**THE TWINS:** After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4 (1-2 vs. Seattle and 2-2 vs. Toronto), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a win over the Nationals in D.C. last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three against the Nationals...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, they will travel to Cleveland to play the Guardians for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins are seeking their third-straight win today, which would mark their longest winning streak since April 11-14, when they won four-straight — two over Toronto and two over Boston.  
☞ Twins are playing their third National League opponent of the season...they went 0-3 vs. Cincinnati from April 17-19 and 1-2 at New York from April 21-23...their last series win over an NL team was August 29-31, vs. San Diego (2-1).

**CAPITOL WON:** The Twins beat the Nationals last night in D.C. by a score of 11-3, their largest margin of victory this season...Taj Bradley was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits and walked six times...Luke Keaschall reached four times, going 1-for-2 with three walks, while Brooks Lee went 3-for-5 with three RBI...Byron Buxton hit his team-leading 11th home run, a three-run jimmy jack in the top of the eighth.

**MONUMENT MATCH-UPS:** The Twins and Nationals are playing each other for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this series...the Twins are 14-14 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise...Twins are 3-6 at Target Field, 4-6 at Nationals Park, 4-2 at the Metrodome and 3-0 in Montreal.

☞ Twins and Nationals/Expos began playing each other in 2004...Minnesota went 8-2 in their first 10, but have gone 6-12 against the Montreal/Washington franchise since then.  
☞ Derek Shelton has a managerial record of 19-13 all-time against the Nats, 6-7 in D.C.

**I'M JUST A BELL ON CAPITOL HILL:** Josh Bell played parts of three seasons with the Nationals from 2021-August of 2022 and 2025...in 387 games for the Nats, he hit .264 (354-for-1341) with 64 doubles, 63 home runs and 208 RBI.

☞ As an opponent vs. the Nationals, he is hitting just .217 (39-for-180) with nine home runs, 22 RBI and a .732 OPS in 49 games.  
☞ Ranks on Nationals Park all-time list: 11th in walks (89), tied for 12th in home runs (31), 13th in extra-base hits (75) and 14th in RBI (105).

**FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX:** After going homerless in his first 14 games (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered 11 times in his last 19 games (91 PA), since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...despite the early season homer drought, Buck still ranks tied for fifth in the AL in homers on the entire season (tied for 6th in MLB).  
☞ Along with Buck, here are Twins/Senators players with 11-plus homers in any 19-game span: Nelson Cruz (2019), Eddie Rosario (2019), Brian Dozier (2016), Trevor Plouffe (2012), Kent Hrbek (1988), Kirby Puckett (1986), Harmon Killebrew (1970, '64, '62 & '59).

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** After going 2-for-5 last night, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in 19-straight games with a plate appearance, extending his career-high...it is the fifth-longest active streak in baseball...it marks the longest for a Twin since Iy France reached in 24-straight from May 16-June 13, 2025...during this streak, Larnach has recorded 18 hits and 13 walks in 77 plate appearances for a .403 on-base percentage.

☞ Larnach is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with 16 walks, a .469 on-base percentage and a .931 OPS against right-handed pitching on the season...his average vs. lefties ranks fourth in the AL among players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances.

**SIMP-LEE FIRE:** After recording three more hits last night, Brooks Lee now has 31 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (35)...below are his numbers over his last 23 games (since April 9) and his last 11 games (since April 23):

**COOL HANDS LUKE:** Luke Keaschall is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with four doubles, five runs scored, three RBI, seven walks, just eight strikeouts, a .429 on-base percentage and an .853 OPS over his last 10 games.

**TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD):** Twins need a victory either tonight or tomorrow to earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...they have gone 3-7-1 in series play, 2-3-1 at home and 1-4-0 on the road...results to the lower right.  
☞ Twins last series win over the Nats came May 20-22, 2024 in Washington, taking two of three.

**PLATING FOR KEEPS:** The 11 runs scored last night marked Minnesota's most on the road this season...they scored 21 runs on their entire last roadtrip from April 21-26 at New York-NL and Tampa Bay...marked their most runs in a road game since scoring 12 on September 8, 2025 at Angel Stadium.  
☞ On the season, the Twins have scored 176 runs, third-most in the AL, trailing New York (199) and Houston (183).

**I BELIEVE IT'S JOGGING OR YOGGING, MIGHT BE A SOFT J:** After drawing six walks last night, the Twins have drawn 147 walks on the season, second-most in the AL, trailing only New York (165)...they rank fourth in baseball in walks, trailing Chicago-NL (168), the Yankees and Milwaukee (159).  
☞ Twins have a .328 on-base percentage on the season, ranking third-best in the AL, trailing Houston (.342) and New York (.338).

**HERE IS WHAT IS MOST IMPORTANT:** Did you know...? That Nationals manager Blake Butera (age 33) is the youngest manager in baseball since Minnesota's Billy Heywood in 1994...that season, the 12-year-old led a miraculous comeback as the Twins tied the Seattle Mariners, forcing a one-game playoff to decide the final Postseason berth in the American League, with the game to be played in the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome...Game No. 163 headed to extra innings, but the Mariners took the lead in the top of the 10th...with two outs in the bottom half, Lou Collins cracked a ball deep to centerfield, only to watch as Ken Griffey Jr. robbed the game-winning, potential walk-off home run, ending the Twins' season...Heywood would never manage again, as he decided to retire and return to junior high.

