THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, sweeping the Rangers in Arlington (Monday, Tuesday & Thursday), followed by a split of the first two games in Phoenix this weekend...today, Minnesota will complete the roadtrip with the three-game series finale at Chase Field...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Dodgers (Monday-Wednesday) and three against the Rockies (Friday-Sunday).

☞ Twins have won five of their last six and seven of their last 10.
☞ Twins have gone 5-6 in rubber games this season...their five wins were April 12 at Toronto, May 10 at Cleveland, May 14 vs. Miami, May 20 vs. Houston and June 14 vs. St. Louis.

VALLEY OF THE FUN: The Twins beat the Diamondbacks last night at Chase Field by a score of 16-8, setting season-highs in both runs and hits...Taj Bradley (6-3) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 20 hits, while four Twins had three-plus hits — Lee - 4, Caratini - 3, Keaschall - 3 and Kreidler - 3...Byron Buxton hit his third career grand slam in the 10-run fifth inning.

☞ Twins scored 10 runs off 10 hits in the fifth inning...the 10 hits tied a club record, done twice previously (5/20/1994 vs. BOS — 5th inn & 8/17/73 at CLE — 2nd inn).

ROJAS RETURNS: The Twins have returned left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas from his rehab assignment and have reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Rojas, who was placed on the 15-day IL on May 29 with left elbow inflammation, made one appearance on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul on June 18 vs. Omaha...he allowed five runs on five hits in 1.1 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout.
☞ To make room for Rojas on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Justin Lawrence for release or assignment.

CACTUS GAMES: The Twins and D-backs are playing each other for the 36th time in their history today...the Twins have gone 21-14 all-time against Arizona, going 4-2 at the Metrodome (2003-08), 9-3 at Target Field (2014-25) and 8-9 at Chase Field (2004-26).

☞ Minnesota's .600 winning percentage (21-14) against the D-backs is their second-highest all-time against any NL opponent... .656 (21-11) vs. San Diego is the highest.
☞ Twins are 13-6 in their last 19 against the D-backs, dating back to September of 2014.
☞ Twins have homered 34 times in their last 17 games against Arizona (since 2017).
☞ All-time at Chase Field, the Twins have scored 6.2 runs-per-game, including 6.8 runs-per-game here since 2022.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are looking to win their 11th series of the season...they have gone 10-13-1 in series play, 6-4-1 at home and 4-9-0 on the road.

☞ Twins are 7-4-0 all-time in series play against Arizona, 3-2-0 all-time at Chase Field...they are seeking their first series win over the D-backs since June 25-27, 2024 at Chase Field.
☞ Twins are 2-5-0 vs. NL opponents in series play this season, their two wins being May 12-14 vs. Miami & June 12-14 vs. St. Louis.
☞ Minnesota's last series win vs. an NL opponent on the road was May 16-18, 2025, taking two of three at Milwaukee...they are 0-8-0 away from Minnesota vs. the NL since.
☞ Twins are seeking their third-straight series win...their last stretch as long as April 6-15, winning series over the Tigers, Blue Jays and Red Sox.

BROO S LEE: Brooks Lee has not struck out in 48 consecutive plate appearances, the longest active streak in baseball...his last strikeout was June 7 vs. Kansas City, against Noah Cameron in the fifth inning...marks the longest streak for a Twin since Andreilton Simmons went 48-straight from July 17-31, 2021...after that would be Williams Astudillo with 55 from September 1-26, 2018 (source: *Elias*).
☞ Lee's 6.6 strikeout % this month leads the AL and ranks third-best in baseball, trailing Luis Arraez (4.9%) and Jung Hoo Lee (5.8%).

HEAT ADVISORY: Twins have homered 32 times over their last 15 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (39)...their only homerless game in that 15-game span was the 11-0 shutout in the Detroit finale on June 11.
☞ Those 32 home runs have accounted for 50 of the club's 94 runs in that span (53%).
☞ Twins rank second in the AL this month in slugging percentage (.502) and third in baseball, trailing the Athletics (.506) and Rockies (.503).
☞ Over five games this roadtrip, the Twins have hit .326 (63-for-193) with 11 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 46 runs scored (9.2 R/G) and a .966 OPS.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Eduardo Tait and Double-A Wichita catcher Andrew Cossetti as Twins co-minor league Players of the Week, and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher C.J. Culppepper as their minor league Pitcher of the Week.
☞ Tait, 19, went 8-for-24 with three home runs and 11 RBI for the Kernels...he recorded five RBI on Tuesday and six RBI on Thursday — both vs. Beloit.
☞ Cossetti, 26, went 8-for-23 with four home runs and 12 RBI, including six walks in six games for the Wind Surge...he drove in multiple RBI in four-straight games, from Sunday-Wednesday.
☞ Culppepper, 24, made three relief appearances for the Saints during the week, allowing one unearned run, on two hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts.

WHO'S YOUR DADDY: Twins are 35-32 all-time on Father's Day (since 1961)...last season, they lost on Father's Day by a score of 2-1 in 10 innings at Houston...Brooks Lee had three hits, including a home run...their last Father's Day win was a 6-2 victory over Oakland in 2024.
