THE TWINS: Began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with consecutive wins over Texas on Monday and Tuesday night...today, they will play the three-game series finale at Globe Life Field...after today's game, they will travel to Arizona to play the D-backs for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins have won four of their last five and five of their last seven.
 ☞ Twins have won three-straight games and are seeking their first four-game winning streak since May 20-24.
 ☞ They are seeking three-straight wins on the road for the first time since May 9-24, when they won five-straight away from Minnesota.
 ☞ Twins are 5-3 this season following an off-day...their five wins are March 28 at Baltimore, April 21 at New York-NL, May 5 at Washington, May 12 vs. Miami and May 22 at Boston...their three losses are April 1 at Kansas City, April 17 vs. Cincinnati and June 9 at Detroit.

TEXAS TWO STOMP: The Twins beat the Rangers on Tuesday night at Globe Life Field by a score of 12-2, one run short of their season-high (13 on 4/13 vs. BOS) and their largest margin of victory this season...Zebby Matthews (3-4) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded a season-high 17 hits, their most since June 22, 2025 vs. Milwaukee (18)...six different Twins recorded multiple hits, as Trevor Larnach tied his career high with four and Alex Jackson set a career high with three...Larnach and Clemens both homered, as Larnach (4) hit his second career leadoff homer and Clemens (11) hit a three-run shot.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing the third of six games in 2026...Twins will host the Rangers for three games to finish the regular season, from September 25-27 at Target Field.
 ☞ The Twins are 15-7 against the Rangers since the start of 2023, including a record of 9-3 in Texas.
 ☞ The Twins are 13-5 all-time at Globe Life Field, going 3-0 in 2021, 1-2 in 2022, 2-1 in 2023, 3-1 in 2024, 2-1 in 2025 and 2-0 in 2026...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 23-9 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined.
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with three doubles, three home runs and a 1.030 OPS in 13 career games against Texas...he is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with two doubles and three home runs in nine games in this ballpark.
 ☞ In 21 games against the Rangers, Victor Caratini is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with nine walks, three doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .908 OPS...in 13 games in this ballpark, he is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with two home runs and a .985 OPS.
 ☞ In 21 career games vs. Texas, Josh Bell is hitting .312 (24-for-77) with nine doubles, one triple, two home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks and a .919 OPS...he is hitting .383 (18-for-47) with six doubles, one home run, seven walks, a .463 on-base percentage, a .617 slugging percentage and a 1.080 OPS in 12 games at both Arlington ballparks combined.

LOUD HORNS ON THE HIGHWAYS: Over his last 16 road games, Byron Buxton has posted a 1.023 OPS with seven home runs and a .662 slugging percentage.
 ☞ Buxton has homered 10 times in his last 24 road games...he has homered in seven of his last nine road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS, CWS, DET & TEX); his two misses were the TB and PIT series).
 ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 27 road home runs, tied with Christian Walker for most in baseball since that date.

ADDITIONALLY ON LEE: He has not struck out in 33 consecutive plate appearances, the longest active streak in baseball...his last strikeout was June 7 vs. Kansas City, against Noah Cameron in the fifth inning.

SWEEP SOUNDS: Twins are seeking their third sweep of the season today; their other two were a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9 and a three-game sweep of the Red Sox at Fenway Park from May 22-24...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games.
 ☞ Twins are seeking their first sweep of the Rangers since June 18-20, 2021, taking three games in this ballpark.
 ☞ Twins have entered a finale with a chance to sweep four times this season, going 2-2...their two misses were April 15 vs. Boston at Target Field and June 3 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field.

TEXAS SIZED SLUGGER: Josh Bell has hit safely in 16 of his last 19 games, since May 28...over his last 16 games, he is hitting .339 (19-for-56) with four doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .373 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .944 OPS.
 ☞ Bell has multiple hits in each of his last three games, his longest streak since May 28-30, 2025 with Washington (also 3)...his career-long for a multi-hit streak is five, from July 23-27, 2024, with Miami.
 ☞ He leads the club in RBI with 45...13 of those RBI have come in his last 11 games.

JUNE BOOMS: Twins have homered 25 times over their last 12 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank third in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (33) and Milwaukee (26)...their only homerless game in that 12-game span was the 11-0 shutout in the Detroit finale on June 11...those 25 home runs have accounted for 37 of the club's 64 runs in that span (58%).

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOU CLEMENS: Over his last 33 games, Kody Clemens is hitting .297 (38-for-128) with 11 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 19 RBI, 20 runs scored, a .328 on-base percentage, a .602 slugging percentage and a .930 OPS.
 ☞ Since being acquired in a trade with Philadelphia in late April of 2025, Clemens has 30 home runs in 174 games (617 plate appearances)...second-most home runs on the club in that time, trailing only Buxton (52).

ABEL TO TAKE THE NEXT STEP: Mick Abel made his second start on rehab assignment Tuesday night for Triple-A St. Paul against Omaha...Abel allowed two runs (1 earned) on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts, while throwing 61 pitches...he was placed on the 15-day IL on April 20 with right elbow inflammation.

