DID BUCK HOMER LAST NIGHT?

—NO— *YES, OF COURSE*

THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, losing a series 1-2 in D.C. against the Nationals earlier this week, followed by a loss last night in Cleveland against the Guardians...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three in Cleveland...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Monday...starting on Tuesday, they will begin a nine-game homestand with three against Miami (Tuesday-Thursday), three against Milwaukee (next weekend), then three against Houston (May 18-20).

☞ After beginning the season 5-5 on the road, the Twins have gone 1-8 away from Minnesota since April 22.

FIRST IS THE WORST FOR TWINS: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night by a score of 6-4 at Progressive Field as the Twins fell behind 4-0 in the first inning...Connor Prielipp (1-1) was the starter and took the loss, allowing four runs (1 earned) on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded a season-high 13 hits, went 3-for-12 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base...the top two hitters in the Twins lineup (Buxton & Martin) combined to go 6-for-10 as Buxton doubled (6) and homered (12).

MANY HAPPY RETURNS: Tonight's starter, Joe Ryan, left his last start on May 3 vs. Toronto after 0.1 inning...he faced two batters and threw nine pitches, striking out Yohendrick Piñango and walking Kazuma Okamoto, then leaving with right elbow soreness...the bullpen combined for 8.2 innings pitched, the most relief innings by a Twins 'pen in a nine-inning game since July 24, 2024 vs. Philadelphia (also 8.2 IP).

☞ Ryan (while sporting long hair and uniform number 74) earned his first career win (2nd career start) in this ballpark on September 8, 2021, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...he carried a perfect game into the seventh inning until a Amed Rosario one-out single to leftfield...Twins won the game 3-0.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Taj Bradley on the 15-day Injured List with right pectoralis muscle inflammation...Bradley made eight starts for the Twins, going 4-1, 2.87 ERA (47.0 IP, 15 ER), 17 walks, 52 strikeouts, a 1.19 WHIP, a .219 opponent batting average and five quality starts...the 25-year-old leads the Twins in innings pitched, strikeouts and wins, while ranking ninth among American League qualifying pitchers in ERA.

☞ To replace Bradley on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Travis Adams from Triple-A St. Paul...Adams recently made two appearances for the Saints from May 3-6, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and two strikeouts...prior to that stretch, he made five appearances on rehab assignment for St. Paul and Low-A Fort Myers, while recovering from a right triceps strain, an injury he sustained during spring training...the 26-year-old appeared in 18 games (2 starts) for Minnesota during his rookie season in 2025, going 1-4, 7.49 ERA (33.2 IP, 28 ER), 17 walks and 31 strikeouts.

STANDING GUARD: The Twins and Guardians are playing the second of 13 meetings tonight...after this series, Minnesota will host Cleveland for a three-game series at Target Field from July 7-9.

☞ Since the start of 2024, 16 of the 27 games between these two have been decided by two runs-or-fewer (Twins 3-13 in those), and 11 have been decided by one run (Twins 2-9).

☞ Royce Lewis is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with two doubles, one home run, four walks, eight RBI, a .395 on-base percentage and an .857 OPS in 11 career games at Progressive Field...he has hit safely in six-straight games in this ballpark.

☞ Matt Wallner is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with three home runs, nine RBI and a .955 OPS in 15 career games at Progressive Field.

THE BOOK ON BROOKS: Brooks Lee has 35 hits on the season, second-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (39)...below are Lee's first 10 games (March 26-April 8) compared to his numbers over his last 26 games (since April 9):

BUCK SHOTS: After going homerless in his first 14 games (62 plate appearances), Byron Buxton has homered 12 times in his last 22 games (104 PA), since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...despite the early season homer drought, Buck's 12 home runs still rank tied for fourth in the AL on the entire season (tied for 6th in MLB).

☞ Over his last full calendar year - since May 9, 2025 - Buck has hit 38 home runs in 127 games...over his last 162 games (since September 27, 2024), he has hit 47 home runs.

