THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, sweeping the Rangers in Arlington (Monday, Tuesday & Thursday), followed by a loss against the D-backs in Phoenix last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three against the Diamondbacks at Chase Field...after tomorrow's series finale, the Twins will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Dodgers (Monday-Wednesday) and three against the Rockies (next weekend).
 ☞ Twins have won four of their last five and six of their last nine.

CHASE IS NOT THE PLACE: The Twins lost to the Diamondbacks last night at Chase Field by a score of 9-5...Connor Prielipp (2-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing six runs (3 earned) on nine hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and four strikeouts...the Twins held a 3-1 lead entering the fifth inning, but the D-backs outscored the Twins 8-2 in the final five innings...the offense recorded nine hits, walked five times and struck out just six times...three of the hits were homers from Victor Caratini (5), Josh Bell (9) and Royce Lewis (7).

SNAKE BITS: The Twins and D-backs are playing each other for the 34th, 35th and 36th times in their history this weekend...the Twins have gone 20-14 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 9-3 at Target Field (2014-25) and 7-9 at Chase Field (2004-26).
 ☞ Minnesota's .588 winning percentage (20-14) against the D-backs is their second-highest all-time against any NL opponent... .656 (21-11) vs. San Diego is the highest.
 ☞ Twins are 12-6 in their last 18 against the D-backs, dating back to September of 2014.
 ☞ Twins have homered 33 times in their last 16 games against Arizona (since 2017).
 ☞ All-time at Chase Field, the Twins have scored 6.1 runs-per-game, including 6.3 runs-per-game here since 2022.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .360 (18-for-50) with three doubles, two triples, four home runs, eight RBI, a .740 slugging percentage and a 1.151 OPS in 12 career games vs. the D-backs...in this ballpark, he is 11-for-23 (.478) with two doubles and three home runs in six games.
 ☞ In 13 career games vs. the D-backs, Kody Clemens is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and a 1.012 OPS.

BROO S LEE: Brooks Lee has not struck out in 42 consecutive plate appearances, the longest active streak in baseball...his last strikeout was June 7 vs. Kansas City, against Noah Cameron in the fifth inning...marks the longest streak for a Twin since Ty France's 42-straight plate appearances, from April 2-13, 2025; next is Nick Gordon with 46 from 2022-23 (source: Elias)... additionally, below are Lee's road numbers compared to his home numbers:

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need wins tonight and tomorrow to earn their 11th series victory of the season...they have gone 10-13-1 in series play, 6-4-1 at home and 4-9-0 on the road.
 ☞ Twins are 7-4-0 all-time in series play against Arizona, 3-2-0 all-time at Chase Field...they are seeking their first series win over the D-backs since June 25-27, 2024 at Chase Field.
 ☞ Twins are 2-5-0 vs. NL opponents in series play this season, their two wins being May 12-14 vs. Miami & June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
 ☞ Minnesota's last series win vs. an NL opponent on the road was May 16-18, 2025, taking two of three at Milwaukee...they are 0-8-0 away from Minnesota vs. the NL since.
 ☞ Twins are seeking their third-straight series win...their last stretch as long as April 6-15, winning series over the Tigers, Blue Jays and Red Sox.

BUCK TRUCK PARKING: Over his last 18 road games, Byron Buxton has posted a .962 OPS with seven home runs and a .608 slugging percentage...in those 18, he has reached safely in 15, posting a .284 average and a .354 on-base percentage.
 ☞ Buxton entered the Arizona series having homered in seven of his last nine road series (NYM, WAS, CLE, BOS, CWS, DET & TEX); his two misses were the TB and PIT series).
 ☞ Since June 17, 2025, Buck has hit 27 road home runs, tied with Christian Walker for most in baseball since that date.

24 CARAT MAGIC IN THE AIR: Victor Caratini has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games, hitting .370 (17-for-46) with four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, seven walks, a .455 on-base percentage, a .652 slugging percentage and a 1.107 OPS in that span.
 ☞ Through two games on this roadtrip, he is 4-for-6 with two walks.

COOL HANDS LUKE: Over his last 18 games, Luke Keaschall is hitting .310 (18-for-58) with two doubles, one home run, six RBI, 12 runs scored, nine walks, a .406 on-base percentage and an .802 OPS.
 ☞ On the season, Keaschall's slashing .296/.393/.339 on the road and .216/.287/.328 at home.

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGIN': Josh Bell has hit safely in 18 of his last 21 games, since May 28...over his last 18 games, he is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with four doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, a .382 on-base percentage, a .594 slugging percentage and a .976 OPS.
 ☞ He leads the club with 47 RBI...15 of those RBI have come in his last 13 games.

SUMMER HEATING: Twins have homered 31 times over their last 14 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (39)...their only homerless game in that 12-game span was the 11-0 shutout in the Detroit finale on June 11...those 31 home runs have accounted for 46 of the club's 78 runs in that span (59%).

'PENMANSHIP: Over their last five games, the Twins bullpen has allowed six runs on 15 hits in 14.2 innings pitched, posting an ERA of 3.68...in that span, they have also walked just four batters, struck out 20 (12.3 K/9.0 IP) and held opponents to a .259 batting average.