- Is scheduled to make his 16th start of 2026 and 130th start (131st game) of his career.
- In three career starts vs. Texas, he is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (17.1 IP, 4 ER), five walks and 20 strikeouts.
- In his last start on June 12 vs. St. Louis, Ryan made a quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan made his 15th start of the season on June 12 vs. St. Louis opposite right-hander Kyle Leahy...made his team-leading ninth quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits – including a solo home run by Alec Burleson – with no walks and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched, as the Twins erased four different deficits to defeat the Cardinals 9-8 at Target Field.

- His nine quality starts are tied for the second most in the American League this season, only behind Kansas City's Michael Wacha (10)...is also tied for the seventh most in Major League Baseball (Miami's Sandy Alcantara and Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez are tied for the league lead with 11).
- Has allowed a home run in four consecutive starts dating back to May 26 at Chicago-AL, his longest such streak since doing so in four straight from September 6-26, 2025.
- Threw 102 pitches, marking the fourth time he has eclipsed the century mark this season...Twins starting pitchers have thrown 100-plus pitches 15 times this season, second most in MLB behind Los Angeles-NL (17).

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan made his 14th start of the season on June 6 vs. Kansas City opposite right-hander Luinder Avila...made his eighth quality start but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run – courtesy of a leadoff solo home run from Carter Jensen – with six hits allowed, two walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched, as the Twins suffered a 3-2 loss vs. the Royals at Target Field.

- Marked the sixth time this season (excluding his start on May 3 when he was removed after nine pitches due to right elbow soreness) that he has allowed one-or-fewer earned runs in a start.

RYAN, TEXAS RANGER: This will mark Ryan's fourth career start against Texas...he is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (17.1 IP, 4 ER), five walks, 20 strikeouts, three home runs allowed, a 0.87 WHIP and a .172 (10-for-58) BAA...the start will be his first against the Rangers since 2023.

- In his most recent bout with the Rangers on September 1, 2023, Joe earned the win while making a quality start, allowing just one run on three hits – including a solo homer from Corey Seager – with no walks and seven strikeouts in a 5-1 Twins win at Globe Life Field.
- Current Rangers' hitters (including Injured List) are hitting .128 (6-for-47) with one double (Elias Díaz), one home run (Corey Seager), two walks and 18 strikeouts in their career against Ryan.

WILD WILD WEST: Today will mark Joe's 26th career start against an opponent from the American League West...he is 9-10 with a 4.49 ERA (134.1 IP, 67 ER), 40 walks, 168 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and a .231 (117-for-506) BAA.

- This will be his first road start against an AL West opponent since June 14, 2025 at Houston, snapping a streak of four consecutive home starts; fired 7.0 innings of two-run, two-hit ball, with two walks and seven strikeouts in a 3-2 Twins loss at Daiskin Park.
- This season, he is 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), one walk and 15 strikeouts in two starts vs. American League West opponents (vs. Seattle and Houston); both starts have been quality starts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 62 career road starts, Ryan is 21-20 with a 3.89 ERA (344.1 IP, 149 ER), 77 walks and 363 strikeouts, compared to 29-19 with a 3.56 ERA (379.1 IP, 150 ER), 87 walks and 448 strikeouts in 68 home appearances (67 starts).

- In six starts away from Target Field this season, Ryan is 1-1 with a 3.60 ERA (35.0 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 34 strikeouts, a 0.97 WHIP and a .205 (26-for-127) BAA.
- Has not received a road decision since April 11 at Toronto, when he earned the win in a two-run, two-hit performance in 7.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts at Rogers Centre.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: In 2026, lefties are slashing .208/.260/.366 (38-for-183) with eight doubles, seven home runs, eight walks and 52 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties are slashing .222/.265/.310 (28-for-126) with eight doubles, one home run, eight walks and 40 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .215/.274/.383 (291-for-1,354) with 91 walks and 345 strikeouts (3.79 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .227/.273/.412 (309-for-1,362) with 73 walks and 466 strikeouts (6.38 K/BB).

- Ryan's 6.38 K/BB against righties is the sixth highest among all pitchers in Major League Baseball since he made his debut on September 1, 2021 (min. 1,000 batters faced).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan relies on a six-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- Opponents are hitting .103 (3-for-29) against Joe's split finger, which ranks as the second lowest opponent batting average against the split finger in Major League Baseball, only behind San Diego's Jeremieah Estrada, whose split finger has produced a .087 BAA (min. 100 pitches).
- Joe has an overall pitching run value of 13, which falls within the league's 96th percentile, and is tied for the sixth highest in the American League.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Joe has made seven consecutive starts of 6.0 innings-or-more dating back to May 9 at Cleveland, tied with Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski for the second longest active streak in Major League Baseball, only behind Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler (9)...below are some of his numbers during that span and where they rank among American League pitchers:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP CONNOR PRIELIPP (2026: 2-4, 5.26 ERA // CAREER: 2-4, 5.26 ERA)

Left-hander Connor Prielipp is slated to make his 11th start of the season/his career tomorrow in the first game of a three-game weekend set against the Arizona Diamondbacks at Chase Field...in his most recent start on June 13 vs. St. Louis, Prielipp did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts, as the Twins fell to the Cardinals by a score of 9-6 at Target Field...he is 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.79 WHIP and a .324 (23-for-71) BAA in four starts away from Target Field this season...this will be his first career game against the Diamondbacks.