☞ Since the start of last season, Buck has hit 47 home runs, fourth-most in the AL and tied for seventh-most in baseball in that span.

☞ Buck is on pace to finish the season with 49 homers...single-season career-high is 35 (2025).

SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES: Twins need victories tonight and tomorrow to earn their fourth series win of the season and first since April 13-15 vs. Boston...they have gone 3-8-1 in series play, 2-3-1 at home and 1-5-0 on the road...results to the right. >>>

☞ Twins last series win over Cleveland was September 4-6, 2023 at Progressive Field, going 0-6-2 in series play vs. the Guards since.

FEELS LIKE YOU'RE RUNNING AT AN INCREDIBLE RATE: With a stolen base from Austin Martin last night, the Twins have now stolen 13 bases in their last 13 games, since April 25...in that span, they are tied with San Diego and Seattle for fourth-most in baseball, trailing Boston (18), Cleveland (18) and Tampa Bay (14)...in those games, Minnesota is 13-for-14 in stolen bases.

LARN TO FLY: In a starting role, Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in 24 of 25 games...in those games, he has posted a .392 on-base percentage with 24 hits and 16 walks in 102 plate appearances.

☞ Larnach is hitting .315 (23-for-73) with 16 walks, a .438 on-base percentage and an .863 OPS against right-handed pitching on the season...his average vs. righties ranks ninth in the AL among players (min. 80 PA).

BEYOND OFFENSIVE: The Twins have scored 4.58 runs-per-game on the road, the fourth-highest among AL teams...they have posted a 1.26 home run-per-game ratio on the road, tied with New York for third-most in the AL, trailing Los Angeles (1.57) and Chicago (1.50).

☞ The Twins recorded a season-high 13 hits last night...in four of their last six losses they have recorded double-digit hit totals.

DON'T FORGET TO SEND A BIRTHDAY CARD, PERK: Former Twins left-handed reliever Buddy Boshers is celebrating his 38th birthday today and former outfielder Oswaldo Arcia is celebrating his 35th...Twins radio virtuoso Glen Perkins was teammates with both...he and Arcia were together from 2013-16, while Boshers and Perk shared a bullpen mound from 2016-17.

- ⚡ Is 3-5 with a 2.94 ERA (70.1 IP, 23 ER), 11 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .199 (51-for-256) BAA in 11 career starts (12 games) against Cleveland.
- ⚡ In his last start on May 3 vs. Toronto, Ryan pitched just 0.1 innings on nine pitches, fanning Yohendrick Piñango and walking Kazuma Okamoto before being removed from the game with right elbow soreness.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his eighth start of the season on May 3 vs. Toronto opposite right-hander Trey Yesavage...struck out Yohendrick Piñango to begin the game, then walked Kazuma Okamoto...was removed from the game after just nine pitches with right elbow soreness.

- ⚡ The outing marked the shortest of his career, with his previous low being 2.0 innings pitched on August 7, 2024 at Chicago-NL and on September 6, 2025 at Kansas City.
- ⚡ The last time the Twins had a starter go 0.1 innings was when Steven Okert served as an opener on July 24, 2024 vs. Philadelphia; last true starter to go 0.1 innings was Matt Shoemaker on June 24, 2021 at Kansas City.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his seventh start of the season on April 28 vs. Seattle opposite right-hander Logan Gilbert...took the loss despite making his third quality start of the season, allowing two runs on six hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...exited the game with no outs in the seventh inning in a 1-1 game, but was responsible for the runner on second base following a Randy Arozarena double to begin the frame; left-hander Kody Funderburk took over and recorded back-to-back outs before a Cole Young single broke the tie and ultimately handed Joe the loss.

