THE TWINS: Have gone 4-4 through eight games on their 10-game roadtrip, going 3-0 at Boston last weekend, 1-3 at Chicago-AL earlier this week and 0-1 against the Pirates to start this weekend...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three against the Pirates at PNC Park through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the White Sox (Monday-Wednesday) and four against the Royals (Thursday-Sunday).
 ☞ Twins are 7-5 over their last 12, 11-8 over their last 19 and 13-11 over their last 24.
 ☞ Twins have gone 6-4 in their last 10 road games.
 ☞ Twins are on day nine of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.

NOT SO JOLLY ROGER(S): The Twins lost to the Pirates last night at PNC Park by a score of 6-5 in walk-off fashion, their first walk-off defeat of the season...also just their second loss this season when leading after eight innings...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts on 87 pitches...Taylor Rogers was issued the loss and blown save, allowing a two-run walk-off homer to Bryan Reynolds with one out in the ninth...Minnesota's offense recorded eight hits, including home runs from Kody Clemens and Trevor Larnach...for Larnach he became the 54th different player (86th time) to hit a ball into the Allegheny River.

KLEIN TIME: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher John Klein from Triple-A St. Paul...Klein, who will be in his second stint with the Twins, recently appeared in four games for the Saints, allowing five runs in 12.1 innings pitched (3.65 ERA), with six hits, five walks, 16 strikeouts, a 0.89 WHIP and a .143 opponent batting average in four games (3 starts)...during his first stint with the Twins, the right-hander went 0-1, 7.71 ERA (2.1 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and one strikeout.

☞ To make room for Klein on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson for release or assignment...Woods Richardson appeared in 12 games (10 starts) for the Twins this season, going 0-7, 7.74 ERA (47.2 IP, 41 ER), 25 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .330 opponent batting average.

DISTURBING THE PS: The Twins and Pirates are playing each other for the 49th, 50th and 51st times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 28-21 all-time against the Bucs, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 9-7 at PNC Park (2006-26) and 9-6 at Target Field (2015-25).

☞ Nine wins at PNC Park for the Twins are tied for their second-most in any NL ballpark with Wrigley Field...they have won the most at American Family Field in Milwaukee (32 wins).
 ☞ 49 games against the Pirates are Minnesota's most against any non-Milwaukee NL opponent.
 ☞ In 16 career games vs. the Pirates, Byron Buxton is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with four doubles, one triple, seven RBI and an .831 OPS.
 ☞ Victor Caratini is hitting .289 (41-for-142) in 54 career games vs. the Pirates...his 41 hits, six home runs and 13 doubles are his most vs. any opponent.
 ☞ Notables lifetime vs. Mitch Keller: Josh Bell is 6-for-14 (.429) with one double, one home run and four RBI...Orlando Arcia is 5-for-10 (.500) with one double.

 ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 24 road home runs, second-most in baseball, trailing only Christian Walker (25).

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton has hit 12 home runs over his last 24 games and 17 home runs over his last 35 games, since April 13...since that date, he rank second in baseball in home runs, trailing only Kyle Schwarber...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

 ☞ Twins' last series win over the Pirates was last season, taking two of three at Target Field from July 11-13...their last series loss to the Pirates was June 3-9, 2024 at PNC Park, dropping two of three.

TREVOR LARNACH, PROFESSIONAL HITTER: Through eight games on this trip, Trevor Larnach is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, one walk, a .538 slugging percentage and a .931 OPS.

IT'S ALL IN THE RISP: On the season, the Twins have hit .271 (133-for-491) with RISP, the second-highest in the AL and sixth-highest in baseball...overall, they have had 590 plate appearances with runners in scoring position this season, the most in the AL and fifth-most in baseball.

☞ Notable individuals with RISP this season: Brooks Lee is hitting .429 (21-for-49)...Austin Martin is hitting .355 (11-for-31)...Luke Keaschall is hitting .314 (16-for-51)...Josh Bell is hitting .300 (18-for-60)...Trevor Larnach is hitting .300 (9-for-30).
 ☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 50 RISP plate appearances: Lee ranks second, Keaschall ranks eighth and Bell is tied for 11th.

- ☞ Ober is due to make his 12th start of 2026 and 127th start of his career.
- ☞ In his most recent start on May 24 at Boston, Ober earned the win, allowing four runs on seven hits (2 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts in a 6-5 Twins victory.
- ☞ Making his second career start against Pittsburgh; 0-0, 7.71 ERA (4.2 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and five strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Bailey made his 11th start of the season on May 24 at Boston opposite right-hander and former Twin, Sonny Gray...earned his third-straight win, allowing four runs on seven hits - including two home runs by Wilson Contreras and Masataka Yoshida - with no walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins defeated the Red Sox in the series finale by a score of 6-5, sweeping Boston at Fenway Park for the first time since 1994.

- ☞ The win marked his team-high sixth of the season, already matching his season win total from 2025...it is also the earliest in a season that he has reached the six-win mark in his career, with his earliest prior to this season coming on June 16, 2024 (finished that season with a career-high 12 wins).
- ☞ Also marked his first win away from Target Field this season, with his previous five all coming while pitching at home.
- ☞ The outing marked the 27th time Ober has surrendered multiple home runs in his career and first time doing so in back-to-back games since allowing a pair of homers in consecutive games on August 26, 2025 at Toronto and September 1 vs. Chicago-AL.
- ☞ Threw a season-high 72.0% (82/59) of his pitches for strikes, his best strike percentage since throwing 73.6% (87/64) of pitches for strikes on June 6, 2025 vs. Toronto.

