THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 to begin their 10-game roadtrip, sweeping Boston over the weekend, followed by a loss to Chicago-AL yesterday...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of four against the White Sox at Rate Field through Thursday afternoon...following this series, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins are 6-2 over their last eight, 10-5 over their last 15 and 12-8 over their last 20.
 ☞ Twins have gone 5-1 in their last six road games and 6-4 in their last 10 road games.

TWINS DROP MEMORIAL DAY MATINEE: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Rate Field by a score of 3-1, snapping their four-game winning streak...Derek Shelton managed his 800th game at the major league level...Zebby Matthews (1-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...all three of his runs allowed came on home runs from Munetaka Murakami (solo) and Drew Romo (2-run)...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Alex Jackson...Brooks Lee provided the only run for the Twins with a first-inning home run, his sixth of the season.

MAKING MOVES IN MAY: Since May 9, Minnesota has gone 10-5...the 10 wins since that date are tied with Atlanta (10-5), Chicago-AL (10-5), Los Angeles-NL (10-6) and Philadelphia (10-5) for fourth-most in baseball, trailing Arizona (12-4), Cleveland (11-5) and Milwaukee (11-4).

CHICAGO STYLE: The Twins and White Sox are playing the second of 13 games this season.
 ☞ The Twins have lost seven-straight to the White Sox...their seven-game losing streak is tied for Minnesota's second-longest losing streak to the Sox...they lost eight from May 8-September 23, 1995, and seven from September 18, 1979-May 20, 1980.

☞ Twins last win over the White Sox was August 22, 2025 at Rate Field (9-7 victory).
 ☞ Minnesota has gone 24-11 in its last 35 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
 ☞ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 104-79 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span...second-most for Minnesota is Detroit (98-88).
 ☞ In his last 22 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .312 (24-for-77) with four doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 13 walks, a .411 on-base percentage and a .931 OPS.
 ☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all 10 career games vs. the Sox, hitting .389 (14-for-36) with three doubles, seven walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .972 OPS...he is 5-for-15 (.333) with one double and two walks in four career games at Rate Field.

BEARS, BULLS, BLACKHAWKS, BUXTON: Byron Buxton is hitting .284 (97-for-342) with 31 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs, 56 RBI, 69 runs scored and a .941 OPS in 100 career games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 52 (June 30, 2019-present):

ALSO: Buxton's 23 career home runs, 97 hits, 31 doubles and 56 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...11 home runs and 21 RBI at Rate Field are his most at any opposing ballpark.

OPENING ACTS: In 15 games since May 9, a start made by Joe Ryan at Cleveland, the Twins starters have combined to go 6-4, 3.19 ERA (79.0 IP, 28 ER) with 20 walks, 69 strikeouts and a .211 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in the AL in both opponent batting average and ERA.
 ☞ In that span, they have allowed nine home runs, accounting for 13 of the 28 earned runs (46%).

PENSION PLAN: Since May 9, Twins relievers have gone 4-1, 2.05 ERA (57.0 IP, 13 ER) with no home runs allowed, 32 walks, 51 strikeouts and a .193 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fourth in all of baseball in bullpen ERA and seventh in opponent batting average.

HOLY MO-LEE: Brooks Lee has 46 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (50)...below are Lee's first 22 games (March 26-April 22) compared to his numbers over his last 28 games (since April 23):

BUCK BOMBS: Byron Buxton has hit 11 home runs over his last 20 games and 16 home runs over his last 31 games, since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in homers, trailing Kyle Schwarber (17).

☞ Buxton has homered six times in his last 14 road games...entering this series, he has homered in four of his last five road series* (NYM, WAS, CLE & BOS; his one miss was the TB series).
 ☞ Buxton has an 11.88 at-bat-per-home run ratio on the season, fifth-best in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (9.19), Munetaka Murakami (10.39), Ben Rice (10.88) and Aaron Judge (11.53).
 ☞ Over the last full calendar year - since May 25, 2025 - Buxton has hit 41 home runs in 130 games...over his last 162 games (since April 7, 2025), he has hit 50 home runs.

ALSO OF NOTE...: On the season, Larnach is hitting .302 (32-for-106) with a .422 on-base percentage against right-handers...his on-base percentage against righties ranks sixth in baseball (minimum 100 PA), trailing Nick Kurtz (.479), Brice Turang (.450), Troy Johnston (.432), James Wood (.427) and Yordan Alvarez (.427).

COOL HIT LUKE: Luke Keaschall went 1-for-4 yesterday afternoon and is 3-for-8 with one RBI, one hit-by-pitch and one run scored in two games on this trip so far...Keaschall is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with one double, one RBI, two HBP, eight walks, two stolen bases, six runs scored, a .463 on-base percentage and a .786 OPS in his last 10 road games, since April 25.

CHECK YOUR SCORECARDS: Major League Baseball made a scoring change to the Twins' May 19 game vs. Houston...in the bottom of the eighth inning, an error on Braden Shewmake was changed to a hit for Josh Bell, giving him an RBI on the play.

THE NARD DAWG: Florida Complex League outfielder Jhonnardo Reyes yesterday was named Florida State League Player of the Week...Reyes, 18, played in four games for the FCL Twins, going 9-for-15 (.600) with three doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI, three walks and a 2.134 OPS...he recorded his first career four-hit game on Saturday at the FCL Red Sox...the Mao, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2025.

