DID BUCK HOMER LAST NIGHT?

—YES— *NO, MAYBE TODAY?*

THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4 (1-2 vs. Seattle and 2-2 vs. Toronto), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in D.C. this week...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the three-game series finale against the Nationals...following today's game, they will travel to Cleveland to play the Guardians for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins have gone 1-4 in rubber games this season...their one win was April 12 at Toronto...their four losses were March 29 at Baltimore, April 5 vs. Tampa Bay, April 23 at New York-NL and April 29 vs. Seattle.

☞ Twins are playing their third National League opponent of the season...they went 0-3 vs. Cincinnati from April 17-19 and 1-2 at New York from April 21-23...their last series win over an NL team was August 29-31, 2025 vs. San Diego (2-1).

DOWN BAD IN THE DISTRICT: The Twins lost to the Nationals last night at Nationals Park by a score of 15-2, their largest margin of defeat this season and most runs allowed in 2026...the Twins were leading 2-1 after the top of the fifth, but the Nats scored 14 unanswered runs the rest of the way...Bailey Ober (3-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow 10 runs on eight hits...the offense recorded just three hits...Luke Keaschall had a double, while Matt Wallner singled and homered, his fourth home run of the season.

T.C. TO D.C.: The Twins and Nationals are playing each other for the 28th, 29th and 30th times in their history this series...the Twins are 14-15 all-time against the Montreal/Washington franchise...Twins are 3-6 at Target Field, 4-7 at Nationals Park, 4-2 at the Metrodome and 3-0 in Montreal.

☞ Derek Shelton has a managerial record of 19-14 all-time against the Nats, 6-7 in D.C.

11-POINT BUCK: After going homerless in his first 14 games (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered 11 times in his last 20 games (94 PA), since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Aaron Judge for the most home runs in MLB...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 11 home runs still ranked tied for fifth in the AL on the entire season (tied for 6th in MLB).
☞ Over his last full calendar year - since May 7, 2025 - Buck has hit 38 home runs in 127 games...over his last 162 games (since September 26, 2024), he has hit 46 home runs.

LARN TO FLY: After going 0-for-4 last night, Trevor Larnach snapped his on-base streak at 19...it was his first time not reaching base since going 0-for-1 in a pinch hitting role on April 8 vs. Detroit...in a starting role, Larnach has reached base safely in 23 of 24 games with last night being his first time not reaching in a non-bench role.

☞ Despite the 0-fer last night, Larnach has posted a .383 on-base percentage with 18 hits and 13 walks in 81 plate appearances in his last 20 games.

☞ Larnach is hitting .324 (22-for-68) with 16 walks, a .452 on-base percentage and an .894 OPS against right-handed pitching on the season...his average vs. righties ranks sixth in the AL among players with a minimum of 75 plate appearances.

AESTHETIC-LEE PLEASEING: Brooks Lee has 31 hits on the season, tied with Luke Keaschall for second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (35)...below are his numbers over his last 24 games (since April 9) and his last 12 games (since April 23):

TURN KEA: Luke Keaschall is hitting .306 (11-for-36) with five doubles, six runs scored, three RBI, seven walks, just eight strikeouts, a .422 on-base percentage and an .867 OPS over his last 11 games.

KEEP AUSTIN WEIRD: Austin Martin currently leads the club with 20 walks...he has posted a .470 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 100 plate appearances...Martin has reached base safely in 25 of 28 games with a plate appearance.

☞ Among players with a minimum of 100 plate appearances, Martin's .333 batting average is fourth in the AL and ninth highest in baseball.

☞ In 14 road games this season, Martin is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with 11 walks, a .523 on-base percentage and a .929 OPS...he leads baseball in road OBP (min. 40 PA).

MOM! THE MEATLOAF!: Twins need a victory today to earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...they have gone 3-7-1 in series play, 2-3-1 at home and 1-4-0 on the road...results to the right. >>>

☞ Twins last series win over the Nats came May 20-22, 2024 in Washington, taking two of three.

