THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game homestand with a record of 3-4 (2-1 vs. Chicago-AL and 1-3 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their three-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in Detroit this week...today, the Twins play the three-game series finale against the Tigers at Comerica Park...after today's game, Minnesota will travel home to play a three-game series/homestand vs. the Cardinals over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins have gone 4-5 in rubber games this season...their four wins were April 12 at Toronto, May 10 at Cleveland, May 14 vs. Miami and May 20 vs. Houston.
 ☞ Twins are playing their 33rd day game today...32 day games, entering today, are tied with Baltimore for second-most in baseball, trailing Washington (34)...Minnesota is 13-19 during the day.

TWINS TAKE TIGERS: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 6-4...Mike Paredes made his first major league start, allowing one run on one hit in 3.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with four walks and 10 strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, walked five times and struck out just three times...every player in the Twins lineup, including Kody Clemens off the bench, recorded at least once hit...Royce Lewis (4) and Byron Buxton (20) each homered for the Twins...for Buxton, he reached the 20-homer mark for the third time in his career (28 in 2022 and 35 in 2025).

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the seventh of 13 games today...these two will meet next for three games at Target Field, from August 31-September 2...the Twins will visit Comerica Park next for three games, September 7-9.

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 158, 40 ahead of Cleveland (118)...76 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 36 times in their last 22 games at Comerica and 27 times in their last 14 here.
 ☞ Over his last 23 games against the Tigers, Byron Buxton has posted a 1.004 OPS and a .641 slugging percentage, hitting eight doubles and eight home runs in 102 plate appearances.
 ☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .894 OPS in 26 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 26 career games vs. the Tigers (.412 OBP, 24 H, 18 BB).
 ☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with two doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, six walks, a .440 on-base percentage and a .975 OPS...in four career games at Comerica, he is 7-for-15 with two doubles, one home run and six RBI.
 ☞ Notables this season vs. Detroit: Josh Bell is 10-for-24 with two home runs and two walks...Byron Buxton is 8-for-24 with two doubles, two home runs and five walks...Royce Lewis is 7-for-20 with one double, one home run, four RBI and five walks.

MR. EVERYTHING: Last night, Byron Buxton hit his 20th home run of the season and stole his sixth base...it marked the 19th time in his career with a homer and a stolen base in the same game...below are the Twins all-time leaders in such instances (since 1961):

IT FEELS LIKE YOU'RE RUNNING AT AN INCREDIBLE RATE: Byron Buxton stole his sixth base of the season, making him six-for-six in stolen base opportunities...additionally, he is now 36-for-his-last-36, dating back to May of 2024...below are the Twins all-time stolen base leaders (since 1961):

37 CARAT GOLD: Victor Caratini has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, hitting .333 (10-for-30) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, three walks, a .400 on-base percentage, a .533 slugging percentage and a .933 OPS in that span.

THE MISSILE: Over his last 27 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .305 (32-for-105) with 10 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 12 RBI, 16 runs scored, a .330 on-base percentage, a .610 slugging percentage and a .940 OPS.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need a win today to earn their ninth series victory of the season...they have gone 8-12-1 in series play, 5-4-1 at home and 3-8-0 on the road...their last road series win was a three-game sweep at Fenway Park, from May 22-24.
 ☞ Twins are seeking their second-straight series win over the Tigers (4-game sweep from April 6-9)...last time they won consecutive series vs. Detroit was in July of 2024.
 ☞ Their last series win at Comerica Park came August 4-6, 2025, taking two of three.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: In 17 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul (since May 21), Royce Lewis has hit .324 (22-for-68) with five doubles, nine home runs, 20 RBI, a .403 on-base percentage, a .794 slugging percentage and a 1.197 OPS.
 ☞ In that span defensively, he has started nine games at third base, five at first base and two at second base.
 ☞ Royce's home run last night was estimated at 444 feet, the longest by a Twin this season and the second-longest home run of his career (451 ft. on 6/20/25 at COL, off Ryan Rolison).

E-LUKE-TRIC FEEL: Luke Keaschall has reached base five times in eight plate appearances this series...over his last 16 games, he is hitting .309 (17-for-55) with two doubles, four RBI, two hit-by-pitches, three walks and a .361 on-base percentage.

MICK GETTING IN THE MIX: Right-handed pitcher Mick Abel made his first start on rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo, opposite Justin Verlander...he pitched 3.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts, facing 11 batters and throwing 47 pitches...Abel has been on the 15-day IL with right elbow inflammation since April 20.

- Zebby Matthews is due to make his sixth start of the season and 31st of his career this afternoon in Detroit against the Tigers.
- It will be his third career start against Detroit and second at Comerica Park; is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER), five walks and 12 strikeouts in his first two career starts against Detroit.
- In his last start on June 5, Zebby made his fifth start of the season vs. Kansas City and earned his second win after allowing two runs on five hits, with four walks and two strikeouts in 7.0 innings pitched.

