THE TWINS: After completing their three-game homestand/series with a 2-1 series win over the Cardinals, the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a win over Texas last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Globe Life Field...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow then conclude the series on Thursday afternoon...after their finale in Texas, they will travel to Arizona to play the Diamondbacks for three games over weekend.
 ☞ Twins are off tomorrow to avoid congestion near the ballpark, as Croatia and England will play a World Cup soccer match at the home of the Dallas Cowboys.
 ☞ Twins are 4-2 over their last six games.
 ☞ Twins have won consecutive games and are seeking a three-game winning streak for the first time since winning four-straight from May 20-24.
 ☞ They are seeking consecutive wins on the road for the first time since May 9-24, when they won five-straight away from Minnesota.

TWINS COWBOY UP: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Globe Life Field by a score of 4-2...Mike Paredes made the start, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with no walks and two strikeouts...Taylor Rogers (0.1), Andrew Morris (1.0), Eric Orze (1.2) and Yoendrys Gomez (1.1) combined to pitch 4.1 scoreless innings of relief, with one hit allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just four hits, their fourth win this season when recording four hits-or-fewer...Josh Bell (8) hit a three-run jimmy jack in the first inning and Byron Buxton (23) hit a solo homer in the sixth inning.

LONE STAR STATS: The Twins and Rangers are playing the second of six games in 2026.
 ☞ The Twins are 14-7 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, that includes a record of 8-3 in Texas.
 ☞ The Twins are 12-5 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023, 3-1 in 2024, 2-1 in 2025 and 1-0 in 2026...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 22-9 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined.

☞ Since the start of 2021, 26 of 35 games between these two have been decided by three-or-fewer runs, while 14 games have been decided by one run.
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with three doubles, two home runs and a .911 OPS in 10 career games against Texas...he is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles and two home runs in eight games in this ballpark.
 ☞ In 21 games against the Rangers, Victor Caratini is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with nine walks, three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .908 OPS...in 13 games in this ballpark, he is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with two home runs and a .985 OPS.
 ☞ In 20 career games vs. Texas, Josh Bell is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with eight doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI, nine walks and an .894 OPS...he is hitting .372 (16-for-43) with five doubles, one home run, six walks, a .449 on-base percentage, a .605 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS in 11 games at both Arlington ballparks combined.

CITY OF BUCK-ERLY LOVE: MLB released Phase 1 voting results yesterday afternoon for the 2026 All-Star Game in Philadelphia...Byron Buxton had 497,562 votes, in fourth place among AL outfielders, trailing Aaron Judge (997,460), Mike Trout (926,601) and Cody Bellinger (533,842)...MLB will release their next update on voting results on Monday, June 22...Phase 1 balloting will end at noon (ET) on June 25 with finalists being announced later that evening...last night, Buck hit his 23rd home run of the season, his sixth over his last nine games...he has hit all 23 home runs over his last 48 games, since April 13...since that date, he leads baseball in home runs...below are Buck's AL rankings in a few offensive categories on the season:

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 38 games, since April 25, Byron Buxton is hitting .314 (48-for-153) with nine doubles, 18 home runs, 29 RBI, a .371 on-base percentage, a .725 slugging percentage and a 1.097 OPS.
 ☞ Byron Buxton has homered 10 times in his last 23 road games...he has now homered in seven of his last nine road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS, CWS, DET & TEX); his two misses were the TB and PIT series.
 ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 27 road home runs, tied with Christian Walker for most in baseball since that date.

TWINS WANT THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): Twins are seeking their 10th series victory of the season...they have gone 9-13-1 in series play, 6-4-1 at home and 3-9-0 on the road.
 ☞ Twins last series win at Texas was September 23-25, 2025, winning two of three.
 ☞ Twins have gone 5-1-0 in their last six series against the Rangers, dating back to August of 2023...they haven't lost a series in Texas since July 8-10, 2022 (3-0-0 here since).

SUMMER BAT-NESS: Twins have homered 23 times over their last 11 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (30)...their only homerless game in that 10-game span was the 11-0 shutout in the Detroit finale on June 11.
 ☞ Those 23 home runs have accounted for 33 of the club's 52 runs in that span (63%).

KODE RED (HOT): Over his last 32 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .290 (36-for-124) with 10 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 18 runs scored, a .318 on-base percentage, a .573 slugging percentage and an .890 OPS.
 ☞ Since being acquired in a trade with Philadelphia in late April of 2025, Clemens has 29 home runs in 173 games...his homer total ranks second on the Twins in that span, trailing only Buxton (52).

BELL POWER: Josh Bell has now hit safely in 15 of his last 18 games, since May 28...over his last 15 games, he is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .352 on-base percentage, a .558 slugging percentage and a .910 OPS.
 ☞ Bell has three home runs in his last eight games after going homerless in 18-straight (May 19-June 6).
 ☞ He leads the club in RBI with 43...11 of those RBI have come in his last 10 games.

(GETTING CLOSE TO) WILLING AND ABEL: Mick Abel is scheduled to make his second start on rehab assignment tonight for Triple-A St. Paul with first pitch at 7:07 pm (CT) against Omaha...Abel made his first rehab start on June 10 at Toledo, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts, while throwing 47 pitches...he was placed on the 15-day IL on April 20 with right elbow inflammation.

