### DID BUCK HOMER YESTERDAY?

—YES— \*NO, MAYBE TODAY\*

**THE TWINS:** After completing their nine-game homestand with a record of 5-4 (2-1 vs. Miami, 1-2 vs. Milwaukee and 2-1 vs. Houston), the Twins began their 10-game roadtrip with consecutive wins in Boston...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the three-game series finale at Fenway Park...after today's game, they will travel to Chicago-AL for four games (tomorrow-Thursday), then to Pittsburgh for three games (next weekend).  
 ☞ Twins have gone 9-4 over their last 13 games...since May 3, they have gone 11-7 after going 3-13 in a 16-game stretch from April 15-May 2.  
 ☞ Twins looking to extend their winning streak to four games today, which would match their season-long, done twice (April 6-9 & April 11-14).  
 ☞ Twins have won four-straight road games, their longest winning streak away from Minnesota since May 3-17, 2025, when they won seven-straight in the middle of their 13-game winning streak.

**TWINS FIND A WAY TO FINISH IN FENWAY:** The Twins beat the Red Sox yesterday at Fenway Park by a score of 4-2...marked their fourth series win in their last five chances...Taj Bradley (5-1) made his return to the Twins and was the winner, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Kendry Rojas pitched 3.0 scoreless innings of relief and Taylor Rogers earned his second save of the season striking out Jarren Duran — his only batter faced...the offense recorded 12 hits, four from Trevor Larnach, which tied his career-high...Austin Martin had two more hits, recording a double and an RBI.

**THAT'S FOR YOU, FORT MYERS COMMISSIONER:** The Twins and Red Sox are playing for the sixth and final time in 2026...yesterday's victory gave the Twins the season-series over Boston for the first time since 2022 (4-3)...they went 3-3 in both 2025 and 2024, and 3-4 in 2023.  
 ☞ Paired with their final two wins at Fenway last season (May 3 and 4), the Twins have now won four-straight in Boston, their longest winning streak here since September 25, 1993-June 15, 1994, when they won five-straight.  
 ☞ Yesterday's series win marked Minnesota's first time winning multiple series vs. the Sox since 2006 (3-0 & 2-1).  
 ☞ Twins have gone 12-7 in their last 19 games against Boston, dating back to June 21, 2023.  
 ☞ Buxton has reached base safely via hit or walk in 18 of his last 19 against Boston, dating back to April of 2021...in that span, he is hitting .351 (27-for-77) with eight home runs, 13 RBI, a .714 slugging percentage and a 1.100 OPS.  
 ☞ Buck has reached base safely in 11-straight at Fenway Park, hitting safely in nine-straight entering today.  
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with seven walks, a .440 on-base percentage and an .825 OPS in 16 career games against the Red Sox.

**ALWAYS SONNY:** Notables lifetime off Sonny Gray: Austin Martin is 2-for-2 with a double... Luke Keaschall is 2-for-3...Trevor Larnach is 4-for-8 with two home runs and six RBI...Brooks Lee is 1-for-2 with a home run...Byron Buxton is 3-for-7 with a home run.  
 ☞ Twins scored five runs on their former teammate on April 14 at Target Field, recording nine hits during his 4.0 innings, while striking out just once...Minnesota won 6-0 behind Mick Abel's 7.0 shutout innings and 10 strikeouts.

**SWEEP CAROLINE:** Twins are seeking their second sweep of the season today, their other was a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games.  
 ☞ Twins are looking to sweep the Red Sox for the first time since May 25-27, 2015, when they swept in three games at Target Field.  
 ☞ Minnesota's last sweep at Boston came July 24-25, 2000, in just two games...their last sweep in Fenway of three games was June 13-15, 1994...they have swept in Fenway 13 times in their history (since 1961), seven times in at least three games.  
 ☞ Twins have entered a finale with a chance to sweep two times this season, going 1-1... their one miss was April 15 vs. Boston at Target Field.

**ONE OF OUR FAVORITE TREVORS:** Below are Trevor Larnach's number comparisons from his first 21 games (through April 26) and his last 19 games:

ALSO OF NOTE...: On the season, Larnach is hitting .297 (30-for-101) with a .418 on-base percentage against right-handers...his on-base percentage ranks fifth in baseball (minimum 100 PA), trailing Nick Kurtz (481), Brice Turang (.456), Yordan Alvarez (.428) and Troy Johnston (.426).

**WITH ARMS WIDE OPEN:** Over their last 14 games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.55 ERA (127.0 IP, 36 ER) with a .200 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank second in baseball in ERA, trailing Milwaukee (2.50); and third in opponent batting average, trailing Atlanta (.186) and Milwaukee (.194).  
 ☞ Over their last 12 games, Twins relievers have gone 4-1, 2.12 ERA (51.0 IP, 12 ER) with 30 walks, 46 strikeouts and a .188 opponent batting average.

