeouts.
- ☞ He has faced seven active Marlins hitters (including Injured List) who have combined for a .200 (3-for-15) BAA, with one home run (Kyle Stowers), three walks and four strikeouts.

SIM AND THE NATIONAL LEAGUE: Sim will be making his 19th career Interleague start (21st game)...he is 4-5 with a 4.61 ERA (91.2 IP, 47 ER), 40 walks, 76 strikeouts, a 1.39 WHIP and a .253 (87-for-344) BAA...the start will snap a streak of four consecutive road starts against Interleague opponents dating back to July 22, 2025 at Los Angeles-NL.

- ☞ He has yielded three-or-fewer runs in each of his last five Interleague starts at Target Field since September 14, 2024 vs. Cincinnati.
- ☞ Today's game will mark Simeon's eighth consecutive opponent hailing from either the American or National League East...in those starts, Simeon is 0-4 with a 7.41 ERA (34.0 IP, 28 ER), seven home runs allowed, 15 walks, 17 strikeouts, a 1.79 WHIP and a .331 (46-for-139) BAA.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-6 with a 4.15 ERA (145.1 IP, 67 ER), 56 walks, 135 strikeouts and a 1.31 WHIP in 29 games (28 starts) at home compared to 6-9 with a 4.98 ERA (148.1 IP, 82 ER), 59 walks, 116 strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP in 32 road games (31 starts).

- ☞ Is 0-2, 6.06 ERA (16.1 IP, 11 ER) with six walks, nine strikeouts, a 1.84 WHIP and a .343 (24-for-70) BAA in three starts at Target Field this season.
- ☞ Has earned just six wins through his first 28 career starts at home, one of just seven starters in Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-) to record six-or-fewer victories within that same span.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: So far in 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .300/.374/.488 (24-for-80) with six doubles, three home runs, nine walks and 14 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .346/.407/.603 (27-for-78) with five doubles, five home runs, seven walks and five strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .250/.325/.389 (129-for-517) with 56 walks and 116 strikeouts (2.07 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .252/.319/.436 (151-for-601) with 59 walks and 135 strikeouts (2.29 K/BB).

- ☞ His .346 (27-for-78) opponent batting average against right-handed hitters is the fourth highest among all right-handed starters in Major League Baseball this season.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson relies on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He and Taj Bradley are the only Twins pitchers to throw at least 150 pitches with three different pitch types within their arsenals this season (4-seam fastball, split finger, slider).
- ☞ Sim's -10 run value with his split finger ranks as the worst among all pitchers in Major League Baseball; it also is tied for the worst run value of any pitch by any pitcher in the league this season (Ryan Weiss's 4-seam fastball, -10 run value).
- ☞ This season, Sim has an overall strikeout percentage of just 10.6%, over nine percent below his career average of 20.0; it falls within the bottom two percent among all pitchers this season.

SPLIT FINGER, SPLIT RESULTS: Simeon debuted his split finger in 2025, throwing it just 187 times and experienced great success...through his first eight starts this season, he has already thrown his split finger 183 times, making it his second most used pitch behind his four-seamer...however, his opponents have found an increased amount of success against it. Here are how some of his split finger numbers this season compare to last season:

CAREER NOTES

- Recorded a career-high 7 wins in 2025, the second most on the team... finished the year third on the team in strikeouts (107), starts (22) and innings pitched (111.1).
- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berríos...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
- Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
- Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
- Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
- Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
