THE TWINS: Have gone 3-0 through three games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, sweeping the Rangers in Arlington, winning on Monday and Tuesday, then again in the finale on Thursday...tonight, Minnesota will play the first of three against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field through the weekend.
 ☞ Twins have won five of their last six and six of their last eight.

TWINS SWEEP RANGERS! PARTY AT GLADDEN'S!!: The Twins beat the Rangers, by a score of 9-3 yesterday afternoon at Globe Life Field, recording their third sweep of the season...Joe Ryan (5-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits, three apiece from Trevor Larnach and Victor Caratini...Larnach hit his fifth home run of the season, Brooks Lee hit his 12th and Ryan Kreidler hit his fourth...Luke Keaschall also matched a career-best by reaching base four times, going 2-for-2 with two walks.

I WANNA GET STREAKY WITH YOU: Twins have won four-straight games, matching a season-long, done four times now, previously done from May 20-24...their last streak of five-plus was when they won 13-straight, from May 3-17, 2025.
 ☞ Twins are seeking four-straight wins on the road for the first time since May 9-24, when they won five-straight away from Minnesota — two on the back end of a roadtrip at Cleveland, then three to start the next roadtrip in Boston.

DUEL IN THE DESERT: The Twins and D-backs are playing each other for the 34th, 35th and 36th times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 20-13 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 9-3 at Target Field (2014-25) and 7-8 at Chase Field (2004-24).
 ☞ These two last met for three games at Target Field from September 12-14, 2025, as the Twins won just the first game.

☞ The Twins last visited Phoenix for three games from June 25-27, 2024, winning the second and third games of the three-game series...they outscored the D-backs 25-14 in that series.
 ☞ Minnesota's .606 winning percentage against the D-backs is their second-highest all-time against any opponent... .656 (21-11) vs. San Diego is the highest.
 ☞ Twins are 12-5 in their last 17 against the D-backs, dating back to September of 2014.
 ☞ Twins have homered 30 times in their last 15 games against Arizona (since 2017).
 ☞ All-time at Chase Field, the Twins have scored 6.1 runs-per-game, including 6.5 runs-per-game over their last two series' here (2022 & '24).

BROOKS LEE: Brooks Lee has not struck out in 38 consecutive plate appearances, the longest active streak in baseball...his last strikeout was June 7 vs. Kansas City, against Noah Cameron in the fifth inning...marks the longest streak for a Twin since Jay France's 42-straight plate appearances, from April 2-13, 2025; next is Nick Gordon with 46 from 2022-23 (source: Elias)... additionally, below are Lee's road numbers compared to his home numbers:

SNAKE BITES: Notable individuals against the Diamondbacks:
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .348 (16-for-46) with three doubles, two triples, four home runs, eight RBI, a .761 slugging percentage and a 1.153 OPS in 11 career games vs. the D-backs...in this ballpark, he is 9-for-19 (.474) with two doubles and three home runs in five games.
 ☞ Josh Bell played in 41 games for the D-Backs after the 2024 trade deadline...he was traded to Arizona from Miami on July 30 of that season...he hit .279 (39-for-140) with five doubles, five home runs, 22 RBI and a .706 OPS...in 47 career games at this ballpark, he is slashing .299/.400/.474 (.874 OPS) with five home runs and 30 RBI.
 ☞ In 12 career games vs. the D-Backs, Kody Clemens is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.086 OPS...he homered three times against Arizona last season, on September 12 — homers off Brandon Pfaadt twice and Jake Woodford once.

BURST IN THE FIRST: Twins scored four first-inning runs yesterday in Texas...they finished the Rangers series by scoring nine first inning runs (3, 2, 4)...they have scored in the first inning in five of their last nine games.
 ☞ Nine runs marked the most the Twins have scored in the first innings of a series (3 games-or-fewer) since August 18-20, 2017 vs. Arizona (also 9) — h/t Twins Radio Network.

HITTING HEAT ADVISORY: Twins have homered 28 times over their last 13 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (35)...their only homerless game in that 12-game span was the 11-0 shutout in the Detroit finale on June 11...those 28 home runs have accounted for 43 of the club's 73 runs in that span (59%).

BUCK TRUCK, PULLING UP IN PHOENIX: Over his last 17 road games, Byron Buxton has posted a .952 OPS with seven home runs and a .614 slugging percentage...in those 17, he has reached safely in 14, posting a .271 average and a .338 on-base percentage.
 ☞ Buxton enters this Arizona series having homered in seven of his last nine road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS, CWS, DET & TEX); his two misses were the TB and PIT series).
 ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 27 road home runs, tied with Christian Walker for most in baseball since that date.

