THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4 (2-1 vs. Chicago-AL and 1-3 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their three-game roadtrip with a loss last night in Detroit...tonight, the Twins play the second of three vs. the Tigers at Comerica Park...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to play a three-game series/homestand vs. the Cardinals over the weekend.

TWINS DROP THE HOME RUN DERBY IN DETROIT: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 10-4, snapping their five-game winning streak over the Tigers...Taj Bradley (5-3) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks, three strikeouts and three home runs...he threw 89 pitches, just 52 for strikes...the offense recorded 10 hits, four being solo home runs from Byron Buxton (19), Brooks Lee (10), Kody Clemens (9) and Josh Bell (7)...for Bell it was the 200th of his career, becoming the 40th active player to reach the 200-homer mark and 391st in baseball history.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the sixth of 13 games tonight.
 ♣ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 156, 38 ahead of Cleveland (118)...74 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 34 times in their last 21 games at Comerica and 25 times in their last 13 here.
 ♣ Over his last 22 games against the Tigers, Byron Buxton has posted a .964 OPS and a .614 slugging percentage, hitting eight doubles and seven home runs in 97 plate appearances.
 ♣ Royce Lewis has posted an .868 OPS in 25 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 25 career games vs. the Tigers (.412 OBP, 23 H, 17 BB).
 ♣ Luke Keaschall is hitting .359 (14-for-39) with two doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, six walks, a .457 on-base percentage and a 1.021 OPS...in three career games at Comerica, he is 6-for-11 with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.
 ♣ Notables this season vs. Detroit: Josh Bell is 9-for-19 (.474) with two home runs and two walks...Byron Buxton is 6-for-20 (.300) with two doubles, one home run and four walks...Royce Lewis is 6-for-16 (.375) with one double, three RBI and four walks.
 ♣ Twins faced Framber Valdez on April 8 at Target Field, scoring eight runs off him, which at the time, tied his single-game career-high...notable individuals in that game: Buxton 3-for-4 with one double...Bell 1-for-3 with one RBI...Keaschall 1-for-3 with one RBI...Lewis 2-for-3 with two RBI...Martin 1-for-3.

TRUCK HORNS: Byron Buxton has homered eight times in his last 20 road games...after last night, he has now homered in six of his last eight road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS, CWS & DET); his two misses were the TB and PIT series).
 ♣ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 25 road home runs, tied with Christian Walker for most in baseball since that date.

BUX MARKS THE SPOT: Last night, Byron Buxton hit his 19th home run of the season...he has hit all 19 home runs over his last 42 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for most homers in baseball...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

THE LEFTORIUM: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 23rd time...they have gone 9-13 against left-handed starters...their last game vs. a lefty starter was a 6-5 loss on Sunday vs. Noah Cameron and Kansas City...their last win vs. a lefty starter was a 4-2 win over Jovani Morán on May 23 at Boston.
 ♣ The 22 lefty starters faced are tied with Baltimore for third-most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (25) and Atlanta (29).
 ♣ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with an .844 OPS vs. lefties.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need a win tonight and tomorrow to earn their ninth series win of the season...they have gone 8-12-1 in series play, 5-4-1 at home and 3-8-0 on the road...their last road series win was a three-game sweep at Fenway Park, from May 22-24.
 ♣ Twins would be seeking their second-straight series win over the Tigers (4-game sweep from April 6-9)...last time they won consecutive series vs. Detroit was in July of 2024.
 ♣ Their last series win at Comerica Park came August 4-6, 2025, taking two of three.

ALL ROADS LEE'D HERE: In 31 road games, Brooks Lee is hitting .318 (35-for-110) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBI, a .375 on-base percentage, a .609 slugging percentage and a .984 OPS...comparatively, in 33 home games, he is hitting .172 (21-for-122) with one double, one triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, a .221 on-base percentage, a .246 slugging percentage and a .467 OPS.

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Over his last 26 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .301 (31-for-103) with nine doubles, two triples, six home runs, 12 RBI, 16 runs scored, a .327 on-base percentage, a .602 slugging percentage and a .929 OPS.

RING THE BELL FOR 200: Josh Bell hit his seventh home run of the season last night and 200th of his career...he became the 40th active player to reach the 200-home run mark...over his last 12 games, Bell is hitting .295 (13-for-44) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .326 on-base percentage, a .523 slugging percentage and an .849 OPS.

READY AND ABEL: Right-handed pitcher Mick Abel is making his first start on rehab assignment tonight for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo with first pitch at 7:05 pm (ET)...Abel has been on the 15-day IL with right elbow inflammation since April 20.