LAST TIME OUT: Matthews made his fifth MLB start of the season on June 5 vs. Kansas City opposite right-hander Michael Wacha...recorded his second win of the season and fourth quality start after giving up two runs on five hits, with a career-high tying four walks and two strikeouts in a 5-3 Minnesota win...gave up both of his runs in the first inning via a Bobby Witt Jr. walk and two doubles by Vinnie Pasquantino and Jac Caglianone...in his next 6.0 innings, from the second inning-seventh inning, allowed zero runs on three hits, with three walks and one strikeout.

- Zebby has now recorded four quality starts in his five MLB outings this season and five quality starts in his last six outings dating back to September 23, 2025 at Texas...his four quality starts since May 14 are tied for the most in the American League and the second most among MLB starters, trailing only Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (5).
- For the second time in his MLB career (30 starts), Matthews walked more hitters (four) than he struck out (two); the other game was August 19, 2024 at San Diego when he walked two and struck out one in 5.0 innings.
- The win broke a three-start losing streak dating back to May 19 vs. Houston...the losing streak was the second longest of his career, trailing his career long five-gamer from August 19, 2024 - May 18, 2025...during his most recent skid, gave up at least one home run in each start; Zebby has not allowed a home run in either of his wins...below is a comparison of his numbers in starts that he allows at least one home run and starts that he does not allow any this season:

TWO STARTS AGO: On May 31 at Pittsburgh, Zebby made his fourth start of the season opposite right-hander Braxton Ashcraft...suffered his third consecutive loss, giving up seven runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts in an MLB season-low 4.1 innings pitched...gave up two runs in the second inning on three hits (1 HR - Ryan O'Hearn solo), two runs in the fourth on one hit (1 HR - Nick Gonzales two-run) and three runs in the fifth on two hits.

FIRST FOUR AND LAST EIGHT: Following a tough beginning to his season with Triple-A St. Paul, Zebby continued his recent success with another quality start against the Royals on June 5...here are his numbers from his first four starts (all with Triple-A St. Paul), compared to his last six (three AAA and five MLB):

NUMBERS AGAINST THE TIGERS: Zebby is 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER), five walks and 12 strikeouts in two starts against Detroit...has one career start at Comerica Park (August 5, 2025), earning the win and allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts.

DETROIT HITTERS VS. MATTHEWS: Current Tigers hitters are batting .270 (10-for-37) against Matthews with four doubles and one home run (Kerry Carpenter)...Carpenter and Colt Keith have combined to hit .555 (5-for-9) off Zebby with three doubles, a home run, three walks, one strikeout and a 1.889 OPS.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (SEASON): Matthews has struggled on the road this season, going 0-2 with an 8.71 ERA (10.1 IP, 10 ER), three walks, 13 strikeouts and a .262 (11-for-42) BAA compared to a 2-1 record with a 1.80 ERA (20.0 IP, 4 ER), five walks, 13 strikeouts and a .200 (14-for-70) BAA in three starts at home.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Matthews has gone 5-5 with a 5.65 ERA (71.2 IP, 45 ER), 19 walks, 76 strikeouts and a .296 (86-for-291) BAA in 15 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-8, 5.47 ERA (75.2 IP, 46 ER) with 24 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .273 (84-for-308) BAA in 15 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through five starts this season, lefties are slashing .227/.311/.409 (15-for-66) with three doubles, three home runs, six walks and 20 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .217/.250/.391 (10-for-46) with two doubles, two home runs, two walks and six strikeouts.

In his most recent start on June 5, held Royals righties hitless (0-for-7) with two walks and a strikeout, marking only the second time in his career he has not allowed a hit to a right-handed hitter in a start (last: July 25, 2025 vs. Washington).

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his five starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

THE SLIDER IS BACK: On June 5, held Royals to a .100 (1-for-10) BAA with one double and two strikeouts off the slider...his .194 BAA the slider ranks second behind Connor Prielipp (.175) among Twins starters (min. 50 sliders thrown).

THE BIG HOOK: Is holding opposing hitters to a .077 (1-for-13) BAA his curveball, fifth lowest in MLB among starters (min. 10 PA and 400 total pitches).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2026: 4-3, 3.07 ERA // CAREER: 50-39, 3.71 ERA)

Joe Ryan is slated to make his 15th start of the season tomorrow night in the first game of a three-game home weekend series against the Cardinals...in his last outing on June 6 against Kansas City at Target Field, Joe did not factor into the decision after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing one run on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in a 3-2 Twins loss...the start marked Ryan's sixth straight game of throwing 6.0-or-more-innings and it was his fifth quality start over those last six...tomorrow will be Ryan's third career start against St. Louis and first at Target Field; he is 0-1 with an 8.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 8 ER), one walk, nine strikeouts and a .350 BAA (14-for-40) in his previous two starts (both at Busch Stadium).