**BUCK SHOTS:** Byron Buxton has hit 11 home runs over his last 19 games and 16 home runs over his last 30 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for most in baseball.  
 ☞ Buck has homered six times in his last 13 road games...he has now homered in four of his last five road series' (NYM, WAS, CLE & BOS).  
 ☞ Buck has an 11.69 at-bat-per-home run ratio on the season, fourth-best in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (9.30), Ben Rice (10.44) and Munetaka Murakami (10.53).  
 ☞ 10 of Buck's 16 home runs have come off fastballs and six have come off breaking pitches.  
 ☞ He ranks tied for fourth in all of baseball with Drake Baldwin and Mike Trout in number of barrels with 27...he trails James Wood (33), Kyle Schwarber (28) and Aaron Judge (28).

**AUSTIN LOVES BOSTON:** Austin Martin has gone 4-for-10 with one double, one home run and three RBI through two games this series... Martin is hitting .301 (40-for-133) with a .413 on-base percentage on the season...among AL players with a minimum of 150 plate appearances, Martin's on-base percentage ranks fourth and his batting average ranks fifth.  
 ☞ His 14.4 strikeout percentage leads the team and is the 13th-lowest in the AL (min. 150 PA).  
 ☞ He ranks in baseball's 99th percentile in chase percentage (16.9%)...only qualified hitters with a lower chase than Martin are Taylor Ward (10.8%), Trent Grisham (15.4%) and Gleyber Torres (16.7%).

**TWINS MILB WEEKLYS:** Florida Complex League outfielder Jhonnardo Reyes and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Kolten Smith have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.  
 ☞ Reyes, 18, played in four games for the FCL Twins, going 9-for-15 (.600) with three doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI and three walks...the Mao, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January.  
 ☞ Smith, 22, made one relief appearance for the Mighty Mussels, coming Wednesday at Dunedin, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the Ocala, FL native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2025 MLB Draft.

- ☞ Is making his sixth career start against Boston and second this season; 2-2, 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 8 ER) with four walks and 27 strikeouts.
- ☞ In his most recent start on May 17 vs. Milwaukee, Ober earned the win, allowing three runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and one strikeout in a 5-4 Twins victory.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bailey made his 10th start of the season on May 17 vs. Milwaukee opposite left-hander Robert Gasser...earned his second straight win, allowing three runs on six hits - including a season-high two home runs by Garrett Mitchell and Christian Yelich - with two walks and one strikeout, as the Twins defeated the Brewers in the series finale by a score of 5-4 at Target Field.

- ☞ The outing marked the 26th time Ober has a surrendered multiple home runs in his career and first time doing so since September 1, 2025 vs. Chicago-AL (2).
- ☞ Earned his fifth win of the season, becoming the first Twins pitcher this season to reach that mark.
- ☞ Brewers hitters combined to go 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position against Ober.
- ☞ All five of his wins this season have come at Target Field, going 5-0 through seven starts at home...he is one of just five Twins starters in Target Field history (2010-) to be undefeated through his first seven starts of a season at home and is the only one to be on that list twice (started 2021 1-0 through his first seven starts at home).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Bailey made his ninth start of the season on May 12 vs. Miami opposite right-hander Eury Pérez...earned the win, tossing his third career complete game and first career complete-game shutout...allowed just two hits - a second-inning single by Jakob Marsee and a fourth-inning single by Kyle Stowers - walked none and struck out seven batters across the 9.0 innings.

- ☞ Struck out the side in the third inning, marking the first time he has done so since the eighth inning on July 28, 2024 at Detroit.
- ☞ Retired the last 16 batters he faced to end the game, beginning with Connor Norby's popout to end the fourth inning...is the most consecutive batters retired by a Twins pitcher this season.
- ☞ Threw 64 of his 89 pitches for strikes for a season-high strike percentage of 71.9.

**BEANTOWN AND THE BEARD:** Ober is making his sixth career start against Boston and second this season; he battled the Red Sox on April 13 at Target Field and earned the win, allowing four runs on seven hits - including a home run off the bat of Jarren Duran - with one walk and seven strikeouts.

- ☞ In his career against Boston, Bailey is 2-2 with a 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 8 ER), four walks, 27 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .265 (30-for-113) BAA.
- ☞ Current Red Sox batters are hitting a combined .276 (16-for-58) against Ober with three doubles (Roman Anthony, Jarren Duran, Caleb Durbin), one home run (Jarren Duran), one walk (Wilner Abreu) and 15 strikeouts.
- ☞ Bailey has been elite at Fenway Park...in three career starts at MLB's oldest ballpark, he is 1-1 with a 0.53 ERA (17.0 IP, 1 ER), three walks and 16 strikeouts...each of his previous two starts at Fenway were quality starts (4/17/2022 and 5/3/2025), and his only other start that did not meet that criteria ended in a scoreless, 5.0 inning effort (8/25/2021).
- ☞ Since earned runs became a stat in 1920, Ober's 0.53 ERA at Fenway is the third lowest by a Twins/Senators pitcher, minimum of 15.0 IP at the ballpark, behind Garland Braxton and National Baseball Hall of Famer Stan Coveleski.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In six MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 21-15 with a 4.02 ERA (356.0 IP, 159 ER), 87 walks, 343 strikeouts, a .234 (315-for-1337) BAA and a .714 OPS against in 65 starts at home compared to 15-17 with a 4.07 ERA (318.2 IP, 144 ER), 63 walks, 301 strikeouts, a .240 (289-for-1205) BAA and a .703 OPS against in 59 road starts.