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGIN': Josh Bell has hit safely in 17 of his last 20 games, since May 28...over his last 17 games, he is hitting .350 (21-for-60) with four doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, a .391 on-base percentage, a .567 slugging percentage and a .957 OPS.
 ☞ Bell has multiple hits in each of his last four games, his longest streak since July 23-27, 2024, with Miami — which is also his career-best.
 ☞ He leads the club in RBI with 46...14 of those RBI have come in his last 12 games.

LARNING TO FLY: Over his last three games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .571 (8-for-14) with two home runs, four RBI, an 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.571 OPS...he has reached base safely in seven of his last 11 plate appearances since Tuesday night in Arlington.

ROJAS REHAB: Left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas began his rehab assignment last night with Triple-A St. Paul...Rojas allowed five runs on five hits in 1.1 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout, while throwing 33 pitches...he averaged 96.2 mph on his four-seam fastball...Rojas was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 29 with left elbow inflammation.

RIP, AL WORTHINGTON: Former Twins pitcher Al Worthington passed away yesterday at the age of 97...Worthington pitched 14 MLB seasons from 1953-69, finishing his career with the Twins from 1965-69...he ranks seventh on the Twins all-time saves list with 88.

- Connor Prielipp is slated to make his 11th career MLB start tonight and first against the Arizona Diamondbacks.
- In his last outing on June 13 vs. St. Louis, Prielipp did not factor into the decision after allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched.
- Tonight will be Prielipp's fifth road start; he currently has a 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER) on the road compared to a 4.18 ERA (32.1 IP, 15 ER) in six home starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Prielipp made his 10th start of the season on June 13 vs. St. Louis opposite Cardinals left-hander Matthew Liberatore...did not factor into the decision, a 9-6 Minnesota defeat, after allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...all four of Prielipp's runs came in the first two frames via an Ivan Herrera two-run homer in the first and three Cardinals hits in the second (Blaze Jordan - triple, Pedro Pagés - double and Nathan Church - single)...from the third-sixth inning pitched 4.0 scoreless, allowing only three hits.

- The 6.0 innings pitched for Prielipp matched his career high (done twice: June 2 vs. CWS and May 16 vs. MIL); each of those three outings have come at home - has yet to pitch into the sixth inning on the road (longest outing - 5.0 IP at CLE on May 8).
- The first-inning blast by Herrera snapped a career-high four-start streak in which Prielipp did not allow a homer...it had been 82 at-bats since he allowed his last homer (Jackson Chourio - MIL on May 16).
- Prielipp tossed a career-high 98 pitches (66 for strikes) against the Cardinals...has now thrown 90-or-more pitches in three of his last four starts and in five of 10 starts this season; heading into this season, had never thrown more than 90 pitches in a start during his professional or collegiate career...**(see Innings and Pitches note below).**

TWO STARTS AGO: On June 7, Prielipp made his fifth home start of the year against the Kansas City Royals opposite left-hander Noah Cameron...suffered his fourth loss of the season, allowing two runs on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in a 6-5 Twins defeat...held the Royals scoreless through his first 3.0 innings, while collecting five strikeouts and allowing one hit (Nick Loftin second inning single)...then gave up one run in the fourth via back-to-back doubles by Vinnie Pasquantino and Loftin...his day ended following a Carter Jensen single to begin the fifth and a Tyler Tolbert strikeout; Jensen scored later in the inning off Andrew Morris to give the Royals a 2-1 lead.

INCHING UP THERE IN INNINGS AND PITCHES: Prielipp has made 14 appearances (13 starts) so far this season for Triple-A St. Paul (four games/three starts) and Minnesota (10 starts); in those appearances he has thrown a total of 65.1 innings...here are some numbers showing Prielipp's workload by season since his freshman year at the University of Alabama.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through 10 games, Prielipp has started six times at home and four times on the road...at Target Field he is 2-2 with a 4.18 ERA (32.1 IP, 15 ER), 12 walks, 33 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP, compared to 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.79 WHIP in his four starts on the road.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through 10 MLB starts, lefties are slashing .255/.298/.392 (13-for-51) with four doubles, one home run, four walks and 13 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .250/.338/.404 (34-for-136) with five doubles, two triples, four home runs, 16 walks and 38 strikeouts against Prielipp.
