THE TWINS: Have gone 3-0 to begin their 10-game roadtrip, sweeping Boston over the weekend...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of four against the White Sox at Rate Field through Thursday afternoon...following this series, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins are 6-1 over their last seven, 10-4 over their last 14 and 12-7 over their last 19.
 ☞ Twins are looking to extend their winning streak to five games today...their last streak as long was 13 games, from May 3-17, 2025.
 ☞ Twins have won five-straight road games, their longest winning streak away from Minnesota since May 3-17, 2025, when they won seven-straight in the middle of their 13-game winning streak.
 ☞ Twins are 10-7 in series openers, winning three of their last four and six of their last eight.

SWEEP CAROLINE, GOOD TIMES NEVER SEEMED SO GOOD: The Twins beat the Red Sox yesterday afternoon at Fenway Park by a score of 6-5, recording their second sweep of the season...it marked Minnesota's first sweep at Fenway in three games since 1994...Bailey Ober (6-2) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Anthony Banda (5), Eric Orze (6), Taylor Rogers (6) and Yoendrys Gómez (4) each earned holds, while Travis Adams earned his first career save...the offense recorded 12 hits and went 5-for-13 with runners in scoring position...Orlando Arcia had three hits in what was his third game with the Twins.
 ☞ Adams became the 11th different Twin to record a save this season, extending the club record that was previously nine held by the 1965, 2019 and 2022 Twins relievers...also marks the most for any bullpen in baseball since 2025 (ARI - 17, CHC - 12, LAD - 12).
 ☞ Adams' save came on one pitch to Ceddanne Rafaela, who flew out to rightfield, becoming third Twins pitcher since 1988 (when pitch count data became available) to throw one pitch and earn a save, joining Aaron Fultz (5/17/04 at TOR) and Rick Aguilera (8/5/91 at CAL).

MOVE ON UP: Twins need a win today to get back to .500 for the first time since being 12-12 after the game on April 22 at New York-NL...since May 9, Minnesota has gone 10-4...through the game on May 8, after a 4-6 loss in Cleveland, the Twins were at a low-water mark seven games under .500 at 16-23.
 ☞ The 10 wins since May 9 are tied with Atlanta (10-5) and Milwaukee (10-4) for third-most in baseball, trailing Arizona (11-4) and Cleveland (11-4).

WELCOME BACK, DAD: The Twins have reinstated infielder Tristan Gray from the Paternity List...Gray missed the last three games to attend to the birth of his son, Walker, who was born on Thursday...the infielder has played in 26 games for the Twins this season, hitting .240 (18-for-75) with one double, three home runs, 14 RBI, nine runs scored and six walks...to make room for Gray on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez to Triple-A St. Paul...the 22-year-old played in one game for Minnesota, making his major league debut on Friday night in Boston, going 1-for-2 with two walks and one run scored.

CHICAGO STYLE: The Twins went 5-8 against the White Sox last season (2-5 at Target Field and 3-3 at Rate Field)...Minnesota started 5-2 against Chicago, but then lost their last six.
 ☞ These two last met for four games at Target Field, from September 1-4, 2025, as the Sox swept in four...last time these two met in Chicago was August 22-24, 2025 as the Twins won the first of three and lost the final two.
 ☞ The current six-game losing streak to the Sox is tied for Minnesota's third-longest losing streak to the Sox...they lost eight from May 8-September 23, 1995, and seven from September 18, 1979-May 20, 1980.
 ☞ Minnesota has gone 24-10 in its last 34 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
 ☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-78 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span...second-most for Minnesota is Detroit (98-88).
 ☞ In his last 21 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .320 (24-for-75) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 13 walks, a .420 on-base percentage and a .954 OPS.
 ☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all nine career games vs. the Sox, hitting .409 (13-for-32) with three doubles, seven walks, a .525 on-base percentage and a 1.025 OPS...he is 4-for-11 with two walks in three career games at Rate Field.

DAAAAAAAAAAHH BUXTON: Byron Buxton is hitting .283 (96-for-339) with 30 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs, 56 RBI, 69 runs scored and a .939 OPS in 99 career games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 51 (June 30, 2019-present):

ALSO: Buxton's 23 career home runs, 96 hits, 30 doubles and 56 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...11 home runs and 21 RBI in this ballpark also his most.

