**THE TWINS:** Have gone 4-3 through seven games on their 10-game roadtrip, sweeping Boston 3-0 last weekend, followed by going 1-3 this week against the White Sox...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of three against the Pirates at PNC Park through the weekend.   
 ☞ Twins are 7-4 over their last 11, 11-7 over their last 18 and 13-10 over their last 23.   
 ☞ Twins have gone 6-3 in their last nine road games and 7-6 in their last 13 road games.   
 ☞ Twins are on day eight of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.

**SOUTHSIDE SLIDE:** The Twins lost to the White Sox on Thursday afternoon at Rate Field by a score of 6-2...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-7) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on five hits in 2.2 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts... Andrew Morris, Travis Adams, Taylor Rogers, Anthony Banda and Yoendrys Gómez combined to allow one unearned run on three hits and one walk over the final 5.1 innings...the offense recorded five hits, two from Tristan Gray, who singled and doubled.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins have placed left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas on the 15-day Injured List with left elbow inflammation.

☞ Rojas has gone 1-0, 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER), 10 walks, 14 strikeouts and a .224 opponent batting average in five games (1 start) across two stints with the Twins this season.

☞ Right-handed pitcher Travis Adams was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...Adams was recalled on May 19 and appeared in five games for the Twins during his most recent stint.

☞ The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Laweryson, who has missed the Twins last 45 games with a right forearm strain, pitched in four games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul.

☞ Twins have recalled Kody Funderburk, who went 1-1, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), one save, six holds, 13 walks, 10 strikeouts and a .167 opponent batting average in 19 games for the Twins prior to being optioned to the Saints on May 10...he went 1-1 with a 9.00 ERA (5.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks and seven strikeouts in five games for St. Paul between May 15-27.

**THE PITT:** The Twins and Pirates are playing each other for the 49th, 50th and 51st times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 28-20 all-time against the Bucs, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 9-6 at PNC Park (2006-20) and 9-6 at Target Field (2015-25).

☞ Nine wins at PNC Park for the Twins are tied for their second-most in any NL ballpark with Wrigley Field...they have won the most at American Family Field in Milwaukee (32 wins).

☞ These two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from July 11-13, 2025 as the Twins won games one and two of the series.

☞ Twins last visited PNC Park for three games from June 7-9, 2024, winning just the third game of the series.

☞ 48 games against the Pirates are Minnesota's most against any non-Milwaukee NL opponent.

☞ In 15 career games vs. the Pirates, Byron Buxton is hitting .327 (18-for-55) with four doubles, one triple, seven RBI and an .890 OPS...during the three-game series vs. the Bucs last season in July, he went 9-for-13, including a 5-for-5 game in which he hit for the cycle on July 12.

☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .288 (40-for-139) in 53 career games vs. the Pirates...his 40 hits, six home runs and 13 doubles are his most vs. any opponent.

☞ Twins manager Derek Shelton helmed the Pirates from 2020-25...Mike Rabelo held a variety of roles on Shelly's coaching staff in Pittsburgh from 2020-25, including assistant hitting coach, major league field coordinator and third base coach.

**BUCK SHOTS:** Byron Buxton has hit 12 home runs over his last 23 games and 17 home runs over his last 34 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for the most home runs in baseball...below are Bucs' season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

**BELL-ACK AND YELLOW:** Josh Bell played five seasons for the Pirates from 2016-20...he made his debut in this ballpark on July 8, 2016 vs. Chicago-NL and recorded his first hit in his first plate appearance, pinch-hitting for Neftali Feliz, singling off Jake Arrieta...his second career plate appearance came the next day, hitting a pinch-hit grand slam off Adam Warren...he played in 552 career games for the Pirates, hitting 86 home runs...he was selected by the Pirates in the second round (61st overall) of the 2011 MLB Draft.

☞ He is tied with Ryan Doumit for 12th on PNC Park's all-time home run list, hitting 41 here.

☞ Named 2019 Pittsburgh's Heart and Hustle Award winner...2019 National League All-Star...2014 and '16 Pirates Minor League Player of the Year.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** Twins have gone just 5-10 against National League opponents this season, going 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23), 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7), 2-1 vs. Miami (May 12-14) and 1-2 vs. Milwaukee (May 15-17)...after this series, their next NL opponent will be the Cardinals at Target Field, from June 12-14.

**BUCK TRUCK ACROSS AMERICA:** Byron Buxton has homered seven times in his last 17 road games...he has homered in five of his last six road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS & CWS; his one miss was the TB series).

☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buxton has hit 24 road home runs, second-most in baseball, trailing only Christian Walker (25).

☞ Yesterday, he extended his road on-base streak to 10-straight games...over those nine, he is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with three doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS.

**MANY LEATHER-BOUND GLOVES AND OUR APARTMENT SMELLS OF RICH MAHOGANY:** Twins team defense has a fielding run value of +2 this month, which ranks sixth in the AL and tied for 15th in all of baseball...by comparison, they had a team fielding run value of -6 in March/April, tied for sixth-lowest in baseball.