☞ Their last series win over an NL team was August 29-31, 2025 vs. San Diego (2-1).

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Over his last 21 games, Ryan Jeffers has hit .309 (21-for-68) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 21 RBI, 14 runs scored, 12 walks, a .415 on-base percentage and a .959 OPS...over those 21 games, he has reached base safely in 18 of those.

☞ Entering his pinch-hitting appearance last night (0-for-1), he had reached base safely in all 12 road games he had played in this season.

GET THE MOOSE LOOSE: After going 0-for-17 in a five-game span from April 25-May 2, Matt Wallner has recorded four hits in seven at-bats with three RBI over his last two games...lifetime against Jake Irvin, Wallner is 1-for-3 with a solo home run.
☞ Wallner ranks in MLB's 89th percentile in bat speed (75.4).

IYCFMI: The Twins announced yesterday that they acquired right-handed pitcher Yoendrys Gómez from the Tampa Bay Rays, in exchange for cash considerations...Gómez, 26, appeared in nine games for the Rays this season, striking out 13 batters in 17.1 innings pitched, while holding right-handed hitters to a .161 (5-for-31) batting average with a .411 OPS...the Nírgua, Venezuela native has pitched in parts of four major league seasons for the Yankees (2023-25), Dodgers (2025), White Sox (2025) and Rays (2026), going 3-3, 5.11 ERA (93.1 IP, 53 ER), two saves, 44 walks, 85 strikeouts and a .251 opponent batting average in 36 games (9 starts).

☞ To make room for Gómez on the 40-man roster, the Twins designated right-handed pitcher Christian Roa for release or assignment...Roa was acquired off waivers from Houston on April 23 and appeared in three games for Triple-A St. Paul...Gómez will be activated at a later date.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2008, in a 13-1 win by the Twins, Carlos Gómez hit for the cycle, the first Twins player to do so since Kirby Puckett in 1986...Gomez homered off Mark Buehrle in the first, tripled in the fifth, doubled in the sixth and singled in the ninth, driving in runs on each of the first three hits...in 2010, the Twins suffered their first rainout at home since 1980, being forced by weather to re-schedule that game against the Orioles as part of a day-night doubleheader on May 8.

LAST TIME OUT: Sim made his seventh start of the season on May 1 vs. Toronto opposite left-hander Patrick Corbin...took the loss, allowing six runs (four earned) on nine hits - including a season-high two home runs, both by Kazuma Okamoto - through 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Jays by a score of 7-3.

- ⌘ Sim has allowed a home run in all seven starts this season, becoming the first Twins starter to allow a homer in seven consecutive starts to begin a season since Liam Hendriks did so to begin his 2012 campaign.
- ⌘ Entering today's start, Sim is tied with Cleveland's Tanner Bibee and Miami's Chris Paddack (DFA'd on May 5) for the most losses in Major League Baseball, and the only one to record five losses within the first seven starts of the season.
- ⌘ His five game losing streak to begin the season is the longest of his career and is the longest losing streak by a Twins starter since Bailey Ober's five games from June 6-28, 2025.

TWO STARTS AGO: Sim made his sixth start of the season on April 26 at Tampa Bay opposite right-hander and former Twins reliever Griffin Jax, who started as the opener for the Rays that day...took the loss, allowing four runs on eight hits - including a home run from Yandy Diaz - through 4.1 innings pitched with three walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell in the series finale by a score of 4-2.

- ⌘ Surrendered three walks in three straight starts dating back to April 15 vs. Boston, becoming the first Twins starter to do so since Lance Lynn walked three-or-more batters in five straight from April 2-30, 2018.
- ⌘ Joined Cleveland's Slade Cecconi and Boston's Brayan Bello as the only starters in MLB to have four losses and an ERA of 6.00-or-higher through their first six starts of 2026.

