THE TWINS: Return home today from their three-game roadtrip, going 1-2 in Detroit, their one win of the series coming on Wednesday night...tonight, Minnesota will begin a three-game weekend series against the St. Louis Cardinals...after Sunday's series finale, the Twins will travel to Texas for a six-game, seven-day roadtrip and play three games against the Rangers and three games against Arizona.

DOWN BAD IN DETROIT: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 11-0, suffering their second shutout of the season...Zebby Matthews (2-4) was the starter and issued the loss, allowing seven runs on nine hits (3 home runs) in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Royce Lewis...all five of the Twins' hits were singles.

LAY DOWN YOUR CARDS: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the 43rd, 44th and 45th times in their history during the regular season today...Twins are 20-22 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997)...in the regular season, the Twins are 6-3 all-time against the Cardinals at Target Field (since 2010), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998-2000), 2-7 at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 8-10 at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23).
 ☞ Twins have lost each of their last four against the Cardinals since August of 2024...their last win over St. Louis was a 6-0 victory (Lopez over Gray) on August 24, 2024 at Target Field.
 ☞ These two played each other last season for three games to open the season at Busch Stadium as the Twins were swept in three games.
 ☞ The last time the Twins hosted the Cardinals was in three games from August 23-25, 2024 as the Twins won just the middle of the three games.
 ☞ Josh Bell has played 92 career games against the Cardinals, hitting 11 home runs with 52 RBI...over his last 13 games against the Cardinals, he is hitting .295 (13-for-44) with five doubles, one home run, seven RBI, six walks, a .373 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS.
 ☞ Byron Buxton, in his second career game, recorded his first major league hit against the Cardinals on June 15, 2015 at Busch Stadium, tripling off John Lackey.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone just 5-13 against National League opponents this season, going 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23), 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7), 2-1 vs. Miami (May 12-14), 1-2 vs. Milwaukee (May 15-17) and 0-3 vs. Pittsburgh.

RYAN KING: In 14 starts this season, Joe Ryan has gone 4-3, 3.07 ERA (76.1 IP, 26 ER) with 16 walks, 84 strikeouts and a .211 opponent batting average...below are his ranks in a few categories among AL pitchers since the start of last season (minimum 75.0 IP):

SLUG BUX: On Wednesday night, Byron Buxton hit his 20th home run of the season, his third over his last five games...he has hit all 20 home runs over his last 44 games, since April 13...since that date, he is tied with Kyle Schwarber for most homers in baseball...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

37 CARAT GOLD: Victor Caratini has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games, hitting .344 (11-for-32) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI, four walks, a .421 on-base percentage, a .531 slugging percentage and a .952 OPS in that span.
 ☞ In that span, he is hitting .500 (2-for-4) as a right-handed batter and .321 (9-for-28) as a left-handed batter.

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Over his last 28 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .294 (32-for-109) with 10 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 12 RBI, 16 runs scored, a .319 on-base percentage, a .587 slugging percentage and a .906 OPS.
 ☞ Clemens has reached base safely in 20 of his last 21 home games, posting a .372 on-base percentage in that span with a .942 OPS.
 ☞ In the Twins' last series at Target Field from June 4-7 vs. Kansas City, he went 7-for-16 (.438) with two doubles and two home runs.

PLAYING FAST AND LEWIS: Royce Lewis is 6-for-19 (.316) in five games since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, reaching base safely in all five...his current four-game hitting streak is a season-long and longest since August 20-23, 2025 (also 4)...his last streak longer was six games, from July 20-26, 2025.
 ☞ In 18 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul (since May 21), Lewis has hit .333 (24-for-72) with five doubles, nine home runs, 20 RBI, a .407 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.185 OPS...in that span defensively, he has started nine games at third base, five at first base and three at second base.

GIMME A BELL YEAH: Josh Bell has now hit safely in 12 of his last 14 games, since May 28...over his last 11 games, he is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, a .341 on-base percentage, a .513 slugging percentage and an .854 OPS.

E-LUKE-TRIC FEEL: Luke Keaschall finished the three-game series in Detroit having reached base safely five times in eight plate appearances...over his last 16 games, he is hitting .309 (17-for-55) with two doubles, four RBI, two hit-by-pitches, three walks and a .361 on-base percentage.

TOUCH OF GRAY: Over his last 13 games, since May 28, Tristan Gray is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with three doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, two stolen bases, a .500 slugging percentage and an .806 OPS...since May 28, his 12 RBI are tied for sixth-most in the AL.
 ☞ He has started at shortstop in 12 of the Twins' last 16 games.
 ☞ This season, he has already set major league single-season career-highs in games (42), runs (13), hits (29), home runs (4), RBI (26), walks (7) and stolen bases (2).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, the Twins selected Royce Lewis with the first overall pick in the MLB Draft out of JSerra Catholic High School...in the following days, in the 12th round, the Twins drafted Bailey Ober out of College of Charleston.

