THE TWINS: Began their short three-game homestand/series with a win over the Cardinals last night...today, Minnesota will continue the series with the second of three against the Cardinals...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Texas for a six-game, seven-day roadtrip and play three games against the Rangers and three games against Arizona.

HERO BALL ALL NIGHT LONG: The Twins beat the Cardinals last night at Target Field by a score of 9-8, earning their first victory of the season when trailing after the seventh inning (1-29)... Joe Ryan was the starter, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Byron Buxton, who hit his 21st home run of the season and doubled twice (11, 12)...Kody Clemens hit a three-run jimmy jack in the seventh inning to tie the game at 7-7...Royce Lewis hit a solo home run in the eighth inning to tie the game at 8-8 and Brooks Lee hit a home run two batters later to give the Twins the lead...Andrew Morris entered to save his second career game with a scoreless ninth.

HOUSE OF CARDS: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the 43rd, 44th and 45th times in their history during the regular season this weekend...Twins are 21-22 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997)...in the regular season, the Twins are 7-3 all-time against the Cardinals at Target Field (since 2010), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998-2000), 2-7 at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and 8-10 at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23). Last night's win snapped a five-game losing streak to the Cardinals and marked Minnesota's first win over St. Louis since a 6-0 victory (Lopez over Gray) on August 24, 2024 at Target Field. Josh Bell has played 93 career games against the Cardinals, hitting 11 home runs with 53 RBI...over his last 14 games against the Cardinals, he is hitting .292 (14-for-48) with six doubles, one home run, eight RBI, six walks, a .364 on-base percentage and an .843 OPS.

EXTRA BUCKS: Byron Buxton homered in the first inning last night, doubled in the fourth and doubled again in the sixth, marking his 75th career game with multiple extra-base hits, tying Joe Mauer for fifth-most such games in club history (since 1961)...below are the all-time leaders (since 1961):

ADDITIONALLY: Was Buck's ninth career game with three-plus extra-base hits, matching Torii Hunter and Kirby Puckett (9) for second most in Twins history (since 1961), trailing only Eddie Rosario (10).

THE BEAT ON BUCK: Over his last 35 games, since April 25, Byron Buxton is hitting .300 (42-for-140) with eight doubles, 16 home runs, 26 RBI, a .364 on-base percentage, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.064 OPS.

In 29 home games this season, he is hitting .310 (35-for-113) with 12 home runs, a .690 slugging percentage and a 1.081 OPS. Over his last 162 games (since April 25, 2025), Buck has 51 home runs and 104 RBI. Buxton is on pace for 47 home runs...just three Twins have reached the 40-homer mark: Harmon Killebrew (7x), Brian Dozier (1x) and Nelson Cruz (1x).

PLAYING FAST AND LEWIS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, Royce Lewis has gone 8-for-22 (.364) with one double, two home runs, three RBI, two walks, and has reached base safely in all six...his current five-game hitting streak is a season-long and longest since July 20-26, 2025 (6).

In his last 19 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul (since May 21), Lewis has hit .347 (26-for-75) with five doubles, 10 home runs, 22 RBI, a .412 on-base percentage, an .813 slugging percentage and a 1.225 OPS...in that span defensively, he has started nine games at third base, six at first base and three at second base.

THE LEFTORIUM: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 24th time...they have gone 10-13 against left-handed starters...their last game vs. a lefty starter was a 6-4 win on Wednesday night at Detroit, against Framber Valdez.

The 23 lefty starters faced are tied with Cleveland for third-most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (25) and Atlanta (29). Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .340 (18-for-53) with a .916 OPS vs. lefties. Since May 8, Luke Keaschall is hitting .320 (8-for-25) against lefties.

JOGGING OR YOGGING, IT MIGHT BE A SOFT J: Twins have homered 17 times over their last eight games, since June 4...since that date, they rank tied with Milwaukee for second-most in baseball, trailing the Athletics (24). Those 17 home runs have accounted for 23 of the club's 37 runs in that span (62%). Twins have homered in five-straight games at home, their longest streak of the season and longest here since July 27-August 8, 2025 (5).

KODE RED (HOT): Over his last 29 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .295 (33-for-112) with 10 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 15 RBI, 17 runs scored, a .325 on-base percentage, a .607 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS.

