THE TWINS: Completed their nine-game homestand with a record of 5-4, going 2-1 vs. Miami, 1-2 vs. Milwaukee and 2-1 vs. Houston...tonight, Minnesota will begin a 10-game roadtrip with the first of three in Boston at Fenway Park...they will complete the series on Sunday afternoon then travel to Chicago-AL for four games (Monday-Thursday), then to Pittsburgh for three games (next weekend).
 ☞ Twins have gone 7-4 over their last 11 games...since May 3, they have gone 10-9 after going 3-13 in a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.

HOUSTON, MISSION COMPLETE: The Twins beat the Astros on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 4-1 at Target Field, winning the three-game series...Joe Ryan (3-3) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and nine strikeouts...Yoendrys Gómez pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief, striking out five of his seven batters faced...Andrew Morris earned his first career save, pitching a scoreless ninth inning...Twins pitchers finished with 15 strikeouts and no walks, their second-most strikeouts in a game this season (16, 3/28 at BAL)...also marked the first time Twins pitchers combined for 15-or-more strikeouts without a walk since September 10, 2023 vs. New York-NL (16 K, 0 BB)...Victor Caratini (solo) hit his second home run of the season and Ryan Kreidler (3-run) hit his third, accounting for all four runs on the day.
 ☞ The save for Morris marked the ninth different reliever to earn a save this season (most in baseball), tying the club record, set in 1965, 2019 and 2022.

GIFT OF GAB: The Twins have recalled outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez from Triple-A St. Paul...Gonzalez, 22, has hit .524 (11-for-21) with one double, one triple, three RBI, four runs scored, five walks, a .615 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.282 OPS over his last six games for the Saints...the 5-foot-11, 247-pound outfielder has played 44 games for the Saints this season, hitting .216 (38-for-176) with five doubles, eight home runs, 21 RBI, 27 runs scored and 19 walks...Gonzalez is ranked by MLB.com as the club's seventh-best prospect, fifth among position players and third among outfielders...the Carupano, VZ native was acquired by the Twins as part of the Jorge Polanco trade with the Mariners in January of 2024.
 ☞ To make room for Gonzalez on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed infielder Tristan Gray on the Paternity List...Gray has played in 26 games for the Twins this season, hitting .240 (18-for-75) with one double, three home runs, 14 RBI, nine runs scored and six walks.

DIRTY WATER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fourth of six meetings in 2026...these two last met for three games at Target Field from April 13-15 as the Twins won the first two games of the series...they outscored the Sox 24-15.
 ☞ Twins have gone 10-7 in their last 17 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.
 ☞ Twins last visited Fenway Park for three games from May 2-4, 2025, winning two of the three games...Byron Buxton went 5-for-13 (.385) in that series.
 ☞ Buxton has reached base safely via hit or walk in 16 of his last 17 against Boston, dating back to April of 2021...in that span, he is hitting .358 (24-for-67) with seven home runs, 10 RBI, a .731 slugging percentage and a 1.129 OPS.
 ☞ Buck has reached base safely in nine-straight at Fenway Park, hitting safely in seven-straight entering tonight...he homered in his last game here on May 4, 2025, a leadoff shot of Garrett Crochet.

FENWAY FLASHBACK: Derek Shelton managed his first games at Fenway Park from July 28-29, 2018, while then-manager Paul Molitor left the club to attend the Hall of Fame ceremonies in Cooperstown (Vladimir Guerrero, Trevor Hoffman, Chipper Jones, Jack Morris, Jim Thome & Alan Trammell)...Shelty lost both games by scores of 4-10 and 0-3.

PITCH PERFECT: Over their last 12 games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.39 ERA (109.0 IP, 29 ER) with a .201 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank third in baseball in ERA, trailing Milwaukee (2.00) and Boston (2.20); and fifth in opponent batting average.
 ☞ Over their last 12 games, Twins starters have gone 4-4, 2.25 ERA (64.0 IP, 16 ER) with 16 walks, 58 strikeouts and a .187 opponent batting average.
 ☞ Over their last 10 games, Twins relievers have gone 3-1, 2.36 ERA (42.0 IP, 11 ER) with 24 walks, 36 strikeouts and a .212 opponent batting average.

