THE TWINS: Have gone 4-5 through nine games on their 10-game roadtrip, going 3-0 at Boston last weekend, 1-3 at Chicago-AL earlier this week and 0-2 against the Pirates this weekend...today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale against the Pirates at PNC Park...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a seven-game homestand with three against the White Sox (Monday-Wednesday) and four against the Royals (Thursday-Sunday).
 ☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing their fifth-straight game today, which would match their longest this season, previously from April 22-26.
 ☞ Twins are on day 10 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day off is Monday, June 8.

TWINS FIGHT BACK BUT FALL SHORT: The Twins lost to the Pirates yesterday at PNC Park by a score of 10-9...they were down 7-1 at one point but tied the game at 7-7 in the fourth inning...Bailey Ober (6-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing eight runs (7 earned) on 12 hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk, three strikeouts and three home runs allowed...the offense recorded 12 hits, tied for their second-most in a loss this season...Kody Clemens and Luke Keaschall each had three hits...Clemens fell a home run short of the cycle.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober on the 15-day Injured List with right elbow inflammation.
 ☞ Ober has gone 6-3, 4.59 ERA (66.2 IP, 34 ER), 18 walks, 46 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP and a .243 opponent batting average in 12 starts for the Twins this season.
 ☞ Additionally, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Mike Paredes, optioned right-handed pitcher John Klein to St. Paul and have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from St. Paul.
 ☞ Paredes, 25, has split the 2026 season between St. Paul and Double-A Wichita, combining to go 3-2, 4.44 ERA (48.2 IP, 24 ER), nine walks, 54 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .258 opponent batting average...the San Diego, CA native was selected by the Twins in the 18th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of San Diego State University...he has spent parts of six seasons in the Twins minor league system, going 30-10, 3.09 ERA (372.1 IP, 128 ER), 12 saves, 87 walks, 334 strikeouts, a 1.10 WHIP and a .232 opponent batting average in 136 games (32 starts).
 ☞ Adams, who was optioned from Minnesota to St. Paul after Thursday afternoon's game in Chicago, has appeared in seven games over two stints with the Twins this season, allowing eight runs in 10.0 innings pitched, with five walks, 12 strikeouts and a .244 opponent batting average.

PIRATE WARNING: The Twins and Pirates are playing each other for the 49th, 50th and 51st times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 28-22 all-time against the Bucs, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium (1998-2000), 8-4 at the Metrodome (1997-2009), 9-8 at PNC Park (2006-26) and 9-6 at Target Field (2015-25).
 ☞ Nine wins at PNC Park for the Twins are tied for their second-most in any NL ballpark with Wrigley Field...they have won the most at American Family Field in Milwaukee (32 wins).
 ☞ 50 games against the Pirates are Minnesota's most against any non-Milwaukee NL opponent.
 ☞ In 17 career games vs. the Pirates, Byron Buxton is hitting .317 (20-for-63) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBI and an .851 OPS.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone just 5-12 against National League opponents this season, going 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23), 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7), 2-1 vs. Miami (May 12-14), 1-2 vs. Milwaukee (May 15-17) and 0-2 vs. Pittsburgh...their next NL opponent will be the Cardinals at Target Field, from June 12-14.

HE'S E-LUKE-TRIC: Luke Keaschall extended his hitting streak to six games yesterday...over that span, he is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with two doubles and an .858 OPS...six games ties his season-high, previously done from May 2-8...his career-high is 11, from April 18-August 10, 2025 (IL for 3+ months in the middle).

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the third time in 2026, the others being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati in three games at Target Field and April 24-26 in three games at Tampa Bay.
 ☞ Twins have been swept just once in the history of this match-up, coming in two games from July 28-29, 2015 at Target Field.
 ☞ Twins have entered a finale four times this season attempting to avoid the sweep and have gone 2-2 in such instances...their two times avoiding the sweep were April 2 at Kansas City and May 1 vs. Milwaukee.

ROAD TRIPPIN' WITH BUCK: Byron Buxton has homered seven times in his last 19 road games...prior to this weekend, he homered in five of his last six road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS & CWS; his one miss was the TB series).
 ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 24 road home runs, second-most in baseball, trailing only Christian Walker (25).
 ☞ Since April 21, Buck has not gone more than three game without hitting a home run (home or road)...his current drought going into today's game is three games, his last homer being a leadoff shot on Wednesday at Chicago-AL.
 ☞ Since April 13, he has hit 17 home runs, second-most in baseball, trailing Kyle Schwarber (18)...ahead of Munetaka Murakami (16) and Yordan Alvarez (14).

