DID BUCK HOMER LAST NIGHT?

—NO— *YES, OF COURSE*

THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game homestand with a record of 5-4 (2-1 vs. Miami, 1-2 vs. Milwaukee and 2-1 vs. Houston), the Twins began their 10-game roadtrip with a win in Boston last night...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three in Boston at Fenway Park...they will complete the series tomorrow afternoon then travel to Chicago-AL for four games (Monday-Thursday), then to Pittsburgh for three games (next weekend).
 ☞ Twins have gone 8-4 over their last 12 games...since May 3, they have gone 11-9 after going 3-13 in a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.
 ☞ Twins have won three-straight road games, seeking their first four-game winning streak away from Minnesota since May 3-17, 2025, when they won seven-straight in the middle of their 13-game winning streak.

A-MAR CAPS A-MONSTER INNING: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 8-6, coming back from a 0-4 deficit in the first inning — their ninth come-from-behind victory of the season...Connor Prielipp was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing six runs (5 earned) on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Travis Adams (2.0 IP), Yoendrys Gómez (1.0 IP), Eric Orze (0.2 IP) and Anthony Banda (1.1 IP) combined to pitch 5.0 no-hit/scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded 10 hits and scored four of their eight runs in the seventh inning...the seventh inning runs were highlighted by a Byron Buxton two-run homer and an Austin Martin go-ahead two-run homer — both over the Green Monster.
 ☞ Banda became the 10th different Twin to record a save this season, setting a club record that was previously held by the 1965, 2019 and 2022 Twins relievers...also marks the most for any bullpen in baseball since 2025 (ARI - 17, CHC - 12, LAD - 12 & PHI - 10).

THAT'S WHAT I'M TAJIN' ABOUT: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Taj Bradley from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Bradley, who was placed on the Injured List on May 9 with right pectoralis muscle inflammation, made one start on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul on May 17 against Columbus, allowing one run on two hits in 1.2 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts.
 ☞ To make room for Bradley on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Luis Garcia for release or assignment...Garcia appeared in nine games for Minnesota, going 0-1, 10.38 ERA (8.2 IP, 10 ER), two home runs allowed, four walks and two strikeouts.

BEANTOWN BREAKDOWN: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fifth of six meetings in 2026.
 ☞ One more win in these two remaining games and the Twins will win the season-series over Boston for the first time since 2022 (4-3)...they went 3-3 in both 2025 and 2024, and 3-4 in 2023.
 ☞ Paired with their final two wins at Fenway last season (May 3 and 4), the Twins have now won three-straight in Boston, their longest winning streak here since May 7-9, 2013 (also 3)...last time they won four-straight here was September 25, 1993-June 15, 1994, when they won five-straight.
 ☞ Twins have gone 11-7 in their last 18 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.
 ☞ Buxton has reached base safely via hit or walk in 17 of his last 18 against Boston, dating back to April of 2021...in that span, he is hitting .361 (26-for-72) with eight home runs, 13 RBI, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.147 OPS.
 ☞ Buck has reached base safely in 10-straight at Fenway Park, hitting safely in eight-straight entering tonight...he has homered in each of his last two games here.
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with seven walks, a .478 on-base percentage and an .895 OPS in 15 career games against the Red Sox.

PITCH MEN: Over their last 13 games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.59 ERA (118.0 IP, 34 ER) with a .202 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA, trailing Milwaukee (1.85), Cleveland (2.51) and Arizona (2.53); and fifth in opponent batting average.
 ☞ Over their last 11 games, Twins relievers have gone 4-1, 2.11 ERA (47.0 IP, 11 ER) with 26 walks, 42 strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average.

E-LUKE-TRIC FEEL: Luke Keaschall went 2-for-4 last night and now has 41 hits on the season, tied with Brooks Lee and Josh Bell for third-most on the club, trailing Buxton (48)...he has reached safely in 15 of 18 games this month, posting a .414 on-base percentage in those games...below are his March/April (31 games) and May (18 games) comparisons:

KISS 'EM GOOD BYRON: Byron Buxton has hit 11 home runs over his last 18 games and 16 home runs over his last 29 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for most in baseball.
 ☞ Buck has homered six times in his last 12 road games...he has now homered in four of his last five road series' (NYM, WAS, CLE & BOS).
 ☞ Buck has a 11.38 at-bat-per-home run ratio on the season, fourth-best in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (9.10), Munetaka Murakami (10.29) and Ben Rice (10.44).

BEST OF YOU: A win today and the Twins will earn their seventh series win of the season...they have gone 6-9-1 in series play, 4-3-1 at home and 2-6-0 on the road...season results in the right margin.
 ☞ Twins last series win in Boston came May 2-4, 2025, taking two of three.
 ☞ They're looking for two series wins over the Sox for the first time since 2006 (3-0 & 2-1).

LEFT SIDE STORY: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 20th time...they have gone 8-11 against left-handed starters this season.
 ☞ The 19 lefty starters are third-most in baseball, tied with Philadelphia for second-most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (20).
 ☞ Austin Martin is hitting .315 (17-for-54) with 16 walks, a .479 on-base percentage and a .924 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...since August 13, 2024, Martin is hitting .331 (43-for-130) with a .909 OPS vs. lefties...since that date, his average ranks third in baseball (min. 150 PA), trailing Nico Hoerner (.359) and Paul Goldschmidt (.333).
 ☞ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with a .798 OPS vs. lefties.
 ☞ Kody Clemens is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with a 1.128 OPS vs. lefties this season...his OPS is the second-highest for left-handed hitter in all of baseball (minimum of 20 plate appearances), trailing only Corbin Carroll (1.179).
 ☞ Since April 18, Luke Keaschall is hitting .333 (7-for-21) with four walks and a .423 on-base percentage vs. lefties.