IT'S ALL IN THE RISP: Despite going 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position over their last two games (1-for-7 Tuesday & 1-for-6 Wednesday), the Twins have hit .304 (14-for-46) and have a .922 OPS with RISP over their last seven games...on the season, they are hitting .274 (116-for-424) with RISP, the third-highest in the AL and seventh-highest in baseball...overall, they have had 511 plate appearances with runners in scoring position this season, the most in the AL.
 ☞ Notable individuals with RISP this season: Brooks Lee is hitting .442 (19-for-43)...Austin Martin is hitting .348 (8-for-23)...Josh Bell is hitting .339 (19-for-56)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .304 (14-for-46)...Trevor Larnach is hitting .296 (8-for-27).
 ☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 40 RISP at-bats: Lee ranks first, Bell ranks fourth and Keaschall ranks seventh...additionally, Lee's RISP average leads all of baseball.

BUCK ON ROOKIE MODE: Byron Buxton has hit 10 home runs over his last 17 games and 15 home runs over his last 28 games, since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in home runs, trailing only Kyle Schwarber (16).
 ☞ Since April 21, he has not gone more than three games without homering...entering tonight, he has not homered in his last two games...his last was May 13 vs. Miami, when he homered twice.
 ☞ Buck has homered five times in his last 11 road games...he has homered in three of his last four road series' (NYM, WAS and CLE).

THE ROCKET MISSILE: Kody Clemens has reached base safely in nine-straight games, hitting .382 (13-for-34) with six doubles, one home run, three RBI, a .417 on-base percentage, a .647 slugging percentage and a 1.064 OPS in that span.
 ☞ Nine-straight marks the third-longest of his career...his two longest were 15 (May 7-28, 2025) and 13 (April 19-May 5, 2026).
 ☞ Clemens' first career game at Fenway Park came on May 3, 2025...in his third at-bat of the day, he hit a go-ahead two-run homer in the sixth inning off Hunter Dobbins, breaking a 1-1 tie...Twins went on to win 4-3.

GIMME A BELL YEAH: Josh Bell finished the three-game series with Houston, going 6-for-11 with one walk, two home runs and five RBI...over his last nine games, he is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with two doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI and an .876 OPS.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 19th time...they have gone 7-11 against left-handed starters this season...they have won their last two vs. lefty starters: 9-1 win over Braxton Garrett (5/14 vs. MIA) and 5-4 win over Robert Gasser (5/17 vs. MIL).
 ☞ The 18 lefty starters are third-most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia and Atlanta, who have each faced 19.
 ☞ Austin Martin is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with 16 walks, a .493 on-base percentage and a .953 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...since August 13, 2024, Martin is hitting .333 (42-for-126) with a .921 OPS vs. lefties...since that date, his average ranks third in baseball (min. 150 PA), trailing Nico Hoerner (.360) and Paul Goldschmidt (.335).
 ☞ In his last 18 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with an .808 OPS vs. lefties.
 ☞ Kody Clemens is hitting .471 (8-for-17) with a 1.315 OPS vs. lefties this season...his average and OPS are the highest for left-handed hitter in all of baseball (minimum of 20 plate appearances).
 ☞ Over his last 13 games vs. lefties, Luke Keaschall is hitting .316 (6-for-19) with four walks and a .417 on-base percentage.

ALL KREID OUT: Ryan Kreidler has reached safely in eight of his last nine games for the Twins...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 12, he is hitting .385 (5-for-13) with one home run, three RBI, one walk, a .429 on-base percentage and a 1.044 OPS.

- Connor Prielipp will make his sixth career start tonight and third on the road tonight against Boston at Fenway Park.
- In his last start on May 16 against vs. Milwaukee, Prielipp pitched an MLB career-high 6.0 innings, giving up two runs (1 earned) on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and eight strikeouts; the outing was the first quality start of his major league career.
- Heading into tonight, Prielipp has thrown a combined 40.2 innings between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota this season; his previous career high is 82.2 innings last year.