Last night marked his 10th home run, reaching double-digit totals for the second-straight season after hitting 19 in 2025. He has reached base safely in 21 of his last 22 home games, posting a .378 on-base percentage in that span with a .975 OPS. Over his last five home games, he is 8-for-19 (.421) with two doubles and three home runs.

GOOD DAY FOR MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): With a win today, the Twins will earn their ninth series victory of the season...they have gone 8-13-1 in series play, 5-4-1 at home and 3-9-0 on the road.

Twins last series win over the Cardinals was August 1-3, 2023 at Busch Stadium...they have gone 0-2-0 in series play vs. St. Louis since. Twins have won just one series vs. an NL opponent this season, coming May 12-14 vs. Miami...prior to that, their last series win over an NL opponent was August 19-31, 2025 vs. San Diego...they have gone 1-7-0 against the NL in series play since that Padres series.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2006, Jason Kubel hit a walk-off grand slam against the Red Sox as Johan Santana struck out 13 batters, including the 1,000th K of his career, fanning David Ortiz...in 2017, the Twins set a franchise record with 28 hits in a 20-7 victory over Seattle at Target Field.

- Connor Prielipp is slated to make his 10th career MLB start this afternoon and first against the St. Louis Cardinals.
- In his last outing on June 7 vs. Kansas City, took his fourth loss of the season after allowing two runs on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 4.1 innings pitched.
- Today will be Prielipp's sixth start of the season at home, where he owns a 3.76 ERA; in comparison he has made four road starts with a 7.27 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT: On June 7, Prielipp made his fifth home start of the year against the Kansas City Royals opposite left-hander Noah Cameron...suffered his fourth loss of the season, allowing two runs on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a 6-5 Twins defeat...held the Royals scoreless through his first 3.0 innings, while collecting five strikeouts and allowing one hit (Nick Loftin second inning single)...then gave up one run in the fourth via back-to-back doubles by Vinnie Pasquantino and Loftin...his day concluded following a Carter Jensen single to begin the fifth and a Tyler Tolbert strikeout; Jensen scored later in the inning off Andrew Morris to give the Royals a 2-1 lead.

- STRIKEOUT COMPANY:** Prielipp recorded seven strikeouts in his second consecutive start; has now had seven-or-more strikeouts in three of his first nine career starts (5/16 vs. MIL, 6/2 vs. CWS and 6/7 vs. KC)...through his first nine starts, has recorded 49 total strikeouts, placing him fifth all-time among Twins/Senators pitchers (1901-) for strikeouts through a pitchers first nine career games...he trails Joe Ryan (55), Francisco Liriano (52), David Festa (51) and Bert Blyleven (50).
- Threw a season-low 77 pitches, but 51 were for strikes, giving him a career high 66.2% strike percentage...walked only one Royal hitter (Maikel Garcia in the 1st inning), marking the least amount of walks he has had in a start since his MLB debut on 4/22 at New York-NL.
- With two runs allowed, broke a three-start span (5/22-6/2) in which he had given up four-or-more runs in each start...in nine starts this year, has now allowed two-or-fewer in six of them.

TWO STARTS AGO: On June 2, Prielipp started against the Chicago White Sox for the second consecutive game, marking the first time in his MLB career he has faced a team twice...earned his second win of the season after throwing 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on six hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts.

INCHING UP THERE IN INNINGS: Prielipp has made 13 appearances (12 starts) so far this season for Triple-A St. Paul (four appearances/three starts) and Minnesota (nine starts); in those appearances he has thrown a total of 59.1 innings...here are some numbers showing Prielipp's workload by season since his freshman year at the University of Alabama.

NUMBERS AGAINST INTERLEAGUE OPPONENTS: Prielipp is 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 3 ER), two walks, 14 strikeouts, a .184 (7-for-38) BAA and a 0.90 WHIP in two career starts against the National League (April 22 at NYM and May 16 vs. MIL)...collected a career-high eight strikeouts in his May 16 start against the Brewers, while pitching 6.0 innings and giving up two runs (one earned); with that start earned his first and only MiLB quality start.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through nine games, Prielipp has started five times at home and four times on the road...at Target Field he is 2-2 with a 3.76 ERA (26.1 IP, 11 ER), 10 walks, 31 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP, compared to 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.79 WHIP in his four starts on the road.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through nine MLB starts, lefties are slashing .261/.308/.413 (12-for-46) with four doubles, one home run, four walks and 13 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .235/.324/.361 (28-for-119) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 walks and 36 strikeouts against Prielipp.

