THE TWINS: Have gone 2-4 through six games on their seven-game homestand, going 1-2 vs. Seattle earlier this week and 1-2 vs. Toronto this weekend...today, Minnesota will play the four-game series finale against the Blue Jays...Minnesota will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then travel to Washington D.C. to begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the Nationals (May 5-7) and three against the Guardians in Cleveland (May 8-10).

THAT ESCALATED QUICKLY: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays yesterday afternoon by a score of 11-4, losing what was a 4-2 lead entering the sixth inning...Connor Prielipp was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow nine runs (8 earned), including an eight-run eighth inning for the Jays...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Trevor Larnach...Byron Buxton hit his 10th home run of the season, fifth on the homestand and third in as many days.

John Klein made his major league debut in the ninth inning, retiring all three batters he faced...he became the fourth Twin to debut in 2026 (Andrew Morris, Kendry Rojas and Connor Prielipp) and the 33rd Minnesota-born player to appear in a Twins uniform (since 1961).

HOW DO YOU LIKE THEM MAPLES: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the seventh and final time this season...Jays and Rays are the only AL teams the Twins are done playing for 2026...a win today for Minnesota and they will clinch the season-series over Toronto for the first time since 2024 (4-2).

Notables this season vs. Toronto: Ryan Jeffers is 6-for-18 (.333) with two home runs and seven RBI...Austin Martin is 7-for-14 (.500) with a double and four walks...Byron Buxton has three homers vs. the Jays and Brooks Lee has two.

Twins have scored 32 runs vs. the Jays this season, their most against any opponent.

Twins have homered in 13-straight against the Blue Jays, totaling 25 homers in that span...Minnesota's longest home run streak against the Jays is 14, from August 26, 2017-April 16, 2019.

Byron Buxton has posted a .957 OPS with 10 doubles, 13 home runs, 26 RBI and a .607 slugging percentage in 38 career regular season games against the Blue Jays.

In 14 career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .375 (18-for-48) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .444 on-base percentage, a .604 slugging percentage and a 1.049 OPS.

BUCK WILD: Byron Buxton has homered in three-straight games and five times on this homestand, his only homerless game being Wednesday afternoon vs. Seattle...his long for a homer streak is three, done five times prior to this current streak...after going homerless in his first 14 games to begin the season (62 plate appearances), Buck has homered 10 times in his last 17 games (81 PA), since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...despite the early season homer drought, Buck still ranks tied for fifth in the AL in homers on the entire season (tied for 7th in MLB).

KEEPING UP WITH PASSING THE JONESES: Buxton hit his first leadoff home run of the season yesterday and 21st of his career, passing Jacque Jones to move into sole possession of second place on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...below are Twins all-time leadoff homers (left) and MLB leadoff homers since 2025 (right):

LARN ON THE FLY: After going 2-for-4 yesterday, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a new career-high 17-straight games with a plate appearance, passing his career-high of 16 (August 17-September 5, 2025)...it marks the longest for a Twin since Austin Martin reached in 18-straight from April 4-28...during this streak, Larnach has recorded 15 hits and 13 walks in 68 plate appearances for a .412 on-base percentage.

Larnach is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with 16 walks, a .479 on-base percentage and a .936 OPS against right-handed pitching on the season.

WE'RE TALKIN' LEE: Over his last nine games, Brooks Lee is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored, three walks, a .405 on-base percentage, a .559 slugging percentage and a .964 OPS...his 27 hits on the season are tied for second-most on the team with Luke Keaschall, trailing Byron Buxton (34).

A-MAR ON THE MARK: Austin Martin went 3-for-4 Friday night, tying his career-high in hits...he currently leads the club with 19 walks...he has posted a .484 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances...Martin has reached base safely in 23 of 26 games with a plate appearance.

Among all AL players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances, Martin's .333 batting average is tied for third.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Riley Quick and catcher/outfielder Khadim Diaw as their minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week. Quick, 22, made the start on Wednesday vs. West Michigan, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...the Trussville, AL native was selected by the Twins in the first round (36th overall) in the 2025 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Alabama...he is ranked by MLB.com as the club's 11th-best prospect.

Diaw, 22, reached base safely in 12 consecutive plate appearances, recording eight hits with four walks...on Wednesday vs. West Michigan, he reached safely five times with four hits and one walk...the Hoboken, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Loyola Marymount University.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2011, Francisco Liriano threw the fifth no-hitter in Twins history and first no-hitter of the MLB season as the Twins beat the White Sox, 1-0...Jason Kubel's solo homer in the fourth inning off Edwin Jackson was the game's only run...in 2013, Justin Morneau recorded his 800th career RBI in a Twins 7-6 loss at Cleveland...Morneau finished his Twins career with 860 RBI which stands as the sixth most in club history.

- ☞ Making his eighth start of 2026 and 122nd start (123rd game) of his career.
- ☞ Is 3-1 with a 4.20 ERA (30.0 IP, 14 ER), six walks, 29 strikeouts and a .227 (25-for-110) BAA in six career starts against Toronto.
- ☞ Took the loss despite making a quality start his last time out on April 28 vs. Seattle, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts in a 7-1 Twins loss.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his seventh start of the season on April 28 vs. Seattle opposite right-hander Logan Gilbert...took the loss despite making his third quality start of the season, allowing two runs on six hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...exited the game with no outs in the seventh inning in a 1-1 game, but was responsible for the runner on second base following a Randy Arozarena double to begin the frame; left-hander Kody Funderburk took over and recorded back-to-back outs before a Cole Young single broke the tie and ultimately handed Joe the loss.

