**THE TWINS:** Began their short three-game homestand/series with a split of the first two games against the Cardinals...today, Minnesota will complete the series with the three-game series finale against St. Louis...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Texas to begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip...they will play the Rangers for three games with an off-day on Wednesday, then travel to Arizona to play the Diamondbacks for three games next weekend. **☑** Twins will spend their next off-day on Wednesday in the Dallas-Fort Worth area to avoid congestion near the ballpark, as Croatia and England will play a World Cup soccer match in Arlington, home of the Dallas Cowboys. **☑** Twins have gone 4-6 in rubber games this season...their four wins were April 12 at Toronto, May 10 at Cleveland, May 14 vs. Miami and May 20 vs. Houston...they lost their last chance on Wednesday afternoon at Detroit.

**SATURDAYS ARE FOR THE BIRDS:** The Twins lost to the Cardinals yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-6, evening the series at one game apiece...Connor Prielpp was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...he allowed four of his runs in the first two innings...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Byron Buxton and Royce Lewis...Buxton hit his 22nd home run of the season, Lewis hit his sixth and Luke Keaschall hit his second.

**PLAY YOUR CARDS RIGHT:** Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the 43rd, 44th and 45th times in their history during the regular season this weekend...Twins are 21-23 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997)...in the regular season, the Twins are 7-4 all-time against the Cardinals at Target Field (since 2010), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998-2000), 2-7 at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and 8-10 at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23). **☑** Minnesota's next National League opponent will be the Dodgers for three games at Target Field, from June 22-24. **☑** Did you know...? In the 1987 World Series, radio stud Dan Gladden, hit safely in all seven games against the Cardinals, hitting .290 (9-for-31) with two doubles, one triple, one home run and seven RBI...he hit a grand slam in the fourth inning of Game 1, off Bob Forsch...it's one of two Postseason grand slams in Twins history (Hrbek the other - same series).

**SEND BUCK TO PHILLY:** Yesterday afternoon, Byron Buxton hit his 22nd home run of the season, his fifth over his last seven games...he has hit all 22 home runs over his last 46 games, since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

**FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUCKS:** Over his last 36 games, since April 25, Byron Buxton is hitting .306 (44-for-144) with eight doubles, 17 home runs, 27 RBI, a .367 on-base percentage, a .715 slugging percentage and a 1.082 OPS.

**☑** In 30 home games this season, he is hitting .316 (37-for-117) with 13 home runs, a .709 slugging percentage and a 1.103 OPS...his home slugging percentage ranks second in baseball and his OPS ranks fourth.

**☑** Over his last 162 games (since April 26, 2025), Buck has 51 home runs and 102 RBI. **☑** Buxton is on pace for 49 home runs...just three Twins have reached the 40-homer mark: Harmon Killebrew (7x), Brian Dozier (1x) and Nelson Cruz (1x)...no Twin has ever reached the 50-homer mark...the club record is 49, by Killebrew in 1964 and 1969.

**GREAT DAY FOR MEATLOAF:** With a win today, the Twins will earn their ninth series victory of the season...they have gone 8-13-1 in series play, 5-4-1 at home and 3-9-0 on the road. **☑** Twins last series win over the Cardinals was August 1-3, 2023 at Busch Stadium...they have gone 0-2-0 in series play vs. St. Louis since.

**☑** Twins have won just one series vs. an NL opponent this season, coming May 12-14 vs. Miami...prior to that, their last series win over an NL opponent was August 19-31, 2025 vs. San Diego...they have gone 1-7-0 against the NL in series play since that Padres series.

**LEWIS WITH AN E.I. (UH OH):** Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, Royce Lewis has gone 10-for-26 (.385) with two doubles, three home runs, four RBI, two walks, and has reached base safely in all seven...his current six-game hitting streak is a season-long and longest since July 20-26, 2025 (also 6)...his career-high is nine (September 14, 2023-June 5, 2024).

**☑** In his last 20 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul (since May 21), Lewis has hit .354 (28-for-79) with six doubles, 11 home runs, 23 RBI, a .416 on-base percentage, an .848 slugging percentage and a 1.264 OPS...in that span defensively, he has started nine games at third base, seven at first base and three at second base.

**☑** Lewis has multiple hits in three-straight games for second time in his career.

**YOGGING AROUND THE BASES (MIGHT BE A SOFT J):** Twins have homered 20 times over their last nine games, since June 4...since that date, they rank tied with Milwaukee for second-most in baseball, trailing the Athletics (25).

**☑** Those 20 home runs have accounted for 27 of the club's 43 runs in that span (63%). **☑** Twins have homered in six-straight games at home, their longest streak of the season and longest here since homering in 13-straight at Target Field from June 22-July 12, 2025.

**KODE RED (HOT):** Over his last 30 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .293 (34-for-116) with 10 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 18 runs scored, a .322 on-base percentage, a .595 slugging percentage and a .917 OPS. **☑** He has reached base safely in 22 of his last 23 home games, posting a .372 on-base percentage in that span with a .954 OPS.

**TWINS MILB WEEKLYS:** Twins have named Double-A Wichita outfielder Kala'i Rosario and High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder/catcher Khadim Diaw as co-minor league Players of the Week, and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Riley Quick as their minor league Pitcher of the Week.

**☑** Rosario, 23, homered in back-to-back-to-back games on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, and recorded five hits on Friday at Tulsa, doubling and homering, while driving in four.

**☑** Diaw, 22, played in four games for theernels, hitting .500 (10-for-20) with two doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .1050 slugging percentage and a 1.550 OPS.

**☑** Quick, 22, made the start on Thursday at Lansing, striking out nine of his 21 batters faced...he also allowed three runs on four hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with two walks.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/BYRON BUXTON HISTORY:** In 2015, a 21-year-old from Baxley, GA named Byron Buxton made his major league debut for the Twins, batting ninth and starting in centerfield against the Rangers in Texas...he went 0-for-4 with one run scored as the Twins won, 4-3...Buck got his first career hit the next day in St. Louis, an eighth-inning triple off John Lackey.

- Taj Bradley is slated to make his 13th start of the season and 86th start (88th game) of his career.
- This will be Taj's second career start against the Cardinals, with his lone start against St. Louis coming on August 7, 2024 with Tampa Bay, when he took the loss after allowing five runs on nine hits, with three walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work.
- In his last outing on June 9 at Detroit, Bradley took his third loss of the season, allowing five runs on seven hits (3 HR) in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Tigers 10-4 at Comerica Park.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Taj made his 12th start of the season on June 9 at Detroit opposite right-hander Troy Melton...took his third loss of the season and second consecutive, allowing five runs while matching his season high with seven hits allowed (done two other times, most recently on June 3 vs. Chicago-AL) in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins took their first loss to Detroit this season (previously 4-0) by a score of 10-4 at Comerica Park.

The outing marked the first time Taj has received the loss in back-to-back outings this season and first time doing so since June 29-July 5, 2025, when he took the loss vs. Minnesota and then followed with a loss at Houston with Tampa Bay.

Taj allowed three home runs in the outing (Dillon Dingler solo, Riley Greene solo, Kerry Carpenter two-run), marking the second time this season he has allowed three-or-more home runs in a game (allowed four on April 24 at Tampa Bay)...he is the only Twins pitcher to allow three-or-more home runs in multiple games this season.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Taj made his 11th start of the season on June 3 vs. Chicago-AL opposite right-hander Erick Fedde...took his second loss of the season, allowing four runs while matching his season-high with seven hits allowed (done one other time on April 24 at Tampa Bay) in 4.2 innings pitched...also matched his career high with five walks (done one other time on September 3, 2023 at Cleveland with Tampa Bay) and five strikeouts, as the Twins suffered their first shutout loss of the season by a score of 8-0 at Target Field.

The loss was his first at Target Field since September 17, 2025 vs. New York-AL, snapping a streak of three consecutive home starts without a loss, his longest such streak as a Twin.

**BIRD IS THE WORD:** Taj is slated to make his second career start against St. Louis, with his lone start against the Cardinals coming on August 7, 2024 with Tampa Bay, when he took the loss after allowing five runs on nine hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts, as the Cardinals defeated the Rays 5-2 at Busch Stadium.

The nine hits allowed is tied for his career high (done six times, last on August 24, 2025 at Chicago-AL).

He has faced six Cardinals batters (including players on the Injured List); they are hitting a combined .333 (6-for-18) with three doubles, one home run (Ramón Urias), two walk and three strikeouts.

**OH BOY, HERE COMES THE NATIONAL LEAGUE:** In 23 career starts in Interleague Play, Taj is 6-7 with a 5.08 ERA (118.2 IP, 67 ER), 42 walks, 131 strikeouts, 19 home runs allowed, a 1.31 WHIP and .247 (113-for-457) BAA...he has made 11 starts at home against National League opponents, combining to go 4-3 with a 4.81 ERA (58.0 IP, 31 ER), 19 walks and 66 strikeouts.

In four Interleague starts as a Twin, Taj is 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), nine walks, 25 strikeouts, a 1.14 WHIP and a .195 (15-for-77) BAA...the Twins have a record of 1-3 in those contests.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER):** Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-16 with a 4.91 ERA (218.0 IP, 119 ER), 73 walks, 245 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP in 41 career home starts compared to 12-14 with a 4.57 ERA (232.1 IP, 118 ER), 98 walks, 238 strikeouts and a 1.35 WHIP in 46 road appearances (44 starts).

**SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-1 record with a 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER), nine walks, 27 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP in four home starts compared to a 4-2 record with a 4.39 ERA (41.0 IP, 20 ER), 20 walks, 46 strikeouts and a 1.44 WHIP in eight road starts.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .218/.304/.401 (31-for-142) with eight doubles, six home runs, 18 walks and 46 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .278/.352/.426 (30-for-108) with seven doubles, three home runs, 11 walks and 27 strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

**DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS:** His strikeout percentage of 29.0% with the cutter is the second highest by a pitcher in baseball, trailing only Toronto's Mason Fluharty, whose cutter produces a 29.4 strikeout percentage (min. 50 plate appearances)...he also ranks second with the cutter in whiff percentage (35.1) and sixth in BAA (.213).

**INJURY BUG:** Taj's hot start to his 2026 campaign was interrupted when he was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 9 (retroactive to May 6) with right pectoralis muscle inflammation...he was reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 23 and has made four starts since, but he has not achieved the same success he was enjoying prior to the injury...below is a table displaying his numbers in eight starts prior to his stint on the IL, compared to what he has done in four starts since making his return:

Prior to being placed on the IL on May 9, Taj ranked 10th in the American League in ERA (2.87), sixth in strikeouts (52), was tied for fifth in both wins (4) and games started (5), and was tied for third in win percentage (.800).