HE'S A BASEBALL PLAYER: Over his last 18 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .306 (22-for-72) with seven doubles, two triples, three home runs, nine RBI, a .333 on-base percentage, a .583 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS...over that 15-game span, he has started at five different positions defensively: first base 10 times, centerfield three times, rightfield three times, leftfield once and second base once.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Merphy Hernandez and right-handed pitcher Justin Mitrovich as minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Hernandez, 19, recorded five hits in seven at-bats in a doubleheader with Jupiter on Thursday, including four hits in Game 2...the Yamasa, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2024.
 ☞ Mitrovich, 22, made the start on Friday vs. Jupiter, allowing one run on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the Trenton, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2025 MLB Draft.

- Zebby Matthews is due to make his fourth start (second on the road) for the Twins this season, 29th start of his career and first career start against the Pittsburgh Pirates.
- In his last outing on May 25 at Chicago-AL, Zebby took the loss, going 6.0 quality innings and allowing three runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in a 3-1 Twins defeat.
- Zebby enters today's start with three consecutive quality starts to begin his MLB season, the longest span of quality starts in a single season of his career.

LAST TIME OUT: Zebby made his most recent start on May 25 at Rate Field against the Chicago White Sox opposite left-hander Anthony Kay...suffered his second consecutive loss after going 6.0 quality innings and allowing three runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts; the Twins ultimately lost by a final score of 3-1.

STACKING QUALITY STARTS: With another quality start, Zebby extended his career long quality start streak to four games dating back to September 23, 2025 at Texas...in those four starts, he is 2-2 with a 2.08 ERA (26.0 IP, 6 ER), two walks, 23 strikeouts, a .186 (18-for-97) BAA and a 0.77 WHIP...before this current streak, his previous long was a two-game streak (August 29, 2025 vs. San Diego and September 3, 2025 vs. Chicago-AL).

OFF TO AN EFFICIENT START: Through three starts this season, Zebby has pitched a combined 19.0 innings, the most in a three-start span in the same season of his MLB career...his previous high was 16.2 innings pitched from 8/29/25-9/9/25 (8/29 - 6.0 IP vs. San Diego, 9/3 - 6.0 IP vs. Chicago-AL and 9/9 - 4.2 IP at Los Angeles-AL).

TWO STARTS AGO: On May 19, Zebby took his first MiLB loss of the season, giving up two runs on five hits (1 HR), with zero walks and six strikeouts at Target Field against the Houston Astros; despite the 2-1 Twins loss, Matthews recorded his third consecutive quality start dating back to 9/23/25.

BACK TO BACK GEMS: Through two starts, Zebby has combined to throw 13.0 innings while allowing only two earned runs...the 13.0 innings in a two-start span in the same season is a career-high for Zebby, while the two earned runs allowed are tied for his least through a two-start span (same season) in his career (9/17/24 at Cleveland - 9/22/24 at Boston).

A FANTASTIC FIRST THREE: Zebby is off to the best start of his career through three MLB starts in 2026...here is a look at how his first three starts this season compare to his first three starts in 2024 and 2025:

INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS: Zebby is slated to make his eighth career Interleague start this afternoon against the Pirates...is 3-3 with a 3.50 ERA (36.0 IP, 14 ER), seven walks, 34 strikeouts and a .245 (34-for-139) BAA in his first seven starts.

NL CENTRAL NUMBERS: Has made two career starts against the National League Central, going 0-1 with a 5.63 ERA (8.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks, 12 strikeouts and a .281 (9-for-32) BAA.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Matthews has gone 4-5 with a 5.98 ERA (64.2 IP, 43 ER), 15 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .302 (81-for-268) BAA in 14 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-7, 4.92 ERA (71.1 IP, 39 ER) with 22 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .270 (78-for-289) BAA in 14 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through three starts this season, lefties are slashing .162/.225/.324 (6-for-37) with zero doubles, two home runs, two walks and 15 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .242/.242/.394 (8-for-33) with two doubles, one home run, zero walks and two strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his three starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

BREAKING BALL USAGE: Zebby threw 43 breaking balls (28 sliders and 15 curveballs) in his last start to the tune of a .076 (1-for-13) BAA with five strikeouts...in his first two starts of the season, averaged 28 breaking balls per game and a .222 (4-for-18) BAA with six strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2026: 3-3, 2.94 ERA // CAREER: 49-39, 3.71 ERA)

Joe Ryan is slated to make his 13th start of the season tomorrow night against the White Sox in game one of a three-game series at Target Field...in his last outing on May 26 at Chicago-AL, he threw a season-high 7.2 innings, allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR), with zero walks, two hit batsman and nine strikeouts; did not factor into the decision as the Twins won 5-3 in 11 innings...the start marked the ninth time in his career that he has recorded nine-or-more strikeouts and zero walks, which is second in Twins history (1961-) behind Johan Santana (13)...Joe is 3-0 with a 3.21 ERA (42.0 IP, 15 ER), 10 walks, 47 strikeouts and a .204 (31-for-152) BAA in seven career starts against the Sox.
