THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4 (1-2 vs. Seattle and 2-2 vs. Toronto), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series loss in D.C. this week against the Nationals...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of three in Cleveland against the Guardians over the weekend.

☞ Last time the Twins played on Apple TV was on May 9, 2025 vs. San Francisco, winning by a score of 3-1 at Target Field...that was the sixth win in a 13-game winning streak.

CAPITOL LOSSES: The Twins lost the rubber game to the Nationals yesterday afternoon in D.C. by a score of 7-5...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched...the defense turned three double plays on the ground...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Ryan Jeffers, who doubled twice and homered (5)...Brooks Lee recorded two hits and drove in two of the club's five runs.

GUARD PLAY: The Twins went 4-9 against the Guardians last season, going 2-4 at Target Field and 2-5 at Progressive Field...the last time these two teams met was at Target Field for three games from September 19-21 as the Guardians won the series 3-1...Minnesota's last trip to Cleveland was August 1-3, as the Guardians won the series 2-1.

☞ Six of the 13 games last season between these two teams were decided by one run...the Twins went 2-4 in those games.

☞ Since the start of 2024, 16 of the 26 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-13 in those)...and 11 have been decided by one run (Twins 2-9).

☞ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 74 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (95)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 59).

☞ Austin Martin is hitting .333 (10-for-30) in 11 career games against the Guardians.

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with one home run, four walks, eight RBI, a .410 on-base percentage and an .896 OPS in 10 career games at Progressive Field.

☞ Matt Wallner is hitting .299 (20-for-67) with five home runs, 14 RBI and a .994 OPS in 22 career games vs. the Guards...in 14 career games at Progressive, he is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.034 OPS...his first major league home run was in this ballpark on September 17, 2022, off Shane Bieber.

☞ Lifetime as an opponent at Progressive, Josh Bell is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with three home runs and a .997 OPS...he played 97 games for the Guards in 2023, before being traded to the Marlins at the deadline for Kahlil Watson and Jean Segura.

ONCE UPON A TIME IN THE 'LAND: The last series the Twins played in Cleveland was the first out of the 2025 trade deadline...on the off-day during the deadline (July 31), the Twins traded eight players away (excluding the other 3 players dealt in the days leading up to that day)...Twins lost that first game 3-2, getting walked-off in 10 innings.

NOTICEAB-LEE DIFFERENT: Brooks Lee has 33 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (36)...Lee hit .167 over his first 10 games...he hit a game-winning/go-ahead two-RBI single on April 9 vs. Detroit and has hit .304 since...below are his first 10 games (March 26-April 8) compared to his numbers over his last 25 games (since April 9):

11-POINT BUCK: After going homerless in his first 14 games (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered 11 times in his last 21 games (99 PA), since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Aaron Judge for the most home runs in MLB...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 11 home runs still rank tied for fifth in the AL on the entire season (tied for 7th in MLB).

☞ Over his last full calendar year - since May 7, 2025 - Buck has hit 37 home runs in 127 games...over his last 162 games (since September 27, 2024), he has hit 46 home runs.

☞ Buck is on pace to finish the season with 46 homers...single-season career-high is 35 (2025).

MAKING LEFTIES POPULAR AGAIN: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 16th time in 39 games...they have gone 5-10 against left-handed starters this season...their five wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framber Valdez (8-6), April 11 at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4) and April 13 vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6).

☞ Twins have dropped their last five when a lefty starts: April 15 against Boston vs. Connelly Early, April 17 against Cincinnati vs. Brandon Williamson, April 18 against Cincinnati vs. Andrew Abbott, April 25 at Tampa Bay vs. Shane Bieber and May 1 against Toronto vs. Patrick Corbin.

☞ The 15 lefty starters are the most any MLB team has faced this season.

☞ Since July 5, 2025, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .366 (34-for-93) with a .464 on-base percentage and a .970 OPS vs. left-handed pitching...since that date, his .464 on-base percentage leads baseball (min. 100 PA) and his batting average ranks second, trailing only Nico Hoerner (.374)...his OPS ranks 10th.

☞ Austin Martin is hitting .317 (13-for-41) with 14 walks, a .491 on-base percentage and a .930 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season...dating back to July 5 of last season, Martin ranks third in baseball in on-base percentage (.447) and seventh in average (.333).

DIRTY MARTINI: Austin Martin has posted a .457 on-base percentage, which leads all of baseball among players with a minimum of 100 plate appearances...Martin has reached base safely in 26 of 29 games with a plate appearance.

☞ Among players with a minimum of 100 plate appearances, Martin's .317 batting average is seventh in the AL.

☞ He has posted a walk percentage of 19.0, ranking fifth-highest in baseball (min. 100 PA), trailing Nick Kurtz (21.6), Mike Trout (21.2), Taylor Ward (20.6) and Bryce Turang (19.5).

☞ In 15 road games this season, Martin is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with 11 walks, a .490 on-base percentage and an .868 OPS...he leads baseball in road OBP (min. 40 PA).

JEFF YEAH: Over his last 20 games, since April 10, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with three doubles, one triple, five home runs, 19 RBI, 16 runs scored, 11 walks, a .436 on-base percentage, a .646 slugging percentage and a 1.082 OPS...since that date, his slugging percentage ranks third in the AL (min. 75 PA) and his OPS ranks fourth.

☞ In 14 road games this season, he is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with a 1.082 OPS, while reaching base safely in 13 of 14 games.