- ⚡ Is 3-0 with a 3.41 ERA (34.1 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks, 38 strikeouts and a .210 (26-for-124) BAA in six career starts against Chicago-AL.
- ⚡ In his last start on May 20 vs. Houston, Ryan earned the win in a quality start, firing 6.0 innings of one-run, four-hit ball, with no walks and nine strikeouts in a 4-1 Twins victory.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his 11th start of the season on May 20 vs. Houston opposite right-hander Mike Burrows...recorded his team-high sixth quality start of the season and earned the win, allowing just one run on four hits through 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high nine strikeouts... Ryan threw 71.7% of his pitches for strikes, matching his season-high set on April 23 at New York-NL.

- ⚡ His only blemish in the game came on a second-inning, RBI single from former Twins teammate Christian Vázquez...following a three-hit, one-run second inning for the Astros, Ryan would go on to retire 13 consecutive batters from the second inning through the sixth inning.
- ⚡ Marked his eighth career start with at least nine strikeouts and no walks, breaking a tie with National Baseball Hall of Famers Bert Blyleven and Jim Kaat to take sole possession of the second-most such games in Twins history (1961-), trailing only Johan Santana (13 G).

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his 10th start of the season on May 15 vs. Milwaukee opposite right-hander Coleman Crow...recorded his fifth quality start of the season but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on four hits through 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts, matching a season-high...Ryan received just one run of support in the outing, making it three consecutive full starts (excluding 5/3 vs. Toronto) in which he has received one run of support from the Twins offense.

- ⚡ His only blemish in the game came on a first-inning, RBI single from William Contreras...following a three-hit, one-run opening frame for the Brewers, Ryan would go on to retire 14 of his final 16 batters faced in his last 5.0 innings pitched, six of them via the strikeout.
- ⚡ The no decision marked three consecutive no decisions for Ryan, matching the longest no decision streak of his career (also done two other times, most recently from June 19-30, 2024).

WIN-DY CITY: This will mark Ryan's seventh career start against the White Sox and first since 2024... he is 3-0 with a 3.41 ERA (34.1 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks, 38 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .210 (26-for-124) BAA...Ryan last faced Chicago-AL on August 2, 2024, when he earned the win, allowing two runs on three hits - including a two-run homer from Miguel Vargas - in 6.1 innings pitched, with three walks and seven strikeouts.

- ⚡ He has gone 6.0-or-more innings in five consecutive outings against the White Sox dating back to May 2, 2023, with four of those being quality starts.
- ⚡ Ryan has faced six hitters on the White Sox' active roster (including IL); those hitters have combined for a .378 (14-for-37) BAA with four doubles, three home runs, two walks and three strikeouts.

COMMANDING THE CENTRAL: Today marks Joe's 41st career start (42nd game) against an opponent from the American League Central division...he is 19-9 with a 2.99 ERA (234.2 IP, 78 ER), 50 walks, 247 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .201 (172-for-857) BAA.

- ⚡ In his first eight career starts against AL Central opponents on the road, Ryan owned a 7-0 record with a 0.94 ERA (48.0 IP, 5 ER), 11 walks and 44 strikeouts, but has gone just 1-5 with a 3.22 ERA (64.1 IP, 23 ER), 15 walks and 60 strikeouts in his last 12 such outings.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 61 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.93 ERA (336.2 IP, 147 ER), 77 walks and 354 strikeouts, compared to 28-19 with a 3.54 ERA (361.1 IP, 142 ER), 85 walks and 426 strikeouts in 65 home appearances (64 starts).

- ⚡ In five starts away from Target Field this season, Ryan is 1-1 with a 3.95 ERA (27.1 IP, 12 ER), eight walks, 27 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .212 (21-for-99) BAA.
- ⚡ He is looking for his first two-win decision streak on the road since doing so from July 20-August 13, 2025, when he defeated Colorado at Coors Field, followed by a no decision at Cleveland and then a win at New York-AL.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .205/.264/.348 (23-for-112) with seven doubles, three home runs, six walks and 28 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .191/.250/.255 (18-for-94) with six doubles, eight walks and 33 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .215/.275/.383 (276-for-1,283) with 89 walks and 321 strikeouts (3.61 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.272/.411 (299-for-1,330) with 73 walks and 459 strikeouts (6.29 K/BB).

- ⚡ Ryan's 6.29 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ Ryan ranks third among major league pitchers with a .063 (2-for-32) BAA on his curveball and is fourth with a 47.1 strikeout percentage (min. 30 plate appearances).
- ⚡ Has a 27.8% whiff percentage on his four-seamer, which is tied for eighth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball (min. 300 pitches).
- ⚡ Joe has an overall pitching run value of 12, which falls within the league's 97th percentile.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY: Joe has made a team-high six quality starts this season, all of which have come within his last eight starts dating back to April 11 at Toronto...he has made three consecutive quality starts since May 9 at Cleveland, marking his first time with a stretch of three straight quality starts since doing so from June 25-July 6, 2025.

- ⚡ In his career, Joe has made 59 quality starts, which is the eighth most in the American League since he made his major league debut on September 1, 2021.