- Zebby Matthews is due to make his 32nd career start and seventh start of the 2026 season tonight against the Texas Rangers.
- Tonight will mark Zebby's second career start against the Rangers; the other was on September 23, 2025 (his last start of the 2025 season) in which he earned the win in a quality start, throwing 7.0 innings of one-run ball, with zero walks and six strikeouts.
- In his most recent start this season on June 11 at Detroit, took the loss after allowing seven runs on nine hits (3 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

LAST TIME OUT: In his last start on June 11 at Detroit opposite right-hander Keider Montero, Zebby took his fourth loss of the season after allowing seven runs on nine hits (3 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in an 11-0 Twins defeat...allowed runs in four of his six innings pitched (1st - 1, 4th - 3, 5th - 1 and 6th - 2) and home runs in each of his last three innings (Spencer Forkelson two-run homer in the fourth, Gleyber Torres solo shot in the fifth and Colt Keith two-run jack in the sixth)...despite the damage, Matthews managed to stay efficient, needing only 81 pitches (51 for strikes) to work his way through the sixth inning for the fifth time in six MLB starts this season.

⚡ **A START FULL OF SEASON HIGHS:** Zebby's seven runs allowed tied a season high (May 31 at Pittsburgh), his nine hits allowed marked a new season high and his three home runs allowed tied his career high (done twice: August 31, 2024 vs. Toronto and August 11, 2025 at New York-AI).

⚡ **IMPORTANCE OF LIMITING THE LONG BALL:** Through six starts this season, Matthews has given up at least one home run in four of them...below is a breakdown of Zebby's stats this year in games he gives up one-or-more homers compared to when he does not allow a homer:

THROUGH HIS FIRST 31 STARTS: Zebby has allowed 31 home runs through his first 31 career MLB games, making him the fourth pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-) to allow 31-or-more homers through their first 31 career outings...the list includes: Frank Viola (34, 1982-83), Brad Radke (32, 1995-96) and most recently Kevin Slowey (31, 2007-08)...Zebby's 1.82 HR/9 through 31 games is the highest among the four (Viola - 1.70, Radke - 1.48 and Slowey - 1.59).

TWO STARTS AGO: Matthews made his fifth MLB start of the season on June 5 vs. Kansas City opposite right-hander Michael Wacha...recorded his second win of the season and fourth quality start after giving up two runs on five hits, with a career-high tying four walks and two strikeouts in a 5-3 Minnesota win...gave up both of his runs in the first inning via a Bobby Witt Jr. walk and two doubles by Vinnie Pasquantino and Jac Caglianone...in his next 6.0 innings, from the second inning-seventh inning, allowed zero runs on three hits, with three walks and one strikeout.

NUMBERS AGAINST THE RANGERS: In his one career start against the Rangers on September 23, 2025, Zebby tied a career high with 7.0 innings pitched (done four times in career); in those 7.0 quality innings allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with zero walks and six strikeouts...the Twins went on to beat the Rangers 4-1 and Zebby earned his fifth and final win of 2025.

⚡ The only run Zebby allowed in the start came via a leadoff home run by Joc Pederson; Pederson finished the game 1-for-3 with the homer and strikeout...excluding Pederson, current Texas hitters have a combined .174 (4-for-23) BAA off Matthews with one double, zero walks and three strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (SEASON): Matthews has struggled on the road this season, going 0-3 with a 9.37 ERA (16.1 IP, 17 ER), four walks, 17 strikeouts and a .294 (20-for-68) BAA in three road starts compared to a 2-1 record with a 1.80 ERA (20.0 IP, 4 ER), five walks, 13 strikeouts and a .200 (14-for-70) BAA in three starts at home.

⚡ **HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER):** Matthews has gone 5-5 with a 5.65 ERA (71.2 IP, 45 ER), 19 walks, 76 strikeouts and a .296 (86-for-291) BAA in 15 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-9, 5.84 ERA (81.2 IP, 53 ER) with 25 walks, 85 strikeouts and a .278 (93-for-334) BAA in 16 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through six starts this season, lefties are slashing .250/.322/.450 (20-for-80) with four doubles, four home runs, seven walks and 21 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .241/.267/.500 (14-for-58) with three doubles, four home runs, two walks and nine strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his six starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

⚡ **SLIDER SHINES BRIGHT:** Despite giving up nine hits on June 11, Tigers hitters were a combined 0-for-8 with three strikeouts against Zebby's slider...against his other five pitches they combined to hit .500 (9-for-18) with two doubles and three home runs...among Twins pitchers, his .159 (7-for-44) BAA and 39.4% whiff rate with the slider this season ranks first (min. 100 sliders thrown)...additionally, his slider run value is two which ranks third on the Twins, trailing Connor Prielipp and Bailey Ober (both with a run value of three).

⚡ **TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE:** Opposing hitters are batting .143 (2-for-14) against Matthews curveball this season; his .143 BAA and 27.8% put away rate both lead all Twins pitchers (min. 50 curveballs thrown).

⚡ **AROUND THE ZONE:** Zebby continues to keep his walk rate low at 6.0%; that number ranks in the 85th percentile among all pitchers in baseball.

THURSDAY'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2026: 4-3, 3.17 ERA // CAREER: 50-39, 3.72 ERA)
