THE TWINS: Have gone 4-2 to begin their 10-game roadtrip, sweeping Boston 3-0 over the weekend, followed by going 1-2 in the first three games this week against the White Sox... today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the four-game series finale against the White Sox at Rate Field...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Pittsburgh to play the Pirates for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 7-3 over their last 10, 11-6 over their last 17 and 13-9 over their last 22.
☞ Twins have gone 6-2 in their last eight road games and 7-5 in their last 12 road games.
☞ Twins are on day seven of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.
☞ Twins are on game five of a stretch of 14 of 17 games against AL Central opponents.

SLAMMED ON THE SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 15-2, tied for their largest margin of defeat this season (15-2 loss on 5/6 at WAS)...Connor Prielipp (1-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just three hits, including home runs from Byron Buxton (17) and Kody Clemens (5)...White Sox pitchers retired 21-straight Twins hitters between the Buxton leadoff homer and Clemens' eighth-inning homer.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the fourth of 13 games this season...the next meeting between these two will be Monday-Wednesday (June 1-3), for three games at Target Field...Twins don't return to Rate Field until a three-game series, from September 4-6. ☞ Minnesota has gone 25-12 in its last 37 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023. ☞ In his last 24 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .298 (25-for-84) with five doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, 13 walks, a .392 on-base percentage and an .892 OPS. ☞ Over his last 54 games against the Sox, Byron Buxton is hitting .319 (61-for-191) with 18 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs, 36 RBI, a .712 slugging percentage and a 1.101 OPS...Buck's 24 career home runs, 98 hits, 31 doubles and 57 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...12 home runs and 22 RBI at Rate Field are his most at any opposing ballpark. ☞ Buck has 24 career home runs against the White Sox, tied with Tony Oliva for fifth-most in club history (since 1961), trailing Harmon Killebrew (61), Bob Allison (34), Torii Hunter (25) and Justin Morneau (25).

BUCK TRUCK ACROSS THE MAP: Byron Buxton has homered seven times in his last 16 road games...he has now homered in five of his last six road series' (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS & CWS; his one miss was the TB series). ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 24 road home runs, second-most in baseball, trailing only Christian Walker (25). ☞ Last night, he extended his road on-base streak to nine-straight games...over those nine, he is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, a .692 slugging percentage and a 1.049 OPS.

SLUG BUCK: Byron Buxton has hit 12 home runs over his last 22 games and 17 home runs over his last 33 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for the most home runs in baseball...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

ADDITIONALLY: Only James Wood and Shohei Ohtani have as many leadoff homers this season, both hitting four.

KEEP YOUR ENEMIES CLOSE: 10 of the last 11 games for the Twins have been within three runs-or-fewer (7-4)...nine have been within two runs-or-fewer (5-4) and five have been within one run (2-3)...Twins began the season 0-4 in one-run games, but have since gone 5-3.

STEADY STARTERS: In 17 games since May 9, Twins starters have combined to go 6-5, 3.56 ERA (91.0 IP, 36 ER) with 23 walks, 83 strikeouts and a .221 opponent batting average...since that date, they rank fifth in the AL in opponent batting average. ☞ In that span, they have allowed nine home runs, accounting for 15 of the 36 earned runs.

SERIES STUFF: The Twins need a win this afternoon to avoid losing the series and taking a 2-2 series tie...they have gone 7-9-1 in series play, 4-3-1 at home and 3-6-0 on the road...season results in the right margin. ☞ Twins have dropped each of their last two series vs. the Sox, one last August and the other last September.

MANY LEATHER-BOUND GLOVES AND OUR APARTMENT SMELLS OF RICH MAHOGANY: Twins team defense has a fielding run value of +3 this month, which ranks fourth in the AL and tied for 11th in all of baseball...by comparison, they had a team fielding run value of -6 in March/April, tied for sixth-lowest in baseball.

CLEMENS TIME: Over his last 15 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, six RBI, a .339 on-base percentage, a .542 slugging percentage and an .881 OPS...over that 15-game span, he has started at five different positions defensively: first base 10 times, rightfield twice, leftfield once, second base once and centerfield once.

ORLANDO MAGIC: Since having his contract selected on May 19, Orlando Arcia has hit safely in five of six games, his one hitless game coming last night as the pitcher...over the six games, he has eight hits in 16 at-bats (.500), with one double, one RBI and a 1.063 OPS with just three strikeouts...against right-handers, he is 5-for-10 (.500).

- ⚔ Kendry Rojas will make his second career major league start (sixth appearance) in today's series finale against the White Sox.
- ⚔ In his last appearance on May 23 at Boston, Rojas pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief of Taj Bradley, allowing just one hit with one walk and three strikeouts in a 4-2 Twins victory.
- ⚔ Rojas is currently ranked as the No. 10 prospect in the Twins organization according to MLB.com and the fourth-best pitching prospect; is ranked as the eighth-best prospect in Twins system according to *Baseball America*.

LAST TIME OUT: Kendry last pitched on May 23 at Boston, firing 3.0 scoreless innings with just one hit allowed in relief of Taj Bradley, with one walk and three strikeouts in a 4-2 Twins victory at Fenway Park.

