THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. Seattle earlier this week and 1-1 vs. Toronto over the last two nights...today, Minnesota will play the third of four games against the Blue Jays and conclude the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, Minnesota will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then travel to Washington D.C. to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Nationals (May 5-7) and three against the Guardians in Cleveland (May 8-10).

CHRIS FINCH, SO DISAPPOINTED: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays last night by a score of 7-3 at Target Field...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-5) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing six runs (4 earned) on nine hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...Eric Orze set a major league single-game career-high with 2.1 innings...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Austin Martin...Byron Buxton homered and drove in two runs, his team-leading ninth homer of the season.

TWINS CALL ON KLEIN: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Cole Sands on the 15-day Injured List with a right forearm strain...Sands has appeared in 12 games for the Twins this season, going 1-1, 4.63 ERA (11.2 IP, 6 ER), one save, three holds, four walks and 11 strikeouts...to replace Sands on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher John Klein from Triple-A St. Paul...Klein, 24, pitched in seven games (6 starts) for the Saints, going 1-1, 7.48 ERA (21.2 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 24 strikeouts...the 6-foot-5, 233-pound right-hander split the 2025 season between St. Paul and Double-A Wichita, combining to go 7-10, 3.98 ERA (106.1 IP, 47 ER), 37 walks, 128 strikeouts and a .234 opponent batting average in 31 games (15 starts).

⚡ Klein was signed by Minnesota as an undrafted free agent in August of 2022 out of Iowa Central Community College and has pitched in parts of five seasons in the Twins' minor league system, going 18-18, 4.46 ERA (288.2 IP, 143 ER), 105 walks and 305 strikeouts in 75 games (54 starts)...the Brooklyn Park, Minnesota native is ranked by MLB.com as the club's No. 20 prospect and is looking to become the 33rd Minnesota-born player to play for the Twins (since 1961).

ROGER THAT: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the sixth of seven games in 2026...one more win for Minnesota in these next two games and they will clinch the season-series over Toronto for the first time since 2024 (4-2).

⚡ Notables this season vs. Toronto: Ryan Jeffers is 6-for-14 (.429) with two home runs and seven RBI...Austin Martin is 7-for-14 (.500) with a double and four walks...Byron Buxton and Brooks Lee each have two home runs.

⚡ Twins have scored 29 runs vs. the Jays this season, their most against any opponent.

⚡ Twins have homered in 12-straight against the Blue Jays and multiple times in nine of their last 10...in those 12, they have totaled 24 homers.

⚡ Byron Buxton has posted a .948 OPS with 10 doubles, 12 home runs, 25 RBI and a .596 slugging percentage in 37 career regular season games against the Blue Jays.

⚡ In 14 career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner has posted a .917 OPS, including five home runs, 11 RBI and a .571 slugging percentage.

⚡ Notables lifetime vs. Cease: Josh Bell is 5-for-14 (.357) with one double and two walks... Matt Wallner is 2-for-6 (.333) with one double and one walk.

WATCH THE THRONE: Byron Buxton became the Target Field all-time home run king earlier this season...he is now one run scored away from passing Max Kepler in that category...below are his Target Field rankings in a few offensive categories:

MAJORITY RULES: Twins need victories today and tomorrow to earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...they are looking to snap a series loss streak of four (Reds, Mets, Rays and Mariners)...they have gone 3-7-0 in series play, 2-3-0 at home and 1-4-0 on the road...results to the right >>>

⚡ Twins won their last series vs. Toronto, taking two of three at Rogers Centre from April 10-12...they would be looking to win two series in one season vs. the Jays for the first time since 2024, when they won two of three in both Canada and Minnesota.

TREVOR TIME: After drawing two walks in four plate appearances on Thursday night vs. Toronto, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in 16-straight games with a plate appearance, tying his career-high, done previously from August 17-September 5, 2025...during this streak, he has recorded 13 hits and 13 walks in 64 plate appearances for a .406 on-base percentage.

⚡ Larnach has started in 11 of the Twins last 13 games due to the Twins facing more right-handed starters recently...on the season, he is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with 16 walks, a .471 on-base percentage and an .897 OPS against right-handed pitching.

BOMBS OVER BUCK-DADDY: After going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered nine times in his last 16 games (77 PA), since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Munetaka Murakami for the most homers in baseball...despite the early season homer drought, Buck still ranks tied for sixth in the AL in homers on the entire season.

JEFF YEA: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in a season-long seven-straight games, matching Austin Martin (April 8-17) and Brooks Lee (April 9-15) for the longest by a Twin this season...over his last 16 games, Jeffers is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with one triple, four home runs, 18 RBI, nine walks, a .444 on-base percentage, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.060 OPS.

WE'RE TALKIN' LEE: Over his last eight games, Brooks Lee is hitting .355 (11-for-31) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, eight runs scored, three walks, a .412 on-base percentage, a .581 slugging percentage and a .992 OPS...his 26 hits on the season are tied for second-most on the team with Josh Bell and Luke Keaschall, trailing Byron Buxton (33).

YARD SALE: Twins have hit 39 home runs this season, fifth-most in the AL, trailing New York (50), Los Angeles (43), Houston (41) and Chicago (40)...through 33 games last season, the Twins had 26 home runs.

⚡ 66 of the club's 157 runs scored have come off homers (42%)...they have hit 23 solo shots, seven two-run homers, seven three-run jimmy jacks and two grand slams.