- ☞ Ober is making his eighth start of 2026 and 123rd of his career.
- ☞ Is making his second career start against Washington; 1-0, 1.59 ERA (5.2 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and four strikeouts.
- ☞ In his most recent start on April 30 vs. Toronto, Ober made a quality start and earned the win, allowing one run on four hits (1 HR) through 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bailey made his seventh start of his 2026 campaign on April 30 vs. Toronto opposite right-hander Kevin Gausman...made his third consecutive quality start and earned the win, allowing just one run on four hits (1 HR) through 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts.

- ☞ The outing marks the first time Ober has recorded a quality start in three consecutive outings since a stretch of five straight quality starts from April 10-May 3, 2025; he went 4-0 with a 1.97 ERA (32.0 IP, 7 ER) during that span.
- ☞ His only blemish was a Daulton Varsho solo home run in the fourth inning; he has now allowed a home run in back-to-back starts for the first time since surrendering a longball in four consecutive from August 14-September 1, 2025 (7 homers allowed in that stretch).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Bailey made his sixth start of his 2026 campaign on April 25 at Tampa Bay opposite left-hander Shane Bieber...took his first loss of the year despite making a quality start, allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) through 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts.

- ☞ Threw just 83 pitches, his fewest amount of pitches thrown in a quality start since a 78-pitch, quality start effort on September 25, 2025 at Texas.
- ☞ In 24 career road quality starts, Ober is 12-3 with a 1.72 ERA (157.0 IP, 30 ER), 21 walks, 154 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP and a .170 (93-for-546) BAA.

**NATIONAL GUARD:** Ober is making his second career start against Washington, and first since 2023; in his lone start against the Nationals on April 23, 2023, Ober earned the win, allowing one run through 5.2 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts as the Twins defeated the Nats 3-1 at Target Field.

- ☞ Current Nationals batters are hitting a combined .300 (3-for-10) against Ober with one double (Keibert Ruiz), two walks and two strikeouts.
- ☞ Bailey is searching for his first win against a National League opponent since April 15, 2025 vs. New York-NL...after starting his career 3-1 through his first seven career Interleague starts, Ober has gone just 2-6 through his last 16, owning a 5.72 ERA (85.0 IP, 54 ER) in those contests.

**NO APRIL SHOWERS HERE:** In his career, Bailey has experienced success in the month of April...after posting a 3-1 record with a 3.18 ERA (34.0 IP, 12 ER) this April, he now owns a career record of 10-2 in the month of showers, posting a 2.34 ERA (119.1 IP, 31 ER) with 32 walks and 100 strikeouts.

- ☞ His career 2.34 ERA is the fifth best in the month of April in Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-), min. 100.0 innings pitched...also the lowest since Walter Johnson, the winningest pitcher in Twins/Senators history in the month of April (36), posted a career 1.73 ERA in April from 1909-1926.
- ☞ Under the same parameters, Ober's .210 (92-for-438) BAA is second, behind only Joe Ryan (.208).

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In six MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 19-15 with a 4.11 ERA (342.0 IP, 156 ER), 85 walks, 335 strikeouts, a .237 (307-for-1298) BAA and a .721 OPS against in 64 starts at home compared to 15-16 with a 3.99 ERA (313.2 IP, 139 ER), 61 walks, 298 strikeouts, a .239 (283-for-1184) BAA and a .699 OPS against in 58 road starts.

- ☞ In two road starts this season, Ober is 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks, four strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .200 (7-for-35) BAA.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .175/.257/.381 (11-for-63) with four doubles, three home runs, six walks and 10 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .241/.310/.329 (19-for-79) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks and 19 strikeouts.

- ☞ His .226 opponent batting average on balls in play ranks fifth among all right-handed starters in Major League Baseball (min. 70 at bats).

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Bailey has thrown 211 changeups this season, the most by an American League pitcher and second most in MLB, trailing only Philadelphia's Christopher Sánchez (229).
- ☞ He is third among MLB pitchers with a .173 (9-for-52) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 50 plate appearances).
- ☞ Ober has a breaking run value of five, which ranks in the league's 97th percentile.
- ☞ His 7.1 foot extension ranks in the league's 95th percentile, which is the fourth highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

**CHANGING IT UP:** Since his debut in 2021, Bailey has relied heavily on his four-seamer, with it being his predominant pitch in each of his first five big league seasons...through seven starts this season, Ober has slowed opposing hitters down with his changeup, making it the primary pitch in his six-pitch arsenal, throwing it at a 34.9% clip...here are how his changeup numbers in 2026 compare to prior seasons:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2026: 0-5, 6.49 ERA // CAREER: 12-15, 4.48 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is set to make his eighth start of the season tomorrow in the series finale against the Washington Nationals, concluding the first half of a six-game road trip spanning stops in Washington, D.C. and Cleveland...in his most recent outing on May 1 vs. Toronto, Sim took the loss, allowing six runs (four earned) on nine hits (2 HR) in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Blue Jays 7-3 at Target Field...this will be Woods Richardson's third career start against the Nationals; is 0-0, 4.82 ERA (9.1 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and six strikeouts against Washington; Twins are 1-1 in his two prior starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Finished 2025 second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1) and strikeouts (120).
- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 second innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