- ⚔ After surrendering a single to Jarren Duran to begin his outing, Kendry retired nine of his final 11 batters faced, with the only two base runners coming on a Nick Sogard walk and a throwing error that allowed Ceddanne Rafaela to reach.
- ⚔ Has pitched 8.0 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the ninth inning on May 14 vs. Miami, allowing just three combined hits with two walks and eight strikeouts in that span.

TWO OUTINGS AGO: Kendry made his first career major league start on May 18 vs. Houston, opposite right-hander Tatsuya Imai...did not factor into the decision, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings on two hits, with one walk and three strikeouts, helping lift the Twins past the Astros by a score of 6-3 at Target Field.

- ⚔ Allowed each of his first three batters to reach (Jeremy Peña hit by pitch, Isaac Paredes single, Yordan Alvarez walk) before escaping a no-out, bases-loaded jam with a Christian Walker popout and a 6-4-3 double play of Zach Dezenzo.
- ⚔ Retired nine of his final 10 batters faced, with the only base runner coming on a two-out single from Cam Smith in the second inning.

¡VIVA CUBA! Rojas, a native of Ciego de Avila, Cuba, is just the sixth Cuban-born pitcher in Twins club history (1961-) to make a start, and first since Liván Hernández made 23 starts for Minnesota during the 2008 season...below is a list of all six Cuban-born starting pitchers in Twins club history, and their numbers as a starter:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (MAJORS): In five major league outings, Kendry has made two appearances at home (one start), going 0-0 with a 1.50 ERA (6.0 IP, 1 ER), three walks and six strikeouts, compared to 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP, 1 ER), seven walks and eight strikeouts in three appearances on the road.

- ⚔ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** Rojas has made two home appearances with St. Paul and three road appearances (one start) this season; at home is 0-0 with a 2.70 ERA (6.2 IP, 2 ER), three walks and five strikeouts and on the road is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 10 strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS (MAJORS): Rojas has faced 61 total batters through his first five outings, with lefties slashing .188/.435/.188 (3-for-16) with zero extra-base hits, seven walks and seven strikeouts, while righties are slashing .242/.324/.303 (8-for-33) with two doubles, three walks and seven strikeouts.

- ⚔ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** Through five appearances with St. Paul this season, lefties are slashing .000/.167/.000 (0-for-10) off Rojas with one walk and four strikeouts, while righties are slashing .304/.360/.391 (14-for-46) with one double, one homer, six RBI, four walks and 11 strikeouts...in his minor league career, lefties are slashing .215/.283/.312 (60-for-279) with 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBI, 18 walks and 82 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .246/.322/.373 (208-for-844) with 50 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs, 96 RBI, 92 walks and 261 strikeouts; if you combine both sides of the plate, Rojas has a career minor league BAA of .239 (268-for-1123).

THE ARSENAL: Rojas has displayed a four-pitch arsenal through his first five big-league appearances...here are his numbers, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚔ **A NOTE ON THE HEATER:** Kendry's .118 (2-for-17) BAA on his 4-Seam Fastball currently ranks first among active Twins' pitchers and also ranks third with a 25.6 whiff percentage (this excludes pitchers on the Injured List).
- ⚔ **A NEW ADDITION TO THE ARSENAL (SINKER):** Kendry has added a sinker to his arsenal after not throwing the pitch in his first MLB outing or any of his minor league outings this season...his xBA of .198 with the sinker is the second lowest on the team, only behind Travis Adams (.107).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2026, Rojas made his MLB debut on April 22 in relief against the New York Mets; he entered in the fifth inning and worked 2.0 scoreless innings, giving up two hits and walking three...relieved Connor Prielipp, who made his MLB debut that same night; was the first time the Twins had two pitchers debut on the same day since April 7, 1999 (three that day).
- Currently ranked as the 10th-best prospect in the Twins organization according to MLB.com and the fourth-best pitching prospect.
- Spent 2026 spring training with major league club, optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on March 9; on March 27, he was placed on 7-day injured list with a right hamstring strain...made one rehab start with Fort Myers on April 4 and was activated by St. Paul on April 11.
- Ranked eighth-best prospect in Twins minor league system by *Baseball America* entering 2026.
- In 2025, began season (Toronto organization) on Double-A New Hampshire's 7-day Injured List with a right oblique strain...pitched in six games for FCL Blue Jays and Low-A Dunedin from May 30-June 26 and was reinstated on June 30.
- Named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on July 13 while pitching for New Hampshire...struck out 10 batters in 5.0 shutout innings for Fisher Cats on July 10.
- Promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on July 29 and made Triple-A debut on July 30.
- Acquired by Minnesota via trade on July 31 along with outfielder Alan Roden, in exchange for infielder Ty France and right-handed pitcher Louis Varland...reported to Triple-A St. Paul and made eight starts in the Saints rotation to finish season.
- Was one of the 30 youngest pitchers to have appeared in a game in the International League in 2025.
- In 2025, combined to go 2-5, 4.70 ERA (69.0 IP, 36 ER) with 32 walks and 90 strikeouts in 19 games (18 starts) at all five stops...held left-handed batters to a .233 average, compared to .293 vs. right-handed batters.
