**THE TWINS:** Have gone 4-4 through eight games on their nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Miami last week, 1-2 vs. Milwaukee over the weekend and 1-1 vs. Houston...today, Minnesota will complete the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Astros...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow before starting a 10-game roadtrip with stops in Boston (3 games), Chicago-AL (4 games) and Pittsburgh (3 games).

☞ Twins have gone 3-5 in rubber games this season...their three wins were April 12 at Toronto, May 10 at Cleveland and last Thursday vs. Miami.

☞ Twins have gone 6-4 over their last 10 games...since May 3, they have gone 9-9 after going 3-13 in a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.

**MISSION FAILED:** The Twins lost to the Astros last night by a score of 2-1 at Target Field, making the Twins 4-7 in one-run games...Zebby Matthews (1-1) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched...his only runs allowed came on a two-run homer by Isaac Paredes in the first inning...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Josh Bell and two from Byron Buxton...Buck doubled twice, giving him nine doubles on the season...Minnesota went 1-for-7 with RISP and left nine men on base.

**ASTROWORLD:** The Twins and Astros are playing the third of six games in 2026...Minnesota will travel to Houston for a three-game series from June 29-July 1.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with one double, one triple, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.226 OPS in eight career games vs. Houston...he has hit safely in all eight.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with four doubles, one home run, four RBI, a .395 on-base percentage, a .543 slugging percentage and a .938 OPS in his last nine games against the Astros...he has reached base safely in all nine.

**KINGS OF THE HILL:** Over their last 11 games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.52 ERA (100.0 IP, 28 ER) with a .204 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA and fifth in opponent batting average.

☞ Over their last 11 games, Twins starters have gone 3-4, 2.33 ERA (58.0 IP, 15 ER) with 16 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .188 opponent batting average.

☞ Over their last nine games, Twins relievers have gone 3-1, 2.54 ERA (39.0 IP, 11 ER) with 24 walks, 30 strikeouts and a .219 opponent batting average.

**AFTERNOON MEATLOAF:** A win today and the Twins will earn their sixth series win of the season...they have gone 5-9-1 in series play, 3-3-1 at home and 2-6-0 on the road...season results in the right margin >>>

☞ Twins are seeking their first series win over the Astros since July 5-7, 2024, taking two of three at Target Field...they are 0-2-0 vs. Houston in series play since.

**OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS:** Despite going 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position last night, the Twins have hit .325 (13-for-40) and have a .929 OPS with RISP over their last six games...on the season, they are hitting .275 (115-for-418) with RISP, the third-highest in the AL and seventh-highest in baseball...overall, they have had 505 plate appearances with runners in scoring position this season, the most in the AL.

**RISP TAKERS:** Notable individuals with RISP this season: Brooks Lee is hitting .442 (19-for-43)...Austin Martin is hitting .348 (8-for-23)...Josh Bell is hitting .345 (19-for-55)...Trevor Larnach is hitting .296 (8-for-27)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .311 (14-for-45).  
☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 40 RISP at-bats: Lee ranks first, Bell ranks third and Keaschall ranks seventh.

**BUXTON BURNER:** Byron Buxton has hit 10 home runs over his last 16 games and 15 home runs over his last 27 games, since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in home runs, trailing only Kyle Schwarber (16).

☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 19, 2025 - Buck has hit 40 home runs in 126 games...over his last 162 games (since April 2, 2025), he has hit 50 home runs.

☞ Since the start of 2025, only eight players in baseball have hit over 50 homers: Schwarber (76), Judge (69), Raleigh (67), Ohtani (62), Caminero (58), Suárez (52), Buxton (50) and Soto (50).

☞ Buck has a 11.60 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fifth-best in baseball, trailing Schwarber (8.90), Rice (9.69), Murakami (9.82) and Judge (11.00).

**GIMME A BELL YEAH:** Josh Bell has six hits in eight at-bats this series...after going 3-for-4 last night, Bell is now hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .594 slugging percentage and a .938 OPS over his last eight games.

**THE ROCKET MISSILE:** Kody Clemens has reached base safely in eight-straight games, hitting .400 (12-for-30) with six doubles, one home run, three RBI, a .438 on-base percentage, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.138 OPS in that span.

☞ Eight-straight marks the third-longest of his career...his two longest were 15 (May 7-28, 2025) and 13 (April 19-May 5, 2026).

**THIS DAY IN TWINS/BASEBALL HISTORY:** In 1970, National Baseball and Twins Hall of Famer Rod Carew hit for the first cycle in Twins history in a 10-5 win in Kansas City...in 1984, Roger Clemens (Kody's dad - not sure if you heard) earned his first major league victory over the Twins...in 2011, the Twins were fortunate enough to be playing in Arizona and were able to attend the funeral of Twins legend Harmon Killebrew, who had passed a few days prior.

- ☞ Making his 11th start of 2026 and 125th start (126th game) of his career.
- ☞ Is 2-4 with a 6.52 ERA (38.2 IP, 28 ER), 14 walks, 45 strikeouts and a .226 (33-for-146) BAA in eight career starts against Houston (including Postseason).
- ☞ In his last start on May 15 vs. Milwaukee, Ryan did not factor into the decision despite making a quality start, firing 6.0 innings of one-run, four-hit ball, with one walk and seven strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ryan made his 10th start of the season on May 15 vs. Milwaukee opposite right-hander Coleman Ryan...recorded his fifth quality start of the season but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on four hits through 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts, matching a season-high...Ryan received just one run of support in the outing, making it three consecutive full starts (excluding 5/3 vs. Toronto) in which he has received one run of support from the Twins offense.