LAST TIME OUT: On May 16 vs. Milwaukee, Prielipp turned in another gem, giving up two runs (one earned) on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and eight strikeouts in six quality innings...despite the quality start, Prielipp suffered his second consecutive loss as the Twins fell 2-1 to the Brewers...his eight strikeouts were a MLB career-high, besting his previous high of six (done twice: April 22, at New York-NL and May 8, at Cleveland).

- STRIKEOUT NOTE:** By striking out 29 hitters in his first five MLB starts, Prielipp joins just four other Minnesota Twins pitchers to do that to start their career...they are Joe Ryan - 30 (2021), Fernando Romero - 29 (2018), Francisco Liriano - 33 (2005) and Jim Merritt - 29 (1965).
- FIRST TWIN EVER:** With 29 strikeouts and only 15 hits allowed this season, Prielipp became the first Twins pitcher ever (1961-) to record more than 29 strikeouts and allow less than 15 hits through his first five career starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: On May 8 at Cleveland, Prielipp took his first career loss after going 5.0 innings for the third straight time and allowing four runs (one earned) on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts...gave up all four runs in the first inning, the most runs he has given up in a single inning in his MLB career; of those four runs, only one was charged to Prielipp due to a Luke Keaschall fielding error with runners on first and second.

BOUNCING BACK: After allowing the four runs in the first inning, Prielipp would struck six of the next eight Guardians batters that he faced from the second inning-fourth inning...here is his line from innings two through five: 4.0 IP, 0 ER, 2 H, 2 BB and 6 K.

ROOKIE RANKINGS: Prielipp has been a steady force in the Twins' rotation through his first five MLB starts...here is where he ranks in a few categories among American League rookie starting pitchers and among all MLB rookie starters (min. 25.0 IP).

TO FENWAY WE GO: Prielipp will make his first career start at Fenway Park tonight and his second career start against an American League East opponent...in his May 2 start against the Toronto Blue Jays, Prielipp did not factor into the decision, after throwing 5.0 innings of two run ball.

ROOKIE VS. ROOKIE: Prielipp will start opposite of Red Sox rookie, Payton Tolle tonight...here is a comparison of some of their numbers so far this season.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through five games, Prielipp has started three at home and two on the road...on the road he is 0-1 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER), two walks, 12 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP, compared to 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), seven walks, 17 strikeouts and a 0.88 WHIP in three starts at Target Field.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, Prielipp went 2-2 with a 4.20 ERA (64.1 IP, 30 ER), 30 walks, 80 strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP in 18 home appearances (17 starts), and 1-8 with a 3.35 ERA (78.0 IP, 29 ER), 25 walks, 103 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 24 road appearances (23 starts).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through five MLB starts, lefties are slashing .200/.261/.400 (4-for-20) with one double, one home run, two walks and four strikeouts, while righties are slashing .159/.253/.319 (11-for-69) with two doubles, three home runs, seven walks and 25 strikeouts against Prielipp.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In his five starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

SLIDER IN HIS LAST START: On May 16 vs. Milwaukee, Brewers hitters combined to go 0-for-10 against Prielipp's slider with four strikeouts...so far this season he has a 31.1% strikeout rate on the pitch, the highest among Twins starters (min. 25 PA).

THE HEATER: Among MLB starters, Prielipp's .100 (2-for-20) BAA on his 4-seam fastball is the third lowest in all of baseball (min. 20 PA and min. 400 total pitches on season); he trails Payton Tolle (.091) and Zach Wheeler (.097).

OVERALL BAA: Prielipp's .169 (15-for-89) BAA currently ranks sixth in MLB among starters (min. 75 PA and min. 400 pitches); he trails Tyler Glasnow (.149), Payton Tolle (.160), Jacob Misiorowski (.160), Paul Skenes (.161) and Shohel Ohtani (.163).