THE ARSENAL: In his nine starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

WHIFFING AT THE CURVE: In his last three games, opposing hitters have a .100 (1-for-10) BAA with six strikeouts against Prielipp's curveball...here are some more numbers on the pitch and where it ranks on the Twins staff and among MLB starters (min. 20 PA and 750 total pitches): .160 BAA (2nd/13th), .200 SLG against (1st/10th), 38.3% whiff (2nd/18th), .051 xBA (1st/1st) and .063 xSLG (1st/1st) and barrels (0, 1st/1st).

CHANGING IT UP: Opposing hitters are batting .000 (0-for-6) with a strikeout in Prielipp's last two starts against his changeup; through his first seven starts, opposing hitters had a .368 (7-for-19) BAA with a triple and two home runs.

SLIP 'N SLIDE: Prielipp has thrown his slider 249 times this year, the most of any pitcher on the Twins staff...here are some Twins pitching ranks on the pitch (min. 50 sliders thrown): run value of two (2nd - Bailey Ober, three), a .175 BAA (3rd - Zebby Matthews, .159 and Anthony Banda, .167) and a .257 SLG against (1st).

CAREER NOTES

- Upon call-up, currently ranked fifth in the Twins system (top-ranked pitching prospect), per MLB.com and ranked as the no. 81 prospect in baseball and fourth-best in Twins system by *Baseball America* (highest ranked pitcher)...ranked 94th-best prospect in baseball by *Baseball America* entering 2026.
- In 2025, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combined to go 1-9 with a 4.03 ERA (82.2 IP, 37 ER), 31 walks and 98 strikeouts in 24 appearances (23 starts).
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year...is the fifth left-hander to win the award, joining Francisco Liriano (2005), Andrew Albers (2013), Stephen Gonsalves (2016) and Lewis Thorpe (2018).
- Ranked as having best slider and best changeup among Minnesota minor leaguers.
- Entering 2025, ranked seventh-best prospect in Twins organization by *Baseball America* entering 2025, and 21st by MLB.com.
- Began season at Double-A Wichita and pitched in short spurts, not going beyond the fourth inning and topping out at 76 pitches in a single outing for Wind Surge...despite innings restrictions, struck out at least five batters in nine of 19 starts.
- Among Texas Leaguers with at least 50.0 inning pitched, ranked ninth in the league in strikeout rate (27%) while holding the 13th-lowest walk-rate (7%).
- Named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July after recording a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks (9.0 BB%) and 17 strikeouts (29.0 K%) across four starts.
- Promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 16, where he finished season.
- In 2024, ranked 16th-best prospect in the Twins farm system by *Baseball America* entering 2024 and was 21st by season's end...began season on 60-day Injured List with High-A Cedar Rapids...had rehab assignments with the FCL Twins and Low-A Fort Myers...was reinstated from the Injured List on July 22 and went 0-1, 3.26 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts in seven starts for the Kernels.
- In 2023, ranked as fifth-best prospect in Twins system entering 2023, per MLB.com...split the season between Rookie FCL Twins and High-A Cedar Rapids, posting a 6.75 ERA (6.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and seven strikeouts in two starts, was placed in the Injured List on April 10 with a left forearm strain, missing the remainder of the season...had Tommy John surgery on left elbow, a procedure performed by Dr. James Andrews.
- In 2022, did not begin his professional career immediately after being drafted by Twins in July...ranked as the fourth-best prospect in Twins system by MLB.com.
- Originally selected by Boston in 37th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Tomah High School, but elected to attend University of Alabama...selected by Twins in second round (48th overall) in 2022 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Matt Williams.
- Spent two seasons pitching at the University of Alabama from 2020-21, going 4-1, 0.96 ERA (28.0 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks and 47 strikeouts in seven starts.