DOUBLE TAKE FROM DOUBLE-A: Double-A Wichita set franchise records last night at Amarillo, hitting 10 home runs and scoring 19 runs in a 19-7 victory...the homers were hit by Garrett Spain (3), Billy Amick (2), Maddux Houghton, Kala'i Rosario, Ricardo Olivar, Jake Rucker and Kyle DeBarge.

- Connor Prielipp will make the fourth start of his career and second road start tonight at Progressive Field against the Cleveland Guardians.
- In his last start on May 2 vs. Toronto, Prielipp went 5.0 innings for his second consecutive start and threw a professional career high 91 pitches, 64.8% for strikes, the highest strike percentage of his MLB career to date.
- Prielipp is listed as the No. 5 prospect and top-ranked pitching prospect in the Twins' system, per MLB.com; he is ranked as the No. 68 prospect in all of baseball and No. 4 in the Twins' system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per *Baseball America*.

LAST TIME OUT: On May 2 vs. Toronto, Prielipp went 5.0 innings, giving up two runs on three hits (2 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts...left the game with the Twins leading 4-2, but did not factor into the final decision as the Twins lost 11-4 to the Jays.

- HITS DON'T COME EASY:** Prielipp has allowed eight hits so far this season, becoming the second starting pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to allow eight-or-fewer hits through their first three career starts; the only other Twin, Joe Ryan (17.0 IP, 7 H) in his debut campaign in 2021.
- HITS DON'T COME EASY - 111 YEARS:** In Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-), only one other starting pitcher other than Prielipp and Ryan began his career by allowing eight-or-fewer hits in his first three starts: George Dumont (23.0 IP, 7 H) in 1915.

TWO STARTS AGO: Prielipp made his Target Field debut on April 27 vs. Seattle, carrying a no-hitter into the fifth inning and securing his first big league win...ended the game with a final line of 5.0 innings pitched, while giving up two runs on one hit, with three walks and five strikeouts in an 11-4 Twins victory over the Mariners.

SEE YA: Became the first Twins starter to record 11-or-more strikeouts through his first two career starts since Josh Winder struck out 15 across his first two career starts in 2022.

ROOKIE RANKINGS: Prielipp has seamlessly slid into the Twins starting rotation and been effective through his first three big league starts...here is where he ranks in a few categories among MLB rookie starting pitchers (min. of 14.0 IP).

DIVISIONAL RIVALRY: Tonight will be Prielipp's first career start against an American League Central divisional opponent; here are how some current Twins starters fared in their first games at Progressive Field in Cleveland.

BUILDING UP THE ENDURANCE: Prielipp has been slowly built up this season in pitch count; after throwing 61 pitches in his first Triple-A start on March 27, he has steadily gone up, and on May 2 vs. Toronto threw 91 pitches...that is the most pitches he has thrown in a start as a professional and as a collegiate pitcher at Alabama (most - 78 pitches).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through three games, Prielipp has started two at home and one on the road...at Target Field this season Prielipp is 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER), five walks, nine strikeouts and a 0.90 WHIP, while on the road he is 0-0 with a 4.50 ERA (4.0 IP, 2 ER), zero walks, six strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP...tonight will be the second road start of MLB career.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, Prielipp went 2-2 with a 4.20 ERA (64.1 IP, 30 ER), 30 walks, 80 strikeouts and a 1.40 WHIP in 18 home appearances (17 starts), and 1-8 with a 3.35 ERA (78.0 IP, 29 ER), 25 walks, 103 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 24 road appearances (23 starts).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through his first three MLB starts, lefties are slashing .111/.182/.222 (1-for-9) with one double, one RBI, one walk and zero strikeouts, while righties are slashing .175/.267/.375 (7-for-40) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, four walks and 15 strikeouts against Prielipp.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In his two starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

SLIDER TALK: Prielipp's .174 (4-for-23) BAA his slider ranks sixth in the MLB among left-handed starting pitchers (min. 20 PA). Some notable pitchers that he trails are, Justin Wrobleksi (LAD) - .125, Chris Sale (ATL) - .161 and Cole Ragans (KC) - .167.

THE RISE OF THE HEATER: In his May 2 start vs. Toronto, Prielipp threw his fastball 39 times, accounting for 42.9% of his pitches; that marked the first time this season, in MLB, that he has thrown his fastball more than 31.0% of the time in a single start and the first time that the heater was his most used pitch (first two games - Slider)...Toronto hitters combined to go 1-for-8 when Prielipp threw his four-seamer, with one strikeout and one home run (Myles Straw - 2nd inning).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOE RYAN (2026: 2-3, 3.72 ERA // CAREER: 48-39, 3.79 ERA)

Joe Ryan will make his ninth start of the season tomorrow evening in game two of a three-game series against the Guardians...Ryan was removed from his most recent start on May 3 vs. Toronto with right elbow soreness after recording just one out...tomorrow night will be Joe's 12th career start against Cleveland; holds a 3-5 record with a 2.94 ERA (70.1 IP, 23 ER), 11 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .199 (51-for-256) BAA; his .199 BAA vs. Cleveland ranks first all-time in Twins club history (1961-) among pitchers with at least 70.0 innings pitched...despite the career success, is 0-5 with a 4.19 ERA (38.2 IP, 18 ER), seven walks and 31 strikeouts in his last seven starts against Cleveland, since May 7, 2023.