DUELING IN THE DISTRICT: This will be Simeon's second career start against Washington and third career game; 0-0, 4.82 ERA (9.1 IP, 5 ER) with four walks, six strikeouts, a 1.50 WHIP and a .286 (10-for-35) BAA.

- ⌘ Made his first career appearance against the Nats out of the bullpen on April 22, 2023, allowing five runs on seven hits - one being a CJ Abrams three-run home run - in 4.2 relief innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts in a 10-4 Twins loss at Target Field.
- ⌘ In his lone start against Washington on May 22, 2024, Simeon did not factor into the decision, firing 4.2 scoreless innings pitched on three hits, with one walk and one strikeout in a 3-2 Twins victory at Nationals Park.
- ⌘ He has faced four active Nationals hitters who have combined for a .083 (1-for-12) BAA, with one home run (CJ Abrams), no walks and three strikeouts.

WICKED PITCH(ER) OF THE EAST: Today's game will mark Simeon's seventh consecutive opponent hailing from either the American or National League East...in those starts, Simeon is 0-4 with a 6.98 ERA (29.2 IP, 23 ER), seven home runs allowed, 13 walks, 15 strikeouts, a 1.85 WHIP and a .333 (42-for-126) BAA.

- ⌘ In his career, he owns a combined 5.99 ERA (106.2 IP, 71 ER) against AL and NL East opponents, compared to a 3.59 ERA (183.0 IP, 73 ER) between opponents from the four remaining divisions.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his career, Sim has gone 6-6 with a 4.15 ERA (145.1 IP, 67 ER), 56 walks, 135 strikeouts and a 1.31 WHIP in 29 games (28 starts) at home compared to 6-9 with a 4.81 ERA (144.0 IP, 77 ER), 57 walks, 114 strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP in 31 road games (30 starts).

- ⌘ Is 0-3, 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks, eight strikeouts, a 1.69 WHIP and a .307 (23-for-75) BAA in four starts away from Target Field this season.
- ⌘ Has earned just six wins through his first 30 career starts on the road, tying LaTroy Hawkins, Nick Blackburn and Bailey Ober for the fewest wins in Twins club history (1961-) through their first 30 career road starts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: So far in 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .306/.375/.486 (22-for-72) with four doubles, three home runs, seven walks and 12 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .342/.400/.616 (25-for-73) with five doubles, five home runs, seven walks and five strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .250/.324/.387 (127-for-509) with 54 walks and 114 strikeouts (2.11 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .251/.318/.436 (151-for-601) with 59 walks and 135 strikeouts (2.29 K/BB).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson relies on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⌘ He and Taj Bradley are the only Twins pitchers to throw at least 150 pitches with three different pitch types within their arsenals this season (4-seam fastball, split finger, slider).
- ⌘ Sim's -10 run value with his split finger ranks as the worst among all pitchers in Major League Baseball; it also is tied for the worst run value of any pitch by any pitcher in the league this season (Ryan Weiss' 4-seam fastball, -10 run value).
- ⌘ This season, Sim has an overall strikeout percentage of just 10.6%, over nine percent below his career average of 20.0; it falls within the bottom two percent among all pitchers this season.

WHERE'S THE SUPPORT?: In seven starts this season, Simeon has received just 11 runs of support from the Twins offense, which is tied for the fourth fewest runs of support provided to a starter through his first seven starts of 2026...it is by far the least amount of run support a Twins starter has received through seven starts this season, with the next fewest being Joe Ryan (18).

- ⌘ Since the start of the 2024 season, Simeon has received 132 total runs of support, which ranks as the fourth fewest among starting pitchers in Major League Baseball during that span (min. 50 starts).
- ⌘ His RSA of 2.86 is the sixth lowest in the American League this season (min. 30.0 IP).

CAREER NOTES

- Recorded a career-high 7 wins in 2025, the second most on the team... finished the year third on the team in strikeouts (107), starts (22) and innings pitched (111.1).
- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
