THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4, going 1-2 vs. Seattle and 2-2 vs. Toronto...tonight, Minnesota will begin a six-game roadtrip with the first of three against the Nationals through Thursday...after this series, they will travel to Cleveland to play the Guardians for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 2-2 this season following an off-day...their two wins are March 28 at Baltimore and April 21 at New York-NL...their two losses are April 1 at Kansas City and April 17 vs. Cincinnati.

☞ Twins have gone 10-10 at home this season, compared to 5-10 on the road...they have scored 5.00 runs-per-game at home and 4.33 runs-per-game on the road.

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP IN FINALE: The Twins beat the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3...Joe Ryan was the starter but only faced two batters after experiencing right elbow soreness...Andrew Morris (1-1) earned his first major league win, pitching 3.2 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...Taylor Rogers added 2.1 innings in relief of Morris, tied for the second-longest outing of his career...the offense recorded nine hits, two apiece from Luke Keaschall and Matt Wallner...it marked Wallner's first multi-hit game since April 6...his fifth inning double was the 50th of his career and first since April 8.

HISTORY LESSONS: For 60 years, the Washington Senators played baseball in our nation's capital, winning one World Championship (1924) and three AL pennants (1925, '33)...in 1961, owner Calvin Griffith moved the Senators from Washington, D.C. to Bloomington, Minnesota...the Senators played from 1901-1960, compiling a record of 4223-4864...the Senators beat the New York Giants in the 1924 World Series in seven games, marking the only World Series victory for the franchise during its first 60-year tenure in Washington.

☞ The Twins enter tonight's game with an all-time club record (since 1961) of 5121-5203 and an all-time franchise record (Senators and Twins) of 9345-10066.

MINNESOTA MEETS THE MONUMENT: The Twins and Nationals are playing each other for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this series...the Twins are 13-14 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise...Twins are 3-6 at Target Field (2019 & '23), 3-6 at Nationals Park (2013, '16 & '24), 4-2 at the Metrodome (2007 & '08) and 3-0 in Montreal (2004).

☞ Twins hosted the Nats last season for three games from July 25-27 as they won game one and lost games two and three...Twins were outscored 16-6.

☞ Twins last trip to the Capital came May 20-22, 2024, winning games two and three of the three-game series.

☞ Twins and Nationals/Expos began playing each other in 2004...Minnesota went 8-2 in their first 10, but have gone 5-12 against the Montreal/Washington franchise since then.

☞ Derek Shelton has a managerial record of 18-13 all-time against the Nats, 5-7 in D.C.

THE CAPITOL BELL-DING: Josh Bell played parts of two seasons with the Nationals from 2021-August of 2022...he was traded with Juan Soto to San Diego at the 2022 trade deadline, in exchange for CJ Abrams, MacKenzie Gore, Robert Hassell, Luke Voit, James Wood and Jarlin Susana...returned to Nats on one-year contract last season...in 387 games for the Nats, he hit .264 (354-for-1341) with 64 doubles, 63 home runs and 208 RBI.

☞ In 2021, led Nationals hitters with 52 extra-base hits...ranked second on the club with 27 homers...hit his 100th career homer on July 20 vs. Miami (Okert).

☞ In 2022, set career highs in hits (147) and walks (81) on his way to winning his first career Silver Slugger Award (DH) between Washington and San Diego...finished sixth in the NL in walks and eighth in on-base percentage (.362).

☞ Two-time Nationals "Good Guy" Award winner in 2021 and '25.

☞ As an opponent vs. the Nationals, he is hitting just .217 (38-for-175) with nine home runs, 21 RBI and a .741 OPS in 48 games.

☞ Ranks on Nationals Park all-time list: 11th in walks (89), tied for 12th in home runs (31), 13th in extra-base hits (75) and 14th in RBI (104).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Twins are playing their third National League opponent of the season...they went 0-3 vs. Cincinnati from April 17-19 and 1-2 at New York from April 21-23...their next NL opponent after the Nats will be Miami at Target Field a week from today...last season, they went 20-28 vs. the NL, their last series win over an NL team was August 29-31, vs. San Diego (2 of 3).

