**THE TWINS:** Have gone 4-3 through seven games on their nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Miami last week, 1-2 vs. Milwaukee over the weekend and 1-0 over Houston...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three against the Astros...after tomorrow's finale, they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday before starting a 10-game roadtrip with stops in Boston (3 games), Chicago-AL (4 games) and Pittsburgh (3 games).  
 ☞ Twins have gone 6-3 over their last nine games...since May 3, they have gone 9-8 after going 3-13 in a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.

**SPACE INVADERS:** The Twins beat the Astros last night by a score of 6-3 at Target Field...Kendry Rojas made his first major league start, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...six relievers were used to hold the lead as Eric Orze was named the winner and Taylor Rogers earned the save...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Josh Bell, who homered twice and drove in a season-high four runs...marked Bell's 12th multi-homer game and landed him on 198 career homers.

**BROTHERS DON'T SHAKE HANDS...** Orlando Arcia's brother, Oswaldo, played for the Twins from 2013-16...the pair will become the second set of brothers to play for Minnesota and eighth different pair of siblings to play for the Twins/Washington Senators (since 1901) franchise (courtesy of *Elias Sports Bureau*):

**BOLD:** The brothers were the only to both play for Minnesota (since 1961).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from Triple-A St. Paul, and have selected the contracts of infielder Orlando Arcia and catcher Alex Jackson.  
 ☞ Adams, who will be making his second stint with the Twins this season, appeared in two games for Minnesota from May 9-14 allowing three runs on six hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...since being optioned from Minnesota last week, he made one appearance for the Saints on May 16 (1.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB).

☞ Arcia, 31, has played in 39 games for the Saints this season, hitting .318 (48-for-151) with 10 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 27 RBI, 27 runs scored, 14 walks, a .376 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS...he was signed by the Twins on a minor league contract in January.

☞ Jackson, 30, has played in 24 games for the Saints this season, hitting .239 (21-for-88) with three doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI, 16 runs scored, a .511 slugging percentage and an .806 OPS...the former sixth overall pick was acquired by the Twins from Baltimore in November in exchange for minor league infielder Payton Eeles and was outrighted off the 40-man roster in late March, reporting to St. Paul.

☞ To make room for Adams, Arcia and Jackson on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed catcher Ryan Jeffers on the 10-day Injured List (left hamate bone fracture), optioned infielder Royce Lewis to St. Paul and designated right-handed pitcher Justin Topa for release or assignment.

☞ Jeffers, who suffered the injury during his at-bat in the eighth inning last night against Houston, has hit .295 (36-for-122) with seven doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 26 RBI, 26 runs scored, 23 walks, a .408 on-base percentage, a .541 slugging percentage and a .949 OPS in 37 games.

☞ Lewis has played in 31 games for the Twins this season, hitting .163 (17-for-104) with three doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 11 runs scored, 12 walks and a .540 OPS.

☞ Topa appeared in 23 games for Minnesota, going 0-1 with an 8.05 ERA (19.0 IP, 17 ER), two saves, 11 walks, 12 strikeouts and a .346 opponent batting average.

**ROCKET MEN:** The Twins and Astros are playing the second of six games in 2026...Minnesota will travel to Houston for a three-game series from June 29-July 1.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .444 (12-for-27) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.259 OPS in seven career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all seven.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .394 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .894 OPS in his last eight games against the Astros...he has reached base safely in all eight.

**MOUND VIEWS:** Over their last 10 games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.57 ERA (91.0 IP, 26 ER) with a .209 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA and sixth in opponent batting average.

☞ Over their last 10 games, Twins starters have gone 3-3, 2.25 ERA (52.0 IP, 13 ER) with 16 walks, 43 strikeouts and a .184 opponent batting average.

☞ Over their last eight games, Twins relievers have gone 3-1, 2.75 ERA (36.0 IP, 11 ER) with 24 walks, 29 strikeouts and a .234 opponent batting average.

**MEATLOAF TONIGHT:** A win tonight or tomorrow and the Twins will earn their sixth series win of the season...they have gone 5-9-1 in series play, 3-3-1 at home and 2-6-0 on the road...season results in the right margin.

☞ Twins would be seeking their first series win over the Astros since July 5-7, 2024, taking two of three at Target Field...they are 0-2-0 vs. Houston in series play since.