KREI ME A RIVER: Ryan Kreidler has reached safely in nine of his last 10 games for the Twins...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 12, he is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with one home run, four RBI, one walk, a .421 on-base percentage and a 1.032 OPS.

- ⚡ Taj Bradley will make his 82nd career start this afternoon, seventh against Boston and fifth at Fenway Park...was returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List today.
- ⚡ The start will be Taj's first since going to the Injured List on May 9 (retroactive to May 6) with right pectoralis muscle inflammation.
- ⚡ Prior to the injury, Bradley led Twins starters in wins (4), quality starts (5), IP (47.0), strikeouts (52), ERA (2.87), batters faced (199) and pitches per game (100.5) - as of May 9.

REHAB START (ST. PAUL): Last Sunday (May 17), Taj made a rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul, throwing 42 pitches in 1.2 innings followed by an additional 20-pitch bullpen after coming out...gave up one run on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts in his 1.2 innings.

LAST TIME OUT (MLB): On May 5 in the nation's capital against the Nationals, Taj went 6.0 innings, giving up two runs on four hits, with two walks and eight strikeouts to earn his fourth victory of the season in an 11-3 Twins win.

⚡ Bradley notched his fifth quality start in 2026 which was tied for second in the AL and was the most by a Twins starting pitcher (as of May 9)...allowed two-or-fewer runs in seven of his first eight starts in 2026; becoming the first Twins starter since Simeon Woods Richardson, April 13-May 28, 2024 to do that to open a season.

FIRST START BACK OFF IL: Taj was put on the Injured List for just the second time in his MLB career on May 9 (retro to May 6)...the other time was in March of 2024, when he was put on the 15-day IL by the Tampa Bay Rays with a strained pectoral...in his first MLB game back from that injury on May 10, 2024 Taj pitched 6.0 innings, giving up one run on four hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts vs. New York-AL.

THE TWINS BULLDOG RETURNS: Through his first eight starts of the season, Bradley threw 804 total pitches, the most in an eight start span to begin a season for the Twins since José Berríos threw 814 to begin the 2017 season...prior to his injury, Taj ranked second in the league in pitches per game (P/G), here are how some of his numbers compared to other qualified pitchers around MLB who ranked at the top of P/G (as of May 9).

FAST STARTER: Taj went a combined 3-1 with a 2.85 ERA in seven starts in March (1) and April (6) of this season...here are his career monthly numbers (March-May) as he prepares to make his second start in the month of May of this season.

CAREER AGAINST BOSTON: Bradley will make his seventh career start against the Red Sox this afternoon...in those seven games, Taj is 4-1 with a 3.44 ERA (34.0 IP, 13 ER), nine walks, 42 strikeouts and a .213 (.26-for-122) BAA...his 34.0 career innings against the Red Sox are his second most against any opponent (Baltimore - 36.1 IP).

⚡ **NUMBERS AT FENWAY PARK:** This will be his fifth career start at Fenway, is 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (22.0 IP, 5 ER), eight walks, 24 strikeouts and a .197 (15-for-76) BAA...his three career wins at Fenway are the most he has at a road stadium (excluding Tropicana Field and Steinbrenner Field).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.85 ERA (213.1 IP, 115 ER), 68 walks, 240 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in 40 career home starts compared to 11-13 with a 4.44 ERA (219.0 IP, 108 ER), 91 walks, 222 strikeouts and a 1.33 WHIP in 43 road appearances (41 starts).

⚡ **SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 2.33 ERA (19.1 IP, 5 ER), four walks, 22 strikeouts and a 0.98 WHIP in three home starts compared to a 3-1 record with a 3.25 ERA (27.2 IP, 10 ER), 13 walks, 30 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in five road starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .194/.269/.357 (19-for-98) with seven doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, 10 walks and 34 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .250/.322/.375 (20-for-80) with four doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, seven walks and 18 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

⚡ **TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** In his last two starts on April 29 and May 5, Bradley threw his curveball 25 times to the tune of a .181 (2-for-11) BAA, with all nine outs being strikeouts...among pitchers in MLB, ranked tied for fourth in whiff rate (50.0%) and third in K% (64.3%) with his curve (min. 50 pitches) prior to his stint on the Injured List (as of May 9).

⚡ **DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS:** Taj's cutter has been dominant this season, here is where the pitch ranked among MLB pitchers as of May 9 (min. 25 PA and 100 pitches): 2nd in SLG against (.152), 2nd in wOBA (.197), 2nd in K% (27.0%), 3rd in BAA (.152) and 4th in whiff rate (33.8%).

CAREER NOTES

- On April 29, 2026 vs. Seattle, Bradley threw a career-high, 114 pitches, in 7.0 innings against the Mariners; the 114 pitches were the most pitches by a Twin since Kenta Maeda threw 115 on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee.
- Made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2, 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