PITCHING IN: Over their last 15 games, since May 8, the Twins staff has posted a 2.71 ERA (136.0 IP, 41 ER) with a .207 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in opponent batting average and fifth in ERA.
 ☞ Over their last 13 games, Twins relievers have gone 4-1, 2.13 ERA (55.0 IP, 13 ER) with 31 walks, 50 strikeouts and a .195 opponent batting average.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton has hit 11 home runs over his last 19 games and 16 home runs over his last 30 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for most in baseball.
 ☞ Buck has homered six times in his last 13 road games...he has now homered in four of his last five road series' (NYM, WAS, CLE & BOS; his one miss was the TB series).
 ☞ Buck has an 11.69 at-bat-per-home run ratio on the season, fifth-best in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (9.50), Ben Rice (10.63), Munetaka Murakami (10.76) and Aaron Judge (11.29).
 ☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 25, 2025 - Buck has hit 41 home runs in 129 games...over his last 162 games (since April 6, 2025), he has hit 50 home runs.

SOUTHPAW STUFF: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 21st time...they have gone 9-11 against left-handed starters.
 ☞ The 20 lefty starters are tied with Philadelphia for second-most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (21).
 ☞ Austin Martin is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with 16 walks, a .486 on-base percentage and a .959 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...since August 13, 2024, Martin is hitting .336 (44-for-131) with a .924 OPS vs. lefties...since that date, his average ranks second in baseball (min. 150 PA), trailing Nico Hoerner (.357).
 ☞ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with an .825 OPS vs. lefties.
 ☞ Kody Clemens is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with a .949 OPS vs. lefties this season.
 ☞ Since April 18, Luke Keaschall is hitting .333 (7-for-21) with four walks and a .423 on-base percentage vs. lefties.

HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY: The Twins are 26-33 all-time on Memorial Day...Twins lost on Memorial Day last season 7-2 at Tropicana Field...the Twins last Memorial Day win was in 2024, a 6-5 victory against the Royals at Target Field.

- Zebby has made one career start at Rate Field on August 22, 2025, went 4.2 innings and allowed four runs on eight hits (1 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts; did not factor into the decision, but the Twins won 9-7.

LAST TIME OUT: On May 19, Zebby took his first MLB loss of the season, giving up two runs on five hits (1 HR), with zero walks and six strikeouts at Target Field against the Houston Astros; despite the 2-1 Twins loss, Matthews recorded his second consecutive quality start.

BACK TO BACK GEMS: Through two starts, Zebby has combined to throw 13.0 innings while allowing only two earned runs...the 13.0 innings in a two-start span in the same season is a career-high for Zebby, while the two earned runs allowed are tied for his least through a two-start span (same season) in his career (9/17/24 at CLE - 9/22/24 at BOS).

TWO STARTS AGO: Matthews made his MLB season debut on May 14 vs. Miami; pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing four hits with one walk and five strikeouts, as the Twins rolled to a 9-1 series-clinching win over the Marlins.

MORE ON THE START: Zebby's 7.0 innings pitched tied his career long (done twice, May 30, 2025 at Seattle and September 23, 2025 at Texas)...the 7.0 scoreless innings marked a career-high; his previous high for a scoreless outing was 6.0 innings pitched July 25, 2025 vs. Washington.

FIRST FOUR AND LAST FIVE: Zebby has made nine total starts this season (seven with Triple-A St. Paul and two with the Twins)...here are his numbers from his first four starts, compared to his last five (AAA and MLB combined):

NUMBERS AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: Zebby will make his third career start against the Sox this afternoon, he is 0-0 with a 4.22 ERA (10.2 IP, 5 ER), five walks and nine strikeouts in two career starts (both in 2025).

NOTABLE SOX HITTERS: Colson Montgomery is batting a career .333 (2-for-6) off Zebby with one home run and two RBI and Edgar Quero is hitting .400 (2-for-5) with a home run and two RBI; in Zebby's lone start at Rate Field last season on August 22, Montgomery was 2-for-5 with a homer, two RBI and two runs scored while Quero was 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Matthews has gone 4-5 with a 5.98 ERA (64.2 IP, 43 ER), 15 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .302 (81-for-268) BAA in 14 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-6, 4.96 ERA (65.1 IP, 36 ER) with 21 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .274 (73-for-266) BAA in 13 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through two MLB starts this season, lefties are slashing .100/.143/.100 (2-for-20) with zero doubles, zero home runs, one walk and nine strikeouts, while righties are slashing .259/.259/.444 (7-for-27) with two doubles, one home run, zero walks and two strikeouts.

2026 MINORS SPLITS: In his seven starts with St. Paul this season, lefties slashed .314/.397/.627 with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, seven walks and seven strikeouts, while righties slashed .287/.326/.552 with four doubles, two triples, five home runs, four walks and 26 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch in his two starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.