**RISPY MOVES:** Over their last five games, the Twins are hitting .364 (12-for-33) with runners in scoring position and have a 1.052 OPS...on the season, they are hitting .277 (114-for-411) with RISP, the second-highest in the AL and sixth-highest in baseball...overall, they have had 498 plate appearances with runners in scoring position this season, fifth-most in baseball.

**BANG FOR YOUR BUCK:** Byron Buxton (hip) is in the lineup for the first time since last Wednesday vs. Miami, when he went 2-for-4 with two home runs...Buck has homered 15 times in his last 26 games (123 PA), since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in home runs (chart in right margin)...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 15 home runs overall still ranked tied for third in the AL on the entire season (tied for 4th in MLB).  
 ☞ In the upper right margin are Buck's number of games in which it took him to reach the 15-homer mark over his career.

☞ Since April 21, he has not gone more than three games without hitting a home run.

☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 19, 2025 - Buck has hit 40 home runs in 125 games...over his last 162 games (since April 1, 2025), he has hit 50 home runs.

☞ Buck is on pace to finish with 50 homers...single-season career-high is 35 (2025).

- In his last start on May 14 vs. Miami, earned his first win of the season and recorded the longest scoreless outing of his career after going 7.0 innings, allowing four hits with one walk and five strikeouts in a 9-1 Twins win.
- Matthews made seven starts for Triple-A St. Paul to begin the year, compiling a 3-2 record with a 4.72 ERA (34.1 IP, 18 ER), 11 walks and 33 strikeouts before being recalled to Minnesota on May 14.

LAST TIME OUT: Zebby Matthews made his MLB season debut on May 14 vs. Miami; pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits with one walk and five strikeouts, as the Twins rolled to a 9-1 series-clinching win over the Marlins.

MORE ON THE START: Zebby's 7.0 innings pitched tied his career long (done twice, May 30, 2025 at Seattle and September 23, 2025 at Texas)...the 7.0 scoreless innings marked a career-high; his previous high for a scoreless outing was 6.0 innings pitched July 25, 2025 vs. Washington...became just the third Twins starter this season to throw 7.0-or-more scoreless innings in an outing, joining Mick Abel (7.0 IP - 4/14 vs. BOS) and Bailey Ober (9.0 IP - 5/12 vs. Miami).

TWO STARTS AGO (TRIPLE-A): In his most recent outing with Triple-A St. Paul on May 8, Matthews earned the win and went a professional career-high 8.0 innings at Las Vegas, allowing three runs on 10 hits (2 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts...Zebby threw 66 of his 95 pitches for strikes (69.5%).

A TALE OF TWO HALVES: Zebby has made eight total starts this season (seven with Triple-A St. Paul and one with the Twins)...here are his numbers from his first four starts, compared to his last four (AAA and MLB combined):

SPLITS AGAINST AL DIVISIONS: Zebby has made five career starts against the American League West, holding a 2-1 record, while his .245 BAA and .694 OPS against the division are his lowest against any AL division...here are some more of his numbers against the West and how they compare to other AL divisions.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Matthews has gone 4-4 with a 6.29 ERA (58.2 IP, 41 ER), 15 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .310 (76-for-245) BAA in 13 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-6, 4.96 ERA (65.1 IP, 36 ER) with 21 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .274 (73-for-266) BAA in 13 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS (MLB): Through 26 career major league starts, lefties are slashing .308/.364/.551 with 13 doubles, 17 home runs, 24 walks and 72 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .274/.308/.395 with 12 doubles, six home runs, 12 walks and 64 strikeouts against Matthews.

2026 MINORS SPLITS: Through his seven starts with St. Paul, lefties slashed .314/.397/.627 with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, seven walks and seven strikeouts, while righties slashed .287/.326/.552 with four doubles, two triples, five home runs, four walks and 26 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL (2026): Zebby used a five-pitch mix in his season debut with the Twins...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

2025 VS. 2026 ARSENALS: Zebby threw his curveball and changeup 15.7% of the time in his first MLB start of 2026; in 2025 threw his changeup 10.6% of the time and his curveball 5.8% of the time... Matthews also threw his slider and cutter significantly less than in 2025, threw the slider 13.3% of the time in his May 14 start and cutter 7.2% of the time; in 2025 threw his slider 24.9% of the time and his cutter 13.2% of the time.