- Connor Prielipp will make his third career start this afternoon in the third of a four game series against the Toronto Blue Jays; this will be Prielipp's second career start at Target Field.
- In his Target Field debut on April 27 vs. Seattle, Prielipp earned his first MLB win after going 5.0 innings while allowing two runs on one hit, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- Upon his callup on April 22, Prielipp is listed as the No. 5 prospect and top-ranked pitching prospect in the Twins' system, per MLB.com; he was ranked as the No. 81 prospect in all of baseball and No. 4 in the Twins' system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per *Baseball America*.

LAST TIME OUT: Prielipp introduced himself to Twins Territory on April 27 vs. Seattle by carrying a no-hitter into the fifth inning and securing his first big league win...ended the game with a final line of 5.0 innings pitched, while giving up two runs on one hit, with three walks and five strikeouts in an 11-4 Twins victory over the Mariners.

- HOT START:** Courtesy of his MLB debut in New York and one-hit gem on April 27, Prielipp became the 13th pitcher in Twins franchise history (1901-) to allow five-or-fewer hits through his first two career starts and first Twin to win in his Target Field debut since Zebby Matthews did so on August 13, 2024 vs. Kansas City.
- SEE YA:** Became the first Twins starter to record 11-or-more strikeouts through his first two career starts since Josh Winder struck out 15 across his first two career starts in 2022.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made his major league debut on April 22 at Citi Field against the New York Mets...went 4.0 innings, giving up two runs on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts...took the no-decision and exited the game with the Twins trailing 2-1; the team would go on to drop the game by a score of 3-2.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING: Prielipp became the 19th pitcher in Twins club history to strike out at least six batters in his debut and the first to do so in four-or-fewer innings (1961-).

TARGET FIELD DEBUT COMPARISONS: Prielipp was brilliant in his home debut...here is how his first start at Target Field compares to some other Twins top pitching prospects.

BRING ON THE OFFSPEED: Just like in his debut, Prielipp once again relied heavily on his offspeed vs. the Mariners, as they accounted for 60.7% of his pitches...he threw his slider 36 times (42.9%), his changeup 9 times (10.7%) and his curveball 6 times (7.1%)...against the 51 offspeed pitches Prielipp threw in his April 27 start, Mariners hitters were a combined 0-for-11 with five strikeouts.

GET TO KNOW CONNOR: Born in Tomah, WI and went 6-2 with a 0.85 ERA and 118 strikeouts (21.7 SO/9) against just five walks (23.60 SO/BB) in 49.0 innings as a senior.

TO TUSCALOOSA WE GO: Despite being selected by Boston in the 37th round of the 2019 draft, Prielipp decided to attend the University of Alabama, where he earned National Freshman Player of the Year, and was named a first team All-American and Freshman All-America by Collegiate Baseball News.

WELCOME TO TWINS TERRITORY: Despite Tommy John surgery, the Twins drafted Prielipp in the second round (48th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft...since being drafted, Prielipp has stormed through the minor leagues to the tune of a 3.72 ERA (128.1 IP, 53 ER) with 50 walks, 168 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP.

2025 WAS AWARD SEASON: Prielipp broke out in 2025, pitching a minor league career-high 82.2 innings (previous high: 23.1 IP in 2024) with a 4.03 ERA, 31 walks and 98 strikeouts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul...he ranked second among all Twins pitchers in starts and was tied for seventh in strikeouts.

PITCHER OF THE YEAR: Following the season, was named the Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year, becoming the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through his first two starts, left-handed hitters have only six at-bats against Prielipp, while righties have faced him in 26 at-bats, here are his splits: lefties are slashing .000/.125/.000 (0-for-6) with zero doubles, one RBI, one walk and zero strikeouts, while righties are slashing .192/.250/.269 (5-for-26) with two doubles, three RBI, two walks and have all 11 strikeouts against Prielipp.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In his two starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

THAT'S A LOT OF FRISBEES: Through two starts, Prielipp has thrown his slider 78 times (47.0%)...the pitch has held opposing hitters to a 4-for-20 clip with seven strikeouts, including 0-for-7 with two strikeouts in his Seattle start...among MLB starters, Prielipp's 47.0% usage rate would easily rank as the highest slider usage in baseball...Chris Sale of the Atlanta Braves currently leads qualified starters in slider usage at 42.3%.

ANOTHER WEAPON FORMING: After not having a ton of success throwing his curveball in his debut, Prielipp bounced back and threw six curveballs in his last start...even with the low usage it was a highly effective pitch, limiting Seattle hitters to an 0-for-2 clip with two strikeouts.

- Upon call-up, currently ranked fifth in the Twins system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per MLB.com and ranked as the no. 81 prospect in baseball and fourth-best in Twins system by *Baseball America* (highest ranked pitcher)...ranked 94th-best prospect in baseball by *Baseball America* entering 2026.
- In 2025, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combined to go 1-9 with a 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks and 98 strikeouts in 24 appearances (23 starts).
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year...is the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).
- Ranked as having best slider and best changeup among Minnesota minor leaguers.
- Entering 2025, ranked seventh-best prospect in Twins organization by *Baseball America* entering 2025, and 21st by MLB.com.
- Began season at Double-A Wichita and pitched in short spurts, not going beyond the fourth inning and topping out at 76 pitches in a single outing for Wind Surge...despite innings restrictions, struck out at least five batters in nine of 19 starts.
