THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 to begin their 10-game roadtrip, sweeping Boston 3-0 over the weekend, followed by a 1-1 split of the first two games against the White Sox...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the third of four against the White Sox at Rate Field through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 7-2 over their last nine, 11-5 over their last 16 and 13-8 over their last 21.
☞ Twins have gone 6-1 in their last seven road games and 7-4 in their last 11 road games.
☞ Twins are on day six of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...their next day off is Monday, June 8.
☞ Twins are on game four of a stretch of 14 of 17 games against AL Central opponents.

TIME-LEE DOUBLE FOR THE WIN: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Rate Field by a score of 5-3 in 11 innings...the win snapped a seven-game losing streak to the White Sox, beating them for the first time since August 22, 2025 at Rate Field (9-7 victory)...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (Murakami 2-run HR in 8th inn) on five hits in 7.2 innings pitched, with no walks and nine strikeouts...Anthony Banda (0.2), Andrew Morris (0.2), Taylor Rogers (1.0) and Yoendrys Gómez (1.0) combined to pitch 3.1 innings without allowing an earned run...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Brooks Lee, who drove in three runs with a double in the top of the 11th.

DEEP DISH: The Twins and White Sox are playing the third of 13 games this season...after tomorrow's finale, the Twins and Sox will play again Monday-Wednesday (June 1-3), for three games at Target Field...they don't return to Rate Field until a three-game series, from September 4-6.
☞ Minnesota has gone 25-11 in its last 36 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
☞ In his last 23 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .313 (25-for-80) with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 13 walks, a .409 on-base percentage and a .934 OPS.

☞ Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all 11 career games vs. the Sox, hitting .375 (15-for-40) with three doubles, seven walks, a .479 on-base percentage and a .929 OPS...he is 6-for-19 (.316) with one double and two walks in five career games at Rate Field.

☞ Keaschall's 11-game hitting streak to begin his career against the White Sox is the longest in Twins history (since 1961) and fifth longest in Twins/Senators history (since 1901), behind Jimmy Ryan (17 G), Jackie Hayes (13 G), George Case (12 G) and Bill Coughlin (12 G).

☞ Over his last 53 games against the Sox, Byron Buxton is hitting .319 (60-for-188) with 18 doubles, three triples, 16 home runs, 35 RBI, a .702 slugging percentage and a 1.092 OPS...Buck's 23 career home runs, 97 hits, 31 doubles and 56 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...11 home runs and 21 RBI at Rate Field are his most at any opposing ballpark.

☞ Buck has 23 career home runs against the White Sox, tied with Miguel Sanó for sixth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing Harmon Killebrew (61), Bob Allison (34), Torii Hunter (25), Justin Morneau (25) and Tony Oliva (24).

MINNESOTA HEATING: Since May 9, Minnesota has gone 11-5...the 11 wins since that date are tied with Atlanta (11-5), Los Angeles-NL (11-6), Cleveland (11-6) and Philadelphia (11-5) for third-most in baseball, trailing Arizona (13-4) and Milwaukee (12-4).

☞ Since that date, they have a run differential of +18 (67-49) — a stat that Twins.TV analyst Trevor Plouffe does not like.

ALSO OF NOTE:... On the season, Larnach is hitting .303 (33-for-109) with a .420 on-base percentage against right-handers...his on-base percentage against righties ranks sixth in baseball (minimum 125 PA), trailing Nick Kurtz (.471), Brice Turang (.448), Troy Johnston (.433), James Wood (.430) and Yordan Alvarez (.425).

ROTATION SENSATION: In 16 games since May 9, Twins starters have combined to go 6-4, 3.12 ERA (86.2 IP, 30 ER) with 20 walks, 78 strikeouts and a .209 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank third in the AL in both opponent batting average and ERA.

☞ In that span, they have allowed nine home runs, accounting for 15 of the 30 earned runs.

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: Since May 9, Twins relievers have gone 5-1, 1.94 ERA (60.1 IP, 13 ER) with no home runs allowed, 32 walks, 54 strikeouts and a .196 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank second in all of baseball in bullpen ERA (San Diego - 1.79) and sixth in opponent batting average.

☞ The Twins 'pen has not allowed a home run in 16-straight games, dating back to a Keibert Ruiz solo home run off John Klein on May 7 at Washington...marks their longest stretch since a 19-game run from June 17-July 7, 2008.

SLUG BUCK: Byron Buxton has hit 11 home runs over his last 21 games and 16 home runs over his last 32 games, since April 13...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing Kyle Schwarber (17)...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

MAJORITY REPORT: With a win tonight and tomorrow, the Twins will earn their eighth series win of the season...they have gone 7-9-1 in series play, 4-3-1 at home and 3-6-0 on the road...season results in the right margin.