- ☞ Is scheduled to make his 15th start of 2026 and 129th start (130th game) of his career.
- ☞ In two career starts vs. St. Louis, he is 0-1 with an 8.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 8 ER), one walk and nine strikeouts...this will be his first start against the Cardinals at Target Field.
- ☞ In his last start on June 6 vs. Kansas City, Ryan made a quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on six hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his 14th start of the season on June 6 vs. Kansas City opposite right-hander Luinder Avila...made his team-leading eighth quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run – courtesy of a leadoff solo home run from Carter Jensen – with six hits allowed, two walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched, as the Twins suffered a 3-2 loss vs. the Royals at Target Field.

- ☞ His eight quality starts are tied for the third most in the American League this season, only behind Chicago-AL's Davis Martin and Kansas City's Michael Wacha (both with nine).
- ☞ Has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in six consecutive starts dating back to May 9 at Cleveland, the longest such streak by a Twins starter since Pablo López pitched at least 6.0 innings in seven consecutive starts from August 12-September 16, 2024...the six-game streak is the second longest of his career, only behind a 10-gamer from September 30, 2022-May 19, 2023.
- ☞ Threw 102 pitches, marking the third time he has eclipsed the century mark this season...Twins starting pitchers have thrown 100-plus pitches 13 times this season, second most in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL (16).

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his 13th start of the season on June 1 vs. Chicago-AL opposite right-hander David Sandlin...earned his fourth win of the season, allowing four runs on eight hits – including home runs from Andrew Benintendi and Miguel Vargas – in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and matched a season high with nine strikeouts, as the Twins took the series-opening win against the White Sox by a score of 9-6 at Target Field.

- ☞ The start was Joe's third consecutive of nine strikeouts and zero walks, becoming the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-) to go three consecutive starts with that line...also was the 10th time in his career he has done that, which moves him within three of Johan Santana (13) for the most such starts in Twins history (1961-).

CARD DEALER: This will mark Ryan's third career start against St. Louis...he is 0-1 with an 8.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 8 ER), one walk, nine strikeouts, four home runs allowed, a 1.67 WHIP and a .350 (14-for-40) BAA...the start will be his first against the Cardinals at Target Field, with his previous two both coming at Busch Stadium.

- ☞ In his most recent bout with the Cardinals on March 29, 2025 in St. Louis, Joe did not factor into the decision, pitching 5.0 innings of one-run, five-hit ball, with no walks and five strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Redbirds 5-1.
- ☞ Joe has received just one run of support from the Twins offense in his two career outings against St. Louis...the Twins are 0-2 against St. Louis when he pitches and have been outscored 12-4 in those contests.

I'M OUT OF YOUR LEAGUE: Today marks Joe's 36th career start against an opponent from the National League...he is 11-14 with a 4.44 ERA (186.2 IP, 92 ER), 43 walks, 211 strikeouts, a 1.15 WHIP and a .239 (172-for-720) BAA.

- ☞ In 16 career Interleague starts at Target Field, Joe is 7-4 with a 2.67 ERA (87.2 IP, 26 ER), 22 walks, 94 strikeouts and a 1.02 WHIP.
- ☞ This season, he is 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 18 strikeouts in three starts in Interleague Play (vs. CIN, at NYM, vs. MIL).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 62 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.89 ERA (344.1 IP, 149 ER), 77 walks and 363 strikeouts, compared to 29-19 with a 3.54 ERA (373.1 IP, 247 ER), 87 walks and 440 strikeouts in 67 home appearances (66 starts).

- ☞ **YES WAY, JOSÉ:** Tonight's start will be Joe's 67th career start at Target Field, tying him with José Berríos for second most in Target Field history (2010-)...Kyle Gibson has made the most career starts in this ballpark with 96.
- ☞ In eight starts at Target Field this season, Ryan is 3-2 with a 2.61 ERA (41.1 IP, 12 ER), eight walks, 50 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and a .215 (34-for-158) BAA.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .206/.262/.359 (35-for-170) with eight doubles, six home runs, eight walks and 46 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .217/.264/.313 (25-for-115) with eight doubles, one home run, eight walks and 38 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .215/.274/.383 (288-for-1,341) with 91 walks and 339 strikeouts (3.73 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .226/.273/.413 (306-for-1,351) with 73 walks and 464 strikeouts (6.36 K/BB).

- ☞ Ryan's 6.36 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Ryan ranks eighth among major league pitchers with a .140 (6-for-43) BAA on his curveball and is seventh with a 41.3 strikeout percentage on the pitch (min. 40 plate appearances).
- ☞ Opponents are hitting .125 (3-for-24) against Joe's split finger, tied for the third lowest opponent batting average against the split finger in Major League Baseball (min. 100 pitches).
- ☞ Joe has an overall pitching run value of 13, which falls within the league's 96th percentile, and is tied for the seventh highest in the American League.

800 AND COUNTING: Ryan recorded his 800th career strikeout in his last outing on June 6 vs. Kansas City, striking out Kyle Isbel in the third inning...he became the 13th pitcher in Twins/Senators franchise history (1901-) to reach the 800-strikeout mark.

- ☞ Joe reached this milestone in his 129th career game, the fastest to reach the 800-strikeout mark in Twins/Senators history, surpassing National Baseball and Twins Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (138 games).