- ☞ He has now been tagged with the loss in each of his last two quality starts (also on 4/17 vs. Cincinnati), marking the first time he has lost in consecutive quality starts in his career...the Twins are 38-18 lifetime when Joe has made a quality start.
- ☞ The loss marked the first time he has received three losses in his first seven starts of a season; also the first time in his career he has made seven starts before May.
- ☞ Picked off Josh Naylor in the fourth inning, his first since picking off St. Louis' Jordan Walker on March 29, 2025.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his sixth start of the season on April 22 at New York-NL opposite right-hander Christian Scott...did not factor into the decision, allowing seven runs (four earned) on seven hits - two of which were home runs from Brett Baty and Carson Benge - with two walks and five strikeouts in a 5.0 inning outing...exited the game with a 7-2 deficit, but an eighth-inning grand slam from Ryan Jeffers to even the game at seven apiece took away a potential decision for Ryan.

- ☞ Surrendered multiple home runs for the first time this season and first time doing so since allowing four blasts on September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland.
- ☞ Threw 71.7% of pitches for strikes, his highest strike percentage of the season and highest since throwing 72.1% of his pitches for strikes on August 31, 2025 vs. San Diego.

JOE AND THE JAYS - ROUND TWO: This will mark Ryan's sixth career start vs. Toronto and second this season; he is 3-1 with a 4.20 ERA (30.0 IP, 14 ER), 29 strikeouts, four home runs allowed, a 1.03 WHIP and a .227 (25-for-110) BAA...in his first bout with Toronto this season on April 11 at Rogers Centre, Ryan made a quality start and earned the win, allowing two runs on two hits - one being a two-run homer from Daulton Varsho - with one walk and five strikeouts in a season-high 7.0 innings pitched.

- ☞ Three of Joe's five career starts against Toronto have been quality starts; Twins are 4-1 all-time vs. Toronto with Ryan on the mound.
- ☞ Ryan has faced 14 hitters on the Blue Jays' active roster (including Injured List); those hitters have combined for a .226 (28-for-124) BAA with seven doubles, three home runs (Giménez, Kirk, Varsho), seven walks and 30 strikeouts.

MAKING IT LOOK EAST-Y: Ryan is set to make his 25th start against an opponent from the AL East, his most against a division behind the the AL Central...in his career, Ryan is 10-6 with a 3.30 ERA (142.0 IP, 52 ER), 28 walks and 153 strikeouts against AL West opponents.

- ☞ In 2026, Ryan has made three starts against the AL East, going 1-0 with a 1.46 ERA (12.1 IP, 2 ER), three walks, 12 strikeouts, a 0.49 WHIP and a .077 (3-for-39) BAA.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 60 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.97 ERA (330.2 IP, 146 ER), 74 walks and 349 strikeouts, compared to 27-18 with a 3.61 ERA (349.0 IP, 140 ER), 83 walks and 409 strikeouts in 62 home appearances (61 starts).

- ☞ Since the start of the 2025 season, Ryan is 8-7 with a 3.34 ERA (102.1 IP, 38 ER), 25 walks, 122 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .216 (82-for-379) BAA in 18 starts (19 games) at Target Field.
- ☞ His 27 wins at home are tied for the eighth most in baseball since the start of the 2022 season.
- ☞ His 10.73 K/9 in home starts since the start of the 2025 season ranks sixth among all starting pitchers in the American League.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .247/.284/.455 (19-for-77) with seven doubles, three home runs, two walks and 19 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .185/.257/.262 (12-for-65) with five doubles, seven walks and 20 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .218/.277/.390 (272-for-1,248) with 85 walks and 312 strikeouts (3.67 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.273/.414 (293-for-1,301) with 72 walks and 446 strikeouts (6.19 K/BB).

- ☞ Ryan's 6.19 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ryan's curveball ranks first among major league pitchers with a .074 (2-for-28) BAA and fifth in the league with a 50.0 strikeout percentage (minimum 25 plate appearances).
- ☞ His .083 (1-for-12) opponent batting average against the split finger is tied for the third lowest in Major League Baseball (min. 10 plate appearances).

HERE COMES THE SUN: Today will mark Ryan's third daytime start of 2026, compared to five starts at night...he has performed significantly better under the sun rather than under the lights so far this season (see table below):

Right-hander Taj Bradley is slated to start Tuesday's series opener at Washington, the first game of a six-game roadtrip spanning stops in Washington, D.C. and Cleveland...in his most recent start on April 29 vs. Seattle, Taj did not factor into the decision but matched the longest start by a Twin this season, firing 7.0 innings of two-run, four-hit ball, with one home run allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Mariners 5-3...the outing matched Taj's career-high in innings pitched, marking the deepest he has gone into a game with the Twins and longest outing since June 1, 2025 at Houston with the Rays (also 7.0 IP)...in his lone career start vs. Washington on June 30, 2024, Bradley tossed 5.2 scoreless innings on three hits with two walks and 11 strikeouts, which matched his career-high (done three times, with that outing being his most recent 11-strikeout game).