A WEEK GONE BY-RON: Byron Buxton was named AL Player of the Week yesterday, his third career honor after previously winning on August 28, 2017 and June 13, 2022...first Twin with the award since Luke Keaschall on August 11, 2025...sixth player to win the award at least three times as a Twin, joining Kent Hrbek (4x), Joe Mauer (4x), Kirby Puckett (4x), Rod Carew (3x) and Johan Santana (3x).

☞ Hit .345 (10-for-29) with five homers, seven RBI, one double, three walks, nine runs scored, two stolen bases, an .897 slugging percentage and a .406 on-base percentage in seven games.

☞ Led baseball in home runs and total bases (26); tied for second in extra-base hits (6); ranked third in slugging; and eighth in OPS (1.303).

☞ Homered in five of his seven games, going deep in three consecutive games to open Minnesota's four-game set against Toronto...it marked the sixth time in Buxton's career that he homered in three consecutive games and the first time since last June.

☞ Hit a home run and stole a base on Tuesday vs. Seattle, marking his 18th career game with a home run and a stolen base...18 games are second-most in Twins history, trailing only Torii Hunter, who had 19 such games.

AUSTIN UNLOCKED: Austin Martin went 1-for-3 with a walk on Sunday vs. Toronto...he currently leads the club with 20 walks...he has posted a .484 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 90 plate appearances...Martin has reached base safely in 24 of 27 games with a plate appearance.

☞ Among all MLB players with a minimum of 90 plate appearances, Martin's .333 batting average is tied for fifth.

☞ In 13 road games this season, Martin is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with 11 walks a .564 on-base percentage and a 1.009 OPS...he leads baseball in road OBP (min. 30 PA).

JEFF YEA: Over his last 18 games, Ryan Jeffers has hit .322 (19-for-59) with four home runs, 19 RBI, 12 runs scored, 11 walks, a .431 on-base percentage, a .559 slugging percentage and a .990 OPS...he has hit safely in seven of his last eight games.

☞ He has reached base safely in all 11 of his road games this season, posting a .442 on-base percentage in those 11.

CINCO DE MAUER: On this day in 2017, Joe Mauer hit his first and only career walk-off home run, a solo shot off Red Sox reliever Matt Barnes, guiding the Twins to a 4-3 victory over the Red Sox...the Sox tied the game with two runs in the top of the ninth inning, then Mauer came up with two outs in the bottom half, hitting a 404-foot shot into the bullpen.

- Taj Bradley will make his eighth start of the season tonight and fifth start on the road against the Nationals tonight.
- Tonight will mark Bradley's first time pitching in the nation's capital; has made one career start against the Nationals, a home start in 2024 while he was a member of the Tampa Bay Rays.
- Bradley comes into tonight leading Twins starters in numerous categories, such as IP (41.0), strikeouts (44), ERA (2.85), batters faced (174), and pitches per game (101.1).
- In his last start on April 29 at home vs. Seattle, Taj tied his career high by pitching 7.0 innings; also matched Joe Ryan and Mick Abel for the longest start by a Twins starting pitcher this season.

LAST TIME OUT: On April 29 vs. Seattle, Taj threw a career-high 114 pitches, while working a career-high tying 7.0 innings of two run ball with four hits (1 HR) allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts... Bradley did not factor into the decision, after leaving the game with the score tied at 2-2; the Twins went on to lose 5-3.

- Bradley's 114 pitches thrown were the most by a Twins starting pitcher since Kenta Maeda threw 115 pitches on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee.
- Notched another quality start, his fourth in seven starts this season, which leads the Twins staff; has also allowed two-or-fewer-runs in six of his first seven starts this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: On April 24 at Tampa Bay, Bradley took the loss after going 6.1 innings and giving up six runs on seven hits (4 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts.

- The loss was Bradley's first of the 2026 season and first in seven starts dating back to last season...the last game he lost was on September 17, 2025 vs. New York-AL.

EVERY STAFF NEEDS A BULLDOG: Through his first seven starts of the season, Bradley has thrown 708 total pitches, the most in a seven start span to begin a season for the Twins since José Berríos threw 717 to begin the 2017 season...Taj currently ranks tied for first in the league in pitches per game (P/G), here are how some of his numbers compare to other qualified pitchers around MLB who are at the top of P/G.