- ☞ His only blemish in the game came on a first-inning, RBI single from William Contreras...following a three-hit, one-run opening frame for the Brewers, Ryan would go on to retire 14 of his final 16 batters faced in his last 5.0 innings pitched, six of them via the strikeout.
- ☞ The no decision marked three consecutive no decisions for Ryan, matching the longest no decision streak of his career (also done two other times, most recently from June 19-30, 2024).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan made his ninth start of the season on May 9 at Cleveland opposite right-hander Tanner Bibee...made his fourth quality start of the season but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on two hits through 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts, as the Twins defeated the Guardians 2-1 in 11 innings.

- ☞ Fired a season-high 108 pitches, his most since throwing 110 pitches on July 6, 2024 vs. Houston.
- ☞ His only blemish came on a fourth-inning single from Kyle Manzardo that drove in Cleveland's lone run.

**ASTRONOMICAL:** This will mark Ryan's eighth career start against the Astros and seventh during the regular season...in eight combined starts against Houston between the regular and Postseason, he is 2-4 with a 6.52 ERA (38.2 IP, 28 ER), 14 walks, 45 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP and a .226 (33-for-146) BAA...Ryan faced Houston twice in 2025 and combined to go 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 6 ER), including a two-run, two-hit effort across 7.0 innings pitched on June 14, 2025 at Daikin Park; Ryan did not factor into the decision in that contest and the Twins fell to the Astros by a score of 3-2.

- ☞ Joe faced Houston in game four of the ALDS on October 11, 2023...allowed one run on two hits - including a Michael Brantley solo home run - in 2.0 innings pitched, with no walks and one strikeout; the Twins went on to lose that game by a score of 3-2, eliminating them from the Postseason.
- ☞ Ryan has faced 14 hitters on the Astros' active roster (including IL); those hitters have combined for a .191 (18-for-94) BAA with one double, seven home runs, six walks and 38 strikeouts.

**WEST ON WEST:** Today marks Joe's 25th career regular season start against an opponent from the American League West...he is 8-10 with a 4.63 ERA (128.1 IP, 66 ER), 40 walks, 159 strikeouts and a 1.19 WHIP against AL West foes...of his 15 career starts against the AL West at Target Field, six of them have been quality starts, including three of his last four dating back to April 27, 2025 vs. Los Angeles-AL; 2-2 with a 2.74 ERA (23.0 IP, 7 ER), three walks and 31 strikeouts (10.33 K/BB) during that span.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In 61 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.93 ERA (336.2 IP, 147 ER), 77 walks and 354 strikeouts, compared to 27-19 with a 3.57 ERA (355.1 IP, 141 ER), 85 walks and 417 strikeouts in 64 home appearances (63 starts).

- ☞ Excluding his start on May 3 vs. Toronto in which he was removed from the game after just 0.1 innings pitched due to right elbow soreness, Ryan has recorded a quality start in three consecutive full outings; the Twins lost all three contests and gave Joe a combined three runs of support.
- ☞ The Twins' offense has provided Joe with one-or-fewer runs of support in seven of his last 11 home starts dating back to July 26, 2025 vs. Washington; he was tagged with the loss in five of those seven games.
- ☞ Since the start of the 2025 season, Ryan's 130 strikeouts at home are the eighth most in the American League.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, lefties are slashing .211/.271/.358 (23-for-109) with seven doubles, three home runs, six walks and 28 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .187/.259/.267 (14-for-75) with six doubles, eight walks and 24 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .216/.276/.384 (276-for-1,280) with 89 walks and 321 strikeouts (3.61 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.273/.413 (295-for-1,311) with 73 walks and 450 strikeouts (6.16 K/BB).

- ☞ Ryan's 6.16 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ryan's curveball ranks fifth among major league pitchers with a .069 (2-for-29) BAA and is fifth with a 45.2 strikeout percentage (min. 25 plate appearances).
- ☞ His four-seamer has a 26.4% whiff percentage, which ranks ninth among all pitchers in Major League Baseball (min. 300 pitches).

**DAY N' NIGHT:** Today will mark Ryan's fourth daytime start of 2026, compared to seven starts at night...he has performed significantly better under the sun rather than under the lights so far this season (see table below):

FRIDAY'S STARTER - LHP CONNOR PRIELIPP (2026: 1-2, 2.88 ERA // CAREER: 1-2, 2.88 ERA)

Left-hander Connor Prielipp is slated to make his sixth start of the season Friday night in game one of a three-game set against the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park, which will kick off a 10-day, 10-game roadtrip for the Twins...in his most recent start on May 16 vs. Milwaukee, Prielipp suffered his second loss of the season despite a quality start, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and an MLB-career high eight strikeouts, as the Twins fell to Prielipp's hometown team by a score of 2-1...Friday will mark Prielipp's first career start against the Red Sox and third road start of his rookie campaign; he is 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER), two walks and 12 strikeouts in his two outings away from Target Field this season.