- Taj Bradley is slated to make his 14th start of the season and 87th start (89th game) of his career.
- This will be Taj's third career start against the Diamondbacks; is 0-1, 9.00 ERA (10.0 IP, 10 ER) with three walks, five strikeouts, a 1.70 WHIP and a .333 (14-for-42) BAA in his career vs. Arizona.
- In his last outing on June 14 vs. St. Louis, Bradley did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts, as the Twins clinched the series with a 5-4 win at Target Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Taj made his 13th start of the season on June 14 vs. St. Louis opposite right-hander Michael McGreevy...did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits — including a pair of homers from Alec Burleson (solo) and JJ Wetherholt (two-run) — in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts, as the Twins rallied to take the series from the Cardinals with a 5-4 win at Target Field.

- The outing marked his longest since pitching a season-high 7.0 innings on April 29 vs. Seattle.
- Has allowed multiple homers in back-to-back games (3 HR on June 9 at Detroit), his first time doing so as a Twin and third time in his career (September 5-10, 2024 and September 8-13, 2023, both with Tampa Bay).

TWO STARTS AGO: Taj made his 12th start of the season on June 9 at Detroit opposite right-hander Troy Melton...took his third loss of the season and second consecutive, allowing five runs while matching his season high with seven hits allowed (done two other times, most recently on June 3 vs. Chicago-AL) in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins took their first loss to Detroit this season (previously 4-0) by a score of 10-4 at Comerica Park.

- The outing marked the first time Taj has received the loss in back-to-back outings this season and first time doing so since June 29-July 5, 2025, when he took the loss vs. Minnesota and then followed with a loss at Houston with Tampa Bay.
- Taj allowed three home runs in the outing (Dillon Dingler solo, Riley Greene solo, Kerry Carpenter two-run), marking the second time this season he has allowed three-or-more home runs in a game (allowed four on April 24 at Tampa Bay)...he is the only Twins pitcher to allow three-or-more home runs in multiple games this season.

DUELING IN THE DESERT: Taj is slated to make his third career start against Arizona, with all three coming at Chase Field...he is 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (10.0 IP, 10 ER), three walks, five strikeouts, five home runs allowed, a 1.70 WHIP and a .333 (14-for-42) BAA in his career against the Diamondbacks.

- In his most recent bout with Arizona on April 23, 2025 with Tampa Bay, Taj did not factor into the decision despite making a quality start, allowing three runs on six hits — including a solo homer from Corbin Carroll — in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts in a 7-6 Rays win.
- He has faced nine Arizona batters (including players on the Injured List); they are hitting a combined .323 (10-for-31) with one double (Geraldo Perdomo), three home runs (Corbin Carroll x2, Ketel Marte), four walks and four strikeouts.

OH BOY, HERE COMES THE NATIONAL LEAGUE: In 24 career starts in Interleague Play, Taj is 6-7 with a 5.10 ERA (125.1 IP, 71 ER), 43 walks, 138 strikeouts, 21 home runs allowed, a 1.28 WHIP and a .244 (118-for-483) BAA...he has made 12 starts on the road against National League opponents, combining to go 2-4 with a 5.34 ERA (60.2 IP, 36 ER), 23 walks and 65 strikeouts.

- In five Interleague starts as a Twin, Taj is 1-0 with a 4.23 ERA (27.2 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks, 32 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .194 (20-for-103) BAA...the Twins have a record of 2-3 in those contests.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Over the course of his career, Bradley is 12-16 with a 4.93 ERA (224.2 IP, 123 ER), 74 walks, 252 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP in 42 career home starts compared to 12-14 with a 4.57 ERA (232.1 IP, 118 ER), 98 walks, 238 strikeouts and a 1.35 WHIP in 46 road appearances (44 starts).

- SO FAR IN 2026:** This year, he owns a 1-1 record with a 3.82 ERA (30.2 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks, 34 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP in five home starts compared to a 4-2 record with a 4.39 ERA (41.0 IP, 20 ER), 20 walks, 46 strikeouts and a 1.44 WHIP in eight road starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters have slashed .224/.307/.429 (35-for-156) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 19 walks and 50 strikeouts against Bradley, while righties are hitting .258/.328/.392 (31-for-120) with seven doubles, three home runs, 11 walks and 30 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: So far this season, Bradley has used a four-pitch mix, here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

DEATH BY A THOUSAND CUTS: His strikeout percentage of 31.1% with the cutter leads all pitchers in Major League Baseball (min. 50 plate appearances)...he also ranks second with the cutter in whiff percentage (37.2) and sixth in BAA (.200).

INJURY BUG: Taj's hot start to his 2026 campaign was interrupted when he was placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 9 (retroactive to May 6) with right pectoralis muscle inflammation...he was reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 23 and has made five starts since, but he has not achieved the same success he was enjoying prior to the injury...below are his numbers in eight starts prior to going on the IL, compared to what he has done in five starts since making his return:
