THE TWINS: Completed their three-game homestand/series with a 2-1 series win over the Cardinals, winning games one and three...today, Minnesota will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip...they will play the Rangers for three games with an off-day on Wednesday, then travel to Arizona to play the Diamondbacks for three games next weekend.

ALL ABOUT BRADLEY: The Twins beat the Cardinals on Sunday afternoon by a score of 5-4, their second one-run win of the series...Taj Bradley was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...marked Taj's longest outing since 7.0 innings on April 29 vs. Seattle...Andrew Morris claimed his second win, striking out three batters in 1.0 scoreless inning, while Yoendrys Gómez earned his sixth save (6-for-6, 5 coming with MIN)...the offense recorded 13 hits and were led by Byron Buxton, who had three, including his 13th double...Ryan Kreidler went 2-for-2 off the bench and had the go-ahead RBI in the bottom of the eighth inning with two outs.

NORTH STARS & LONE STARS: The Twins and Rangers are playing the first of six games in 2026...Twins went 3-3 vs. Texas last season, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 10-12 and 2-1 at Globe Life Field from September 23-25.

- ☞ The Twins are 13-7 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, that includes a record of 7-3 in Texas.
- ☞ The Twins are 11-5 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023, 3-1 in 2024 and 2-1 in 2025...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 21-9 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined.
- ☞ Since the start of 2021, 25 of 34 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while 14 games have been decided by one run.
- ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with three doubles, two home runs and a .911 OPS in 10 career games against Texas...he is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles and two home runs in eight games in this ballpark.
- ☞ In 21 games against the Rangers, Victor Caratini is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with nine walks, three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .908 OPS...in 13 games in this ballpark, he is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with two home runs and a .985 OPS.
- ☞ Byron Buxton made his major league debut across the street at Globe Life Park 11 years ago yesterday...he started in centerfield and batted ninth, going 0-for-4 with one run scored.

FED UP: The Twins have selected the contract of outfielder Kyler Fedko from Triple-A St. Paul...Fedko, 26, played in 58 games for the Saints this season, hitting .286 (59-for-206) with 11 doubles, two triples, 15 home runs, 45 RBI, 44 runs scored, a .372 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a .950 OPS...the 6-foot, 215-pound outfielder ranks tied for fourth in the International League in home runs, seventh in OPS, eighth in RBI and OPS, ninth in runs scored, and 10th in extra-base hits and total bases (119)...the Gibsonia, Pennsylvania native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Connecticut...he has played in parts of six minor league seasons in Minnesota's organization, hitting .252 (397-for-1574) with 79 doubles, eight triples, 62 home runs, 234 RBI, 250 walks, 272 runs scored and a .790 OPS.

☞ To make room for Fedko on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated infielder Orlando Arcia for release or assignment.

ANOTHER WEEK GONE BY-RON: Byron Buxton has been named AL Player of the Week for the second time this season (also May 4).

- ☞ In six games, Buck hit .458 (11-for-24) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, two walks, a .500 on-base percentage, a 1.083 slugging percentage and a 1.583 OPS...over the weekend series vs. St. Louis, he recorded three hits, two hits and three hits respectively.
- ☞ He is the fourth player in club history to win the award a club-record four times, joining Kent Hrbek (4x), Joe Mauer (4x) and Kirby Puckett (4x).
- ☞ He homered and stole a base on Wednesday at Detroit, marking his 19th career game to do so...19 such games tied Torii Hunter for most in club history.
- ☞ Buck's previous three times to win the AL POW were: May of this season, June of 2022 and August of 2017.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUCKS: Over his last 37 games, since April 25, Byron Buxton is hitting .315 (47-for-149) with nine doubles, 17 home runs, 28 RBI, a .374 on-base percentage, a .718 slugging percentage and a 1.092 OPS.

- ☞ All 22 of his home runs have come in 47 games since April 13, most in baseball since that date, ahead of Kyle Schwarber (20).
- ☞ On the season, he ranks third in baseball in home runs, trailing Yordan Alvarez (24) and Schwarber (24).

LEFT TURNS: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 25th time...they have gone 10-14 against lefty starters this season...their last game vs. a left-handed starter was a 9-6 loss on Saturday afternoon to St. Louis and Matthew Liberatore...their last win with a lefty starting was a 6-4 victory last Wednesday night at Detroit, against Framber Valdez.

- ☞ The 24 lefty starters faced are tied with Cleveland for third-most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (30) and Philadelphia (27).
- ☞ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .357 (20-for-56) with a .991 OPS vs. lefties.
- ☞ Since May 8, Luke Keaschall is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with an .861 OPS against lefties.

ROYCE ROLLS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, Royce Lewis is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, three walks, and has reached base safely in all eight...his current seven-game hitting streak is a season-long...his career-high is nine (September 14, 2023-June 5, 2024).

- ☞ In his last 21 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul (since May 21), Lewis has hit .354 (29-for-82) with six doubles, 11 home runs, 24 RBI, a .419 on-base percentage, a .829 slugging percentage and a 1.248 OPS.

JUNE BOOM: Twins have homered 21 times over their last 10 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank third in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (27) and Milwaukee (22)...their only homerless game in that 10-game span was the 11-0 shutout in the Detroit finale.

- ☞ Those 21 home runs have accounted for 29 of the club's 48 runs in that span (60%).

GIMME A BELL YEAH: Josh Bell has now hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games, since May 28...over his last 14 games, he is hitting .313 (15-for-48) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .340 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .840 OPS.

A TEXAS SIZED BIRTHDAY: Twins TV analyst - and The Man With The Strongest Hands in Baseball - Trevor Plouffe is celebrating his 40th birthday today...Plouffe is one of two players in Twins history (1961-present) with a multi-homer game on his birthday, the other being Justin Morneau (who did it twice, in 2007 & 2009).