**HOW DO YOU LIKE THEM APPLES:** Twins are playing on Apple TV+ for the second time this season...their first was May 8 at Cleveland, losing by a score of 6-4...their next scheduled Apple TV game is on Friday, June 5 vs. Kansas City at Target Field.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2021, Josh Donaldson scored the 2 millionth run in Major League Baseball history, crossing home plate after Nelson Cruz drove him in with a first-inning double against the Kansas City Royals.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Making his return from the 15-day Injured List (right pectoralis muscle inflammation), Bradley earned the win in his May 23 start against Boston at Fenway Park; Taj gave up one run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in a 4-2 Twins win...threw an MLB season-low 73 pitches, 48 of them for strikes (65.8%)...improved his career numbers at Fenway Park to 4-0 with a 2.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 6 ER), 10 walks, 31 strikeouts, a .196 (18-for-92) BAA, .304 SLG against and a .587 OPS against in five career starts

⚡ **HIGH FIVE:** The win was his fifth in nine starts this season, which is the least amount of starts it has taken him to get to five wins in his career (previous low: 10 starts in 2023)...the win was also his fifth against the Boston Red Sox, the most he has against a single opponent in his career (next highest: three wins against Toronto).

**TWO STARTS AGO (ST. PAUL):** On May 17, Taj made a rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul vs. Columbus, throwing 42 pitches in 1.2 innings followed by an additional 20-pitch bullpen after coming out...gave up one run on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts in his 1.2 innings pitched.

**TWINS AND AMERICAN LEAGUE RANKINGS:** Despite his stint on the IL, many of Taj's numbers still lead the Twins...here is where he ranks among Twins starters and American League starters in a few categories (min. 50 IP).

**MAY FLOWERS:** Through two May starts, Bradley is 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER), four walks and 15 strikeouts...in his career, his 3.51 ERA, 88 strikeouts, .214 (60-for-281) BAA and .642 OPS against in the month of May each rank second in his career monthly splits...here is a more in-depth breakdown of some of his May numbers.

**A NEW TEST IN THE NL CENTRAL:** Taj is slated to make his first career start against the Pirates and seventh career start against the National League Central; is 2-2 with a 2.34 ERA (34.2 IP, 9 ER), 10 walks and 41 strikeouts through his first six starts...the 2.34 ERA is his lowest against any division in baseball.

**INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS:** Taj is due to make his 23rd career start against an Interleague opponent tonight; in his career, Taj is 6-7 with a 4.94 ERA (114.2 IP, 63 ER), 40 walks, 125 strikeouts, a .245 (108-for-440) BAA and a .732 OPS against...this season he has made two Interleague starts (April 18 vs. Cincinnati and May 5 at Washington), going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 13 strikeouts, a .200 (9-for-45) BAA and a .549 OPS against.

⚡ **LAST EIGHT STARTS - TWO DIFFERENT STORIES:** In his last eight starts against the National League, Taj is 1-1 with a 4.83 ERA (41.0 IP, 22 ER), 19 walks and 40 strikeouts...below is a deeper dive into his last eight, comparing his first four starts (4/23/25-6/7/25) of the eight game span to the last four (6/13/25-5/5/26).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER):** Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.85 ERA (213.1 IP, 115 ER), 68 walks, 240 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in 40 career home starts compared to 12-13 with a 4.38 ERA (224.0 IP, 109 ER), 93 walks, 229 strikeouts and a 1.32 WHIP in 44 road appearances (42 starts).

⚡ **SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 2.33 ERA (19.1 IP, 5 ER), four walks, 22 strikeouts and a 0.98 WHIP in three home starts compared to a 4-1 record with a 3.03 ERA (32.2 IP, 11 ER), 15 walks, 37 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP in six road starts.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .187/.263/.336 (20-for-107) with seven doubles, three home runs, 11 walks and 38 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .253/.327/.379 (22-for-87) with five doubles, two home runs, eight walks and 21 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

⚡ **DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS:** Taj has given up a .154 (6-for-39) BAA on his cutter this season, the lowest by a starting pitcher in baseball (min. 40 PA and 500 total pitches).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - BAILEY OBER (2026: 6-2, 3.92 ERA // CAREER: 37-32, 4.07 ERA)**

Bailey Ober is due to toe the rubber for the 12th time this season tomorrow afternoon against the Pirates...in his last outing on May 24 at Boston, Bailey picked up his team-leading sixth win, allowing four runs on seven hits (2 HR), with zero walks and three strikeouts...the win made it three consecutive starts with a victory for Ober, his longest since a three-start win streak from April 22-May 3, 2025...Bailey has made one career start against the Bucs on June 9, 2024 in Pittsburgh; did not factor into the decision, going 4.2 innings and allowing four runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts in an 11-5 Twins victory.