☞ Twins last series win over the White Sox was April 22-24, 2025 at Target Field, taking two of three...their last series win at Rate Field was March 31-April 2, 2025, taking two of three.

THE BOOK ON BROOKS: Over his last 29 games, Brooks Lee is hitting .292 (33-for-113) with eight doubles, one triple, three home runs, 18 RBI and an .804 OPS...on the season, he is hitting .438 (21-for-38) with runners in scoring position, the third-best in baseball, trailing Nick Kurtz (.486) and Troy Johnston (.450).

CLEMENS TIME: Over his last 14 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with six doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBI, a .339 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .839 OPS...over that 14-game span, he has started at four different positions defensively: first base 10 times, rightfield twice, leftfield once and second base once.

- Prielipp made his last start on May 22 at Boston, giving up six runs (five earned) on seven hits with three walks and one strikeout; did not factor into the decision as the Twins won 8-6 in comeback fashion.
- Heading into tonight, Prielipp has thrown a combined 44.2 innings between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota this season; his previous season career high is 82.2 innings last year.

LAST TIME OUT: On May 22 at Fenway Park, Prielipp endured his shortest outing since his MLB debut on April 22 at New York-NL...he went 4.0 innings, giving up a career-high six runs (five earned) on a career-high seven hits, with three walks and a career-low one strikeout...departed from the ballgame with the Twins trailing 6-3, and did not factor into the decision as Minnesota rallied to win 8-6.

FIRST INNING WOES: Through six starts, Prielipp has given up nine runs on eight hits in the first innings of his outings...hitters are slashing .320/.345/.600 (8-for-25) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, one walk and four strikeouts off Prielipp in the first inning...in comparison, Prielipp has allowed nine runs on 14 hits in all other innings of his starts combined this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: On May 16 vs. Milwaukee, Prielipp turned in a gem, giving up two runs (one earned) on three hits (1 HR) with two walks and eight strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...despite the quality start, Prielipp suffered his second consecutive loss as the Twins fell 2-1 to the Brewers...his eight strikeouts were a MLB career high, besting his previous high of six (done twice: April 22, at New York-NL and May 8, at Cleveland).

STRIKEOUT NOTE: By striking out 29 hitters in his first five MLB starts, Prielipp joined just four other Minnesota Twins pitchers to fan at least 29 batters within their first five career starts...they are Joe Ryan - 30 (2021), Fernando Romero - 29 (2018), Francisco Liriano - 33 (2005) and Jim Merritt - 29 (1965).

FIRST TWIN: With 29 strikeouts and only 15 hits allowed, Prielipp became the first Twins pitcher (1961-) to record more than 29 strikeouts and allow less than 15 hits through his first five career starts.

ROOKIE RANKINGS: Despite his tough outing on May 22, Prielipp has been one of the best rookie starters in baseball this season...here is where he ranks in a few categories among American League rookie starting pitchers and among all MLB rookie starters (min. 29.0 IP).

A DIVISIONAL TEST: Prielipp will face the Chicago White Sox tonight for the first time...the start will be his second against a member of the American League Central division...in his first start against an AL Central foe on May 8 at Cleveland, Prielipp pitched 5.0 innings, allowing four runs (one earned) on four hits (1 HR) with two walks and six strikeouts; did not factor into the decision, as the Twins lost 6-4.

NUMBERS WITH RISP: Opposing hitters are hitting .200 (4-for-20) with one extra-base hit (Willson Contreras RBI triple in 1st inning at Boston - 5/22), two walks and six strikeouts against Prielipp...the .200 BAA ranks fifth among all rookie pitchers in baseball (min. 20 AB)...trails only Toronto's Spencer Miles - .097 and Trey Yesavage - .161 among rookie pitchers in the American League (min. 20 AB).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through six games, Prielipp has started three times at home and three times on the road...on the road he is 0-1 with a 5.54 ERA (13.0 IP, 8 ER), five walks, 13 strikeouts and a 1.54 WHIP, compared to 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), seven walks, 17 strikeouts and a 0.88 WHIP in three starts at Target Field.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through six MLB starts, lefties are slashing .231/.290/.423 (6-for-26) with two doubles, one home run, three walks and five strikeouts, while righties are slashing .203/.297/.367 (16-for-79) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, nine walks and 25 strikeouts against Prielipp.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In his six starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

FASTBALL BAA: Prielipp's .125 (3-for-24) BAA his 4-Seam fastball ranks second among all MLB starting pitchers, trailing only Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler - .077 (min. 30 PA and 500 total pitches).

SLIDER USAGE: Prielipp threw his slider 15 times against Boston on May 22, a career-low for him, coming into the start had averaged 33 sliders thrown per game...Prielipp's slider has generated a .167 (7-for-42) BAA, ranking third among lefty starters in MLB (min. 30 PA and 500 total pitches).