- ⚡ Has been tagged with the loss in each of his last two quality starts (also on 4/17 vs. Cincinnati), marking the first time he has lost in consecutive quality starts in his career...the Twins are 38-18 lifetime when Joe has made a quality start.
- ⚡ The loss marked the first time he received three losses in his first seven starts of a season; also the first time in his career he has made seven starts before May.

JOE IN THE LAND: This will mark Ryan's 12th career start (13th game) vs. Cleveland, the most against an opponent in his career; he is 3-5 with a 2.94 ERA (70.1 IP, 23 ER), 11 walks, 57 strikeouts, nine home runs allowed, a 0.88 WHIP and a .199 (51-for-256) BAA...in his last bout with the Guardians on September 20, 2025, Ryan took the loss, allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits (4 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts, as the Twins fell by a score of 6-0 at Target Field.

- ⚡ He has yielded three-or-fewer earned runs in 11 of his 12 games against Cleveland dating back to September 8, 2021, with the lone exception being his most recent start against the Guardians on September 20, 2025.
- ⚡ In his last seven starts vs. Cleveland dating back to May 7, 2023, Joe is 0-5 with a 4.19 ERA (38.2 IP, 18 ER), seven walks and 31 strikeouts...his last win against the Guardians came on September 18, 2022 at Progressive Field.
- ⚡ Ryan has faced 12 hitters on the Guardians' active roster; those hitters have combined for a .210 (25-for-119) BAA with five doubles, six home runs, seven walks and 21 strikeouts.

FAMILIAR FOES: Ryan is set to make his 40th career start (41st game) against the AL Central...he is 19-9 with a 3.03 ERA (228.2 IP, 77 ER), 47 walks and 242 strikeouts against AL Central opponents...below are some more of his numbers against divisional foes, compared to other pitchers in Twins club history (1961-):

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 60 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.97 ERA (330.2 IP, 146 ER), 74 walks and 349 strikeouts, compared to 27-19 with a 3.61 ERA (349.1 IP, 140 ER), 84 walks and 410 strikeouts in 63 home appearances (62 starts).

- ⚡ Since the start of the 2025 season, Ryan is 7-6 with a 3.62 ERA (107.0 IP, 43 ER), 23 walks, 111 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and a .220 (87-for-396) BAA in 19 starts away from Target Field.
- ⚡ In his last 10 road starts dating back to July 20, 2025 at Colorado, he is 3-4 with a 4.58 ERA (53.0 IP, 27 ER), 14 walks and 60 strikeouts...the Twins are 3-7 in those outings and have lost six of their last seven since August 25, 2025 at Toronto.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .244/.280/.449 (19-for-78) with seven doubles, three home runs, two walks and 20 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .185/.257/.262 (12-for-65) with five doubles, eight walks and 20 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .218/.276/.390 (272-for-1,249) with 85 walks and 313 strikeouts (3.68 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.273/.414 (293-for-1,301) with 73 walks and 446 strikeouts (6.11 K/BB).

- ⚡ Ryan's 6.11 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ Ryan's curveball ranks fourth among major league pitchers with a .074 (2-for-28) BAA and is tied for seventh with a 50.0 strikeout percentage (minimum 25 plate appearances).

- ⚡ His .083 (1-for-12) opponent batting average against the split finger is the lowest in Major League Baseball (min. 10 plate appearances).

- In 2026, was invited to participate in the World Baseball Classic as a member of Team USA.
- In 2025, made first career MLB All-Star Game appearance, throwing a 10-pitch perfect fourth inning with two strikeouts (SD Manny Machado and CHC Kyle Tucker).
- 2025 marks his seventh professional season, including 2020, and his fourth consecutive year in the Twins' season-opening rotation.
- In 2024, set single-game career high in strikeouts (12) and recorded career strikeout no. 500.
- Made first career Postseason start in 2023 vs. Houston (ND, 2.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 0 BB, 1 K).
- In 2023, set career highs in starts (29), innings pitched (161.2) and strikeouts (197).
- In 2022, his first full major league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