TWO STARTS AGO: Bailey made his 10th start of the season on May 17 vs. Milwaukee opposite left-hander Robert Gasser...earned his second straight win, allowing three runs on six hits - including a season-high two home runs by Garrett Mitchell and Christian Yelich - with two walks and one strikeout, as the Twins defeated the Brewers in the series finale by a score of 5-4 at Target Field.

- ☞ Bailey is undefeated through seven starts at Target Field this season, with his last loss at home coming on September 20, 2025 vs. Cleveland...seven consecutive home starts without a loss is tied for the third longest such streak of his career, and is the longest since a career-high 10 consecutive home starts without a loss from July 7, 2023-May 24, 2024.

THE BEARD MEETS THE BUCS: Ober is making his second career start against Pittsburgh and first since 2024; in his lone start against the Pirates on June 9, 2024 at PNC Park, he did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts in an 11-5 Twins win.

- ☞ His 7.71 ERA (4.2, 4 ER) against the Bucs is his third highest against any opponent, only behind his 40.50 ERA (2.0 IP, 9 ER) against Atlanta and his 12.15 ERA (6.2 IP, 9 ER) against St. Louis.
- ☞ Despite only facing Pittsburgh once, there are eight players on the Pirates' roster that have faced Ober (including Injured List); those hitters have combined for a .379 (11-for-29) BAA with two doubles (Marcell Ozuna, Bryan Reynolds), no home runs, one walk (Henry Davis) and seven strikeouts.

THAT LEAGUE FROM ACROSS THE WAY: Bailey is no stranger to pitching in Interleague Play, with tonight marking his 27th career start against a National League opponent, the third most in Twins club history since the inception of Interleague Play in 1997...in his career, Bailey is 7-8 with a 4.98 ERA (141.0 IP, 78 ER), 39 walks, 130 strikeouts, 25 home runs allowed, a 1.19 WHIP and a .241 (129-for-536) BAA in 26 career starts against National League opponents.

- ☞ He has made four starts this season against the National League, combining for a 2-1 record with a 2.84 ERA (25.1 IP, 8 ER), eight walks, 21 strikeouts, a 0.99 WHIP and a .185 (17-for-92) BAA.
- ☞ His .241 (129-for-536) BAA vs. Interleague opponents is the fifth best opponent batting average in Interleague Play by a Twins pitcher (1997-).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In six MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 21-15 with a 4.02 ERA (356.0 IP, 159 ER), 87 walks, 343 strikeouts, a .234 (315-for-1337) BAA and a .714 OPS against in 65 starts at home compared to 16-17 with a 4.12 ERA (323.2 IP, 148 ER), 63 walks, 304 strikeouts, a .241 (296-for-1227) BAA and a .708 OPS against in 60 road starts.

- ☞ This season, Ober owns a 1-2 record with a 6.30 ERA (20.0 IP, 14 ER), five walks and 10 strikeouts in four starts away from Target Field.
- ☞ In his last road start on May 22 at Boston, he received six runs of support from the Twins offense, which matches the six combined runs of support they provided across his first three road starts of the season.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .202/.258/.454 (24-for-119) with nine doubles, seven home runs, eight walks and 18 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .235/.296/.339 (27-for-115) with six doubles, two home runs, nine walks and 25 strikeouts.

- ☞ His .202 opponent batting average against left-handed batters ranks seventh among qualified right-handed American League starters (min. 100 at bats).
- ☞ Opponents are hitting .218 (51-for-234) against Ober, which is the 15th lowest BAA among all qualified American League pitchers.

THE ARSENAL: Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Bailey has thrown 338 changeups this season, the most by an American League pitcher and second most in MLB, trailing Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (436).
- ☞ He is fifth among MLB pitchers with a .212 (18-for-85) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 80 plate appearances).
- ☞ He ranks fourth among MLB pitchers with a .080 (2-for-25) opponent batting average against the sweeper and his run value of four with the sweeper is tied for the fifth-best in MLB (min. 25 plate appearances and min. 50 pitches for both).
- ☞ Ober has a breaking run value of six, which ranks in the league's 95th percentile.
- ☞ His 7.2 foot extension ranks in the league's 96th percentile, which is the fourth highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

WIN, WIN, AND WIN AGAIN: Bailey has emerged victorious in three consecutive starts dating back to his complete-game shutout on May 12 vs. Miami...the three-game win streak is tied for the third longest of his career and is just one shy of matching his career-high of four straight starts with a win (done twice, most recently from April 15-May 3, 2025).

- ☞ He became the second Twins starter to win three straight starts this season, with the other being Taj Bradley, who won three consecutive starts from April 2-12...a win today would make him the first Twin to win four consecutive starts since Joe Ryan won five straight from May 10-June 8, 2025.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - ZEBBY MATTHEWS (2026: 1-2, 2.37 ERA // CAREER: 7-12, 5.43 ERA)