NUMBERS WITH RUNNERS ON/RISP: Taj continues to be at his best with runners on base and with RISP; this season is holding opposing hitters to a .164 (10-for-61) BAA with two doubles, one homer, eight RBI, nine walks and 19 strikeouts with runners on; the .164 BAA ranks sixth in the AL...with RISP has a .200 (6-for-30) BAA with one double, zero home runs, six RBI, two walks and 10 strikeouts; the .200 BAA ranks ninth in the AL...in comparison, his career numbers with runners on base is a .259 (164-for-633) BAA and a .265 (91-for-344) BAA with RISP.

LEADING THE ROTATION: Bradley has been one of the bright spots for a Twins starting rotation that has gotten off to a strong start in 2026, here are how his numbers compare to his fellow starting pitchers who have at least seven starts on the season.

CAREER AGAINST THE NATIONALS: Bradley has made one career start against the Nationals, on June 30, 2024 at Tropicana Field while he was on the Rays...in that start, earned the win after throwing 5.2 scoreless innings while allowing three hits, with two walks and 11 strikeouts.

- MORE ON THOSE 11 K'S:** The 11 strikeouts tied a career-high for Bradley and he has not matched that number since...he has struck out 11 hitters two other times, on June 15, 2023 at Oakland (the Athletics) and June 13, 2024 vs. Chicago-NL.

INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS ON THE ROAD: Taj will be making his 11th career start against a National League opponent on the road tonight...through his first 10 starts he holds a 1-4 record with a 5.33 ERA (50.2 IP, 33 ER), 19 walks, 51 strikeouts, a 1.46 WHIP and a .271 (55-for-203) BAA.

- NUMBERS AGAINST THE NL EAST:** In his career, Taj has started more games against the National League East than any other National League division; he is 2-3 all-time against the Interleague foes out east with a 5.24 ERA (44.2 IP, 26 ER), 20 walks, 51 strikeouts and a .743 OPS against.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-15 with a 4.85 ERA (213.1 IP, 115 ER), 68 walks, 240 strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in 40 career home starts compared to 10-13 with a 4.48 ERA (213.0 IP, 106 ER), 89 walks, 214 strikeouts and a 1.34 WHIP in 42 road appearances (40 starts).

- SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-0 record with a 2.33 ERA (19.1 IP, 5 ER), four walks and 22 strikeouts in three home starts compared to a 2-1 record with a 3.32 ERA (21.2 IP, 8 ER), 11 walks and 22 strikeouts in four road starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .210/.281/.395 (17-for-81) with six doubles, three home runs, six RBI, eight walks and 27 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .243/.321/.365 (17-for-65) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks and 17 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

- THE CURVEBALL:** In his start against Seattle, Taj threw his curveball 13 times, generating a 60.0% whiff rate and four strikeouts; both the whiff rate and the four strikeouts were single game season-highs for Bradley's curveball...the only blemish for the pitch was a third inning homer by J.P. Crawford...so far this season, Bradley owns 13 strikeouts with the curveball, the most by any pitch in his arsenal.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - BAILEY OBER (2026: 3-1, 3.55 ERA // CAREER: 34-31, 4.05 ERA)

Bailey Ober will start tomorrow's middle game against the Nationals...the start will be Bailey's first against Washington on the road; he made one career start against the Nationals on April 23, 2023 at Target Field, where he earned the win after going 5.2 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with three walks and four strikeouts...Ober will look to stay hot this season, as he has gone four consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more innings dating back to April 13 vs. Boston...in his most recent start on April 30 vs. Toronto, he went 6.0 innings pitched and allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts; that earned the win as the Twins defeated the Blue Jays 7-1.

CAREER NOTES

- On April 29, 2026 vs. Seattle, Bradley threw a career-high, 114 pitches, in 7.0 innings against the Mariners; the 114 pitches were the most pitches by a Twin since Kenta Maeda threw 115 on August 18, 2020 vs. Milwaukee.
- Made six starts for Twins to end his season, from August 24-September 24, going 0-2, 6.61 ERA (31.1 IP, 23 ER) with 12 walks and 32 strikeouts.
- Acquired by the Minnesota Twins from Tampa Bay on July 31 in exchange for RHP Griffin Jax.
